Fig. 1 Suspect Acute Encephalitis Syndrome Cases as of April 30, 2016, (N=94)

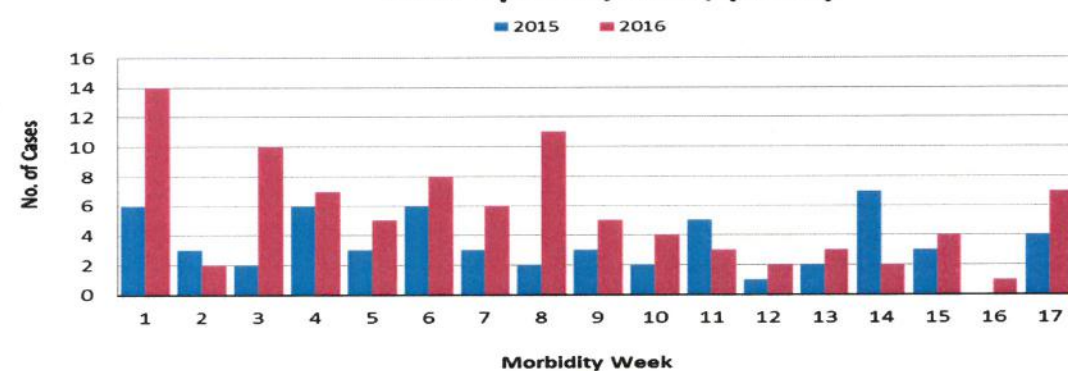


Fig. 2 Confirmed Acute Encephalitis Syndrome Cases as of April 30, 2016, (n=4)

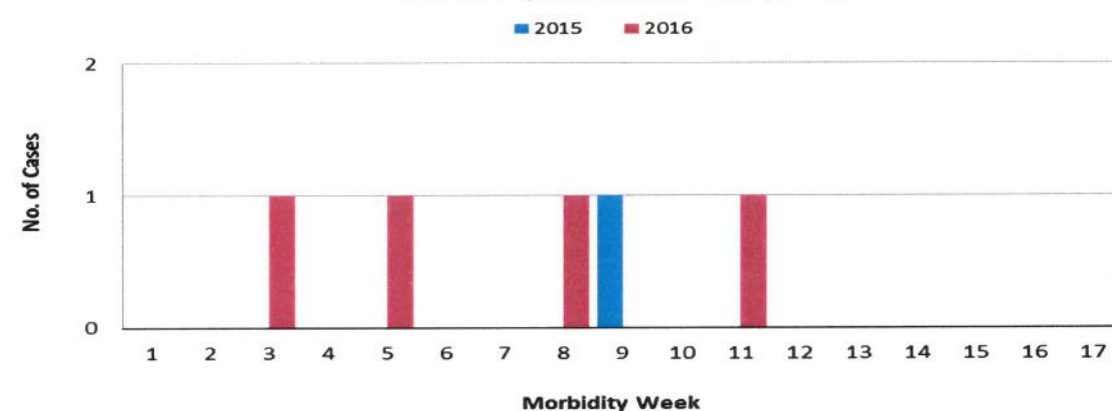
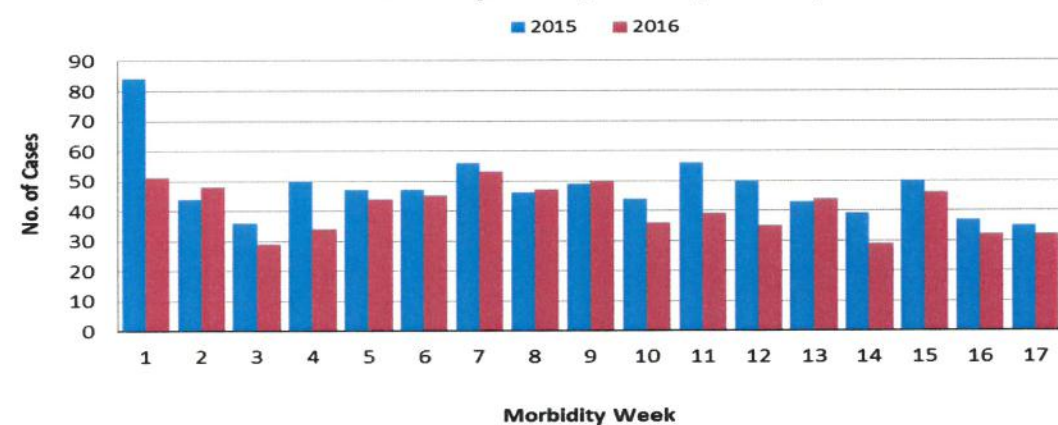


Fig. 3 Suspect Bacterial Meningitis Cases as of April 30, 2016 (N=694)

