Fig. 1 Suspect Acute Encephalitis Syndrome Cases as of April 9, 2016, (N=76)

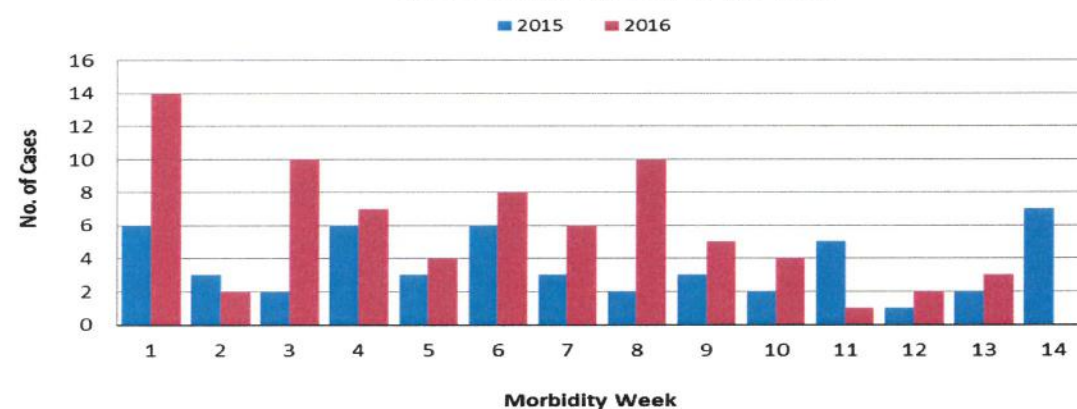


Fig. 2 Suspect Bacterial Meningitis Cases as of April 9, 2016 (N=491)

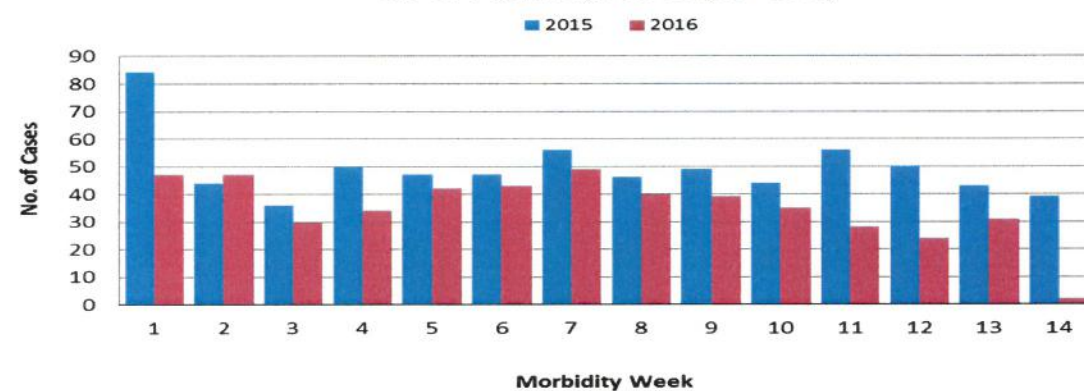
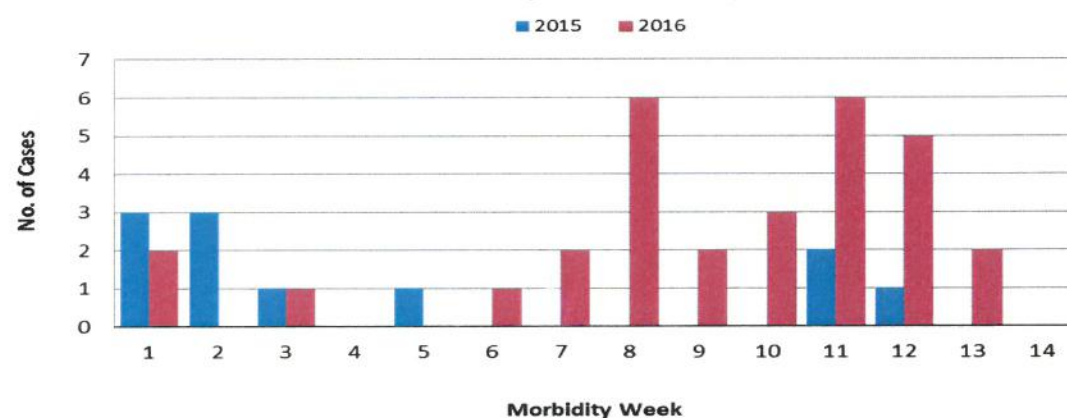


Fig. 3 Confirmed Bacterial Meningitis Cases as of April 9, 2016 (n=30)

