Fig. 1 Suspect Acute Encephalitis Syndrome Cases as of May 7, 2016, (N=97)

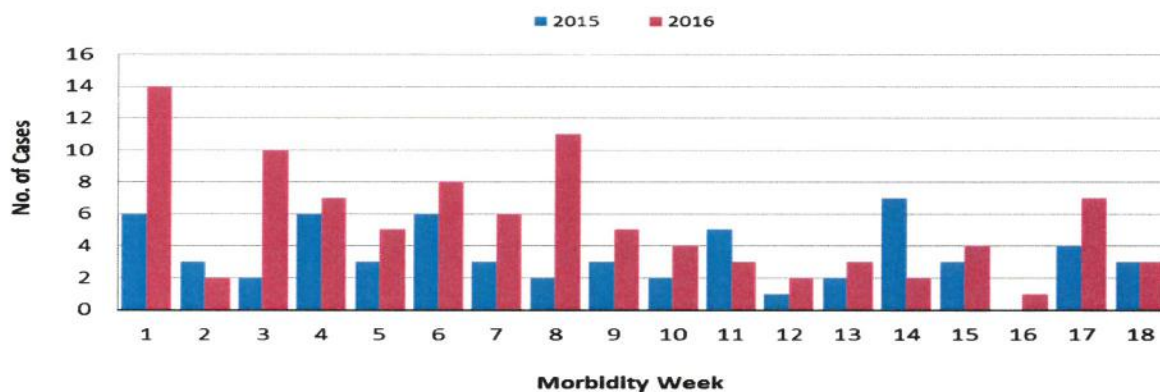


Fig. 2 Confirmed Acute Encephalitis Syndrome Cases as of May 7, 2016, (n=4)

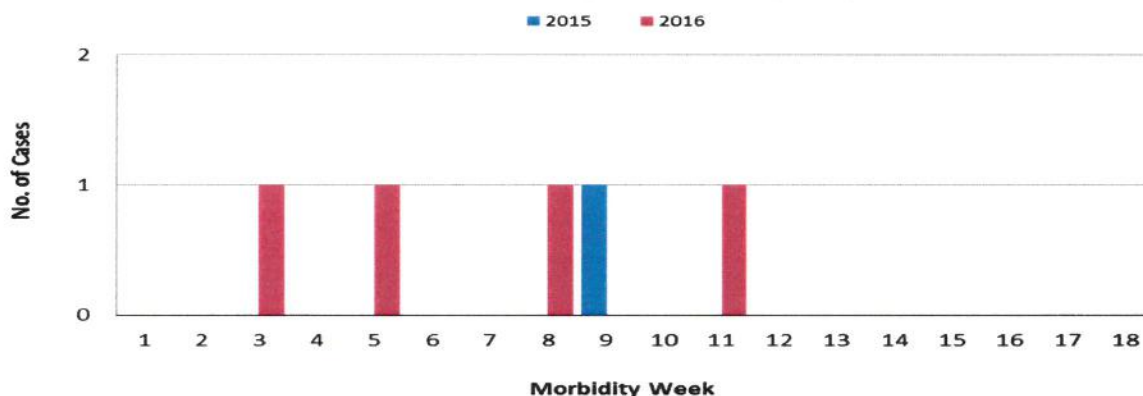
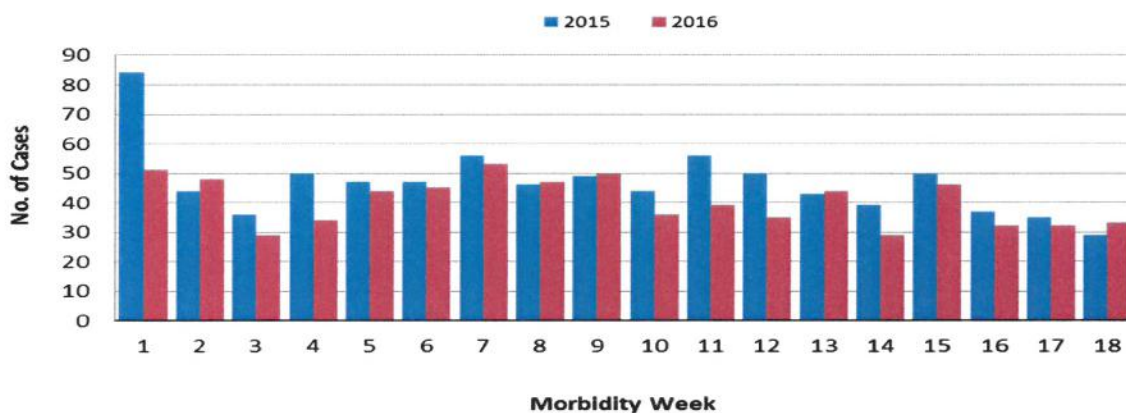


Fig. 3 Suspect Bacterial Meningitis Cases as of May 7, 2016 (N=727)

