Fig. 1 Suspect Acute Encephalitis Syndrome Cases as of June 18, 2016 (N=139)

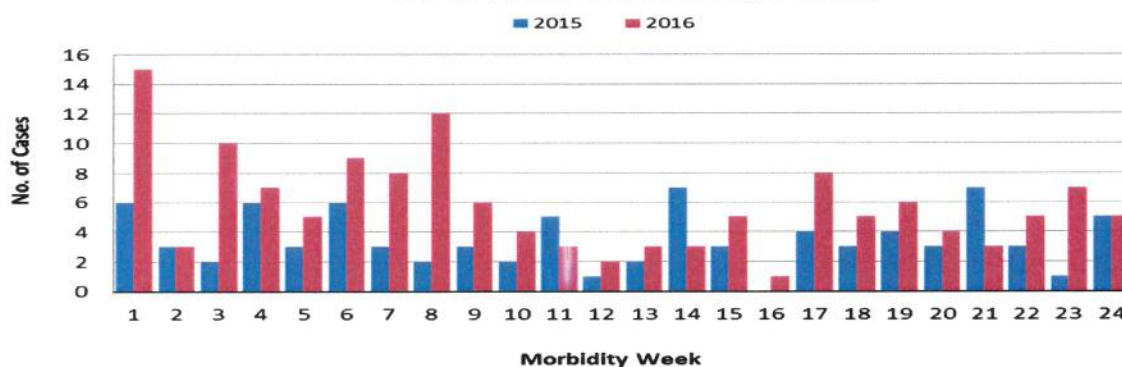


Fig. 2 Confirmed Acute Encephalitis Syndrome Cases as of June 18, 2016 (n=9)

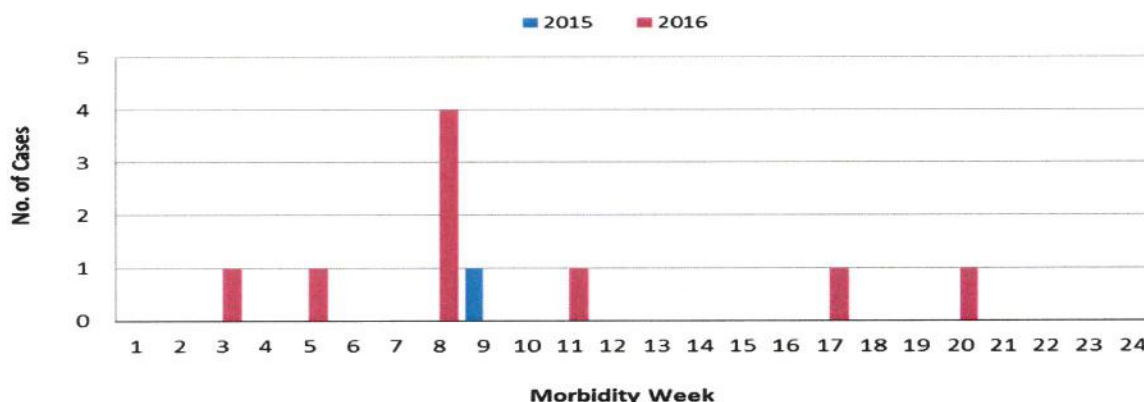
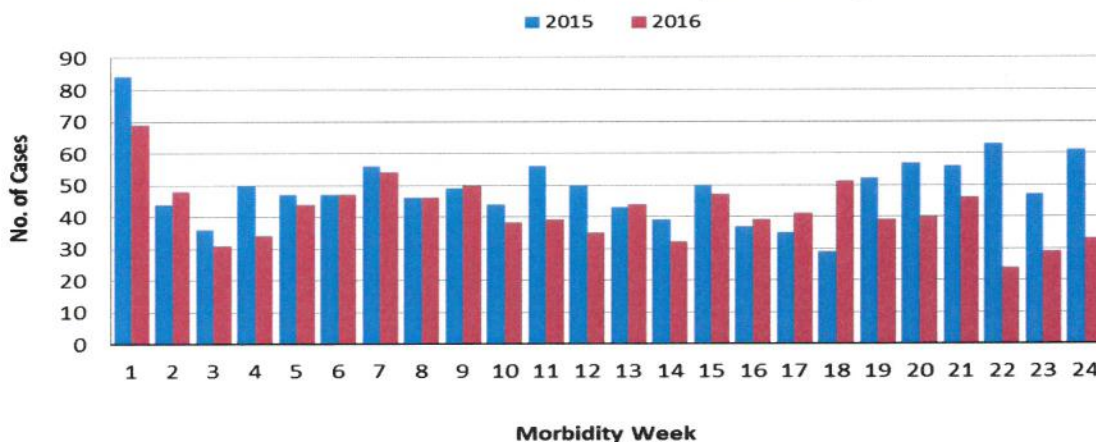


Fig. 3 Suspect Bacterial Meningitis Cases as of June 18, 2016 (N=1,000)

