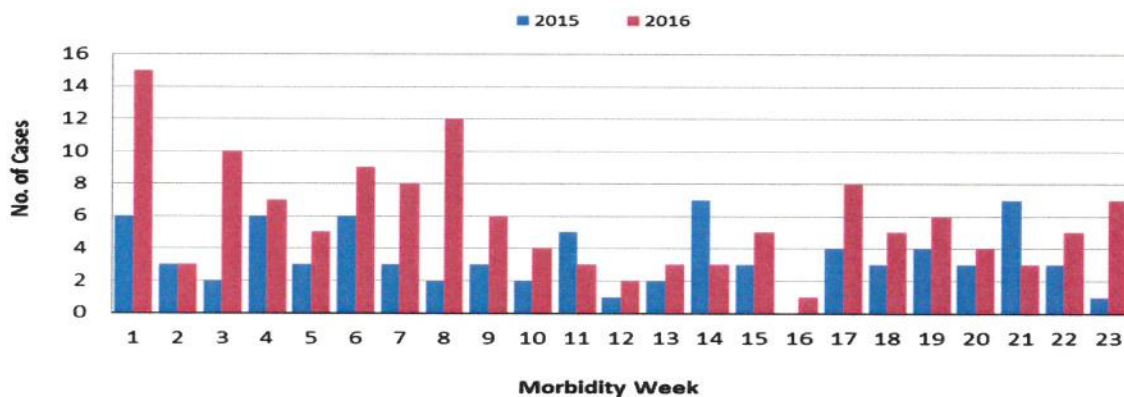


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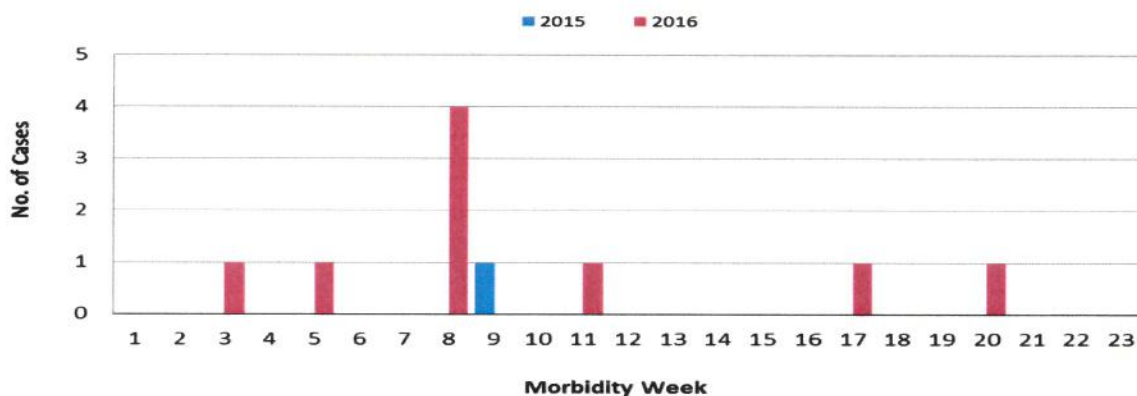

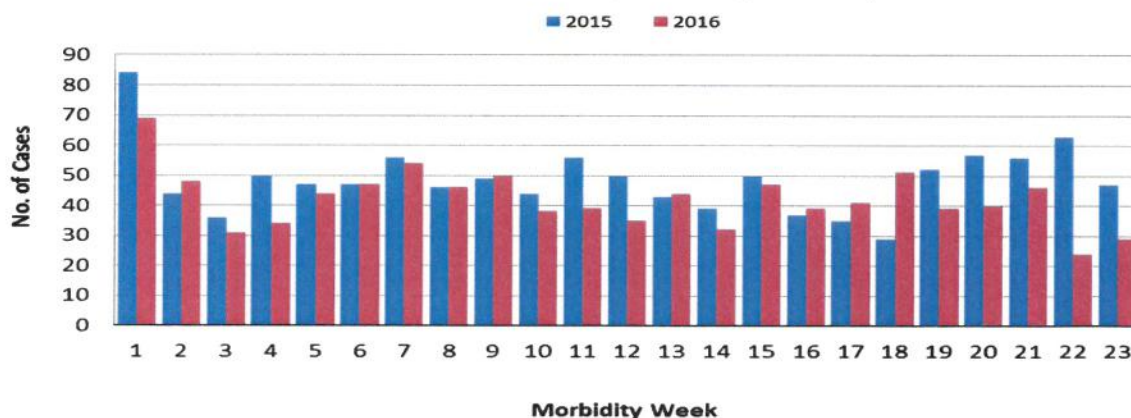
**Fig. 1 Suspect Acute Encephalitis Syndrome Cases as of June 11, 2016 (N=134)**

