Fig. 1 Suspect Acute Encephalitis Syndrome Cases as of April 23, 2016, (N=87)

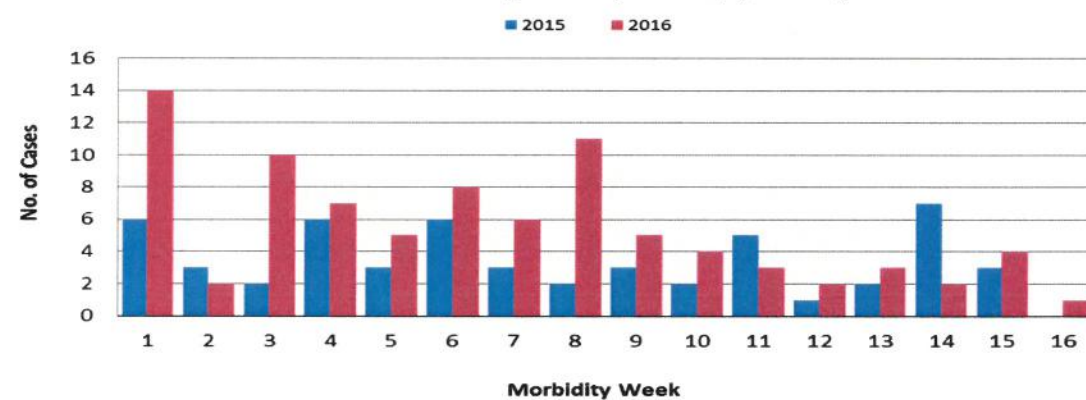


Fig. 2 Confirmed Acute Encephalitis Syndrome Cases as of April 23, 2016, (n=4)

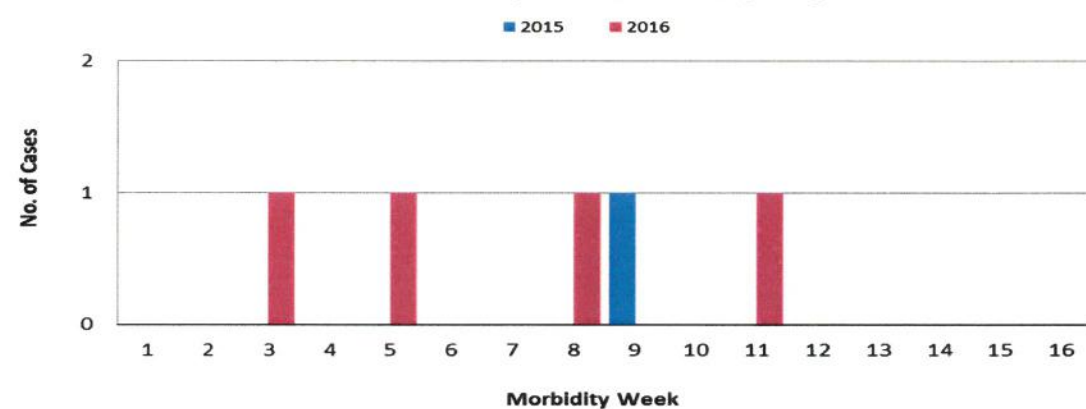
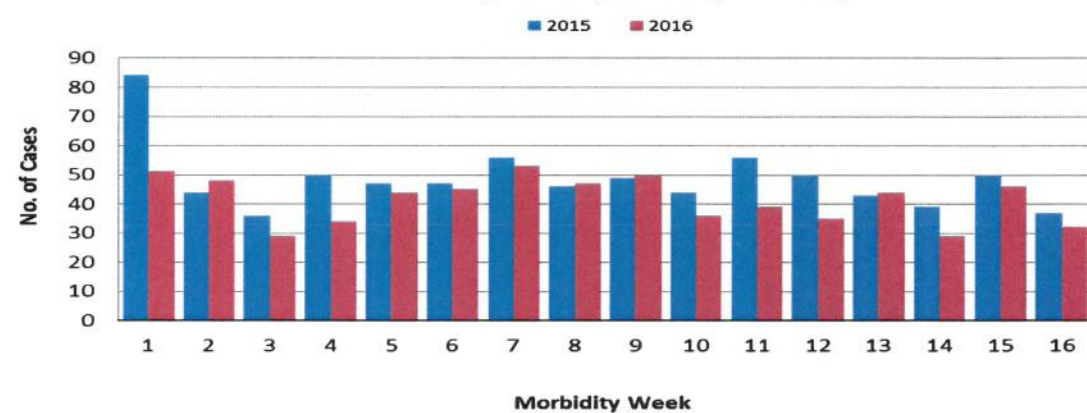


Fig. 3 Suspect Bacterial Meningitis Cases as of April 23, 2016 (N=662)

