Fig. 1 Suspect Acute Encephalitis Syndrome Cases as of April 16, 2016, (N=77)

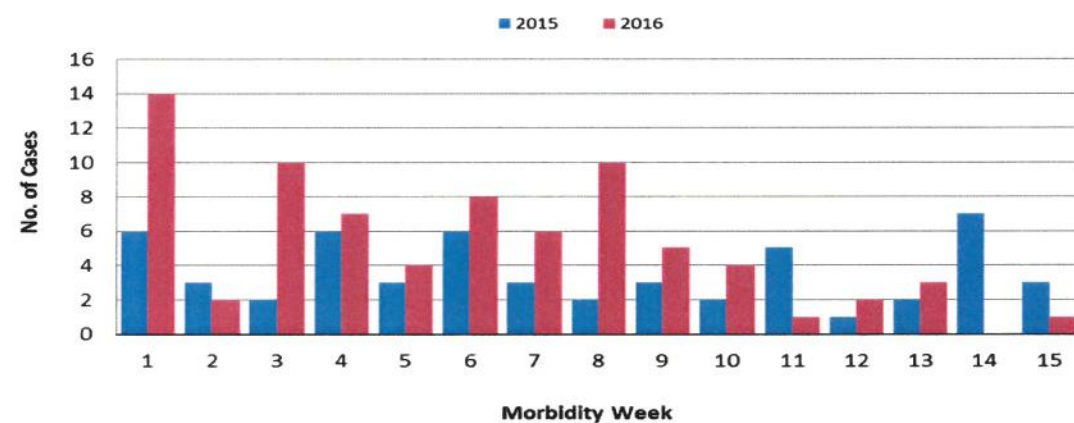


Fig. 2 Confirmed Acute Encephalitis Syndrome Cases as of April 16, 2016, (n=4)

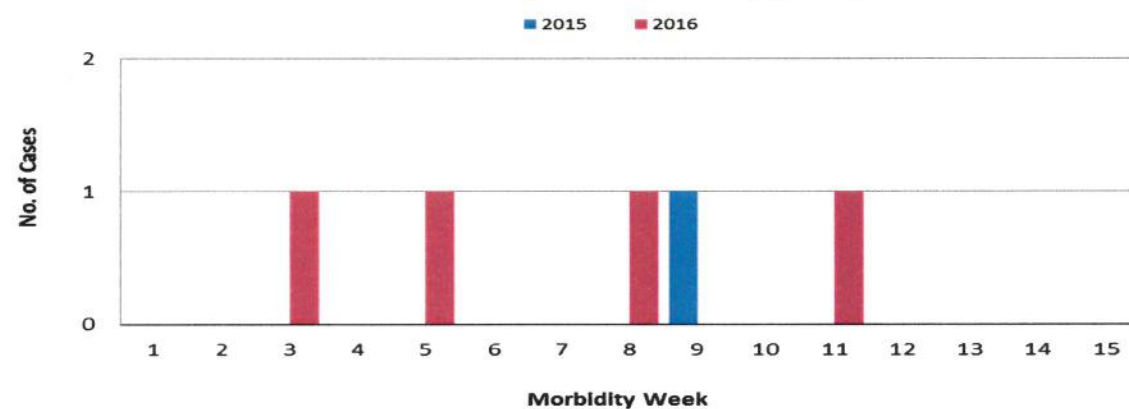
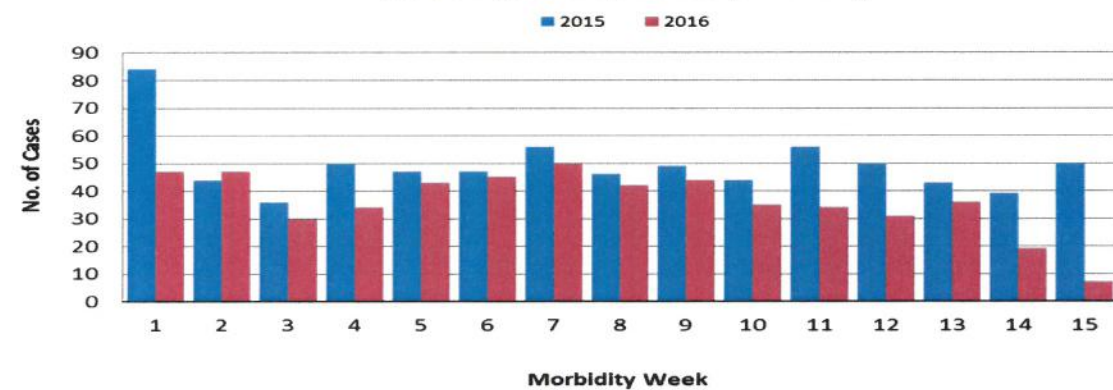


Fig. 3 Suspect Bacterial Meningitis Cases as of April 16, 2016 (N=544)



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Fig. 4 Confirmed Bacterial Meningitis Cases as of April 16, 2016 (n=32)