**Fig. 3 Suspect Bacterial Meningitis Cases as of June 11, 2016 (N=967)**



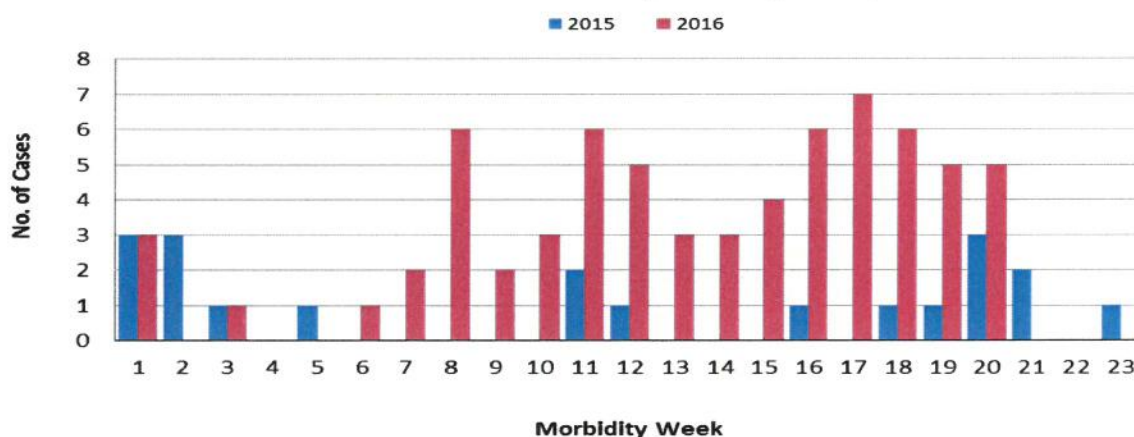




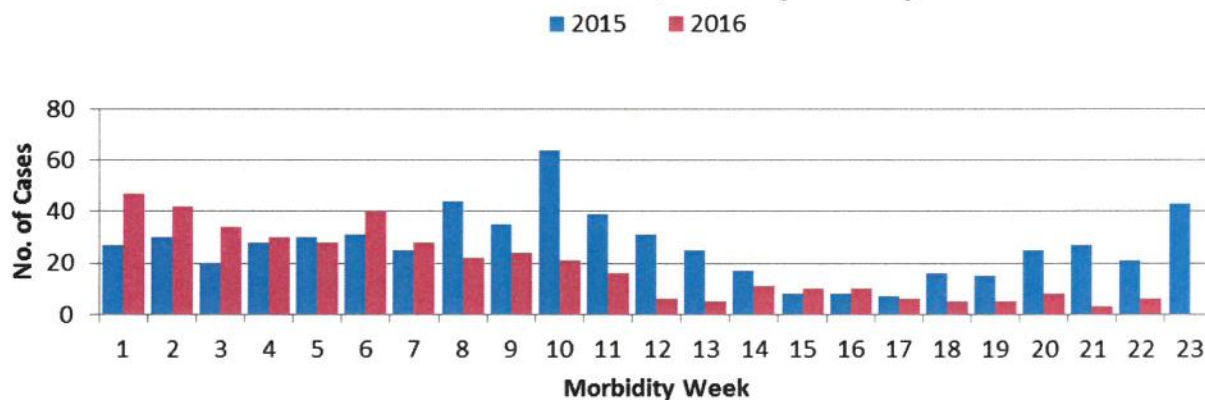
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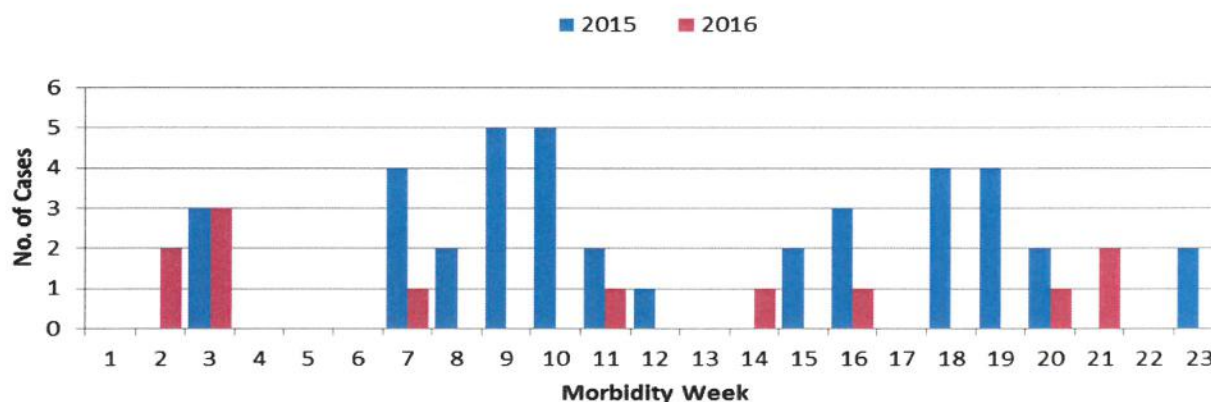
**Fig. 4 Confirmed Bacterial Meningitis Cases