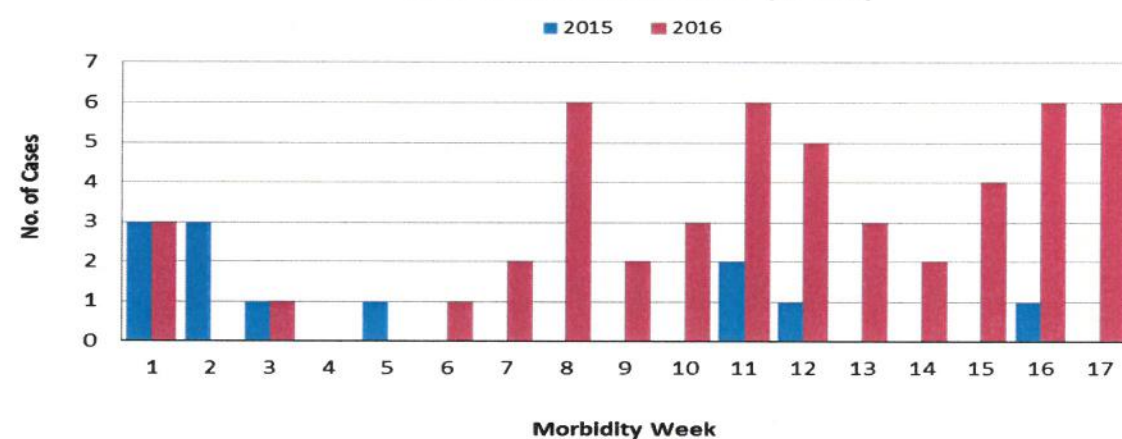




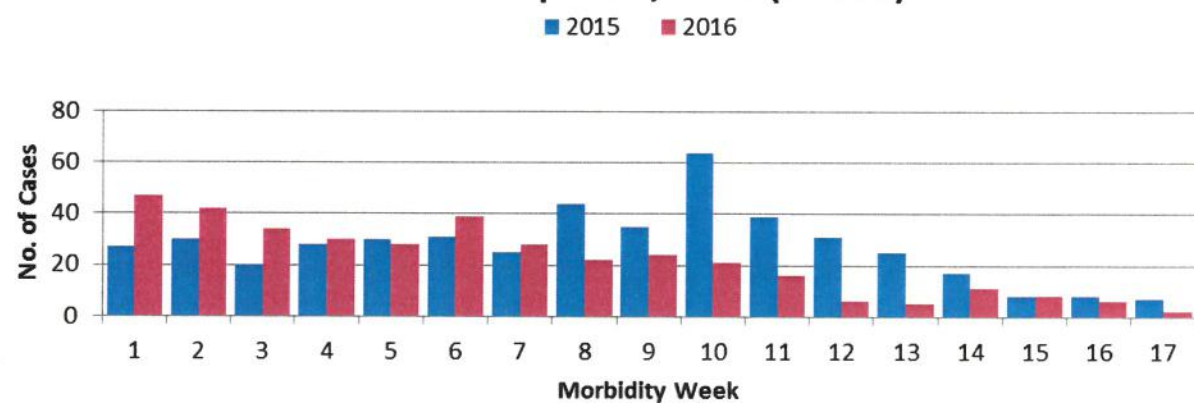
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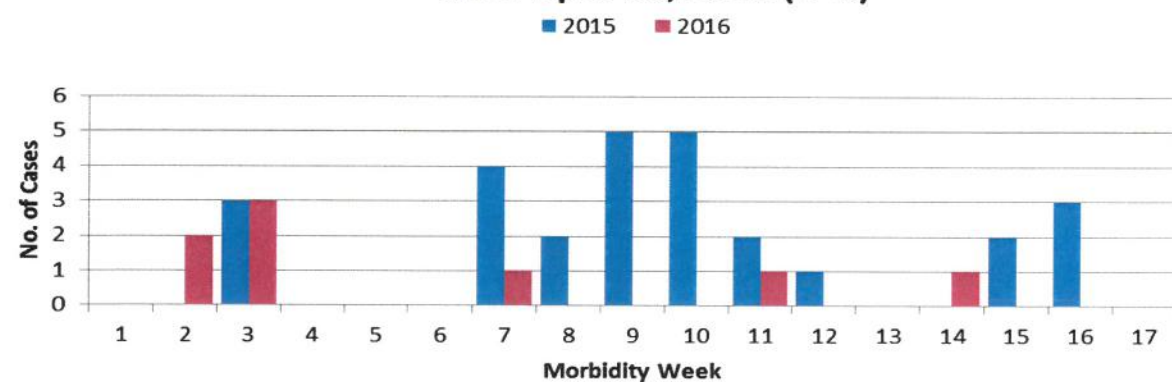
**Fig. 4 Confirmed Bacterial Meningitis Cases