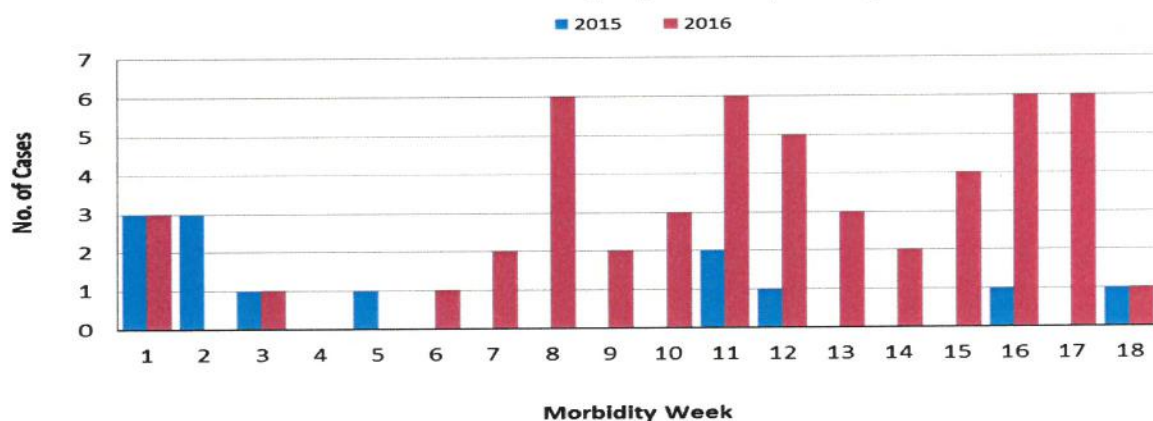




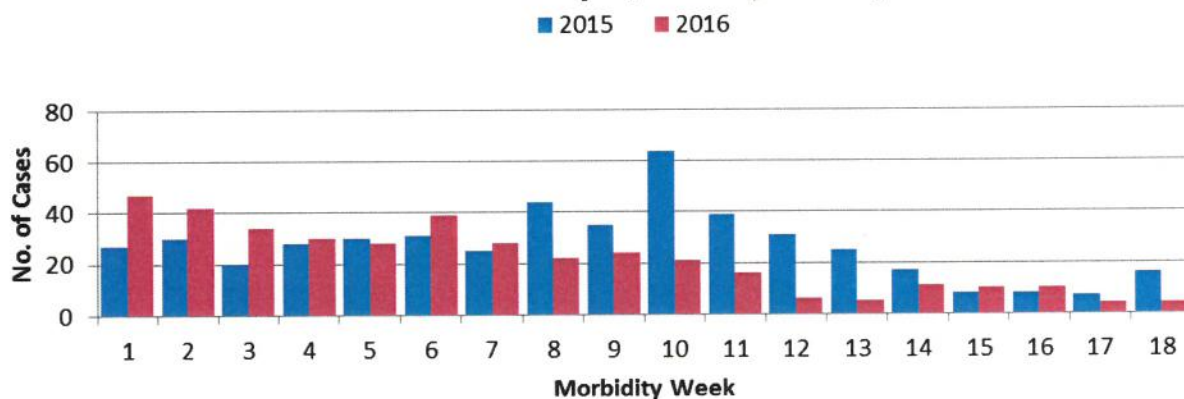
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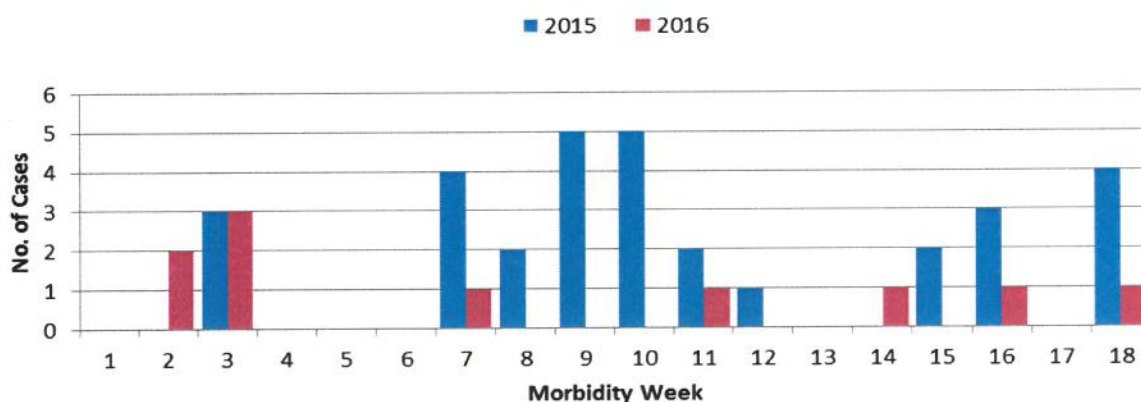
**Fig. 4 Confirmed Bacterial Meningitis Cases