as of June 11, 2016 (n=12)**

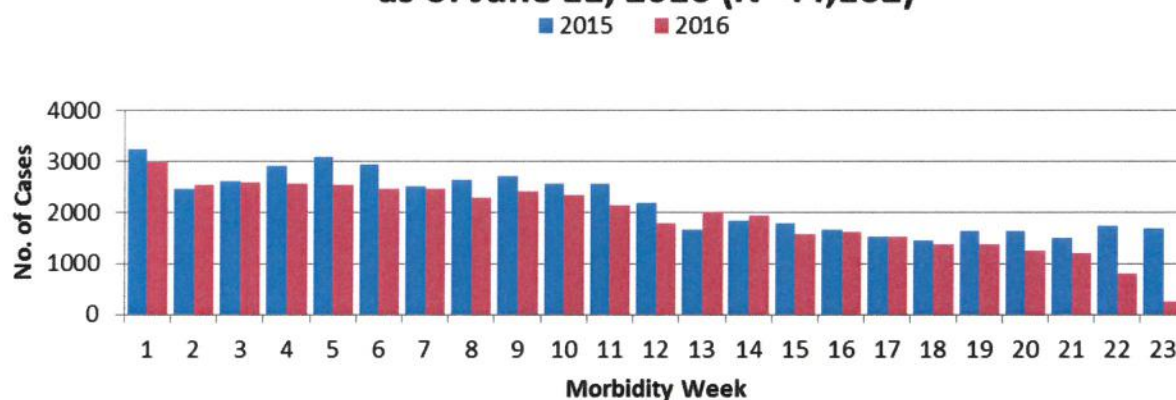




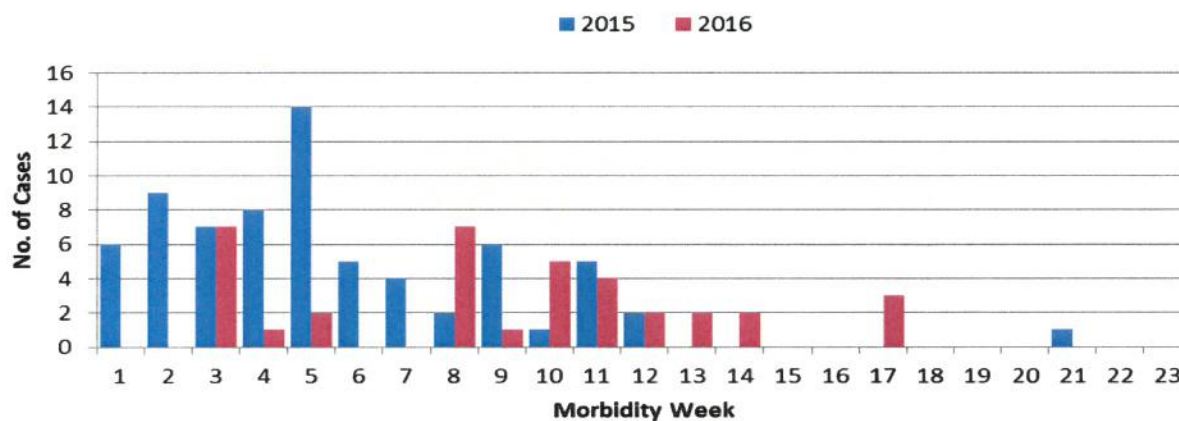
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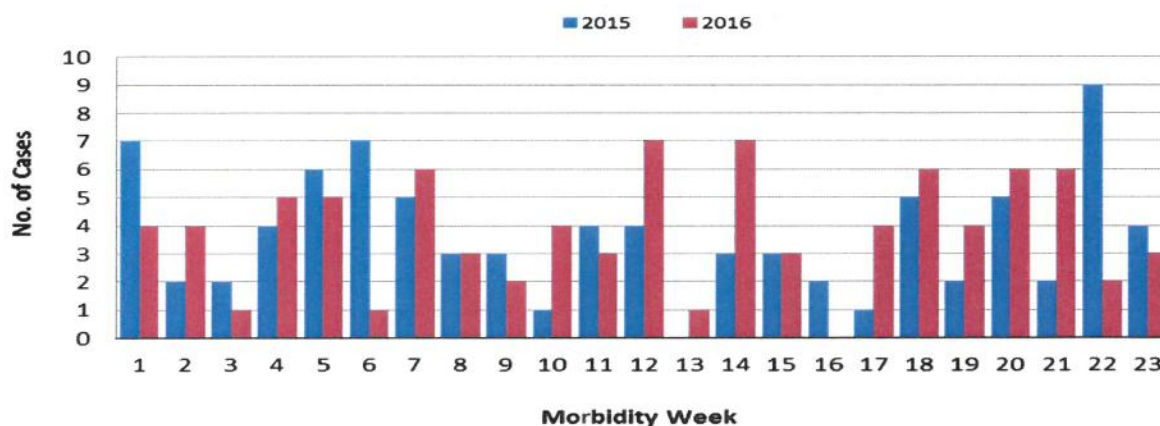
**Fig.7 Influenza-like Illness Cases