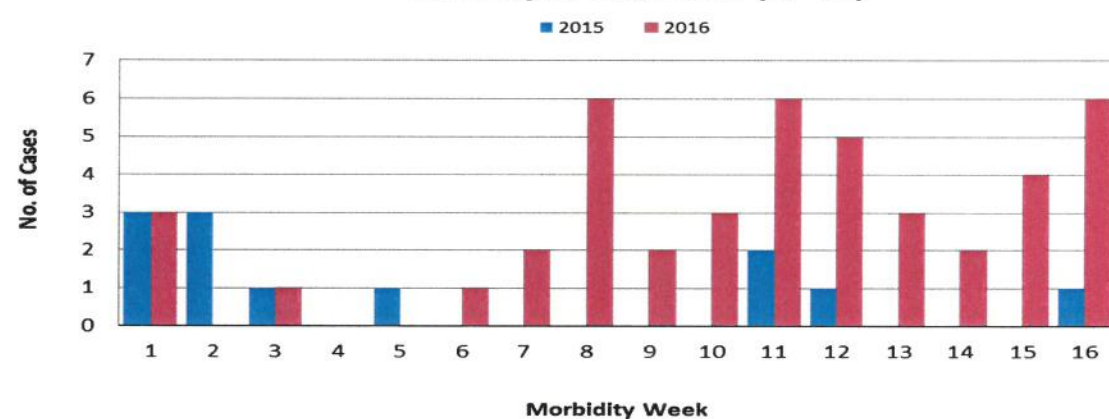




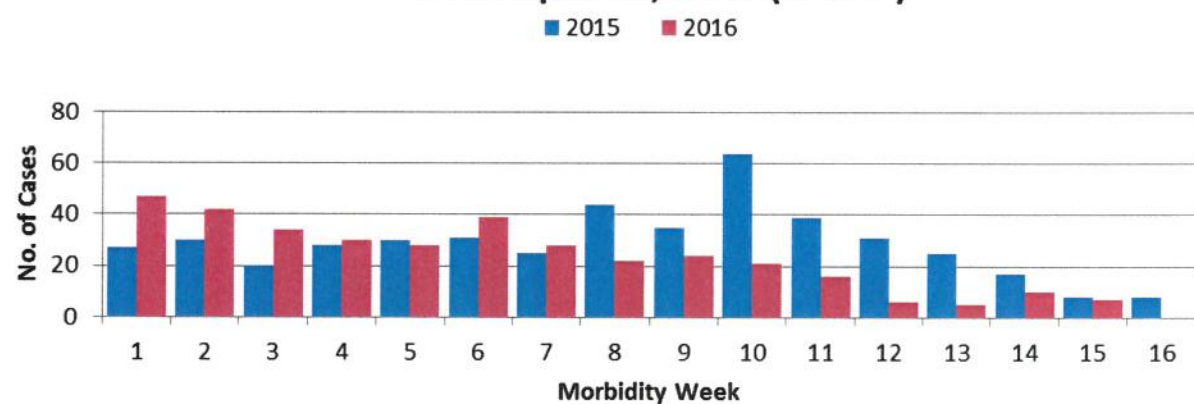

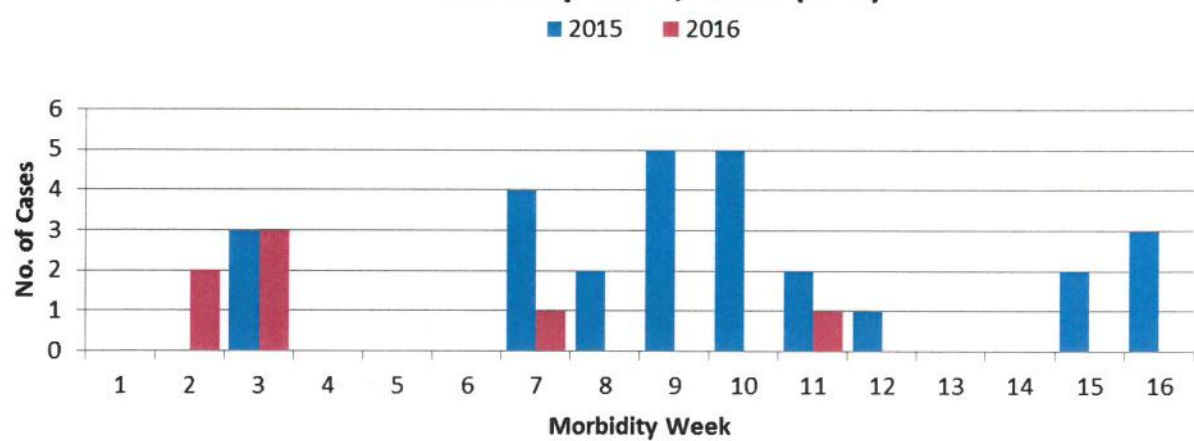
**Fig. 4 Confirmed Bacterial Meningitis Cases