as of May 7, 2016 (n=10)**

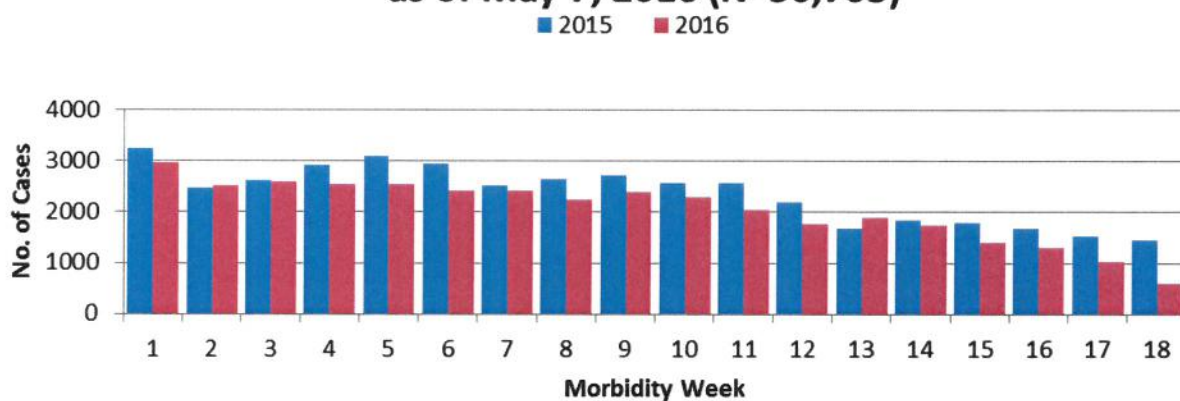




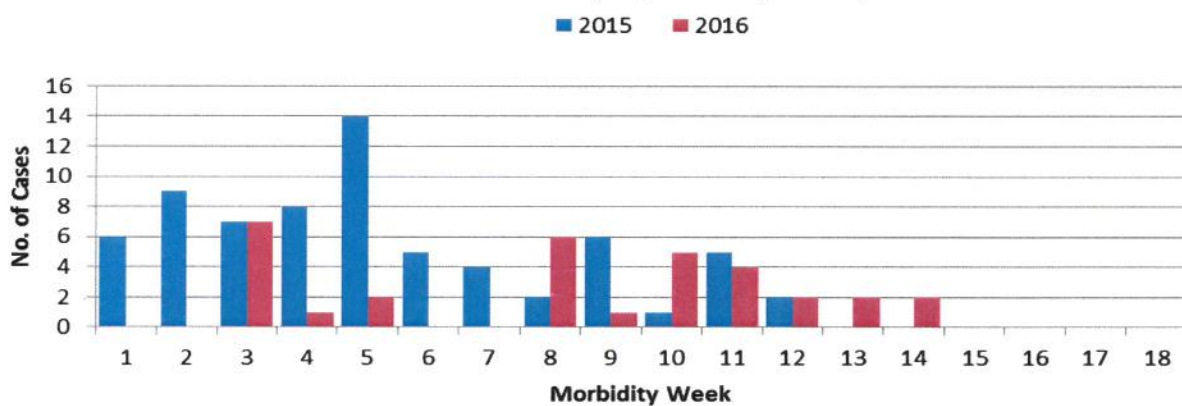
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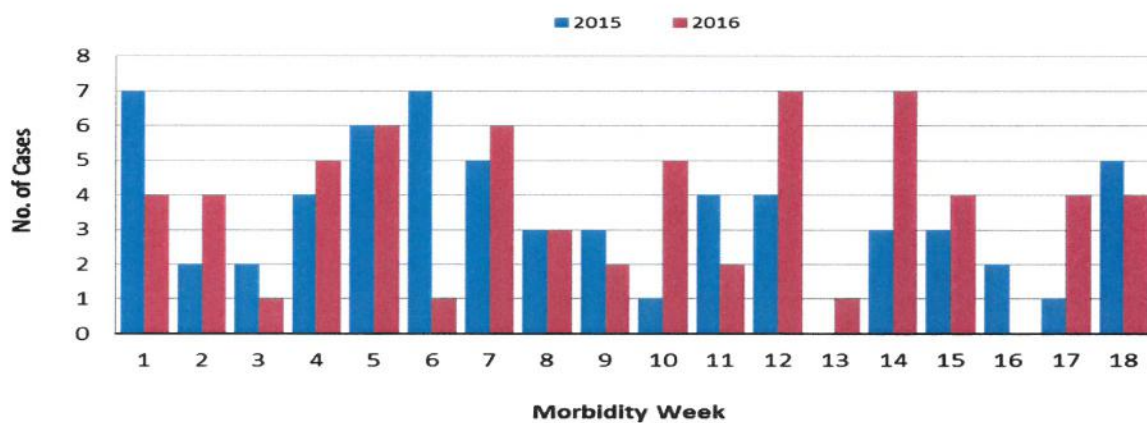
**Fig.7 Influenza-like Illness Cases