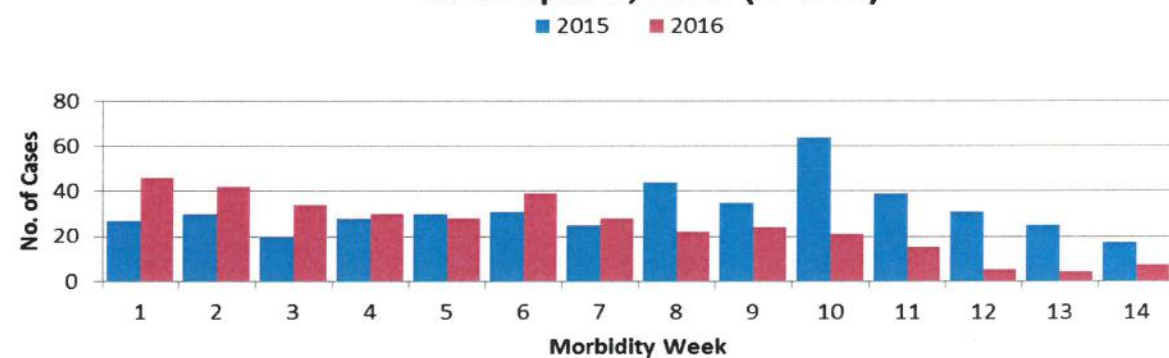




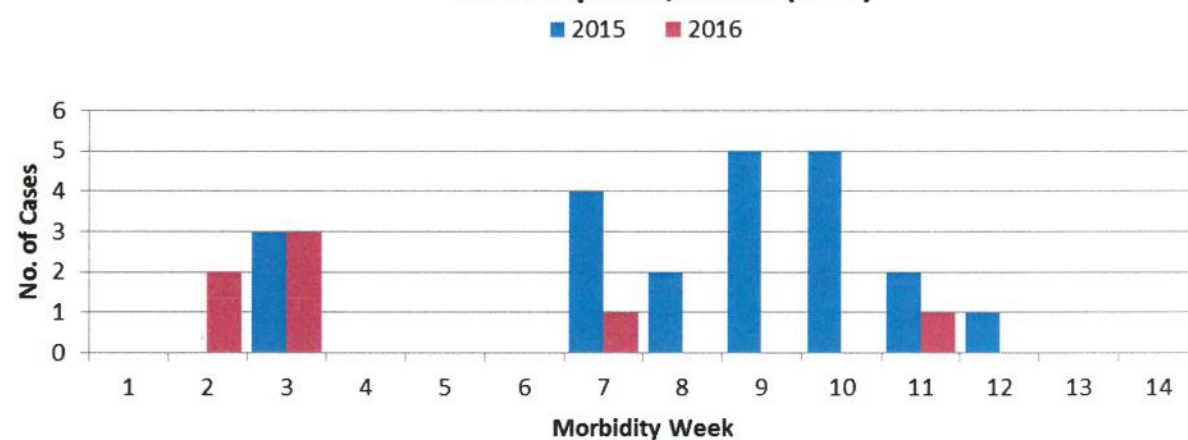
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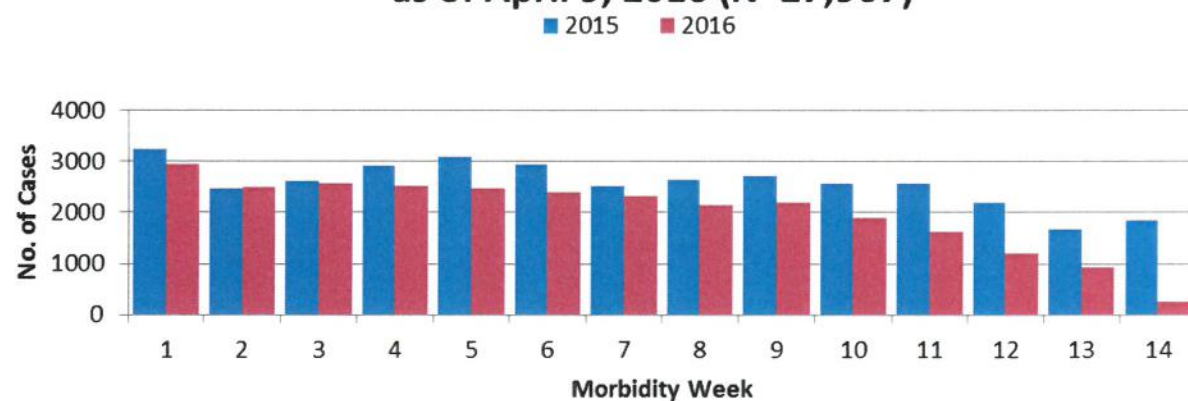
**Fig.4 Suspect Hand, Foot and Mouth Disease Cases

as of April 9, 2016 (n=7)**



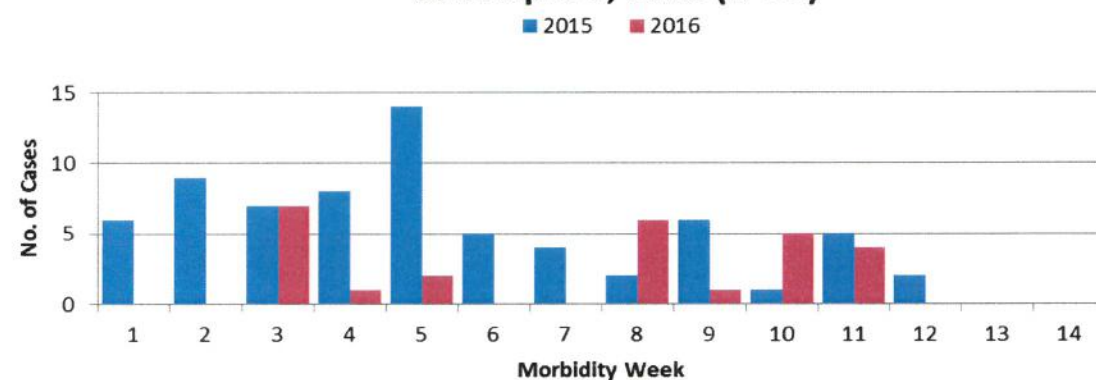
**Fig.6 Influenza-like Illness Cases
as of April 9, 2016 (N=27,907)**