as of April 23, 2016 (n=7)**

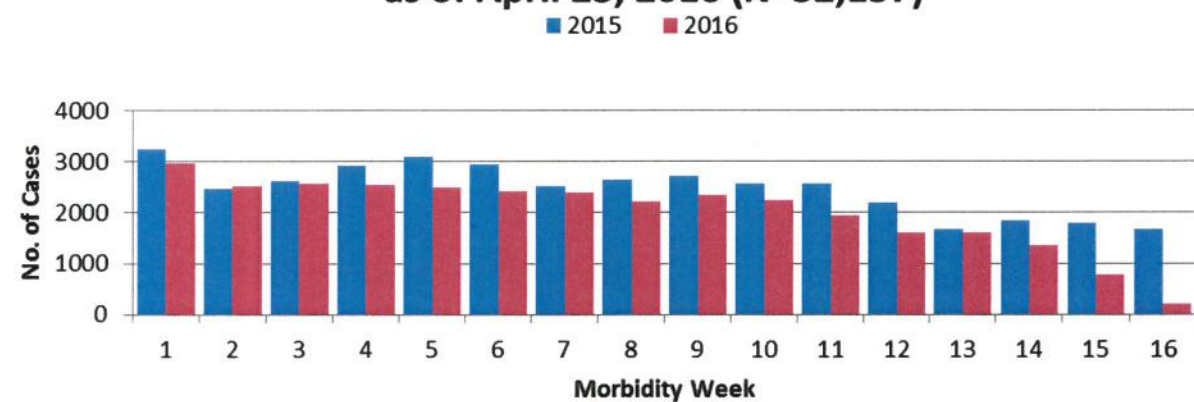




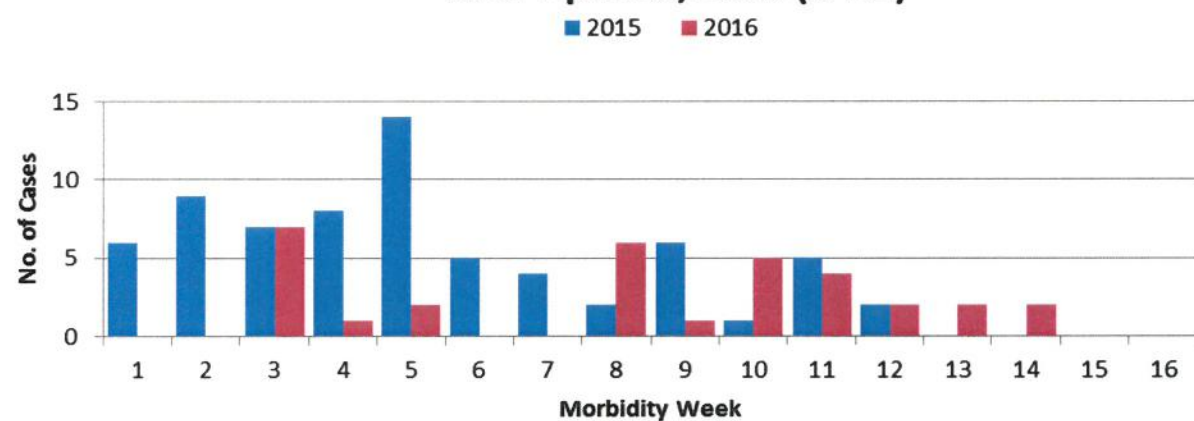

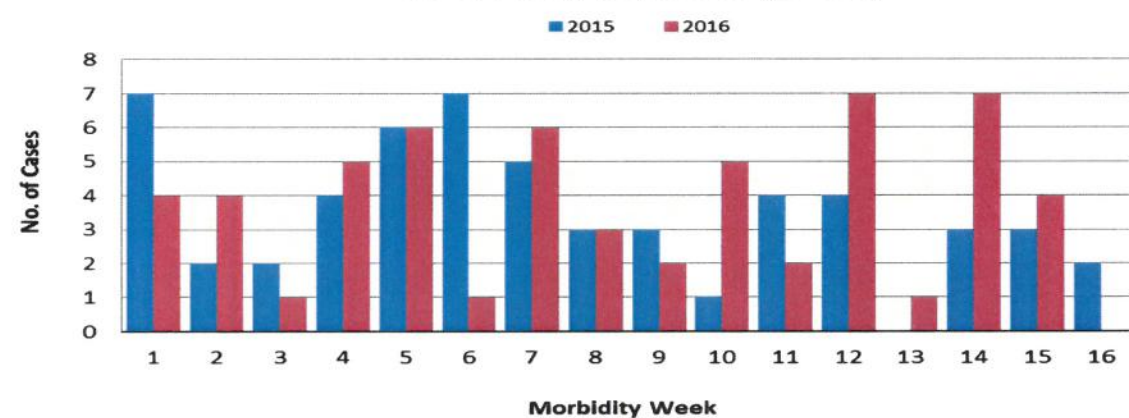
**Fig.7 Influenza-like Illness Cases

as of April 23, 2016 (n=32)**



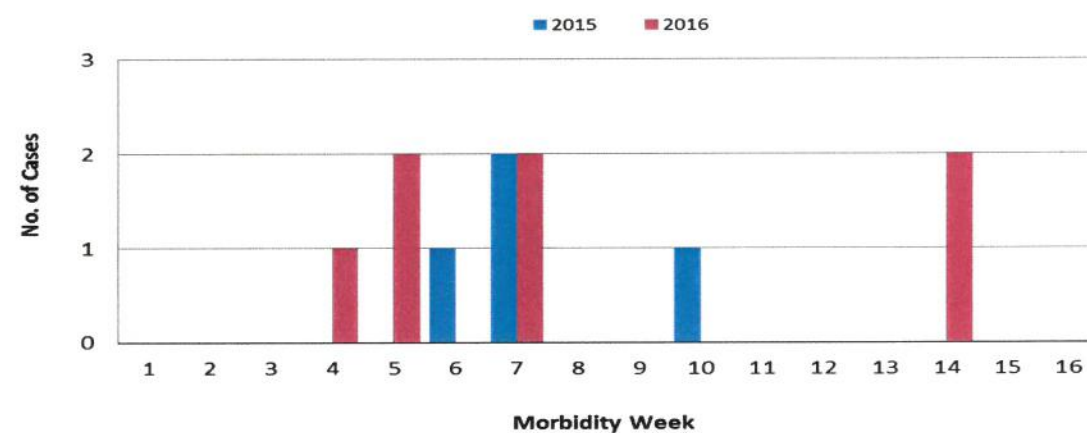
**Fig. 9 Suspect Meningococcal Disease Cases

Fig.11 Acute Bloody Diarrhea Cases as of April 23, 2016 (N=3,495)