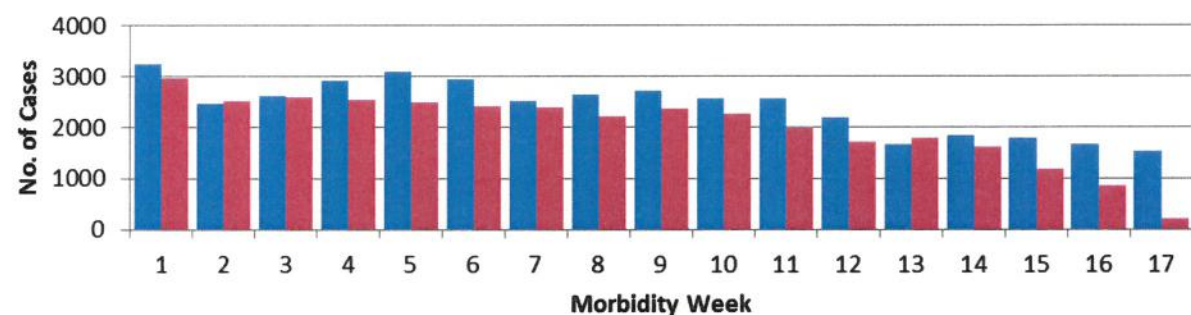


Fig.8 Influenza Cases

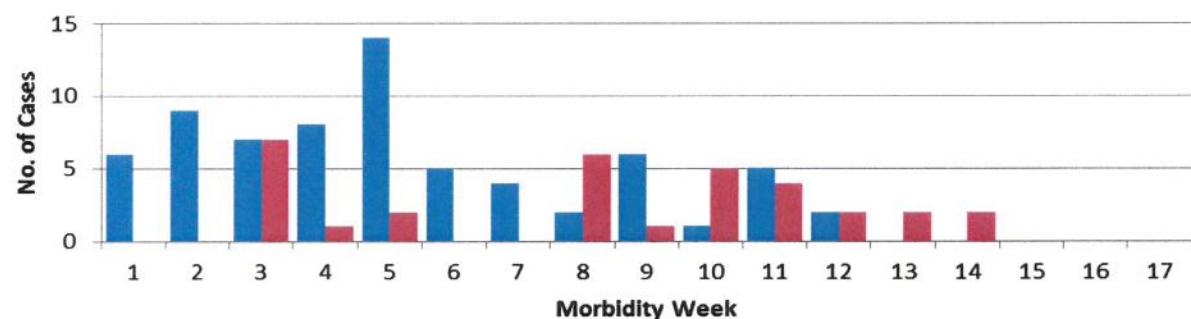
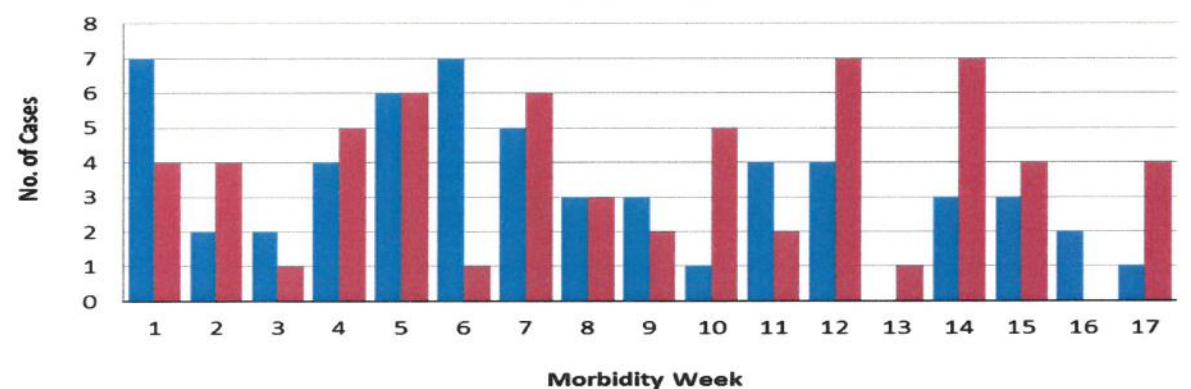


Fig. 9 Suspect Meningococcal Disease Cases

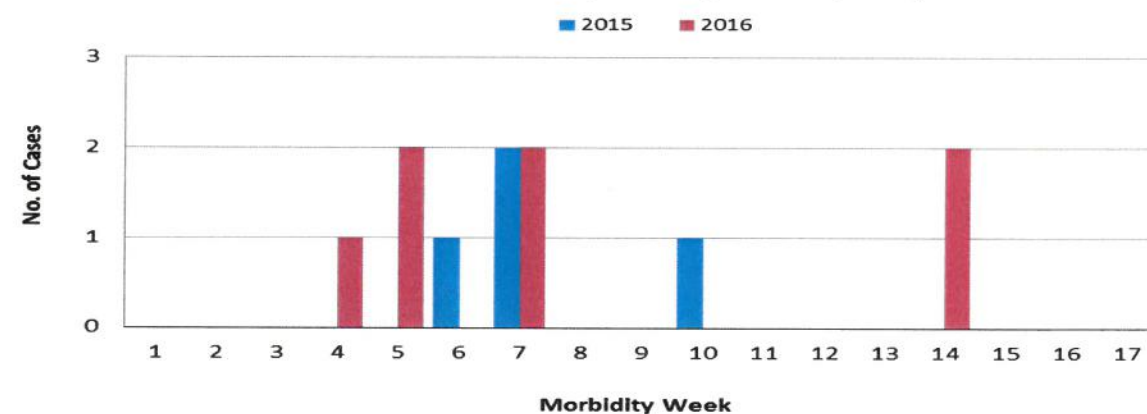




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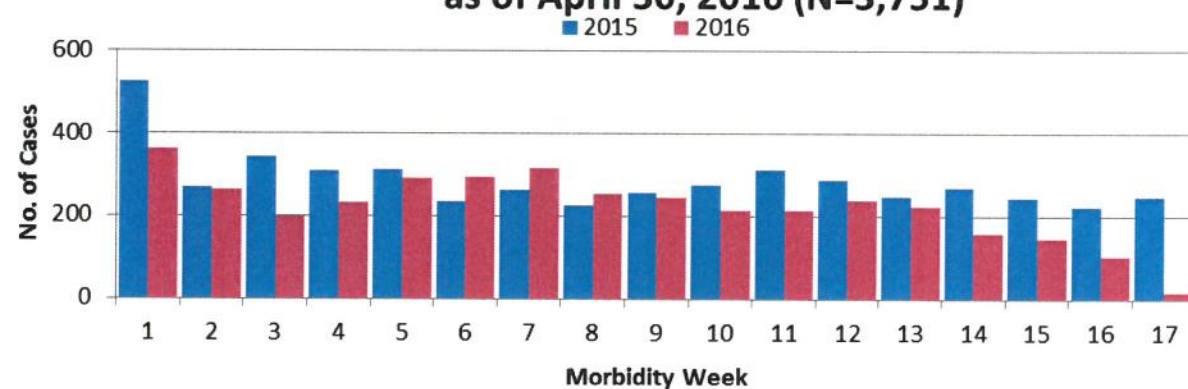
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**Fig. 10 Confirmed Meningococcal Disease Cases
as of April 30, 2016 (n=7)**