as of May 7, 2016 (N=66)**

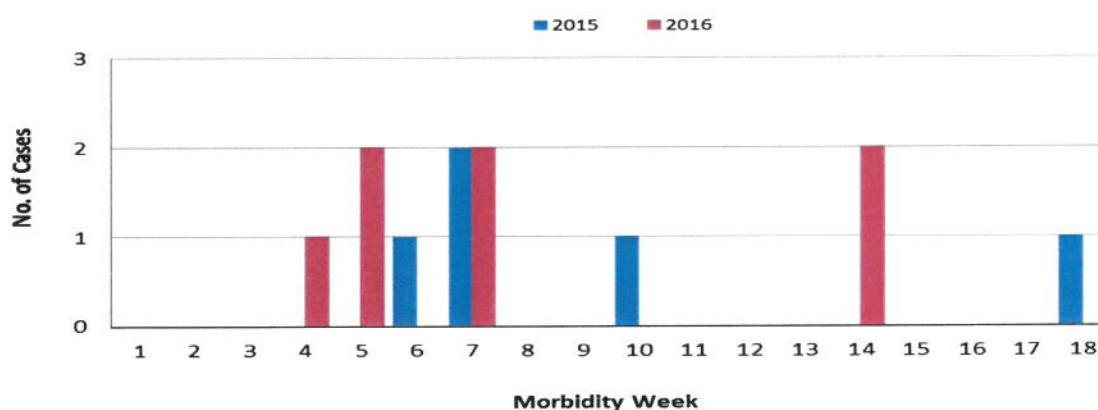




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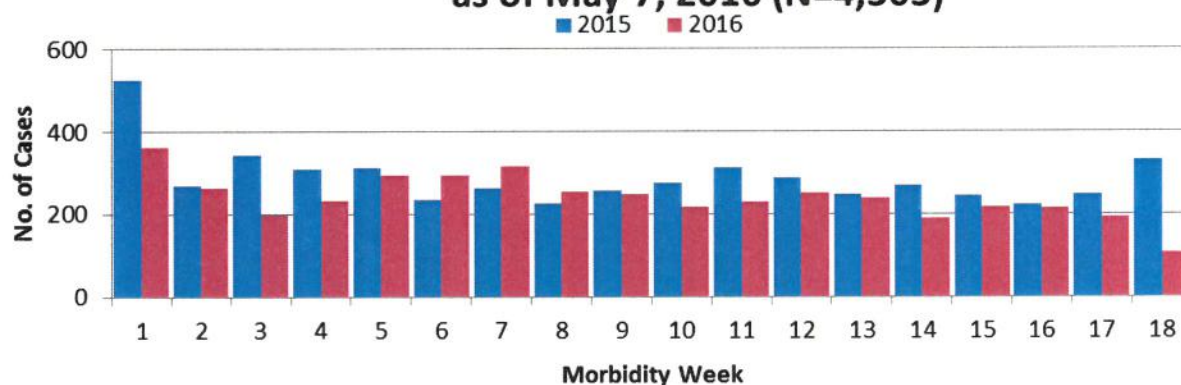
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**Fig. 10 Confirmed Meningococcal Disease Cases
as of May 7, 2016 (n=7)**