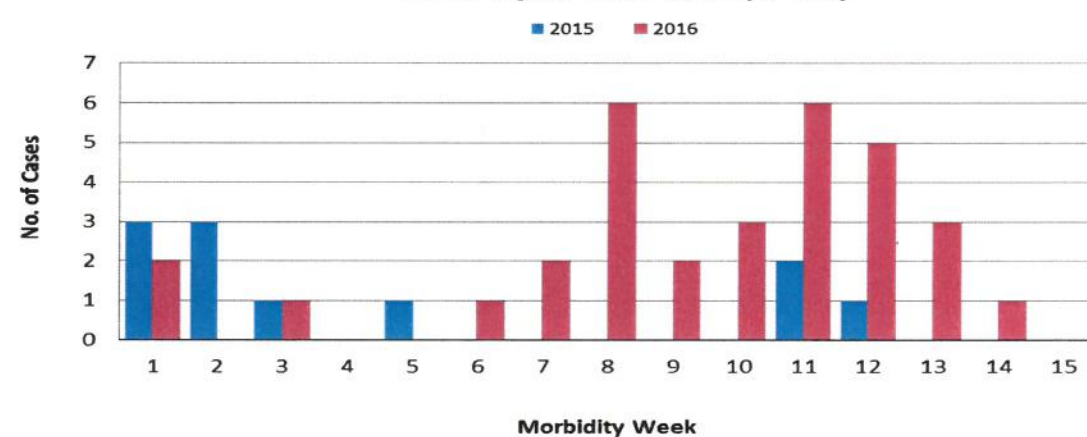


Fig.5 Suspect Hand, Foot and Mouth Disease Cases as of April 16, 2016 (N=345)

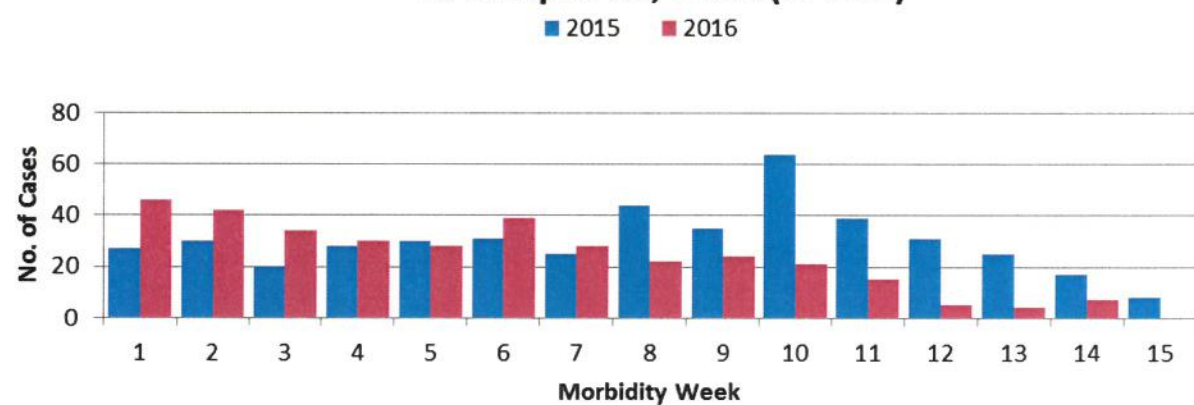
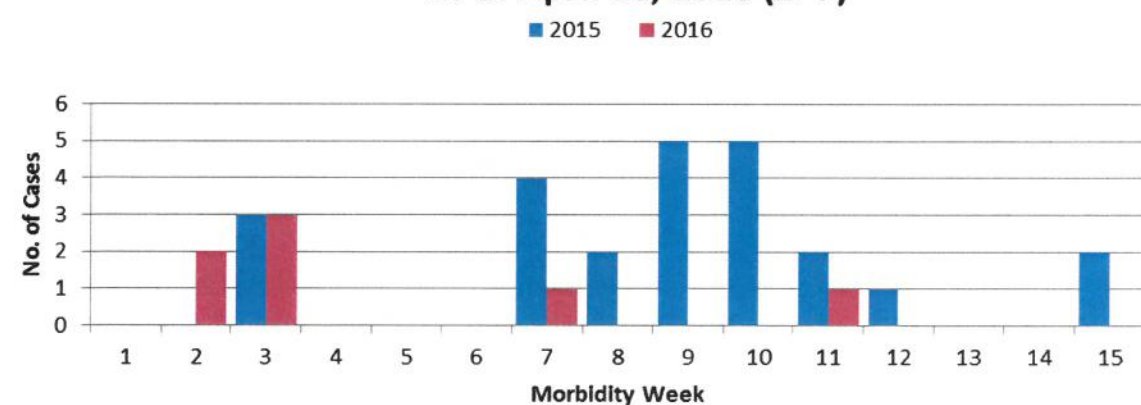


Fig.6 Confirmed Hand, Foot and Mouth Disease Cases as of April 16, 2016 (n=7)