as of June 11, 2016 (N=87)**

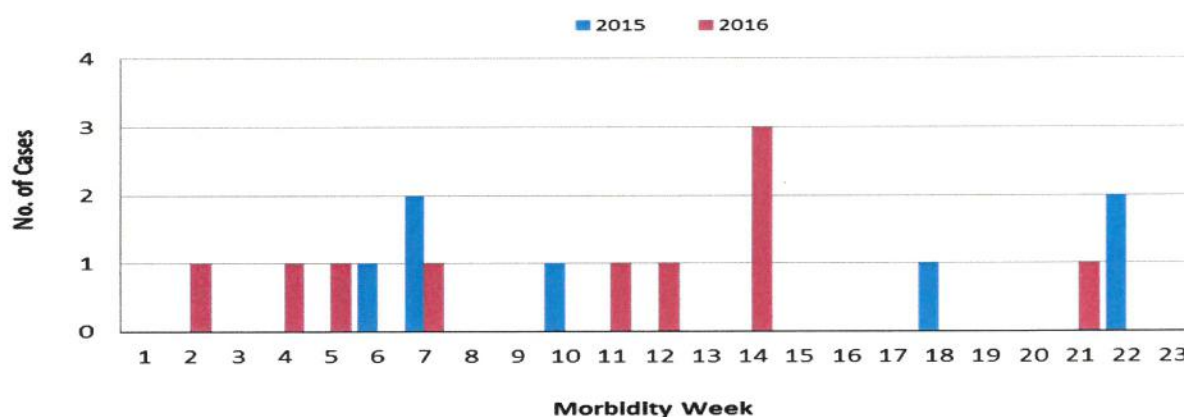




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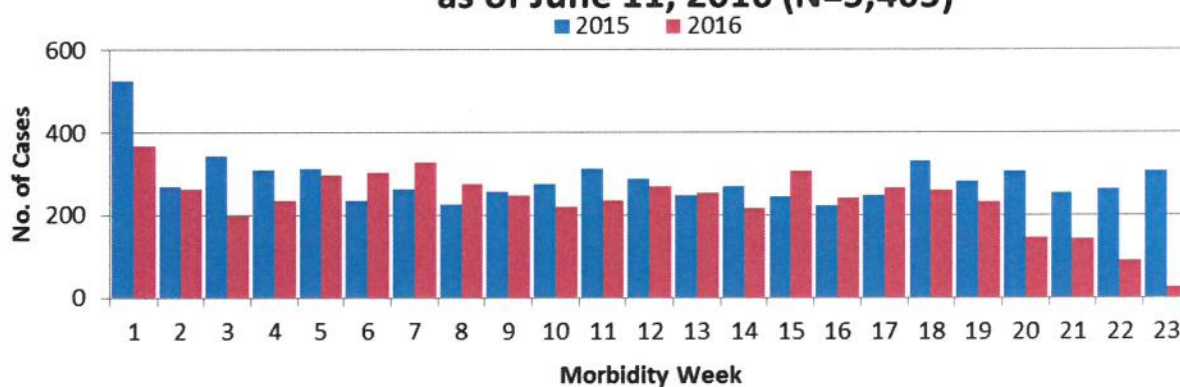
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**Fig. 10 Confirmed Meningococcal Disease Cases  
as of June 11, 2016 (n=10)**