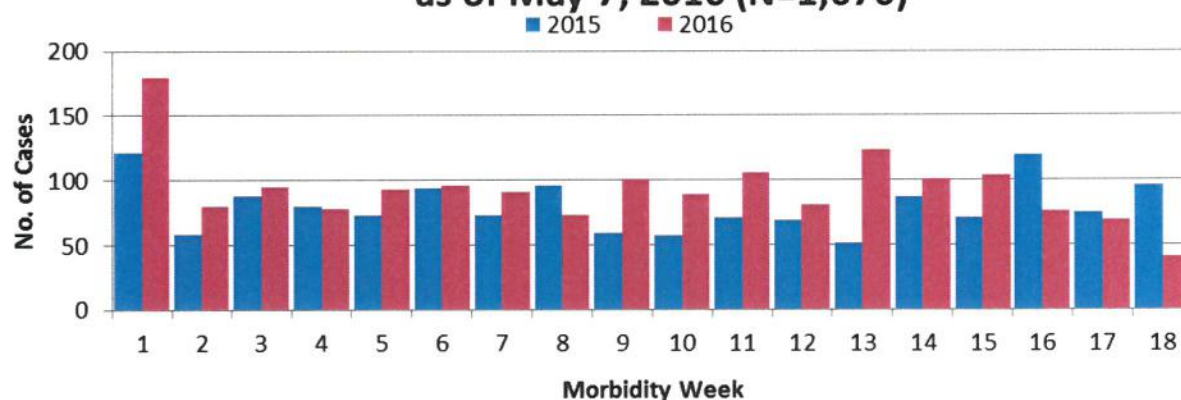

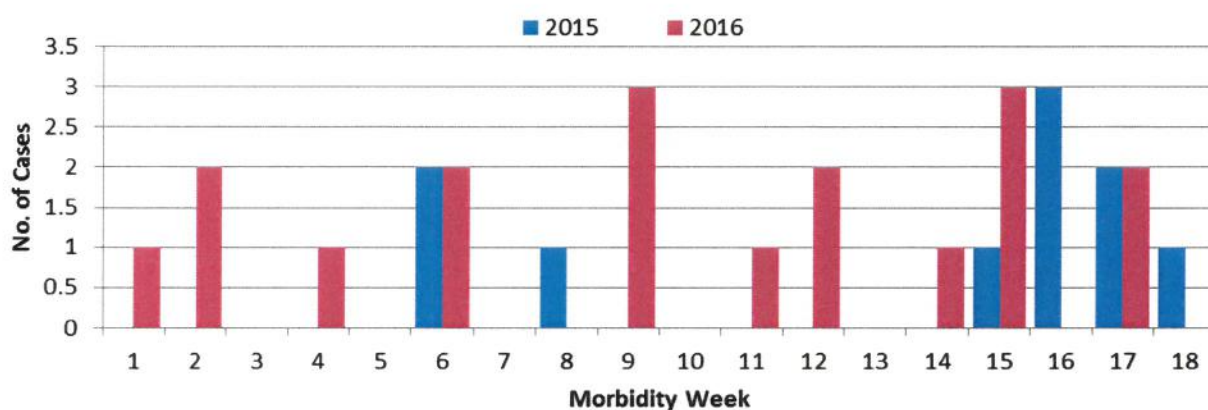




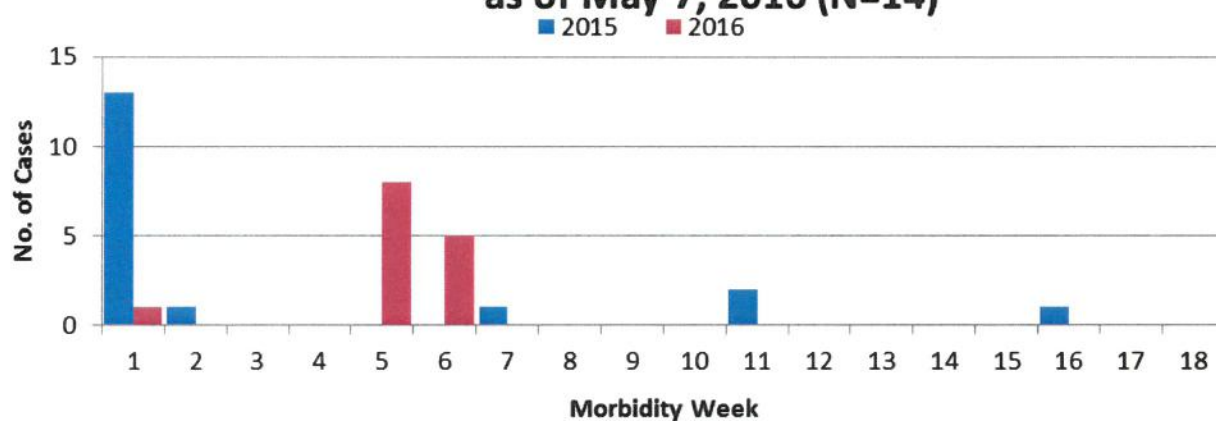
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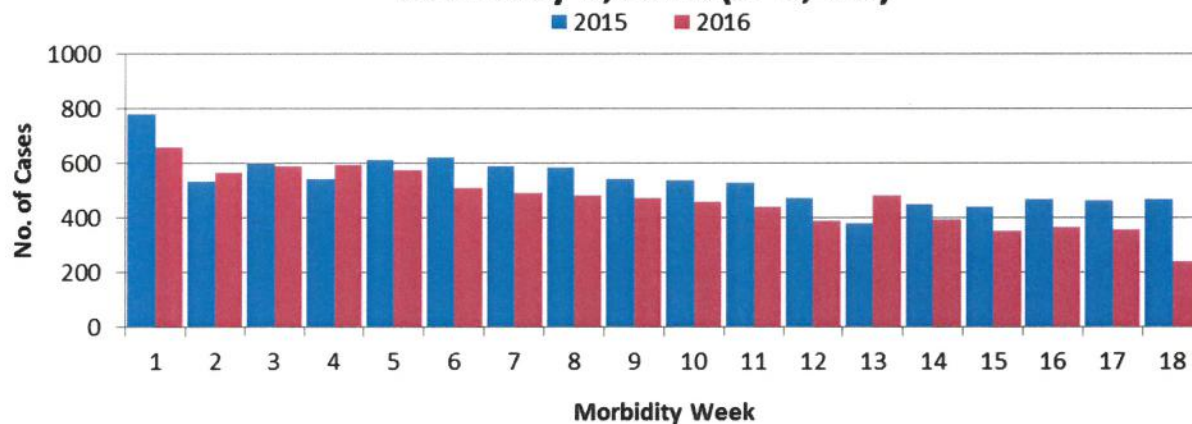
**Fig.13 Confirmed Cholera Cases

as of May 7, 2016 (N=8,433)**

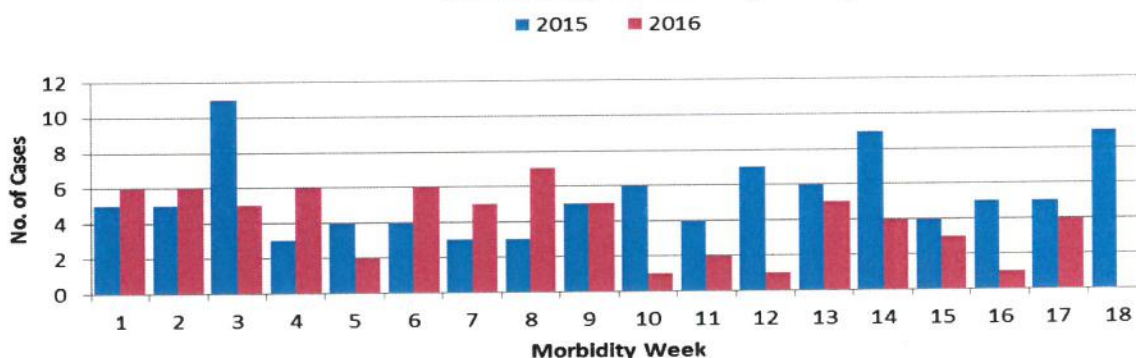




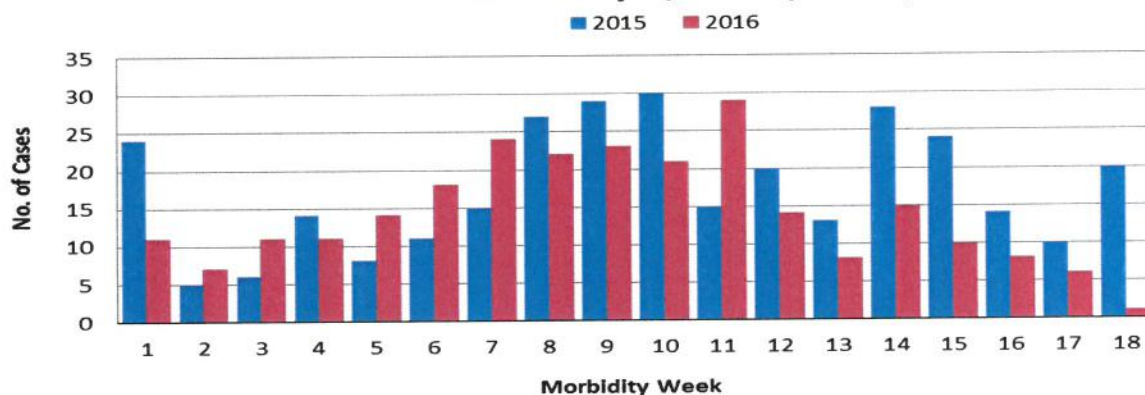
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**Fig.16 Confirmed Typhoid Cases
as of May 7, 2016 (n=69)**