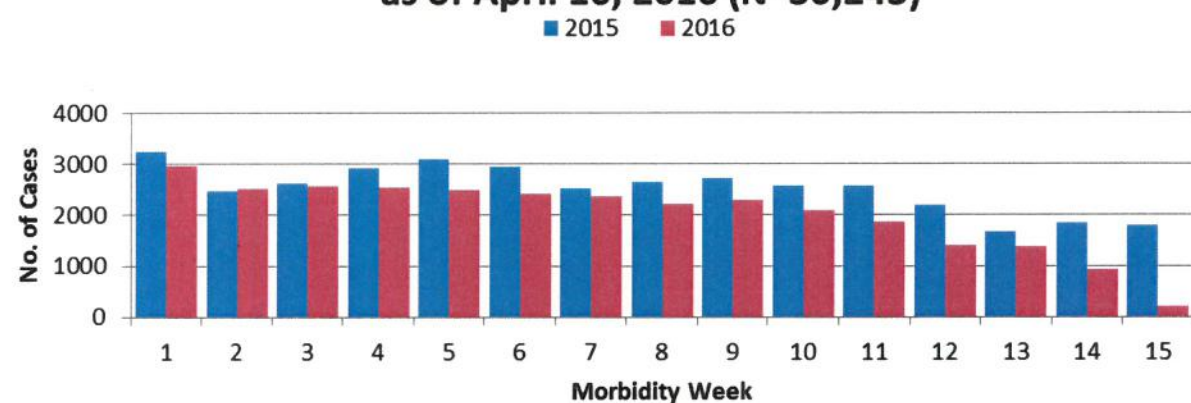




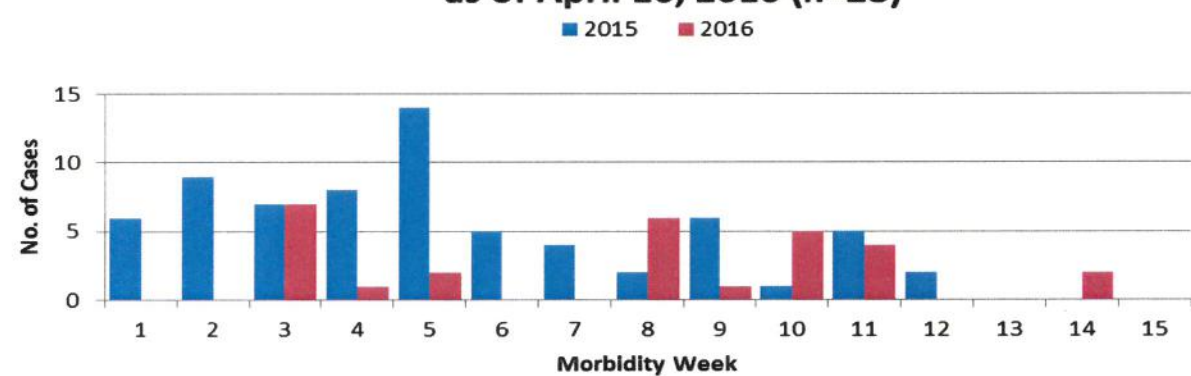
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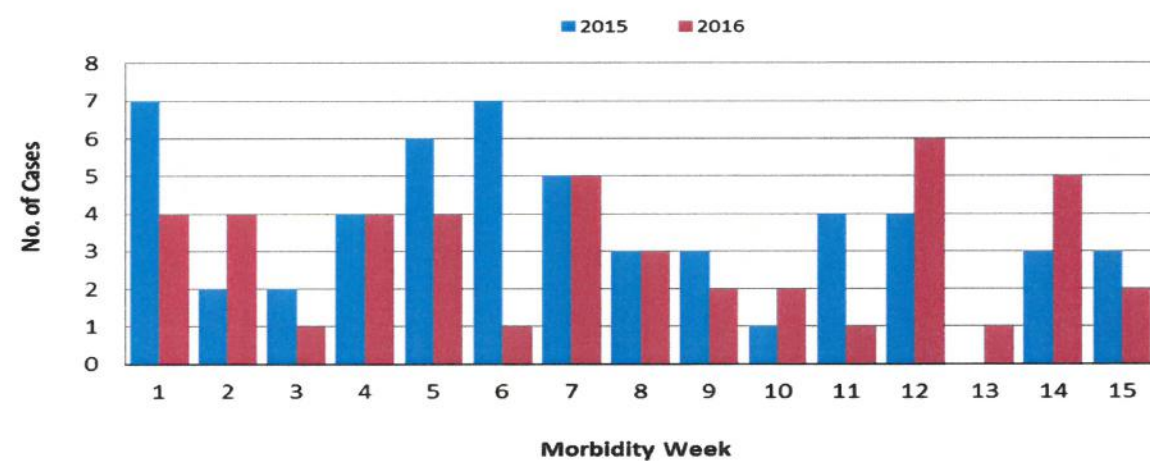
**Fig.7 Influenza-like Illness Cases