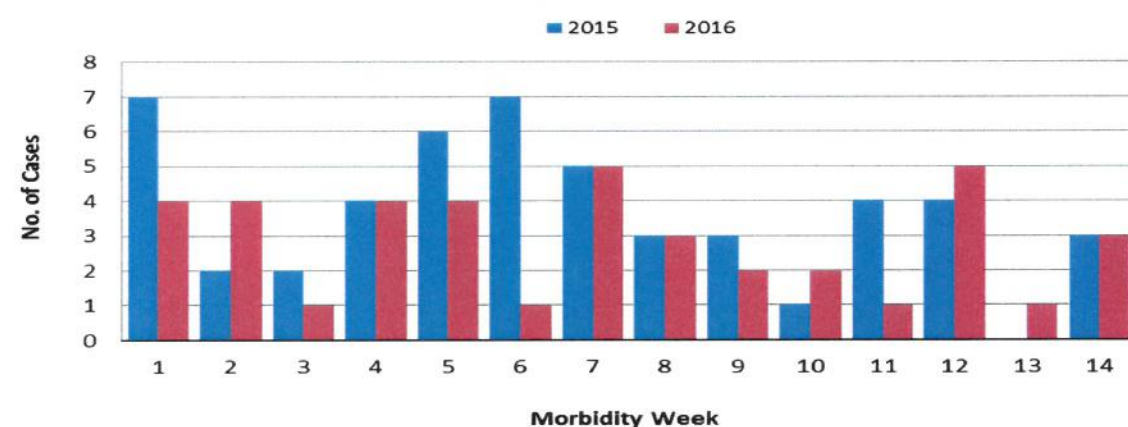
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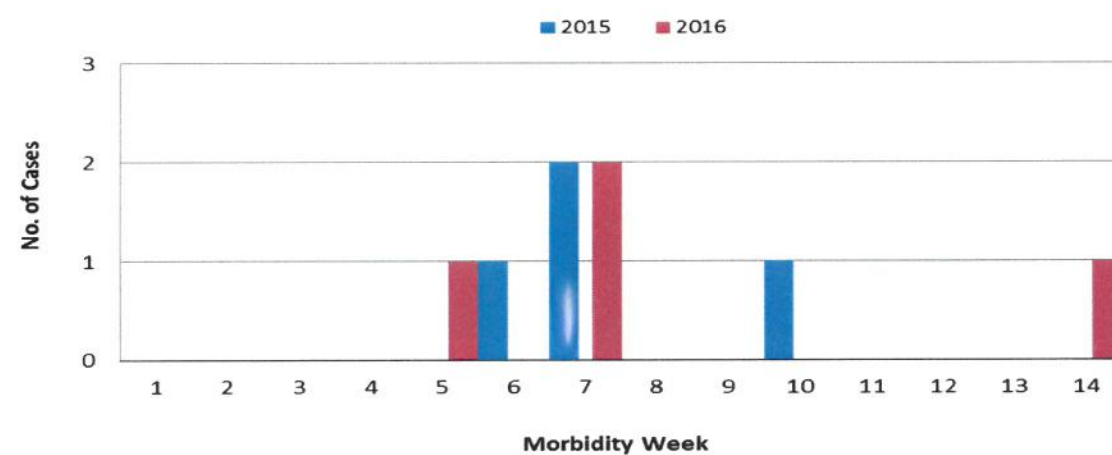
**Fig.7 Influenza Cases