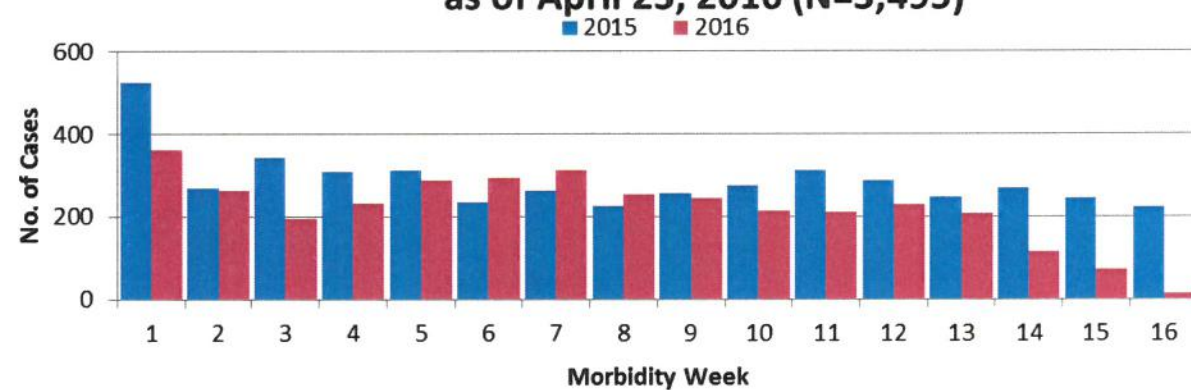
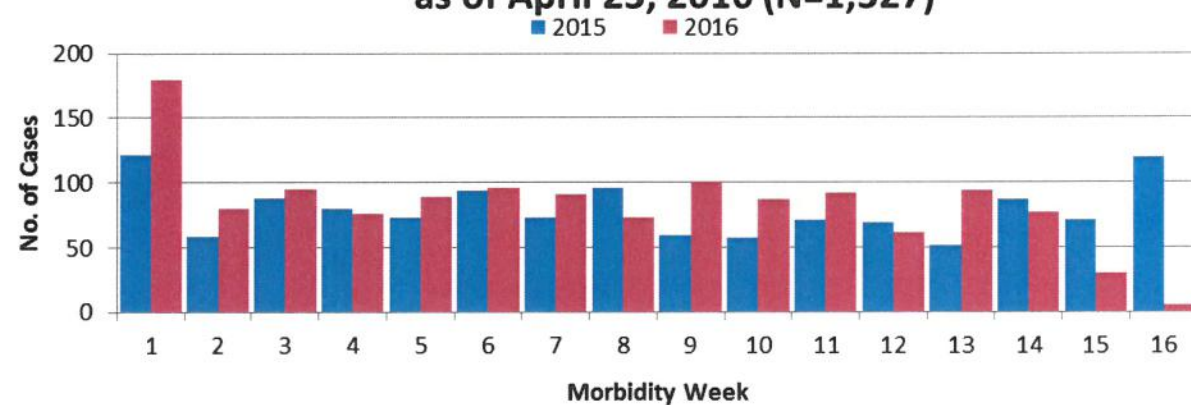


Fig.12 Suspect Cholera Cases as of April 23, 2016 (N=1,327)