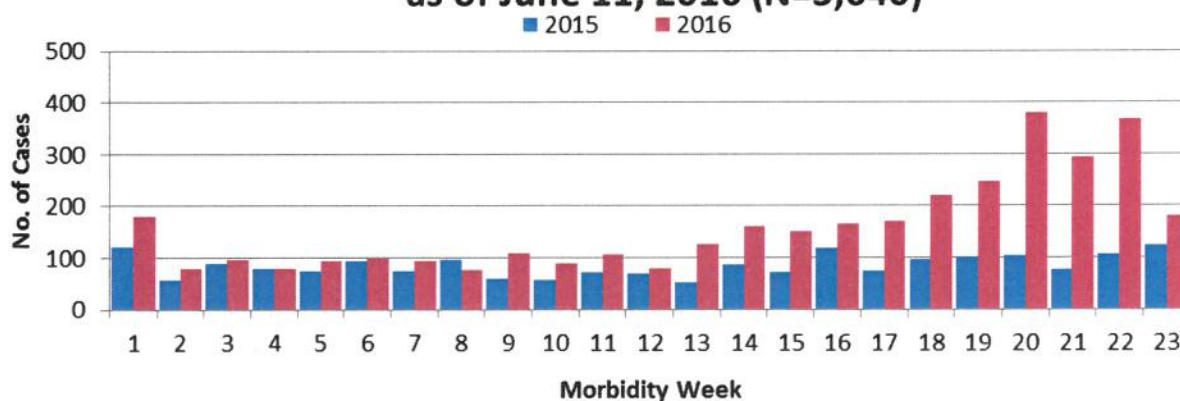

as of June 11, 2016 (N=3,640)**



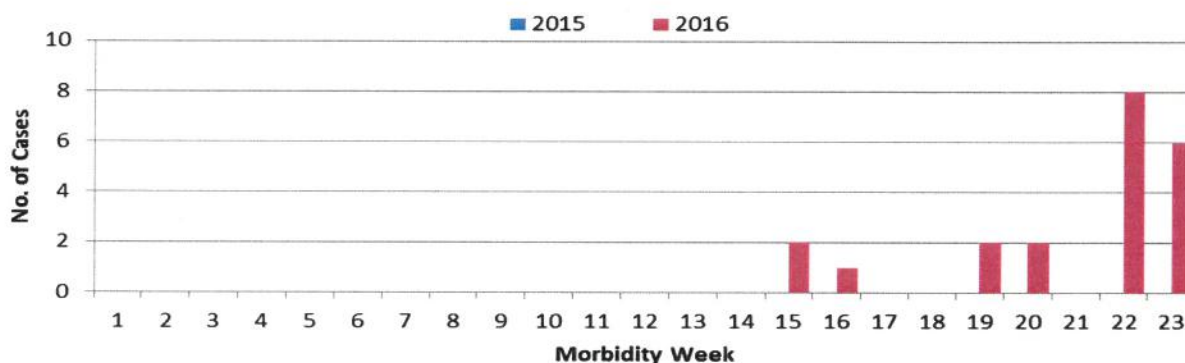




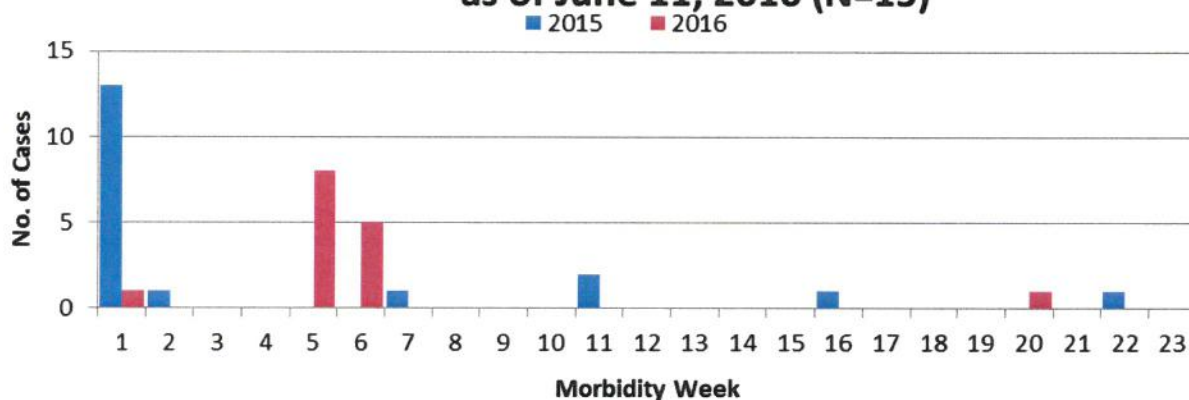
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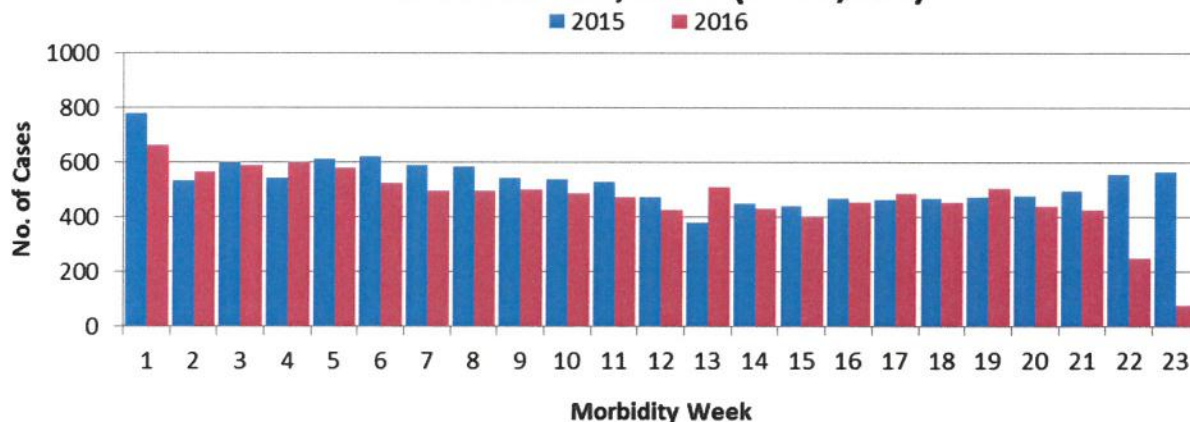
**Fig.13 Confirmed Cholera Cases

as of June 11, 2016 (N=10,864)**

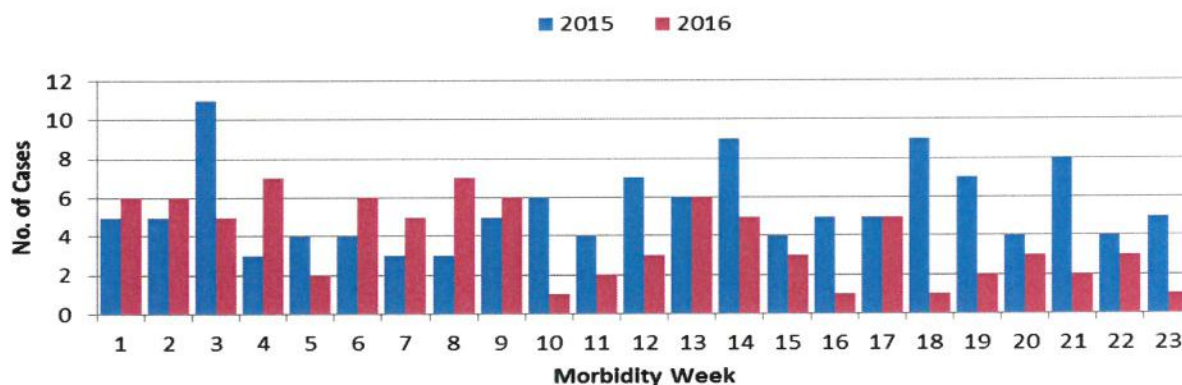




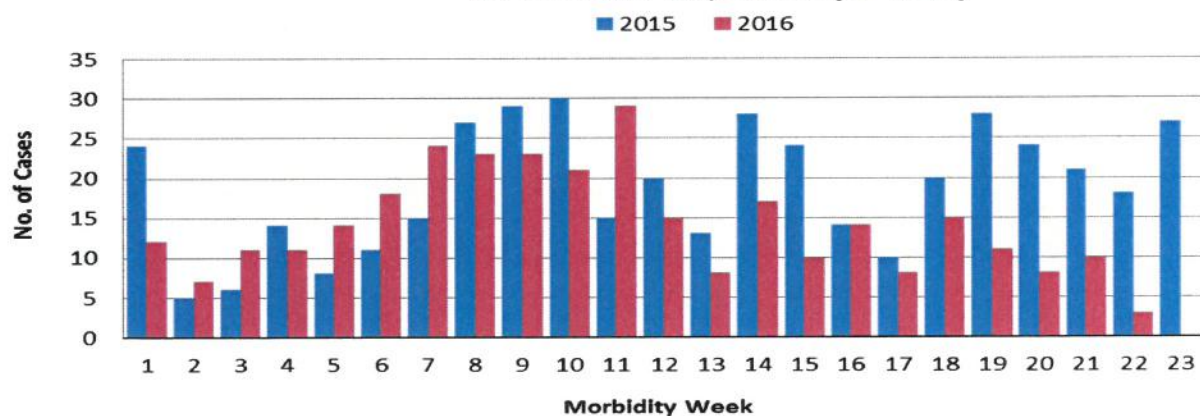
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**Fig.16 Confirmed Typhoid Cases  
as of June 11, 2016 (n=88)**