as of April 16, 2016 (N=45)**

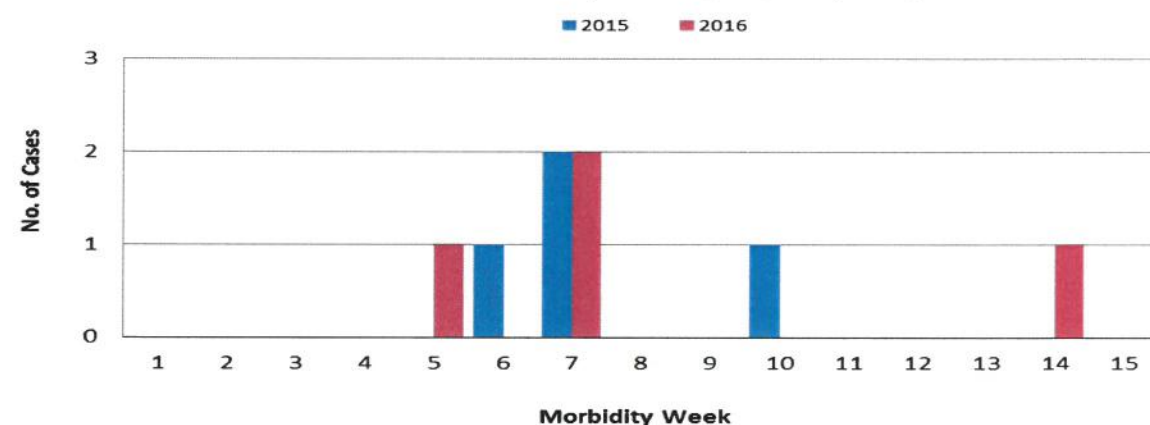




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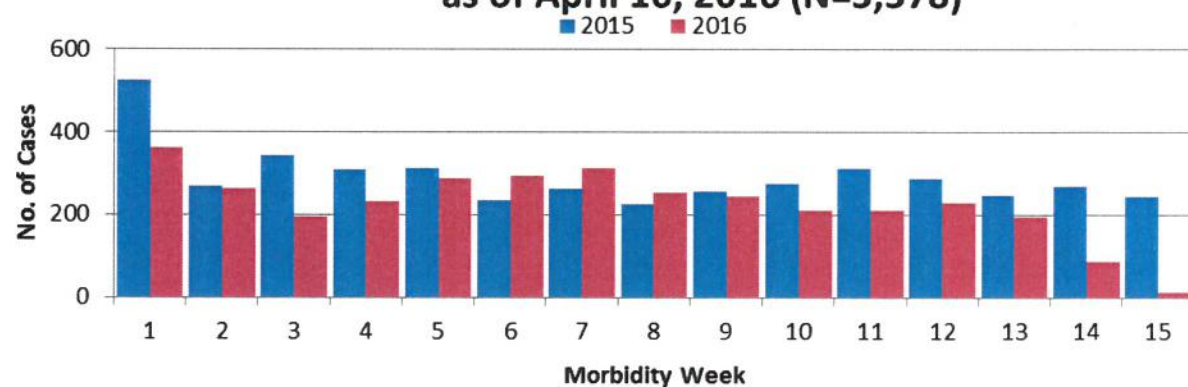
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**Fig. 10 Confirmed Meningococcal Disease Cases
as of April 16, 2016 (n=4)**

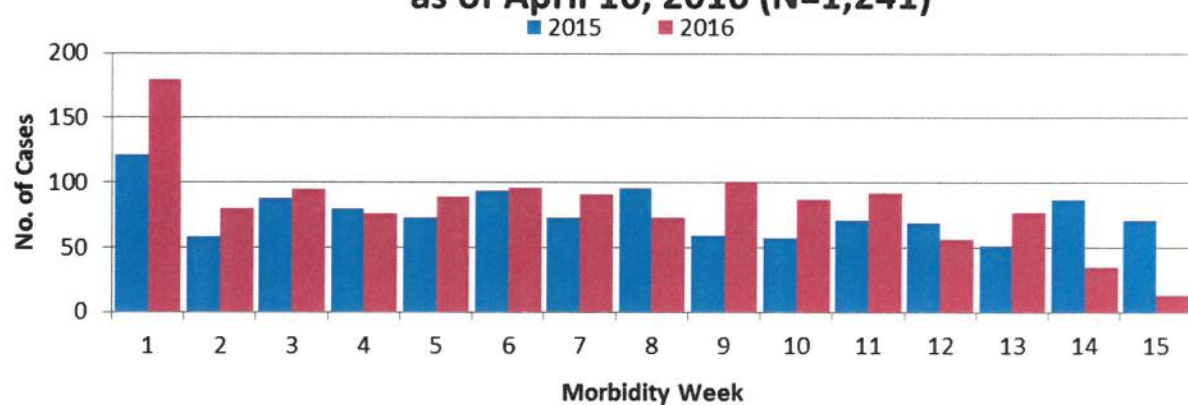

as of April 16, 2016 (N=3,378)**



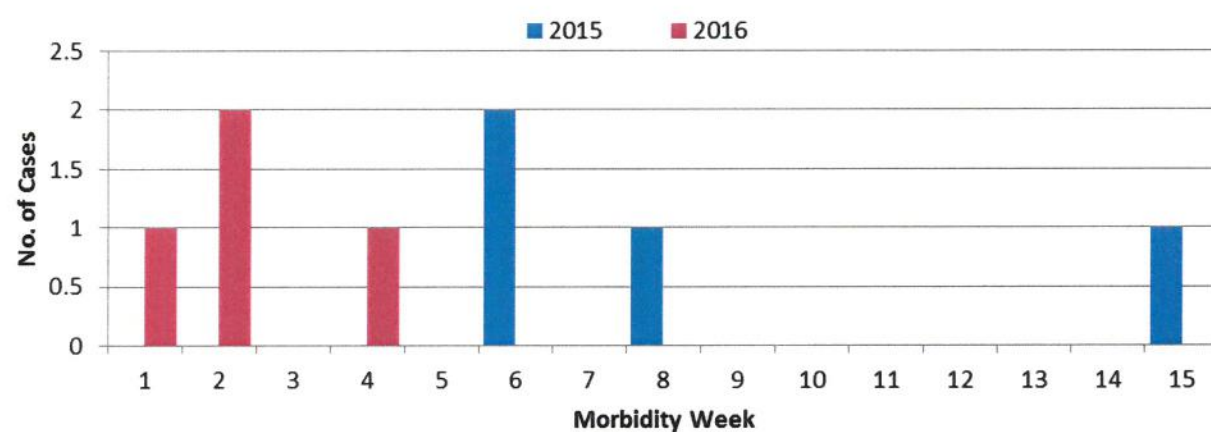
**Fig.12 Suspect Cholera Cases
as of April 16, 2016 (N=1,241)**