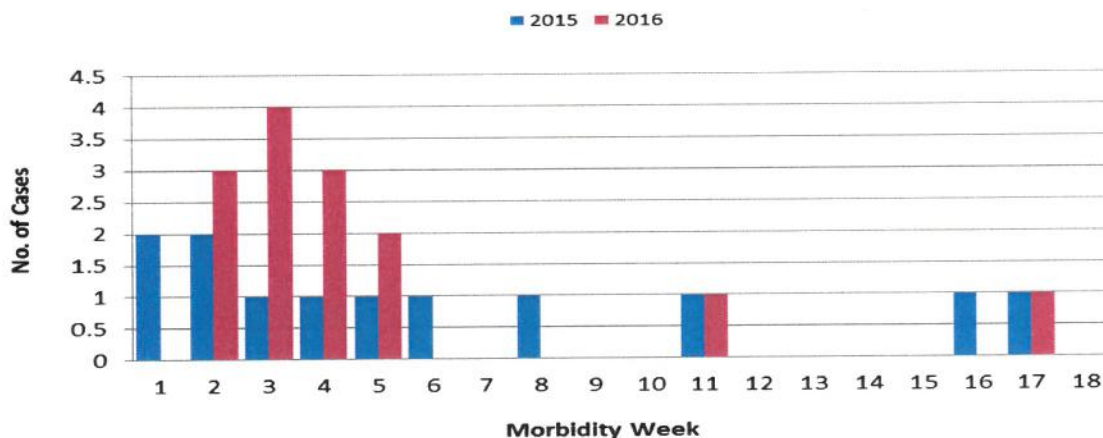


**Fig. 17 Confirmed Hepatitis A Cases

as of May 7, 2016 (N=13)**

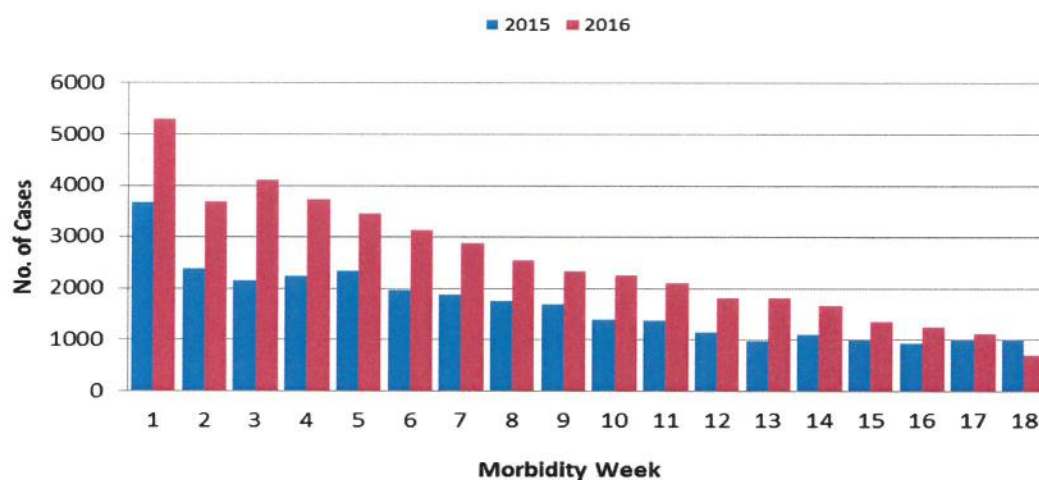




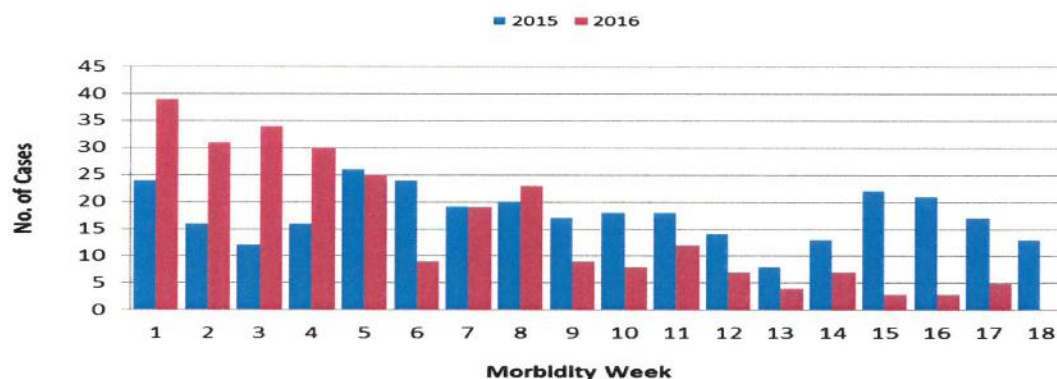
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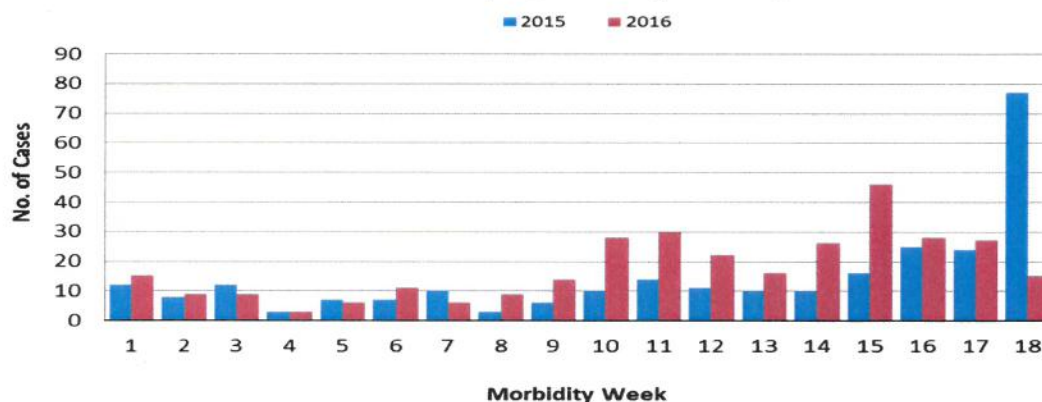
**Fig. 19 Suspect Dengue Cases