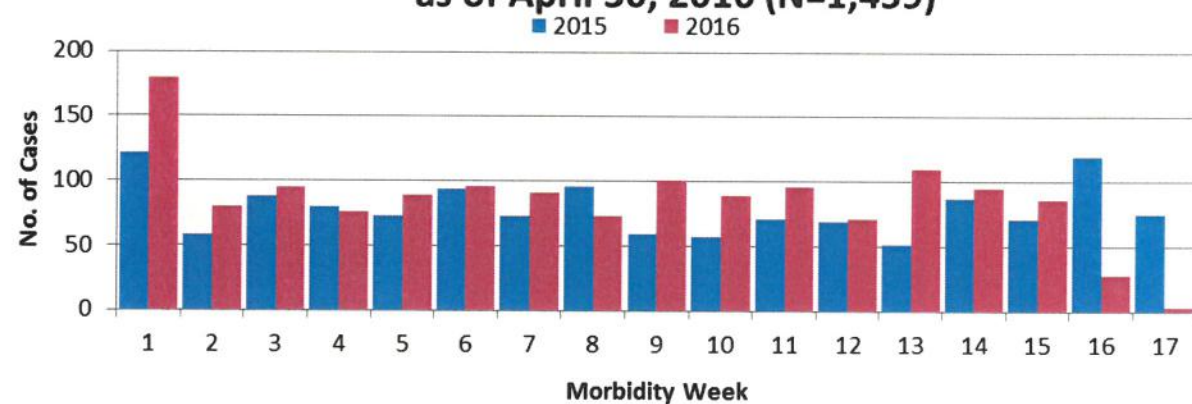

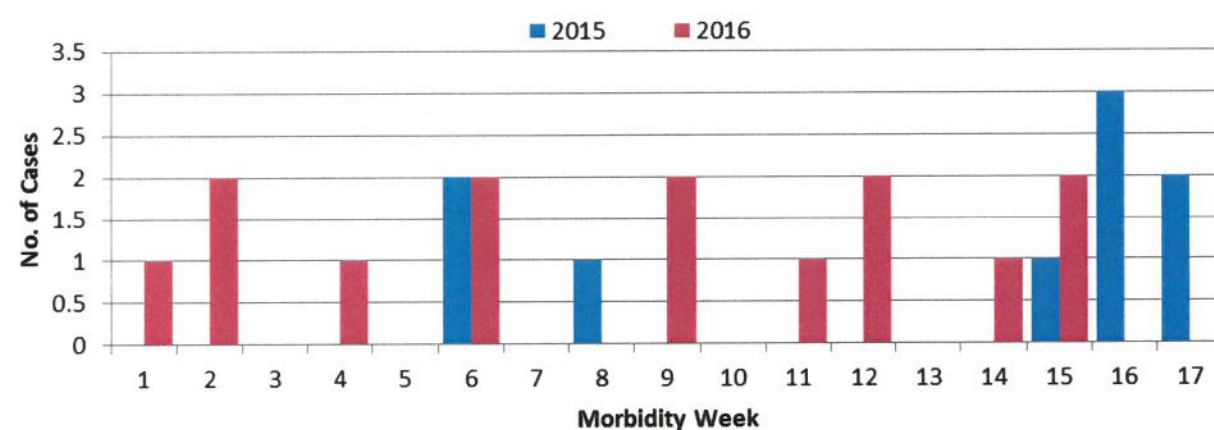


Fig.14 Paralytic Shellfish Poisoning Cases
 as of April 30, 2016 (N=14)

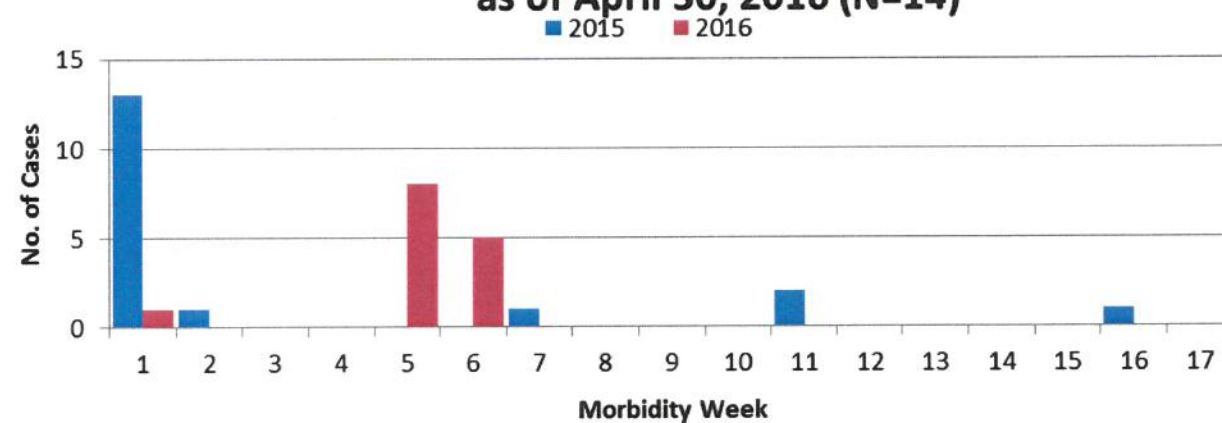
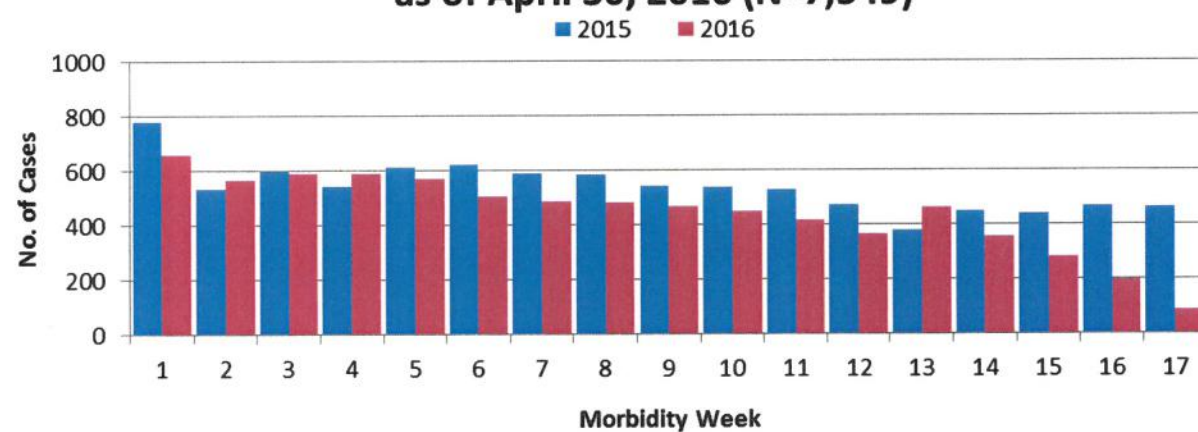