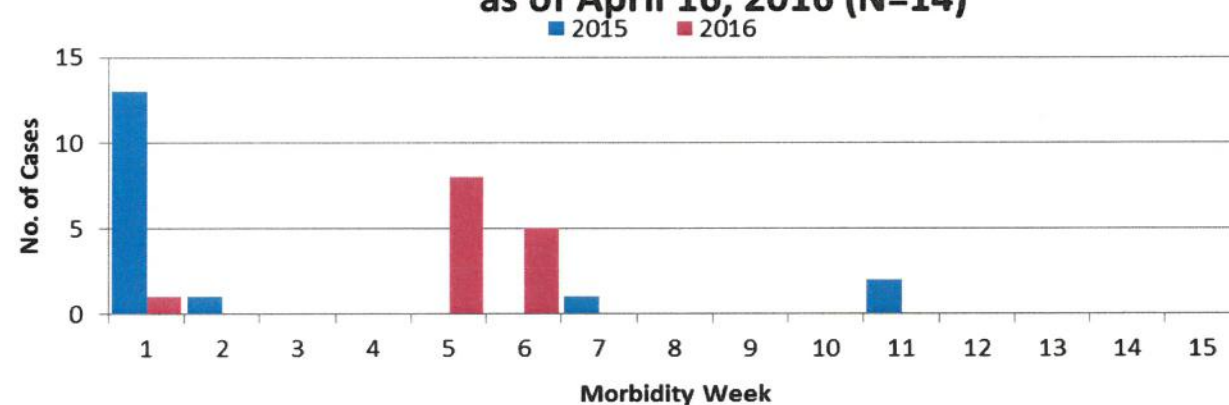
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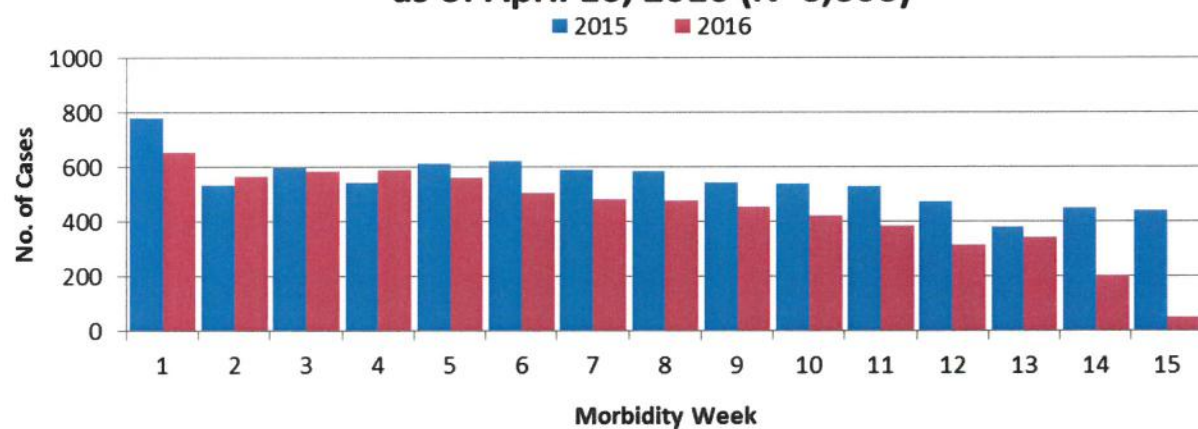
**Fig.13 Confirmed Cholera Cases

 as of April 16, 2016 (N=6,606)**

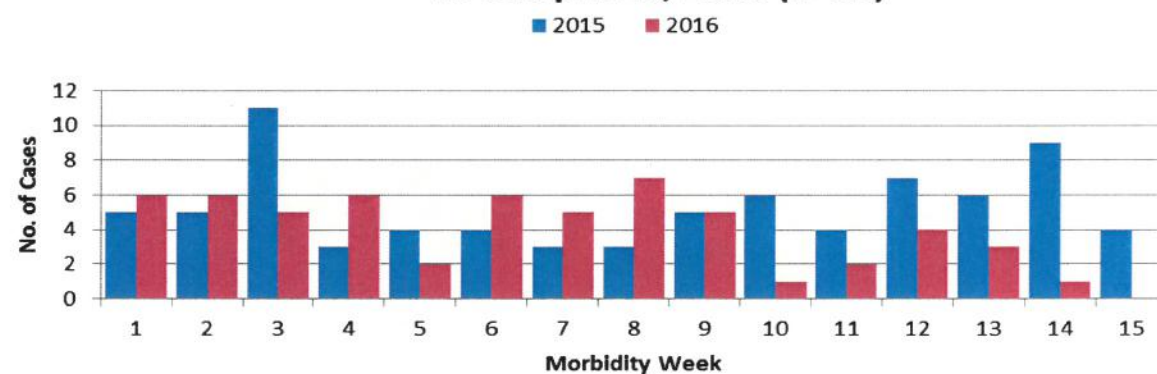




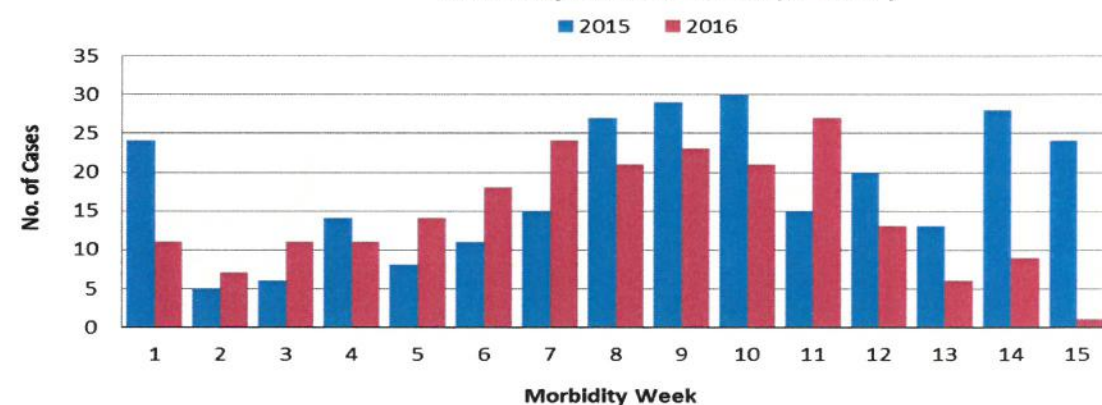
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**Fig.16 Confirmed Typhoid Cases
as of April 16, 2016 (n=59)**