 as of April 9, 2016 (n=4)**



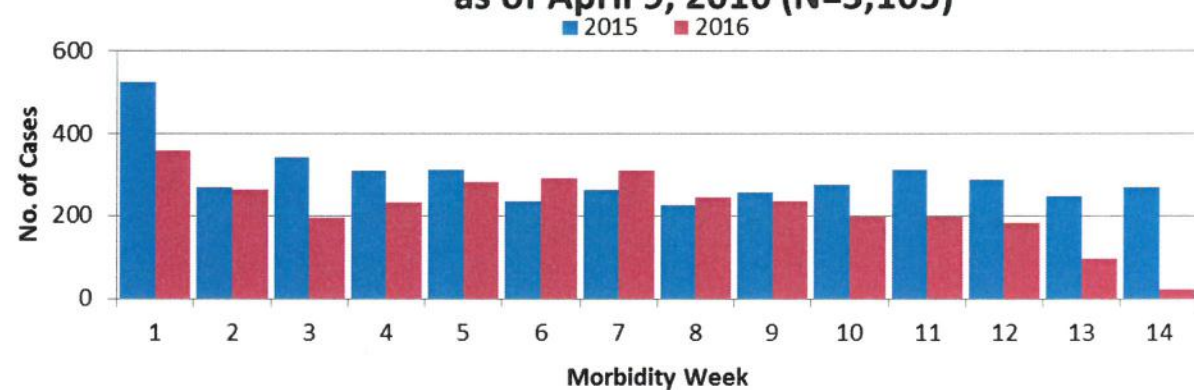


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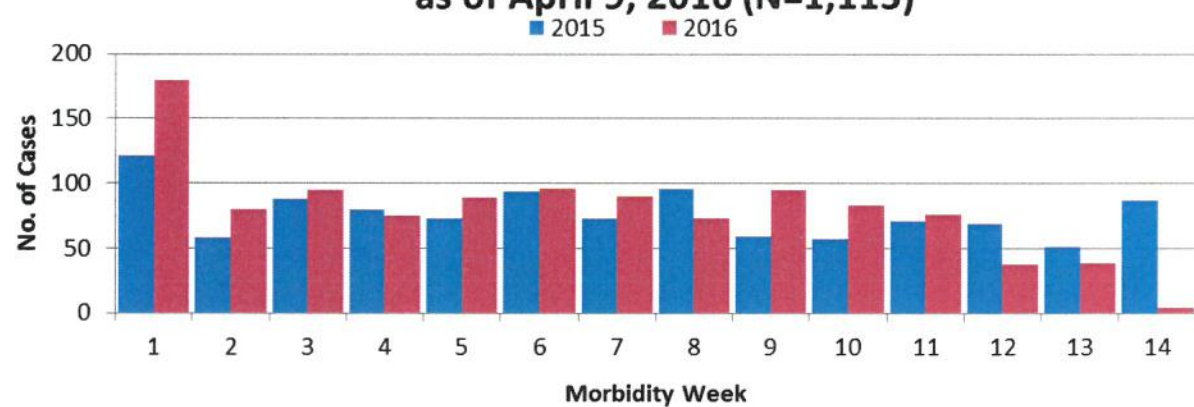

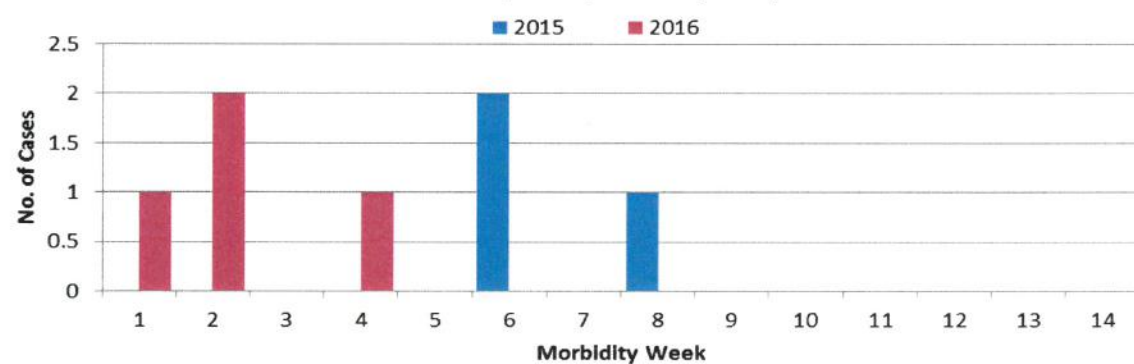
**Fig.10 Acute Bloody Diarrhea Cases

as of April 9, 2016 (N=14)

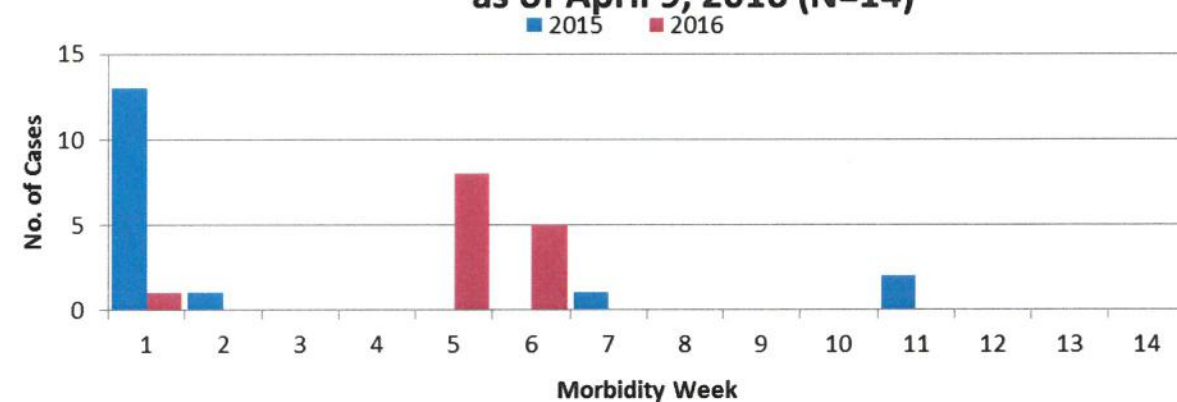


Fig.14 Suspect Typhoid Cases
as of April 9, 2016 (N=6,553)