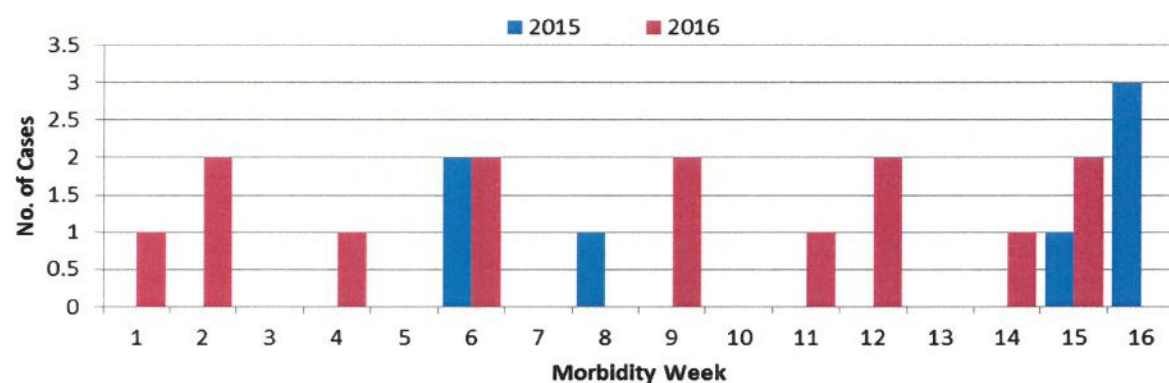




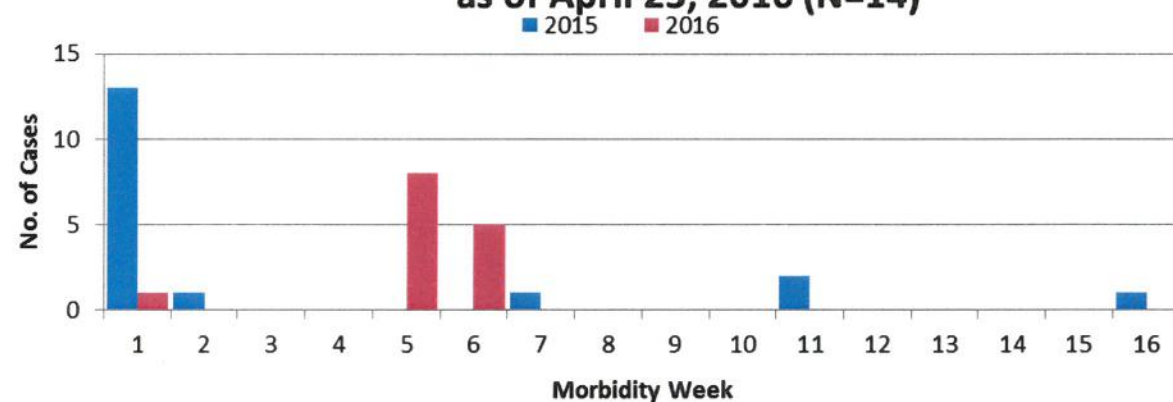

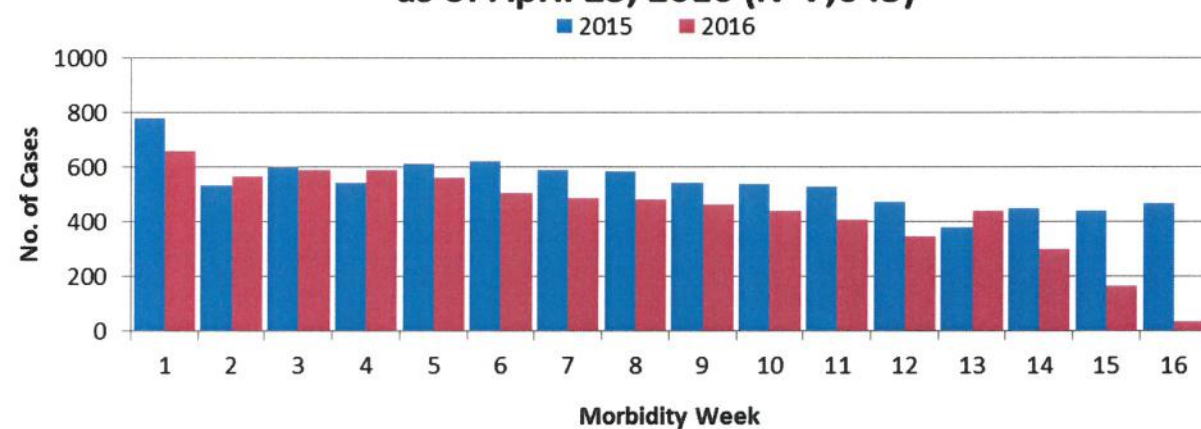
**Fig.13 Confirmed Cholera Cases

as of April 23, 2016 (N=7,045)**

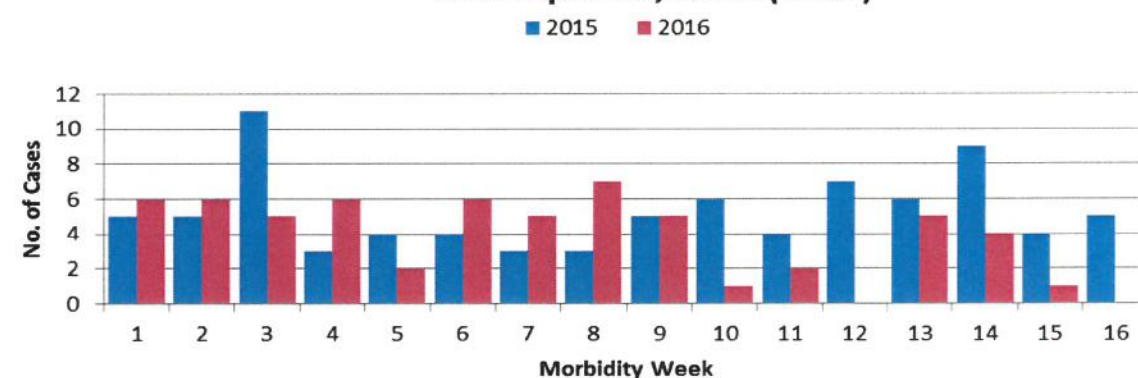




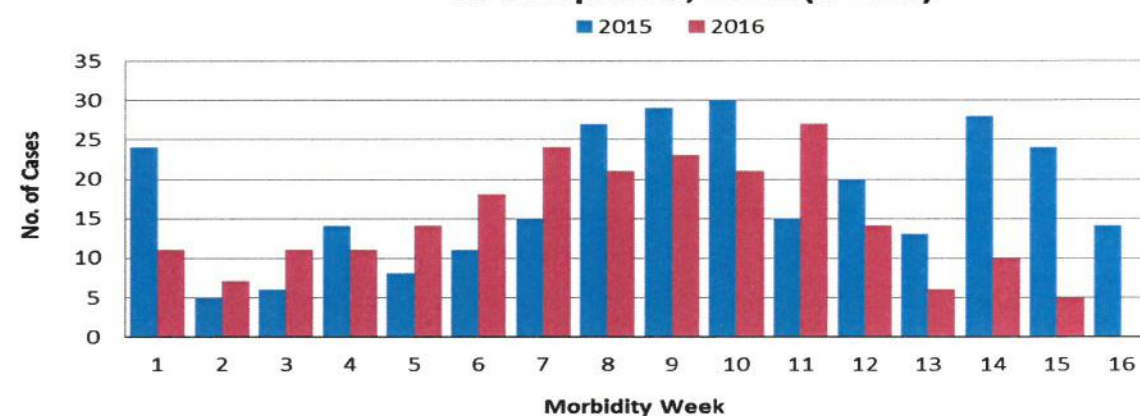