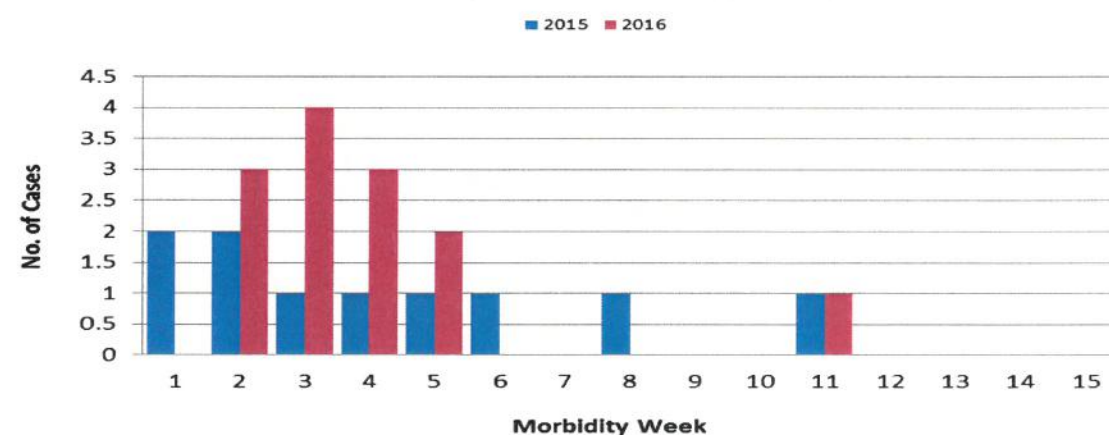


**Fig. 17 Confirmed Hepatitis A Cases

as of April 16, 2016 (N=13)**

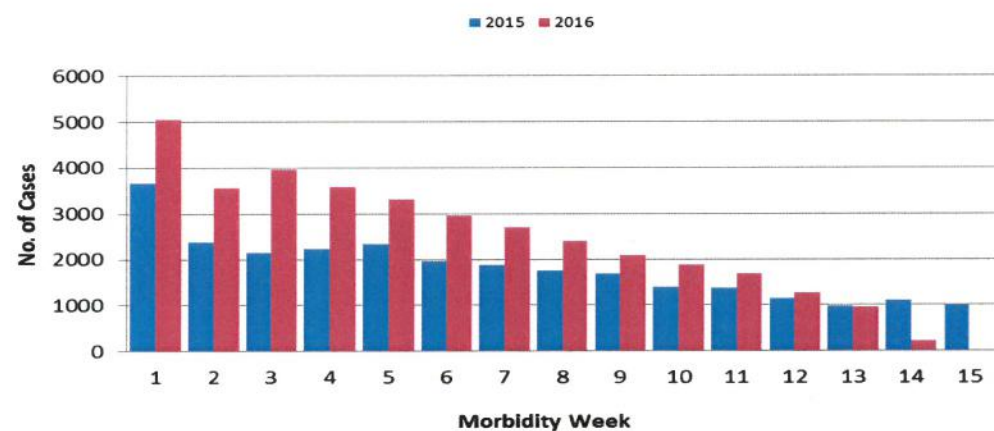




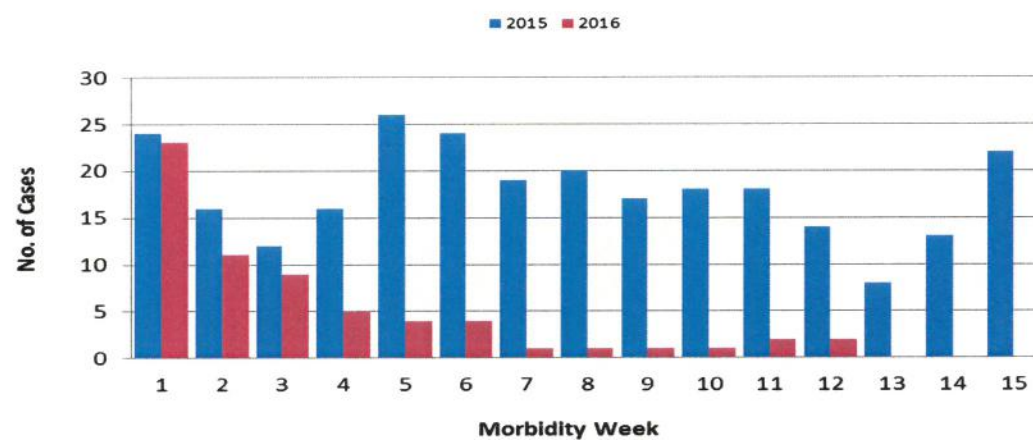
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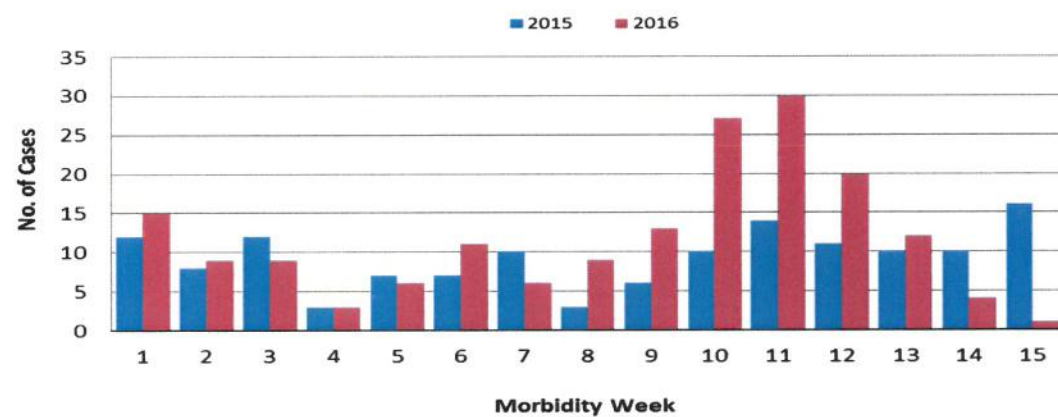
**Fig. 19 Suspect Dengue Cases

