





- For DOH Dengue School-Based Immunization, the vaccine will be given to children 9 years of age and older who are in Grade IV.
- Your child will be given 3 doses of Dengue vaccine at 6 months interval.
- Only trained health workers will vaccinate your child.
- Kindly bring your child's immunization card every vaccination schedule.
- Remember the next scheduled immunization visits.
- Not like any vaccine, your child may experience mild and temporary reactions.

If symptoms persist, immediately bring the child to nearest health facility.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Keep Dengvaxia Identification card as proof of identification that he/she is a vaccinee. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Don't seek alternative medicines instead go to the nearest health facility for medical consultation/ check-up.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Cooperate with all DOH personnel conducting profiling and monitoring (5 years) of Dengvaxia recipients . 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Do not lost Dengvaxia Identification card as this will be used for hospital check-up, admissions, etc. to government hospitals or authorized private hospitals or for any other purposes.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Involve children and communities in dengue education to empower them in their own care , avoid self- medication, identify warning signs and symptoms, etc. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Seek admission at any government hospital to ensure a No Balance Billing policy among vaccinees.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Prevention is better than cure. SUPPORT 4s : <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Search and destroy. 2. Self-Protection measures. 3. Seek early consultation. 4. Say no to indiscriminate fogging. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Keep watch for any unusualities e.g. fever, rashes, joint pains, etc. and bring child to nearest health facility e.g. Barangay Health Station/Center, Rural Health Unit, City Health Office, etc. for medical check up/consultation.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Go to your respective RHU's/CHO's for proper endorsement. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Present Dengvaxia card upon consultation/ admission to avail of medical services in government and partner private hospitals.