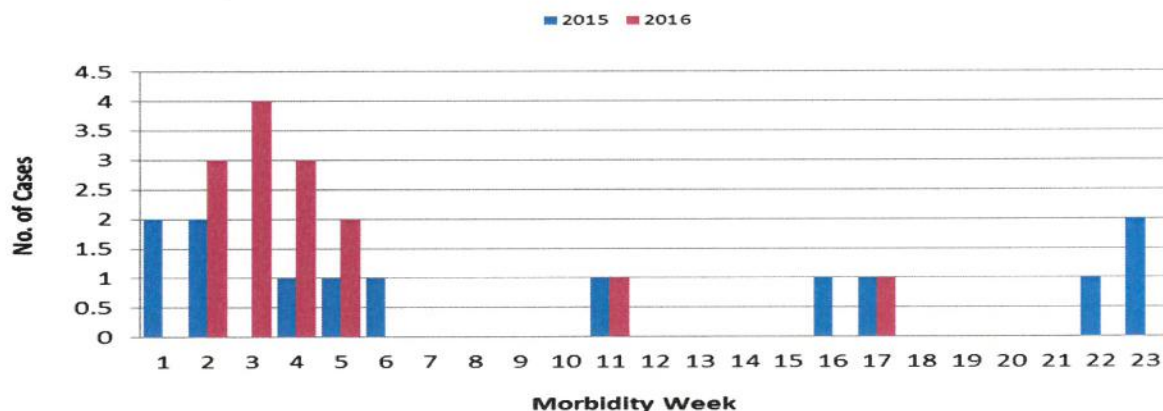


**Fig. 17 Confirmed Hepatitis A Cases

as of June 11, 2016 (N=14)**

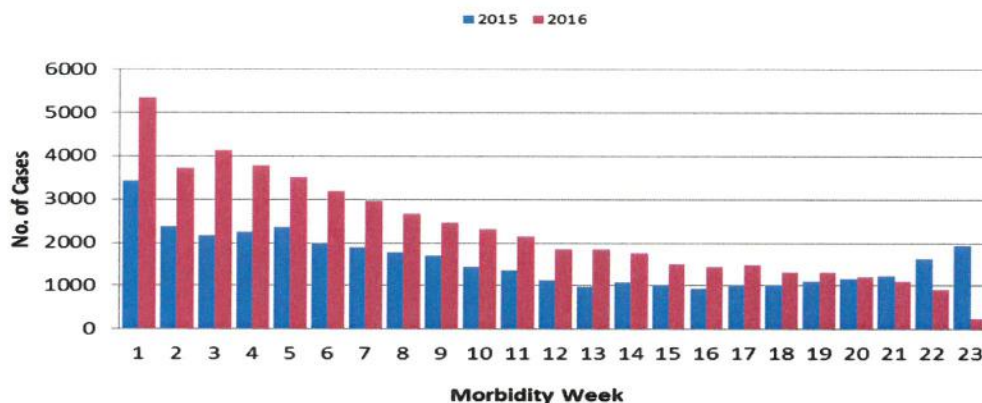




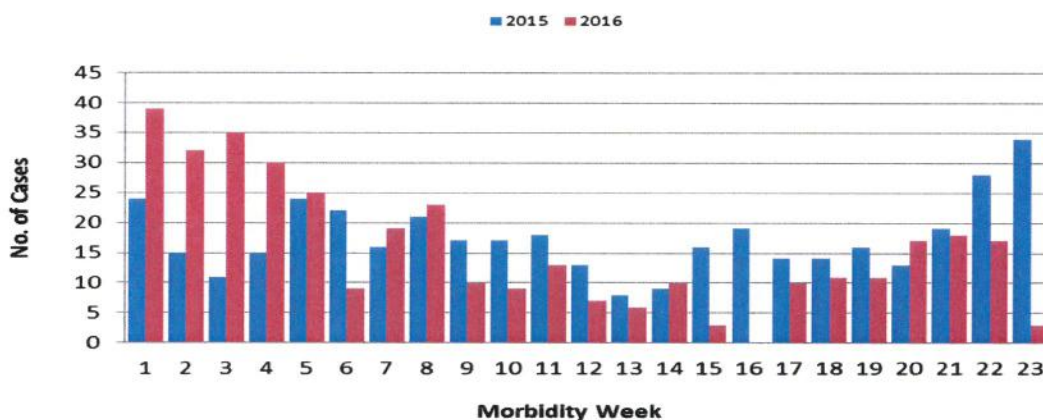
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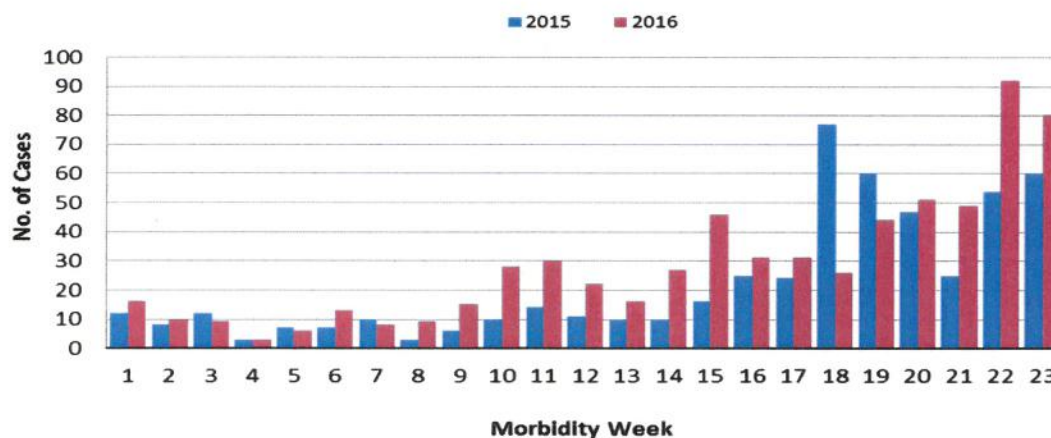
**Fig. 19 Suspect Dengue Cases