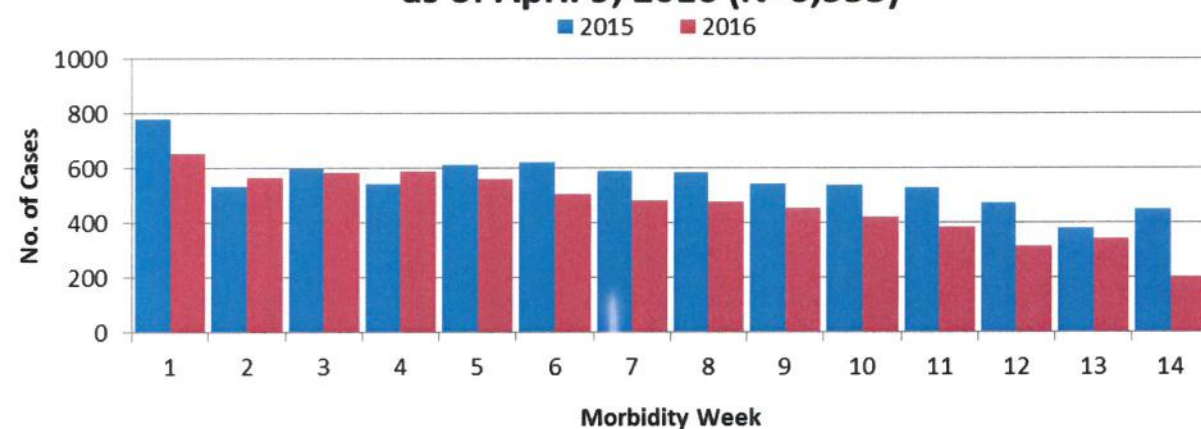
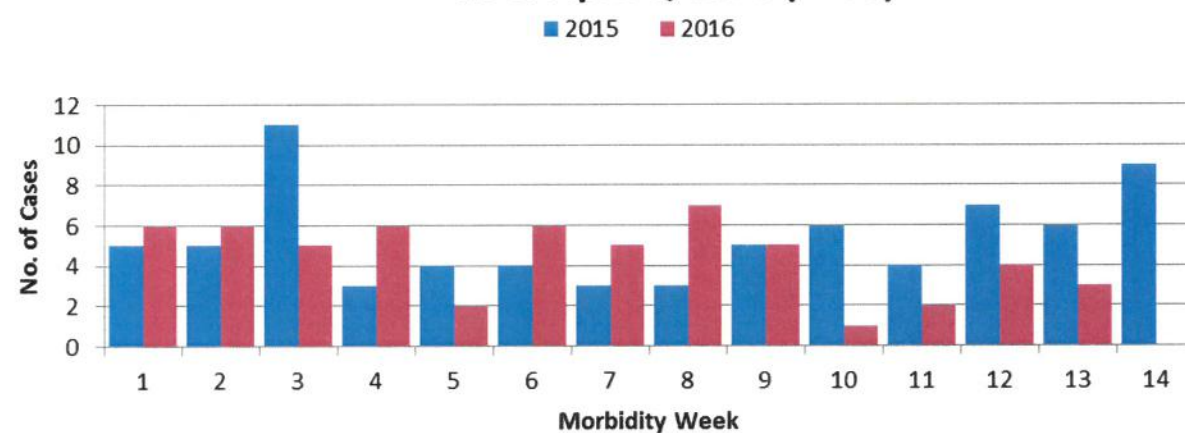


Fig.15 Confirmed Typhoid Cases
as of April 9, 2016 (n=58)