as of April 23, 2016 (n=61)**

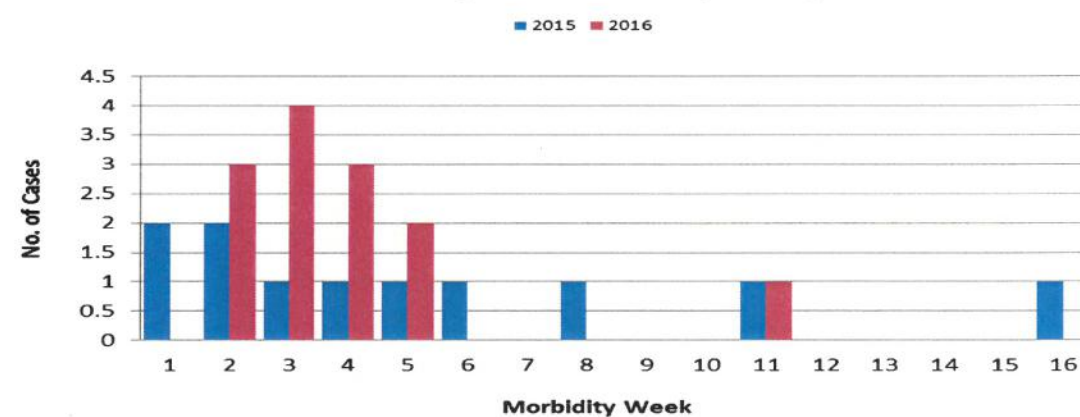


**Fig. 17 Confirmed Hepatitis A Cases

as of April 23, 2016 (N=13)**

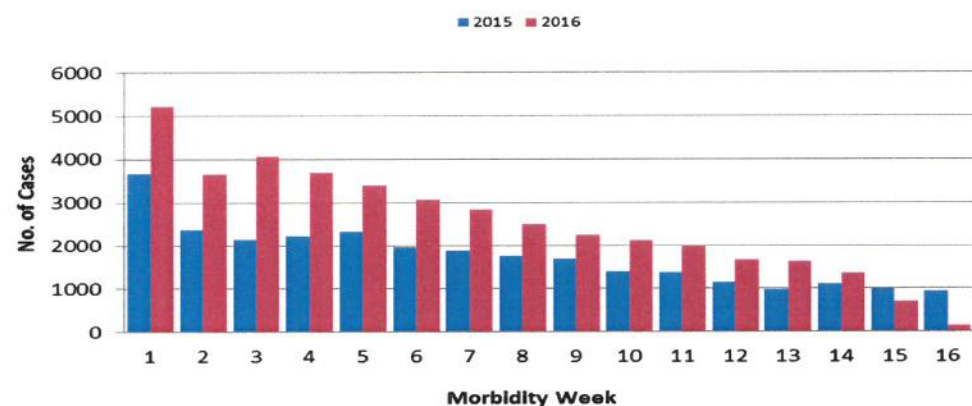




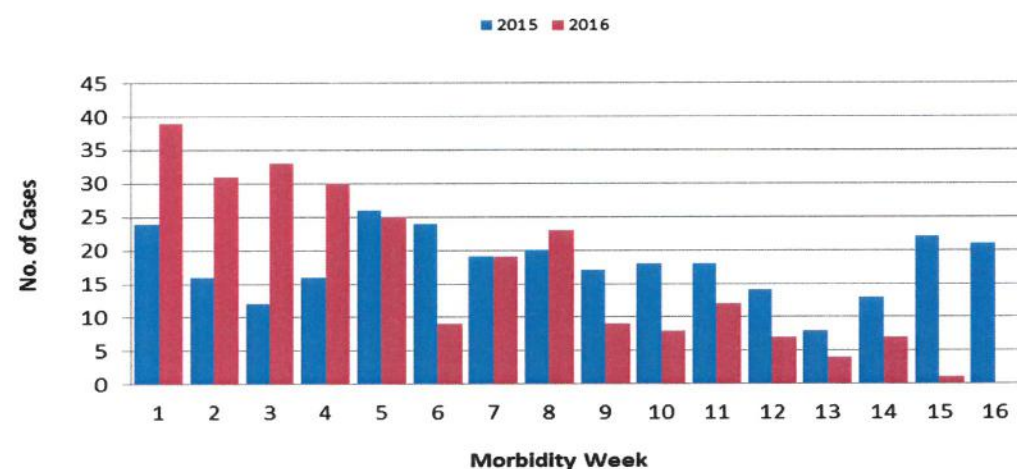

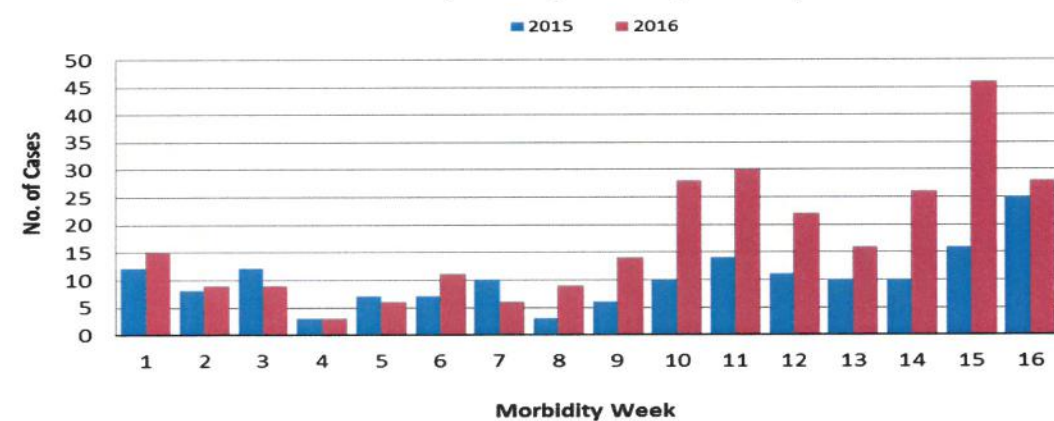