as of June 11, 2016 (N=662)**





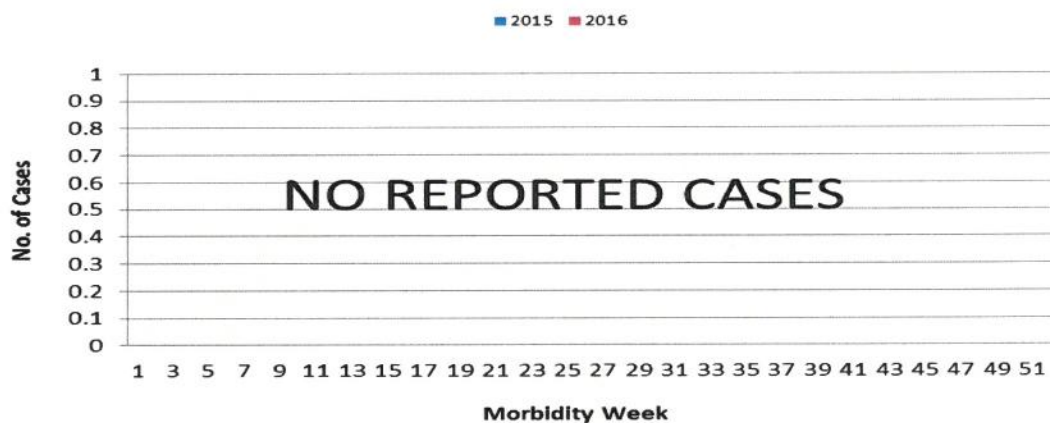


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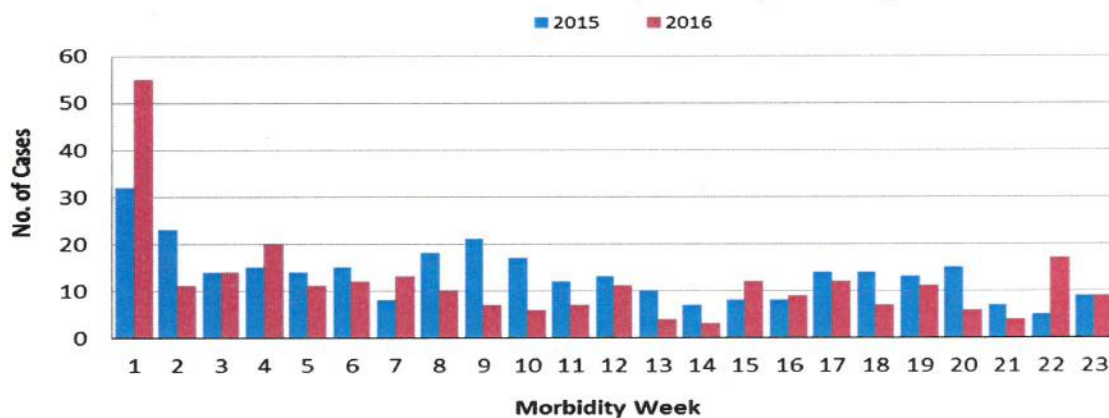

