**SUBJECT: PRICE FREEZE OF EMERGENCY ESSENTIAL MEDICINES  
AND MEDICAL DEVICES FOR TYPHOON ULYSSES VICTIMS**

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Proclamation No. 1051 dated 18 November 2020 as signed by the President of the Philippines Rodrigo Roa Duterte declared a State of Calamity in the entire Luzon Island Group that will effectively control the prices of basic goods and commodities for the affected areas. All department and other concerned agencies are directed to implement and execute rescue, relief and rehabilitation work in accordance with pertinent operational plans and directives.

As stated in Section 6 of Republic Act no. 7581, "An Act Providing Protection to Consumers by Stabilizing the Prices of Basic Necessities and Prime Commodities and by Prescribing Measures Against Under Price Increase During Emergency Situations and Like Occasions", it is the policy of the State to ensure the availability of basic necessities and prime commodities at all time.


The Department of Health (DOH) is mandated to monitor and regulate drug prices as well as ensure that consumers are adequately protected against profiteering, hoarding, cartels and the like that compromise their access to essential pharmaceutical products.

Essential medicines have been identified as a basic necessity especially in time of natural calamities and man-made disasters that put the health and lives of Filipino at risk because of unfavorable conditions that cause or aggravate disease which may lead to epidemics and massive death.

Typhoon Ulysses has recently struck many provinces and cities in the country and has been affected the country leading to deaths, injuries and displacements of many more families vulnerable to hunger and malnutrition as well as other diseases with potential to cause more deaths.

In line with this, the DOH hereby orders a price freeze on Emergency Medicines and Medical Devices (Annex I) in all areas affected by the Typhoon Ulysses.