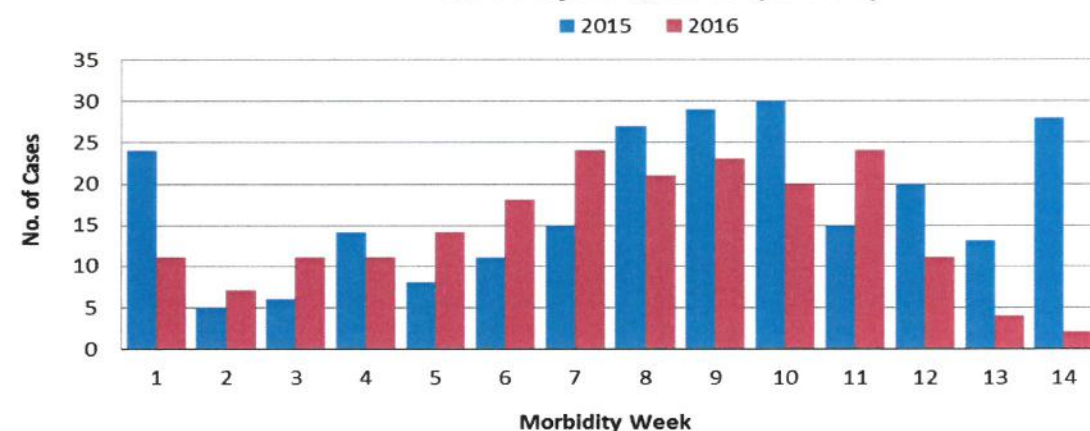




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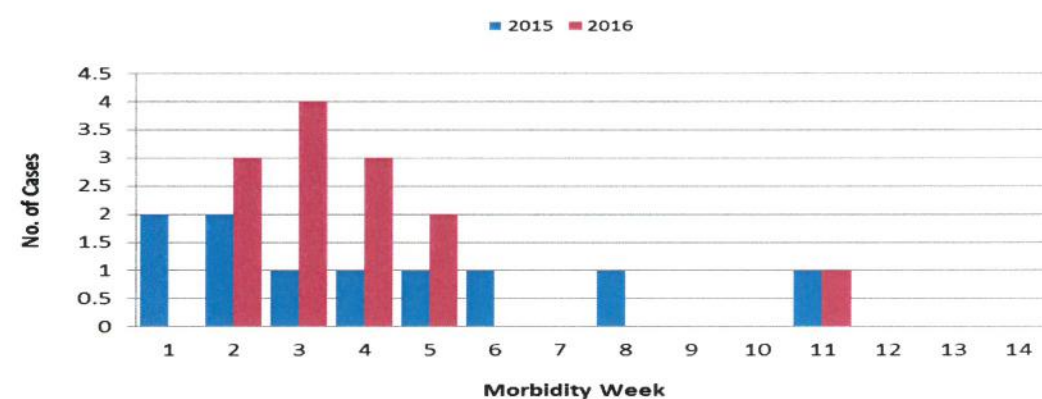
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**Fig. 16 Confirmed Hepatitis A Cases
as of April 9, 2016 (n=201)**

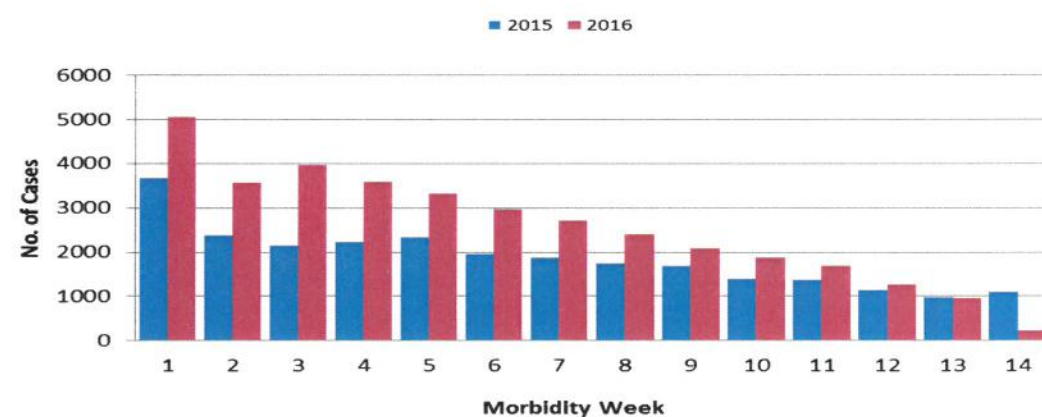

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Fig. 19 Confirmed Dengue Cases as of April 9, 2016 (n=64)

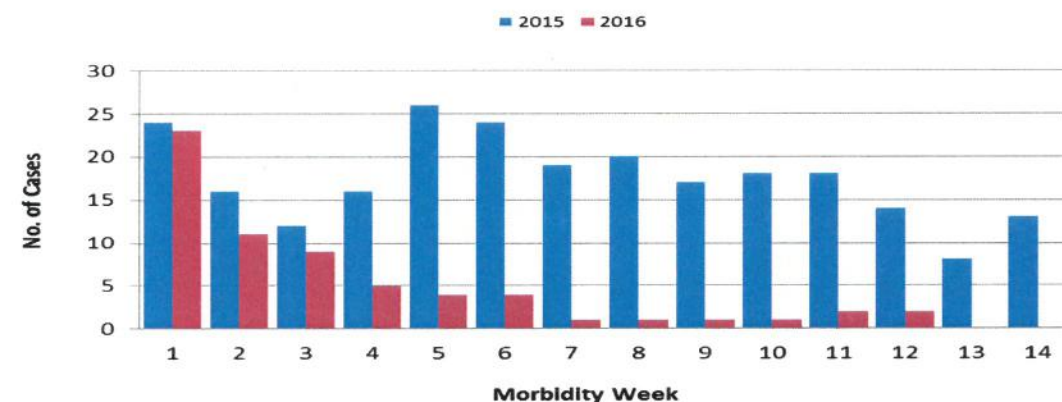
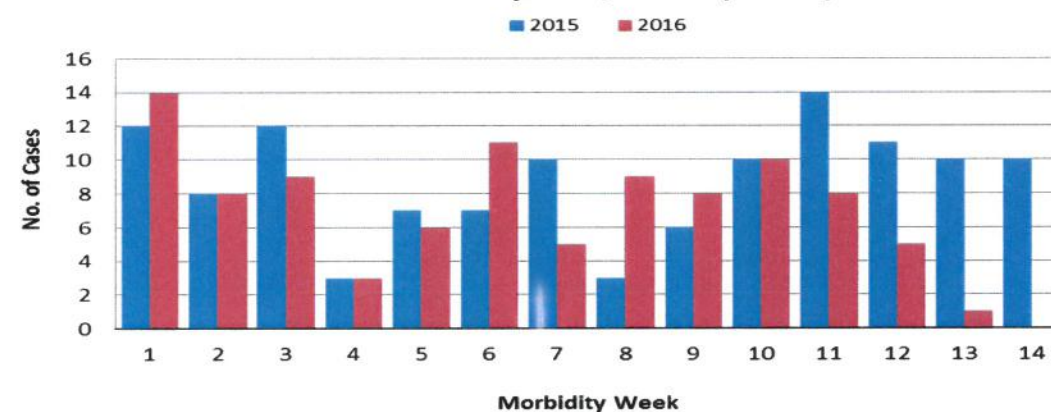
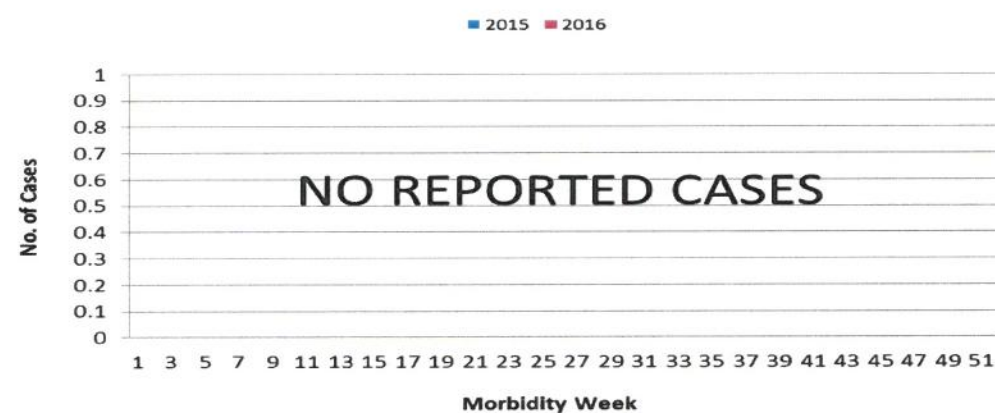