Fig.15 Suspect Typhoid Cases
 as of April 30, 2016 (N=7,549)

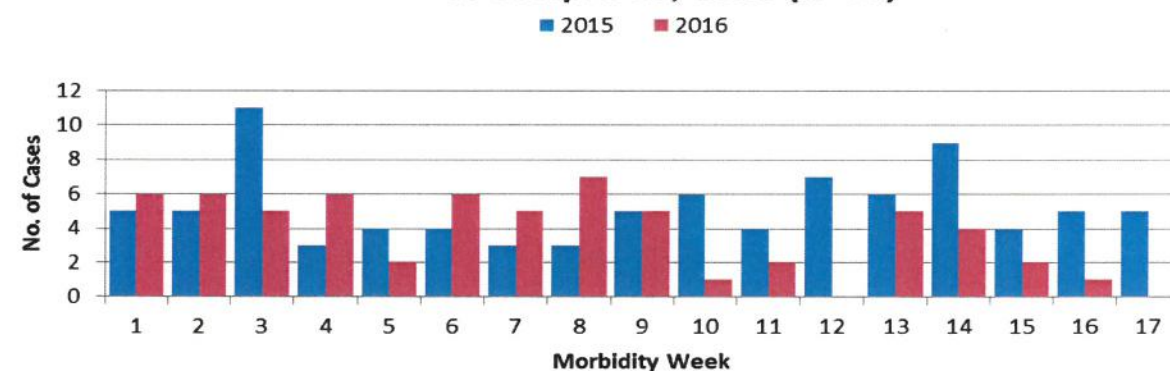




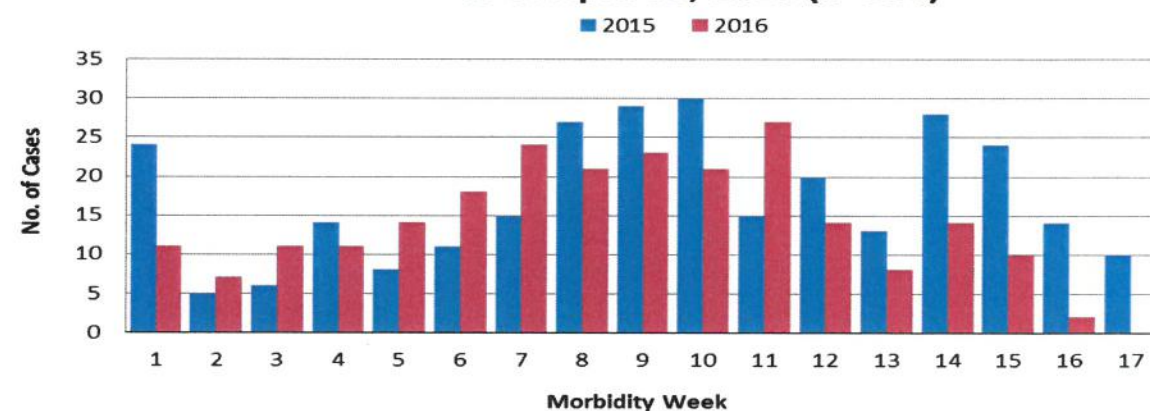
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**Fig.16 Confirmed Typhoid Cases
as of April 30, 2016 (n=63)**