as of April 16, 2016 (N=175)**



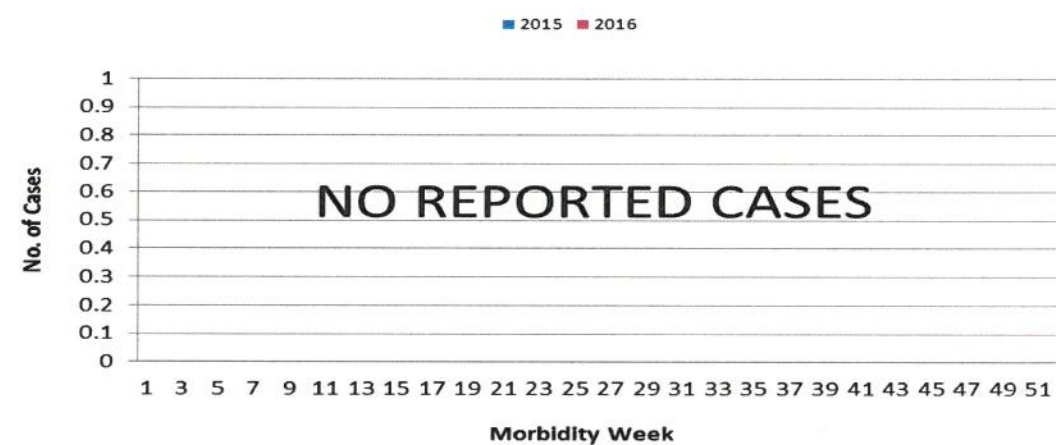


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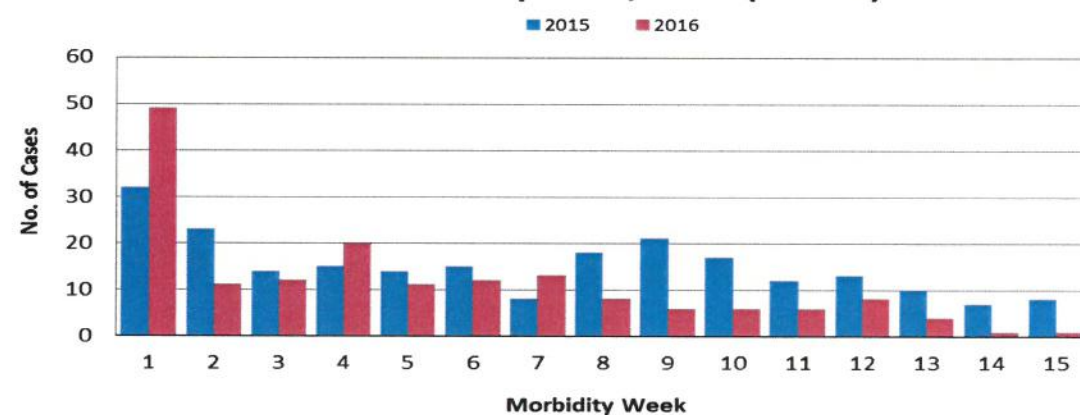