Fig. 20 Suspect Malaria Cases as of April 9, 2016 (N=97)

Fig. 21 Suspect Anthrax Cases as of April 9, 2016 (N=0)

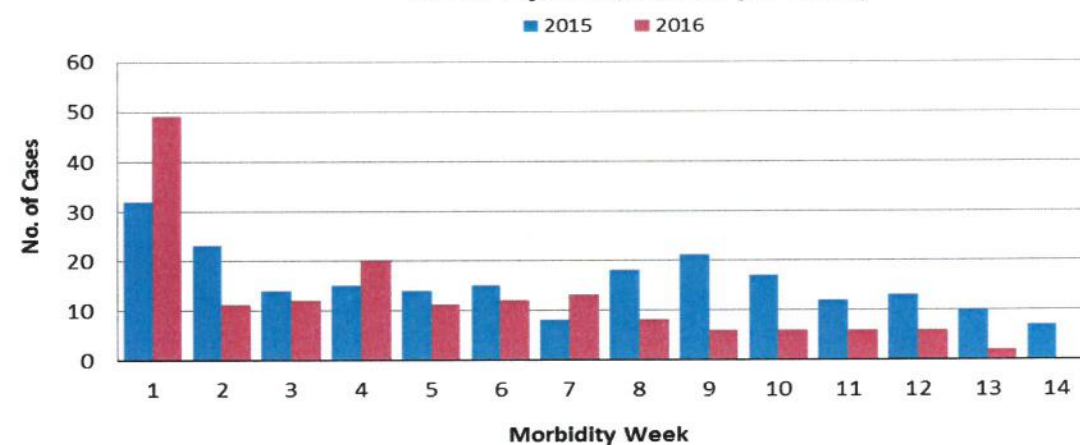




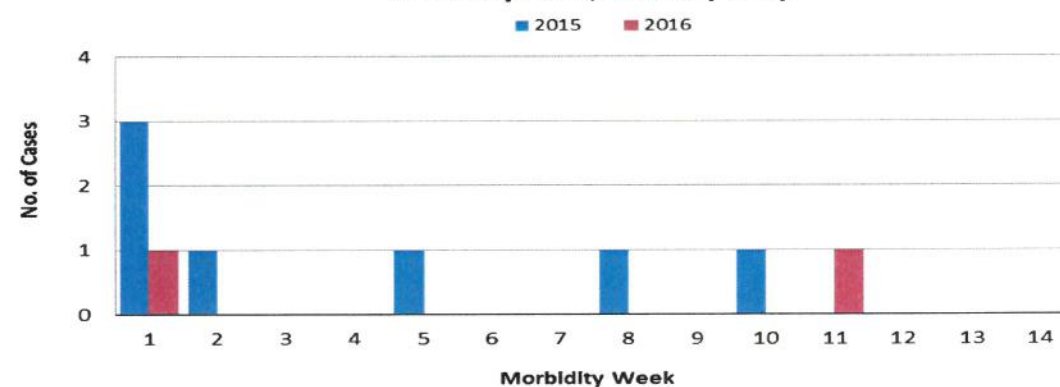
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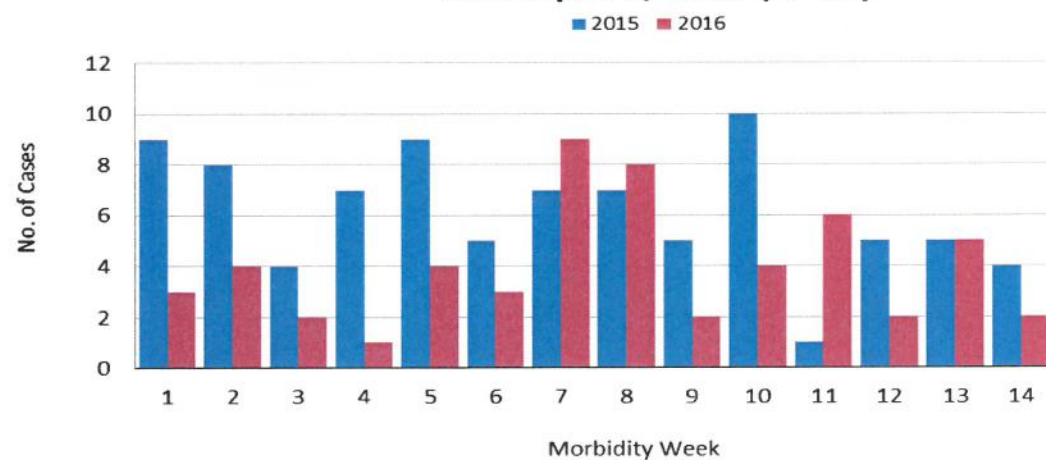
**Fig. 22 Suspect Leptospirosis Cases

