

2. Response to the Query of PPI

Requirement	Issue	Response
Valid and current Certificate of Product Registration (CPR) or Certificate of Medical Device Registration (CMDR) or Certificate of Medical Device Notification (CMDN) or Certificate of Product Notification (CPN) issued by the Philippine Food and Drugs Administration.	If submission of a Certificate of Exemption may be considered in view of Item III. 3 of FDA Circular No. 2020-001 that took effect sometime February 2020 which states that all Certificate of Exemption for Class A medical devices issued from 25 February 2014 shall remain valid until November 2021 or within two (2) years from date of effectivity of this Circular, whichever is earlier.	Though FDA Circular 2020-001 has a provision on the validity of the COE until November 2021, FDA issued FDA Circular No. 2020-018 dated May 26, 2020 that all PPEs should apply for the Certificate of Medical Device Notification three months upon effectivity of the said circular. This means effective August 27, 2020, all PPEs should have CMDN prior to commercialization. Hence, we will stick with the original requirement.

All other provisions of the bidding documents which are not affected shall remain in force and in effect.