**Fig. 19 Suspect Dengue Cases

as of April 23, 2016 (N=278)**



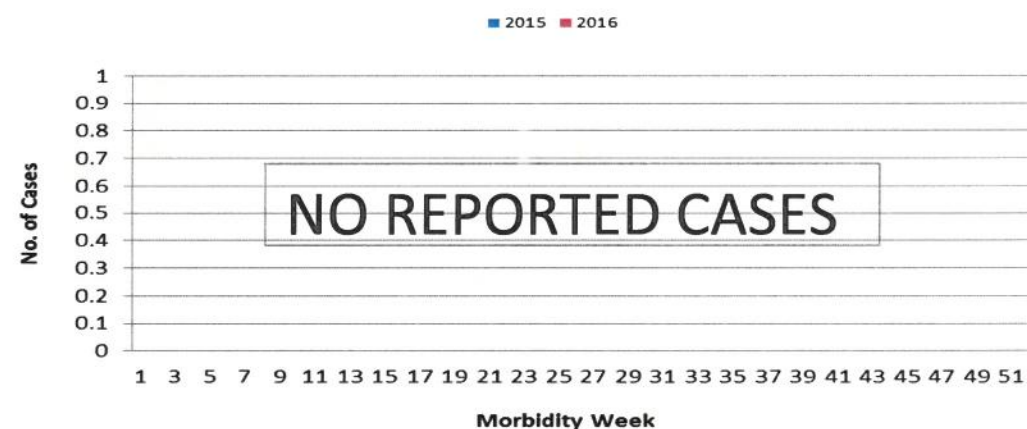

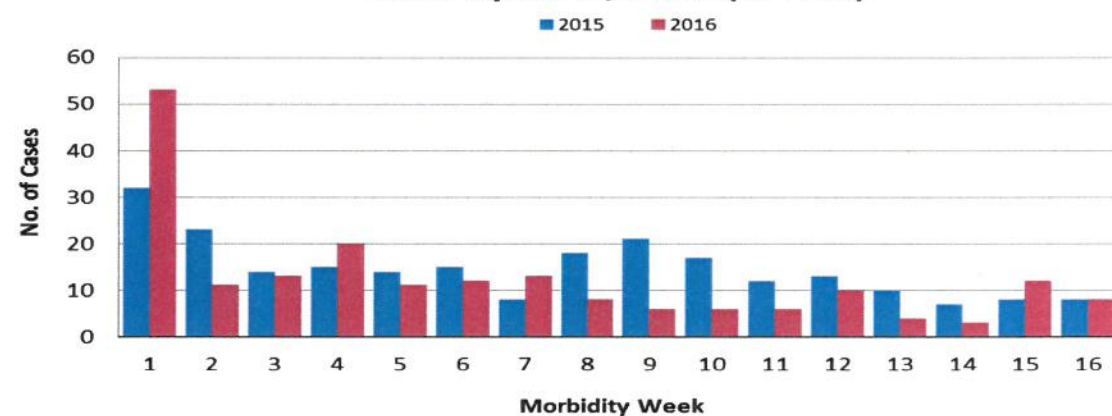

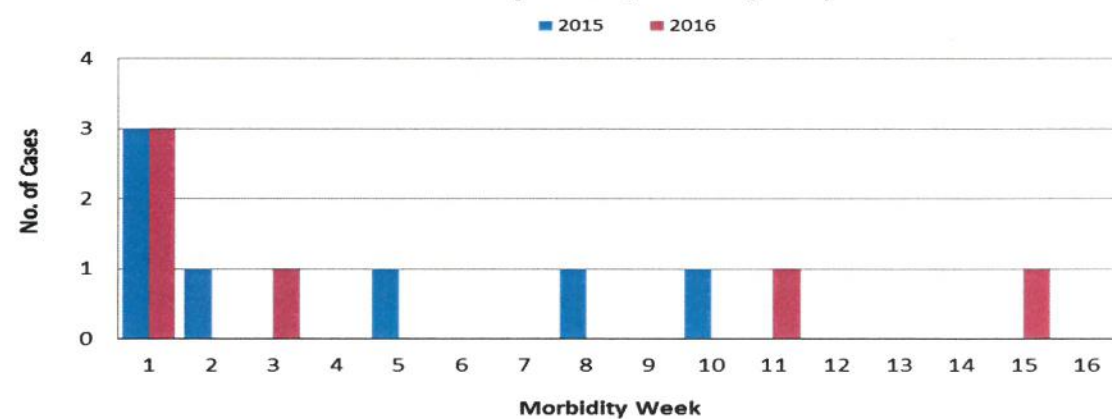
**Fig. 22 Suspect Anthrax Cases
as of April 23, 2016 (N=0)**