as of April 9, 2016 (N=55)**



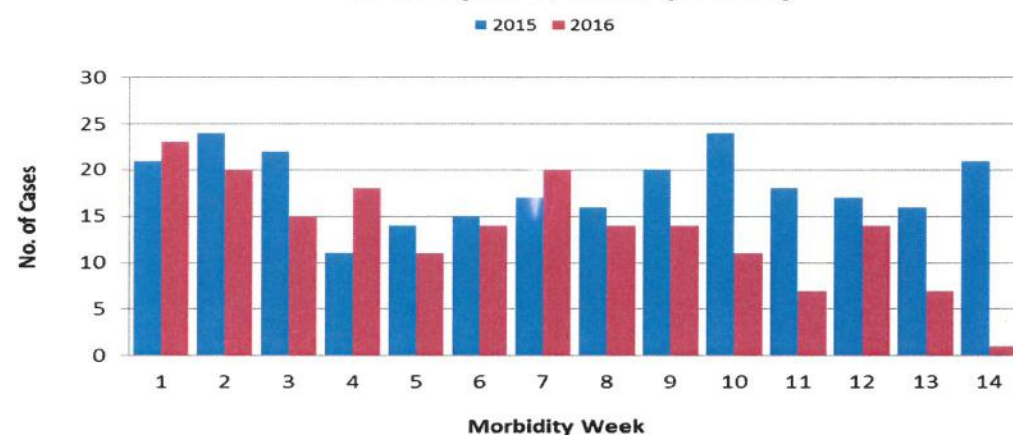


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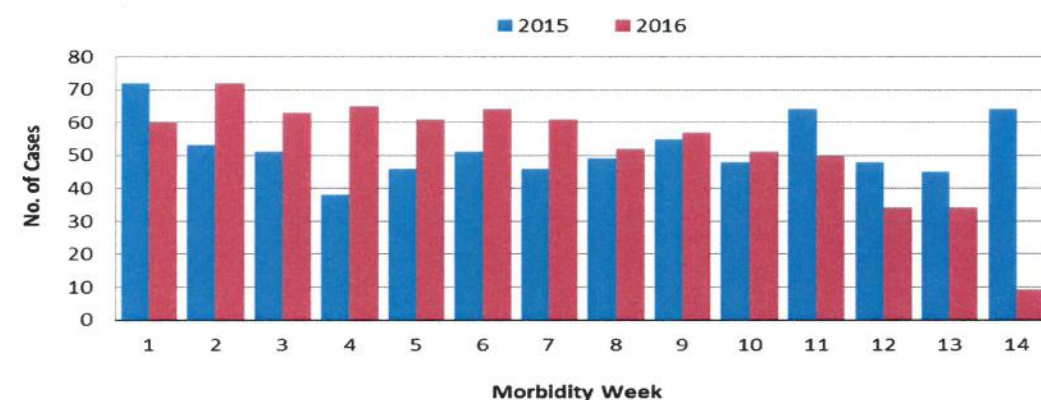

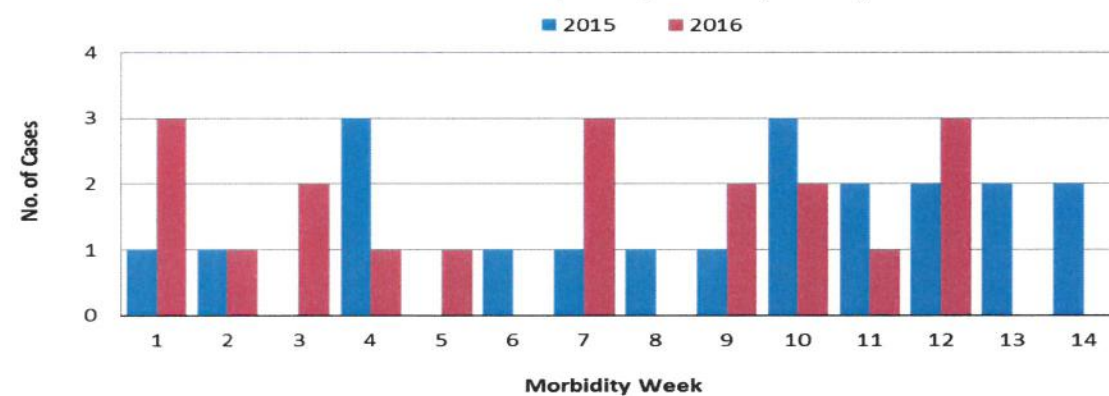
**Fig. 25 Confirmed Non-neonatal Tetanus Cases

as of April 9, 2016 (n=19)**







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
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