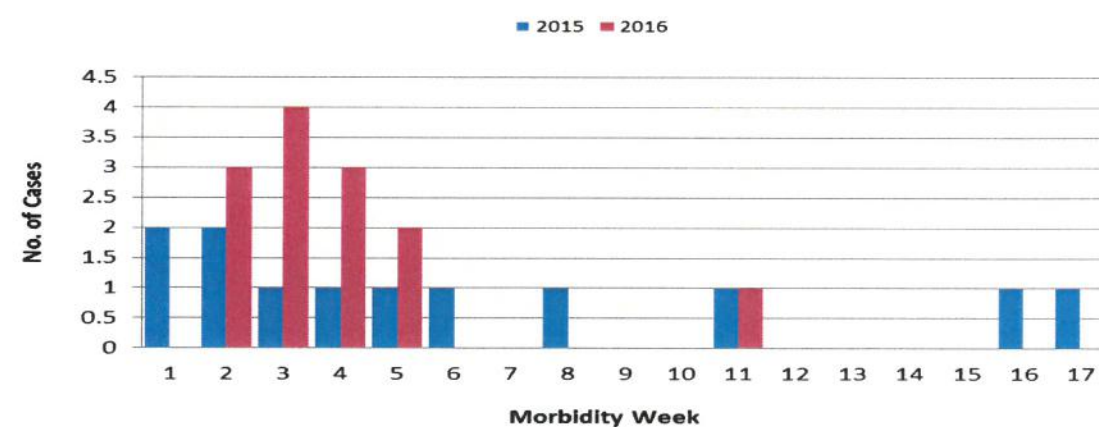


**Fig. 17 Confirmed Hepatitis A Cases

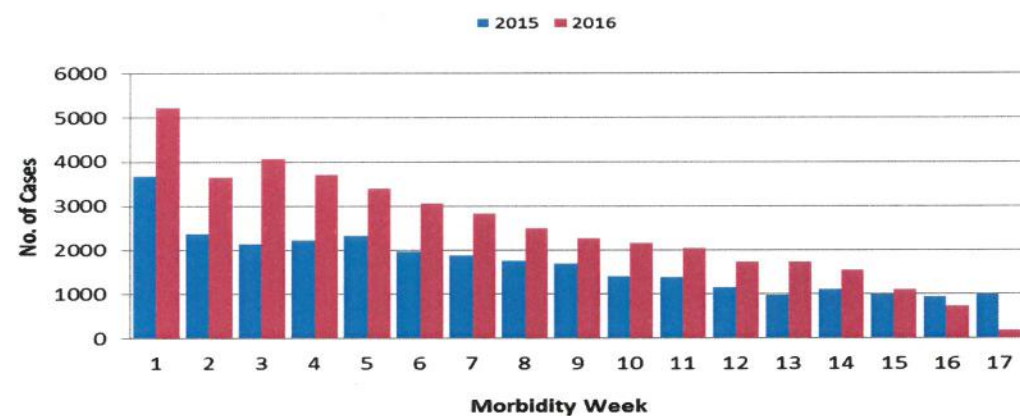
**Fig. 18 Suspect Acute Hemorrhagic Fever Cases
as of April 30, 2016 (N=13)**



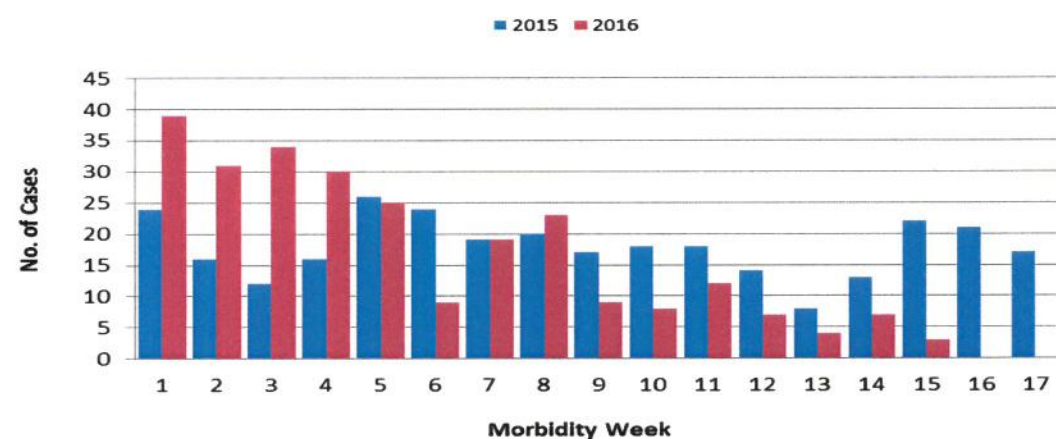
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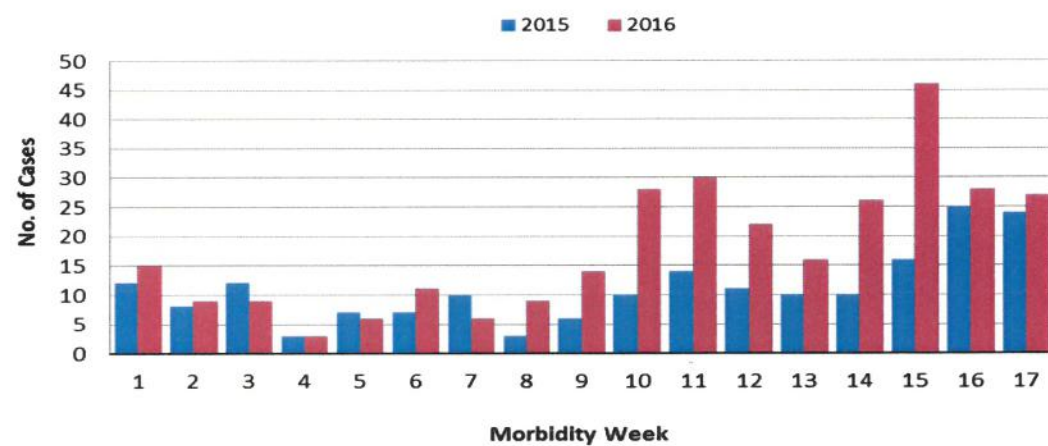
**Fig. 19 Suspect Dengue Cases