as of May 7, 2016 (N=320)**



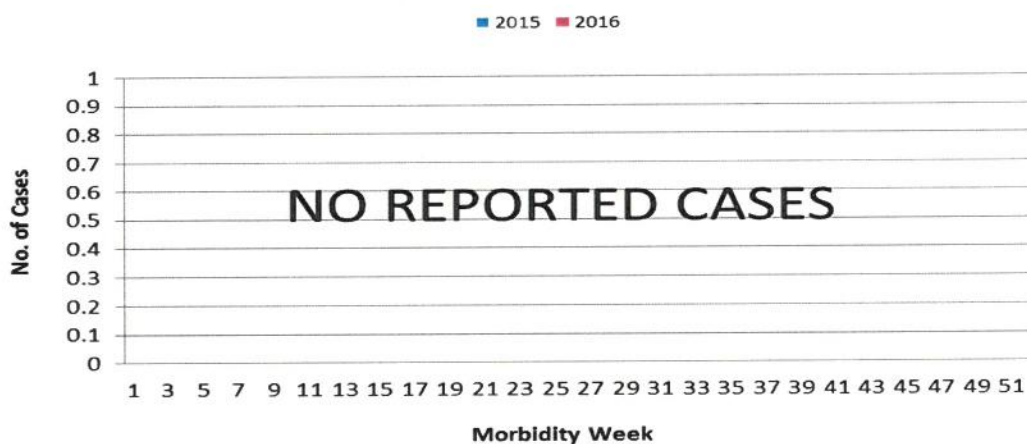


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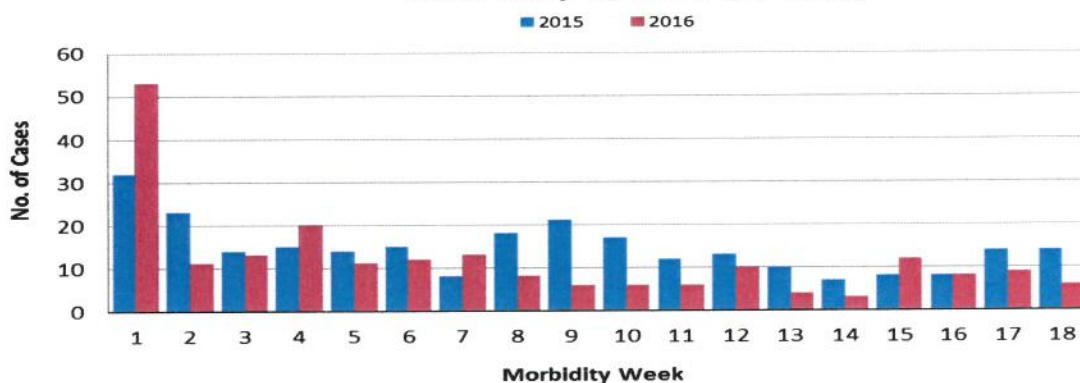

