**RECOMMENDING APPROVAL FOR THE AWARD OF CONTRACT FOR ITEM NO. 2 FOR
THE PRINTING OF UNIVERSAL HEALTH CARE (UHC) BROCHURE & POSTER**

WHEREAS, the Central Office Bids and Awards Committee (COBAC)-D received the request from the Administrative Service (AS) for the Printing of Universal Health Care (UHC) Brochure & Poster in accordance with Republic Act (RA) 9184 and its 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) through the General Appropriations Act of 2019 with a Total Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) of Five Hundred Fifty Thousand Philippine Pesos (PhP550,000.00):

WHEREAS, the COBAC Resolution No. 2019-375, "Recommending Approval for the Use of Negotiated Procurement through Small Value Modality for the Printing of Universal Health Care (UHC) Brochure & Poster", was approved;

WHEREAS, the Technical Working Group (TWG) was created through the issuance of Department Personnel Order (DPO) COBAC No. 2019-339 dated 03 September 2019;

WHEREAS, on 12 September 2019, the Request for Quotation (RFQ) was posted in the PhilGEPS website and in conspicuous places within the premises of the DOH for a continuous period of three (3) calendar days;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Annex "H" Section V (D)(8)(bii), the BAC shall prepare and send the RFQs to at least three (3) suppliers. Receipt of at least one (1) quotation is sufficient to proceed with the evaluation thereof;

WHEREAS, the COBAC-D invited the following suppliers to submit their proposals:

1. Color1 digital, Inc. (CDD);
2. Kayumanggi Press, Inc. (KPI); and,
3. VJ Graphic Arts, Inc. (VJGAI).

WHEREAS, on 17 September 2019, the Submission of Quotations took place but due to lack of quorum, the Opening was rescheduled on 18 September 2019 at 9:00 A.M. at the COBAC Conference Room, G/F, Building 6, DOH;

WHEREAS, thirteen (13) prospective bidder submitted their respective proposals, namely;

WHEREAS, on 19 September 2019, the evaluation on the submitted documents of the Lowest Calculated Quotation (LCQ), MPCl, was undertaken by the designated TWG;

WHEREAS, on the same date, the TWG found MPCl “Complying” and submitted its report;

WHEREAS, 01 October 2019, the TWG report was presented to the COBAC-D during its 38th Regular Meeting, and upon review and deliberation, concurred with the TWG recommendation and declared MPCl “compliant” and recommended the award of contract;

WHEREAS, the COBAC-D, upon review and deliberation on the TWG Report as well as verification of the documents, found MPCl compliant with the requirements. The quotation of VC was declared as the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Quotation (LCRQ) based on the following salient points of discussion:
