Philippine COVID-19 Vaccine Deployment and Vaccination Campaign

Roll-out of Coronavac (Sinovac) Vaccines in Metro Manila

The National Vaccination Operations Center emphasizes that due to considerations on the immediate roll-out of COVID-19 vaccines to the most at risk of the eligible population, especially the healthcare workers in the hospitals of Metro Manila, direct delivery of vaccines to the following levels of hospitals will commence by the DOH - Supply Chain and Management Service:

1. All Department of Health Hospitals
2. All Level-3 Private Hospitals registered in the Health Facilities and Services Regulatory Bureau (HFSRB)

In addition, CoronaVac vaccines for all Levels 1 & 2 Local Government Units (LGUs) Hospitals and Level 2 Private Hospitals will be delivered to the Center for Health Development (CHD) - Metro Manila for allocation to respective LGUs. Due to scarcity of vaccine supplies, Level 1 Private Hospitals are not part of this deployment until further notice.

The allocation of CoronaVac vaccines shall be based on the masterlisted eligible population. However, a staggered distribution strategy will be utilized based on the uptake of CoronaVac Vaccines by the eligible population. The National VOC shall initially distribute a partial allocation of the first dose to the LGUs and implementing units. Additional vaccines will be distributed within a few days depending on the utilization of your allocated CoronaVac vaccines.

Furthermore, all ancillaries to support the COVID-19 vaccination campaign shall be supported by CHD –Metro Manila. Attached herewith is the list of Metro Manila Hospitals together with their submitted eligible population for vaccination.