 as of April 30, 2016 (N=305)**



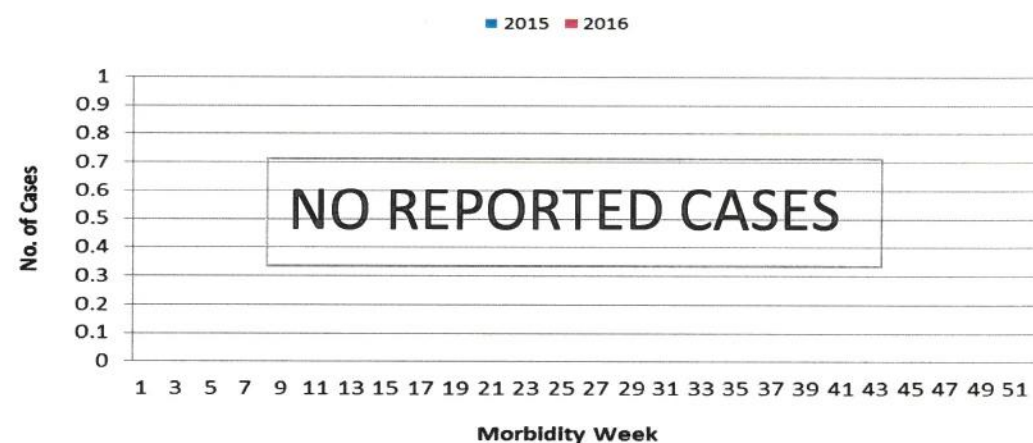


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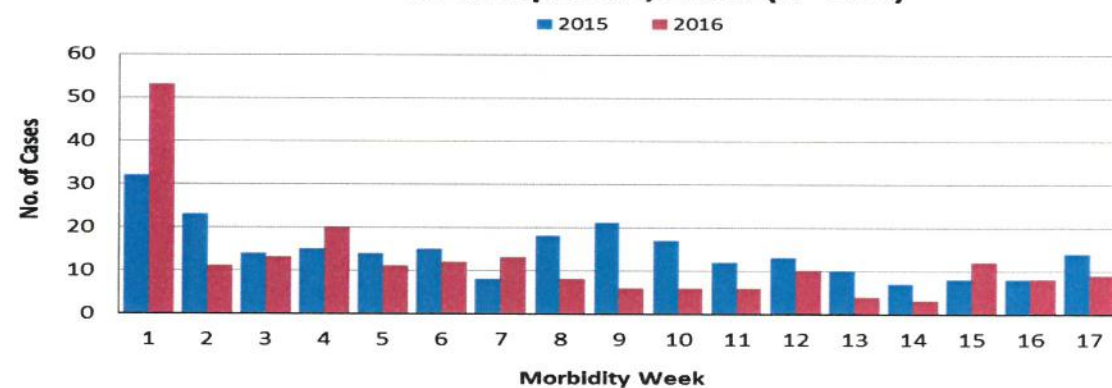

as of April 30, 2016 (n=6)**

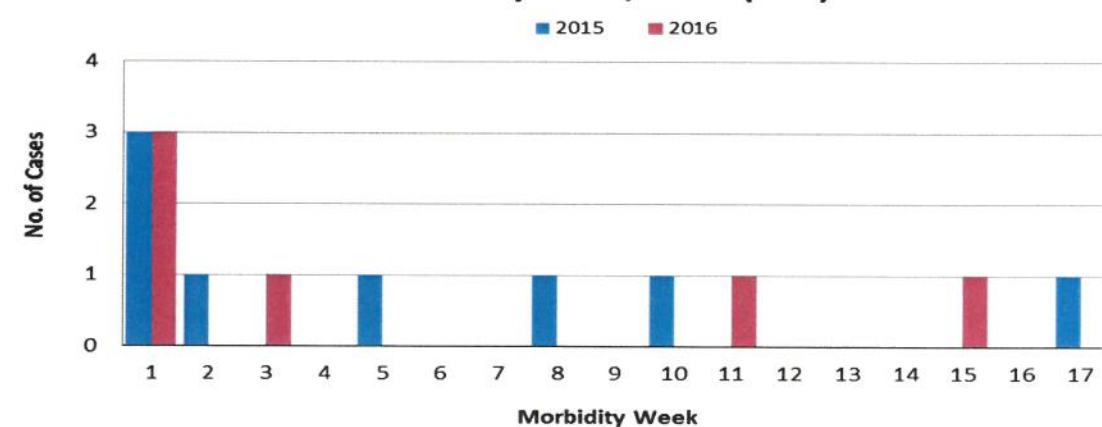
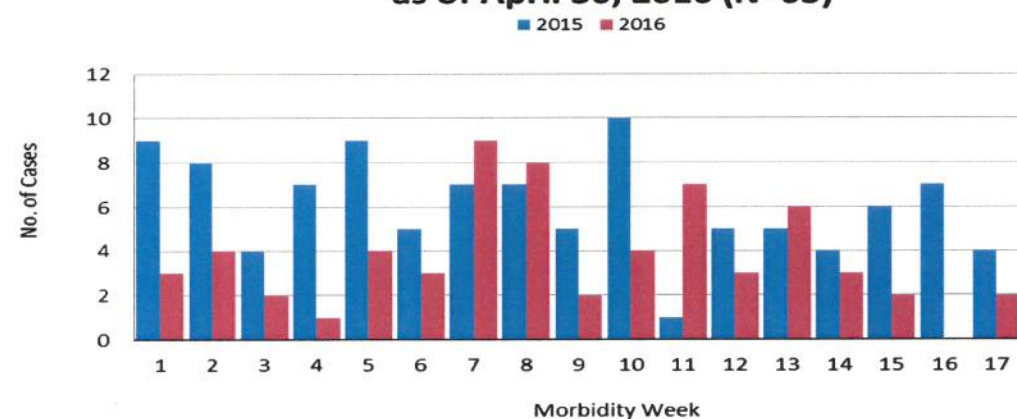