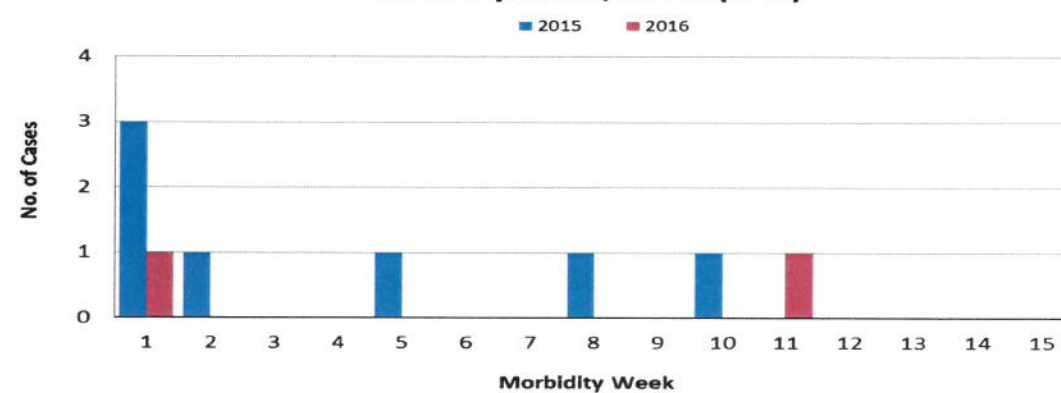
**Fig. 22 Suspect Anthrax Cases

as of April 16, 2016 (n=2)**

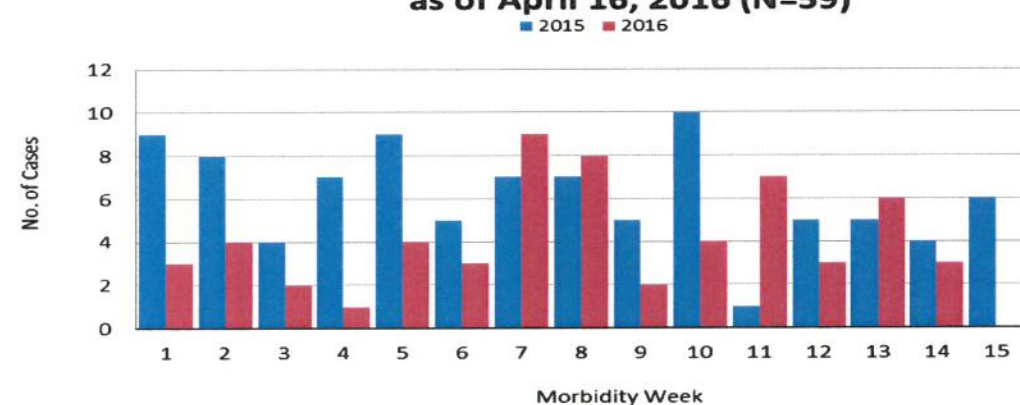




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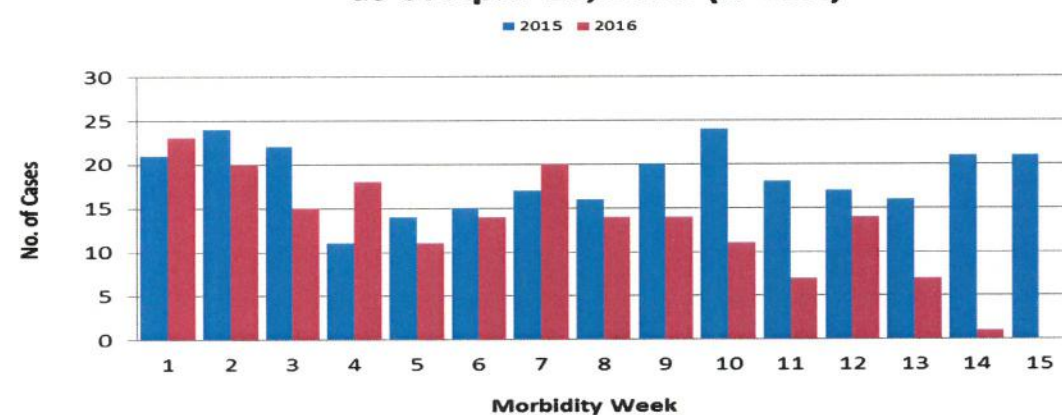
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**Fig. 25 Probable Rabies Cases
as of April 16, 2016 (N=59)**

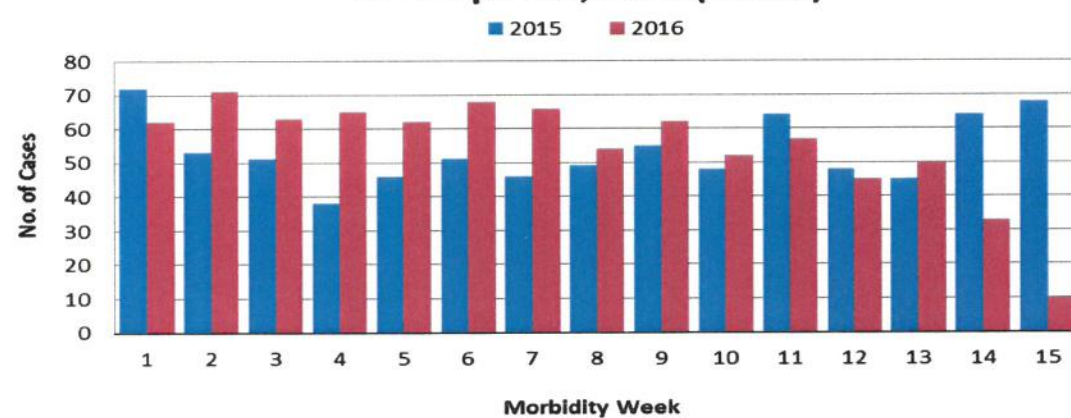

as of April 16, 2016 (n=820)**

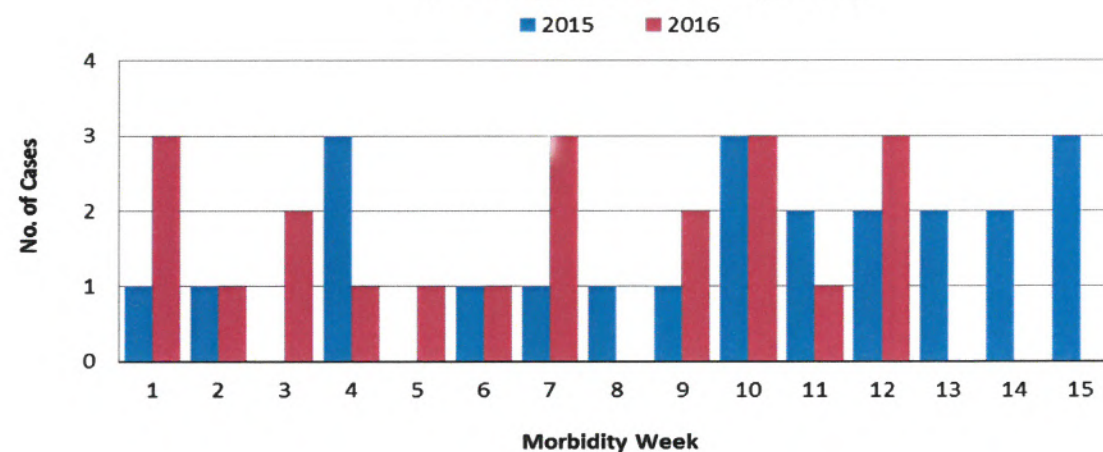




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**Fig. 28 Confirmed Hepatitis C Cases