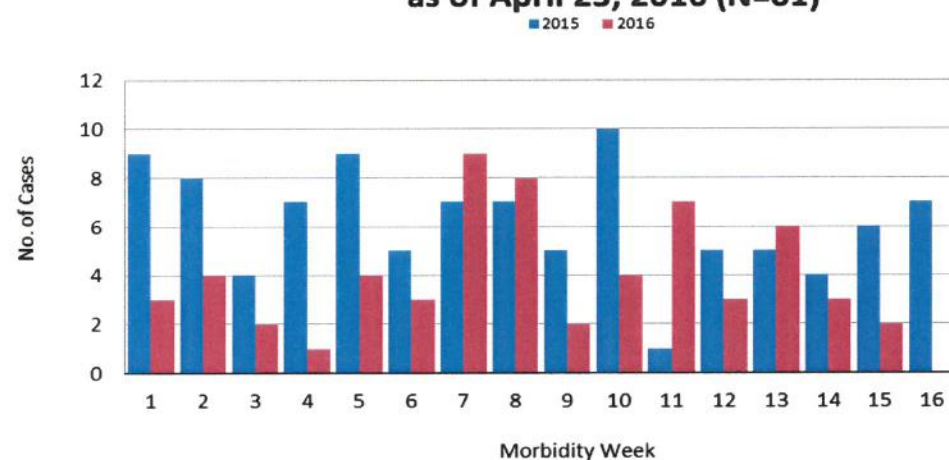
**Fig. 23 Suspect Leptospirosis Cases

as of April 23, 2016 (n=6)**

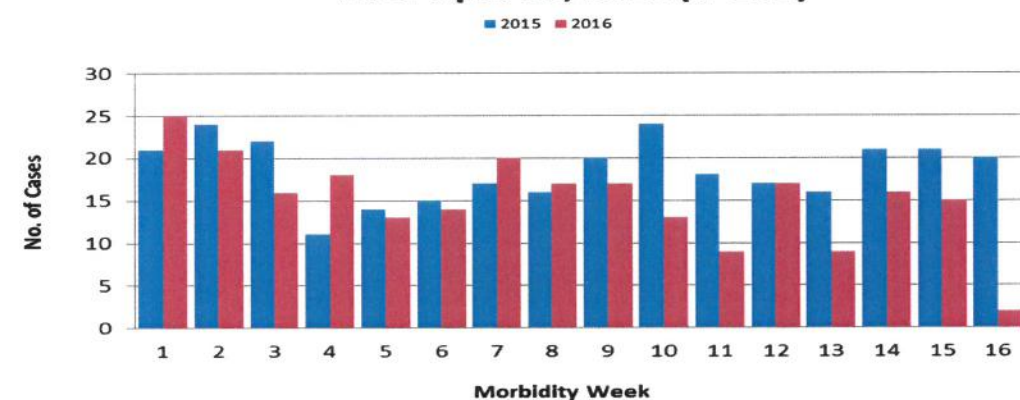


**Fig. 25 Probable Rabies Cases
 as of April 23, 2016 (N=61)**

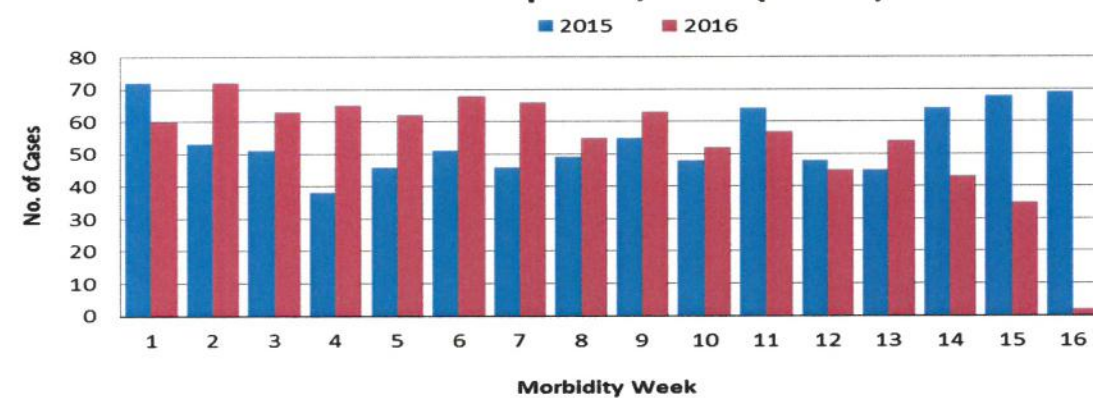

 as of April 23, 2016 (n=862)**

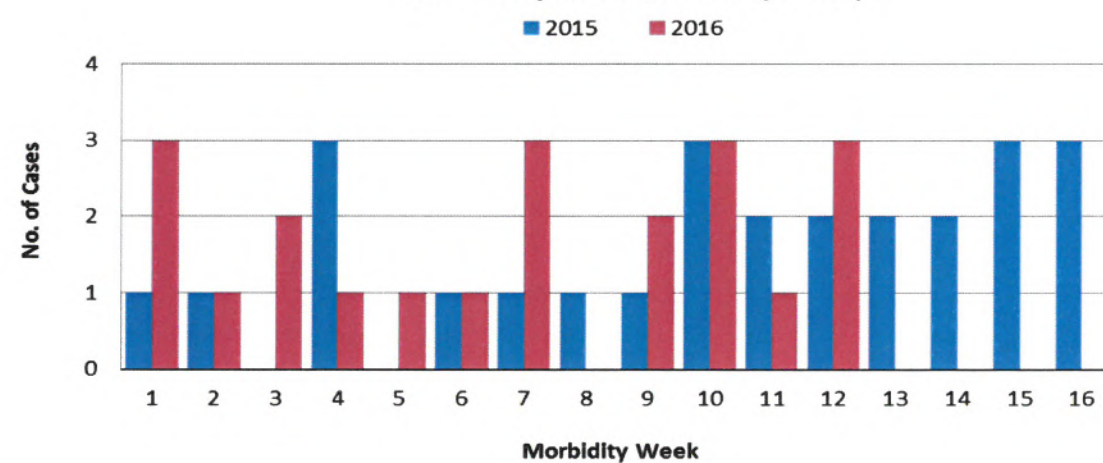