Fig. 25 Probable Rabies Cases as of April 30, 2016 (N=63)

Fig. 26 Confirmed Non-neonatal Tetanus Cases as of April 30, 2016 (n=260)

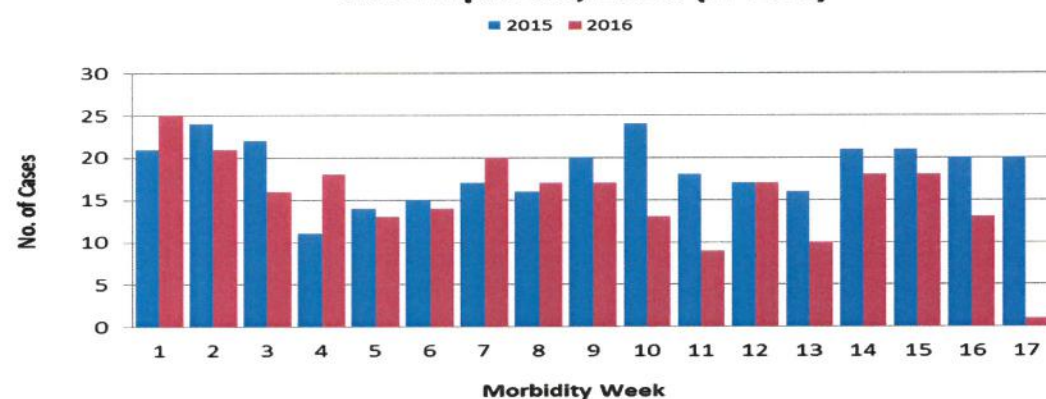
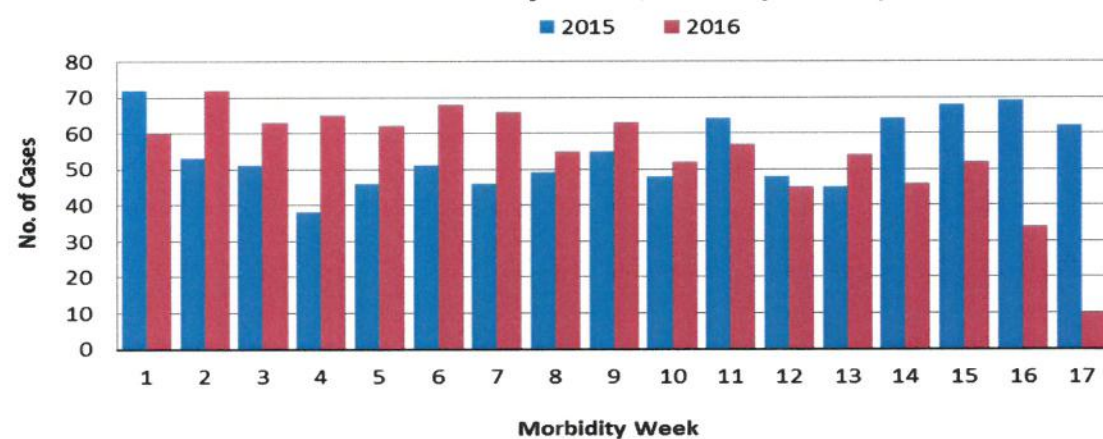


Fig. 27 Confirmed Hepatitis B Cases as of April 30, 2016 (n=924)

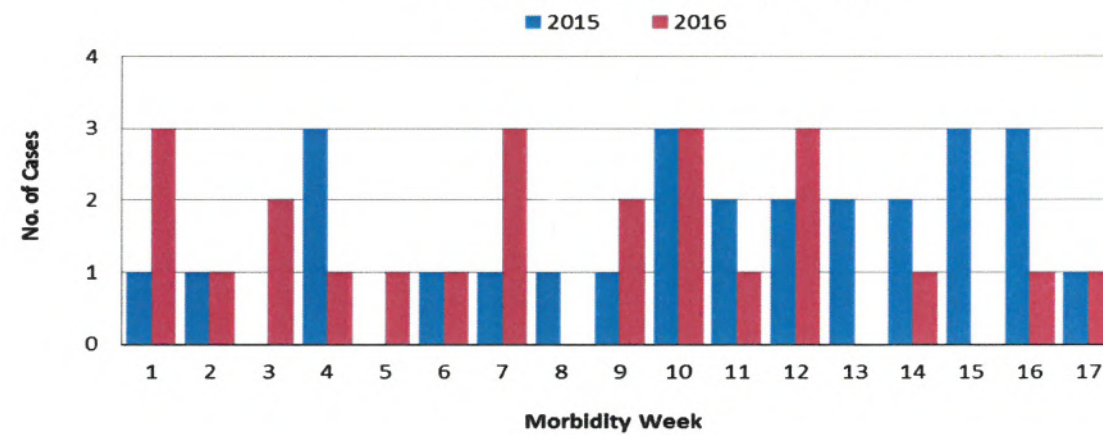




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**Fig. 28 Confirmed Hepatitis C Cases