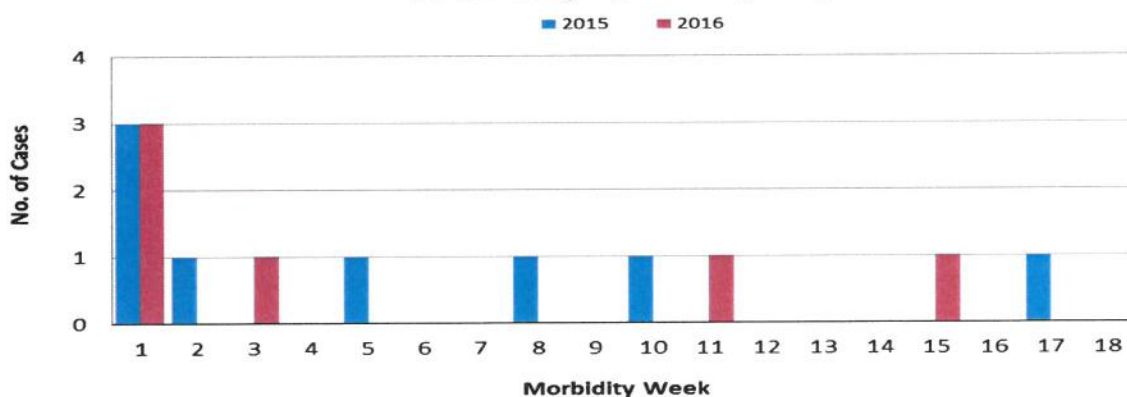
**Fig. 22 Suspect Anthrax Cases

as of May 7, 2016 (n=6)**

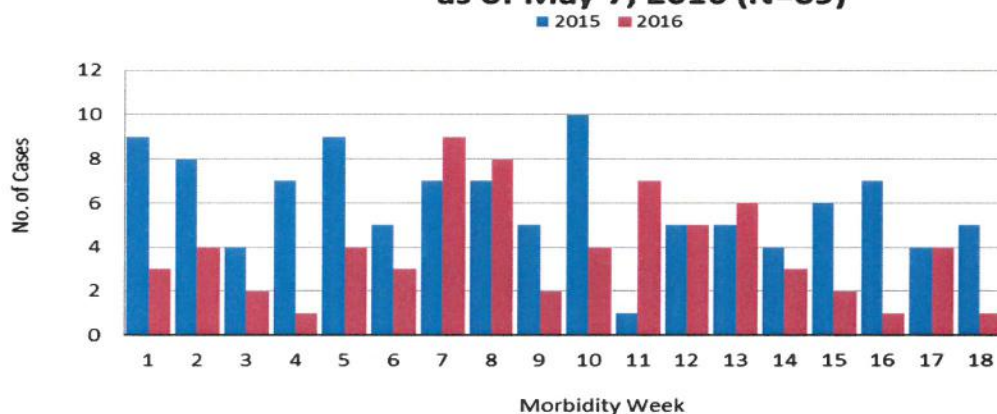




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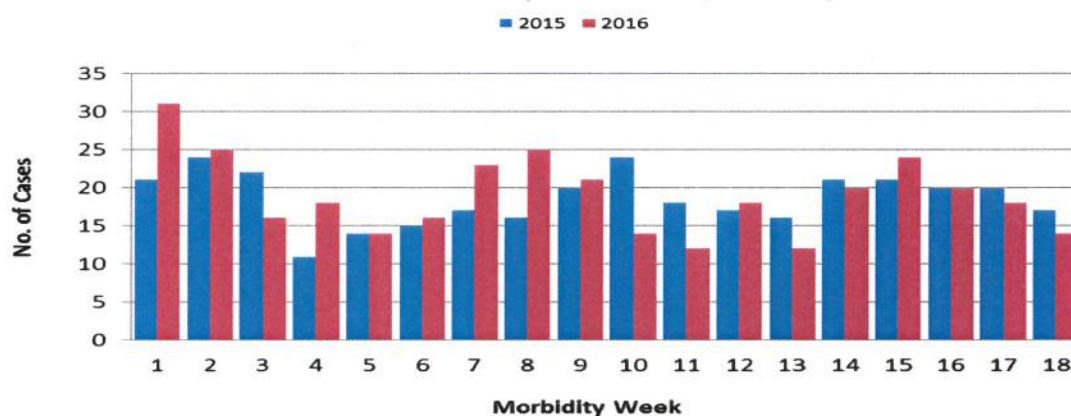
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**Fig. 25 Probable Rabies Cases
as of May 7, 2016 (N=69)**

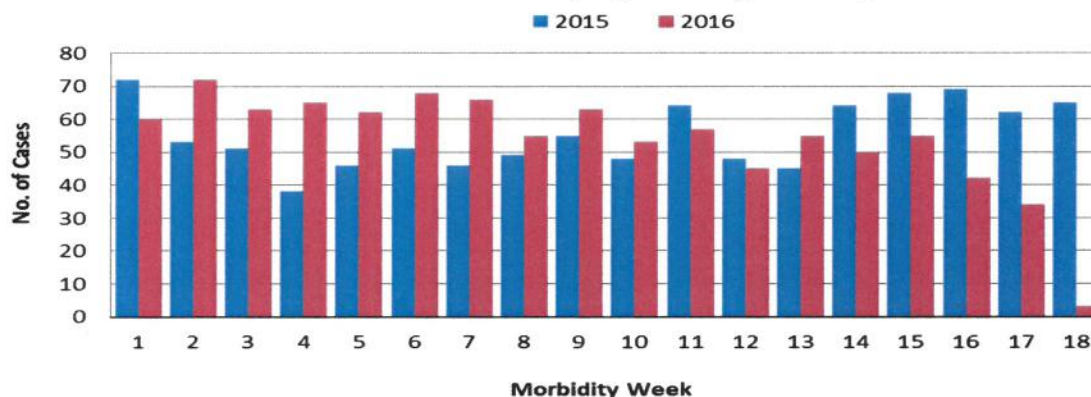

as of May 7, 2016 (n=968)**

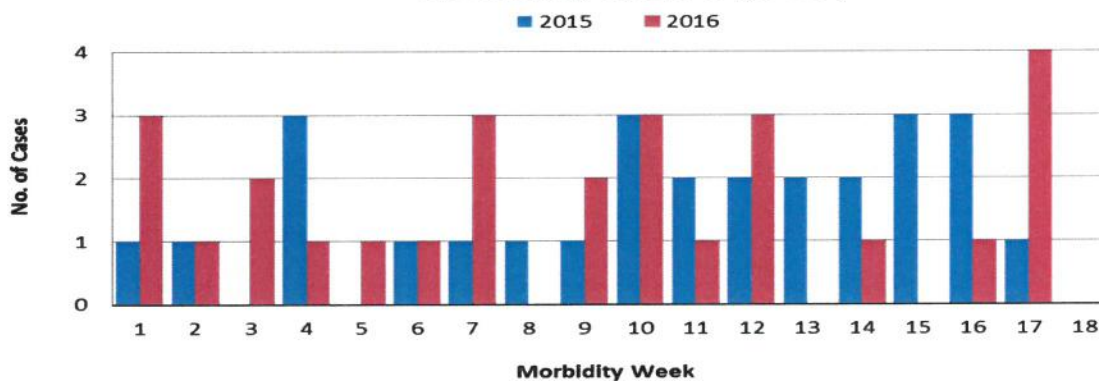




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
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**Fig. 28 Confirmed Hepatitis C Cases