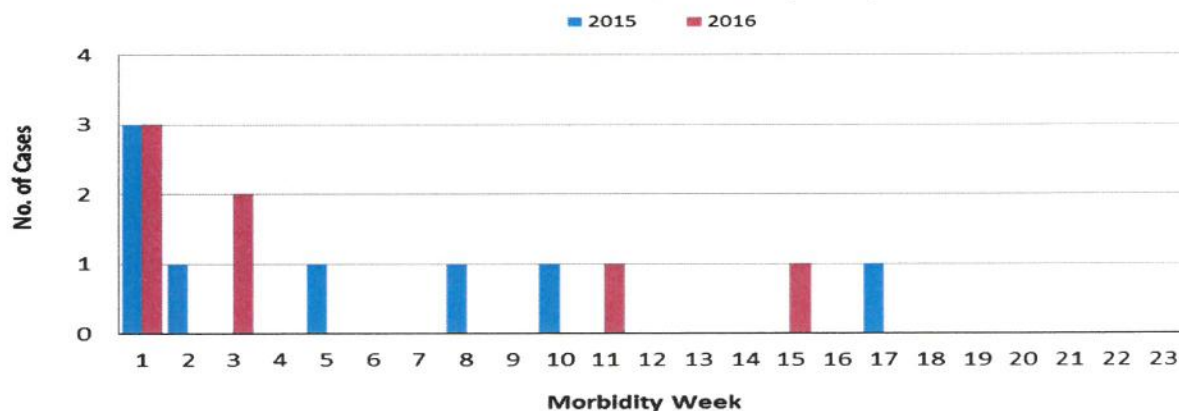
**Fig. 22 Suspect Anthrax Cases

as of June 11, 2016 (n=7)**

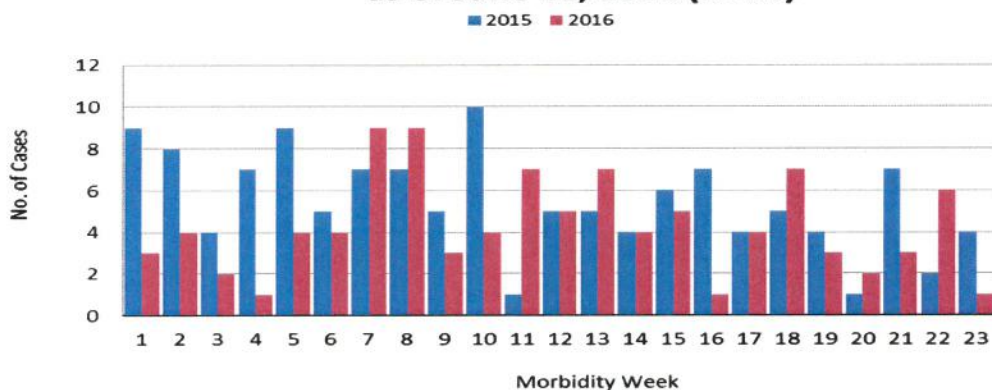




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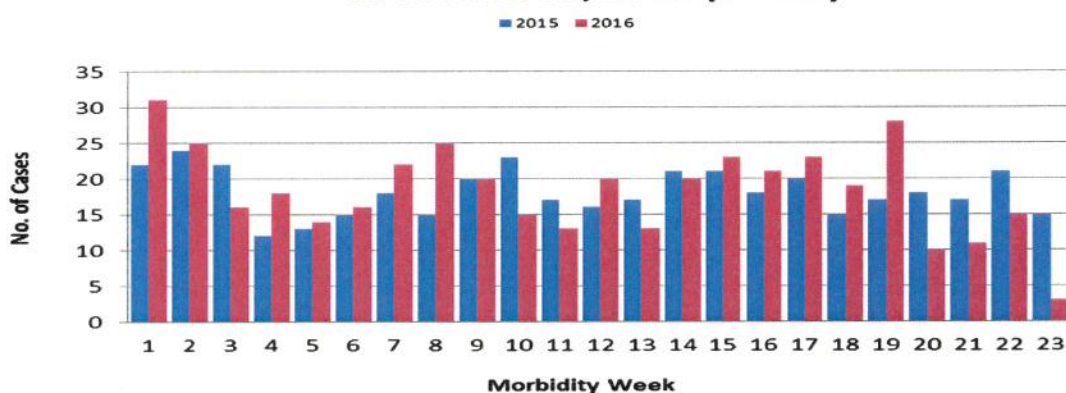
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**Fig. 25 Probable Rabies Cases  
as of June 11, 2016 (N=98)**

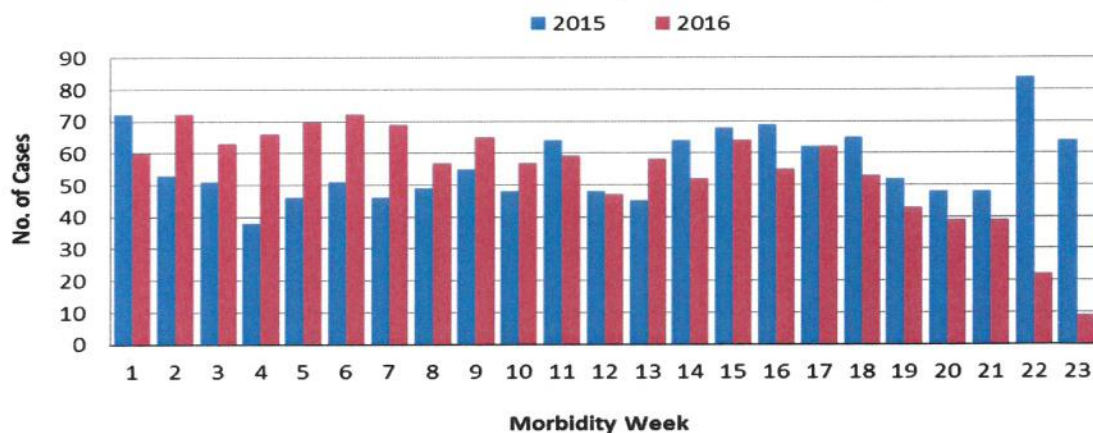

as of June 11, 2016 (n=1253)**

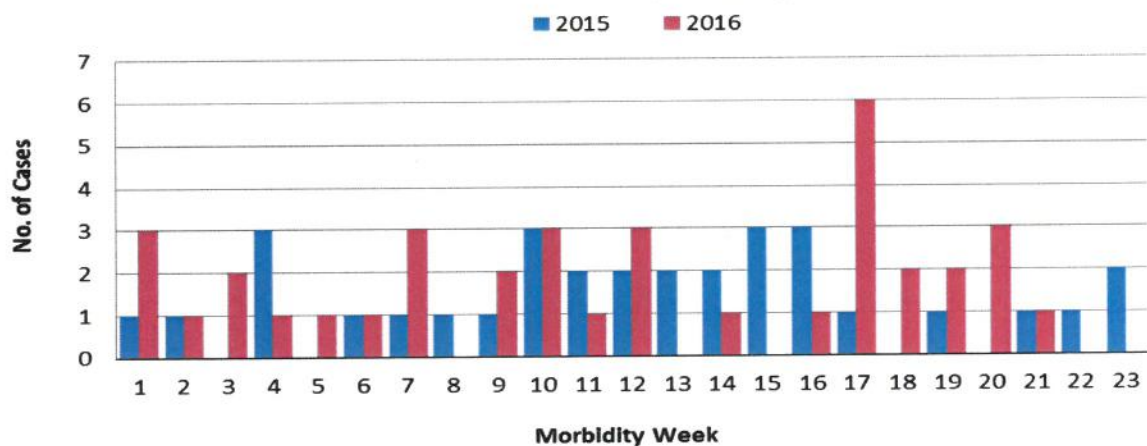





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
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**Fig. 28 Confirmed Hepatitis C Cases  
as of June 11, 2016 (n=37)**





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