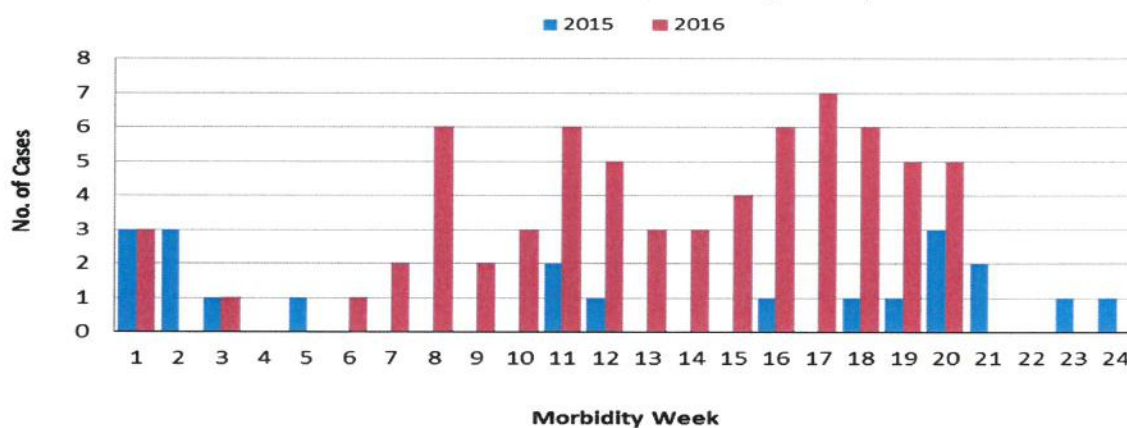




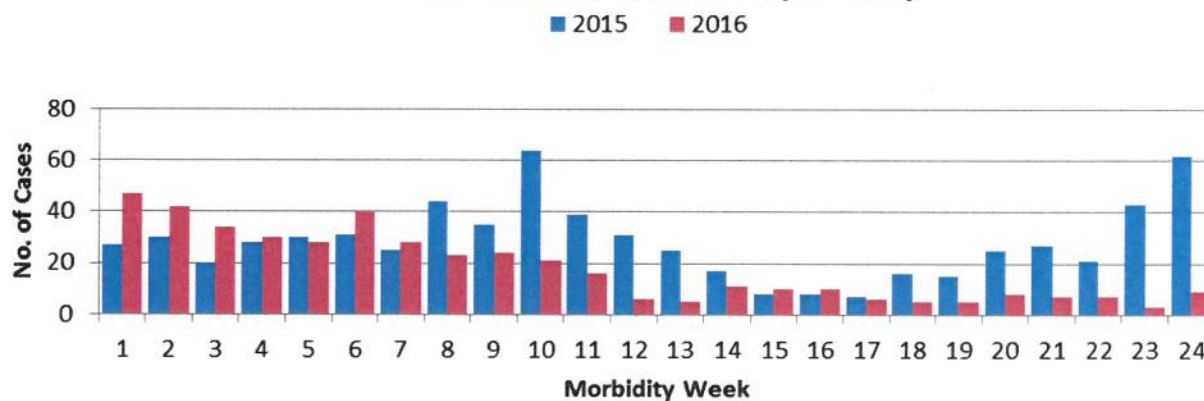
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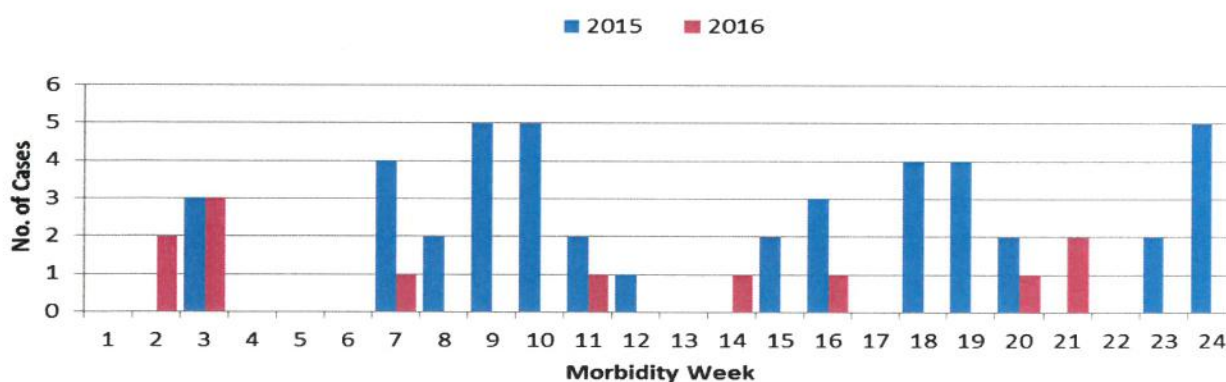
**Fig. 4 Confirmed Bacterial Meningitis Cases

as of June 18, 2016 (n=12)**

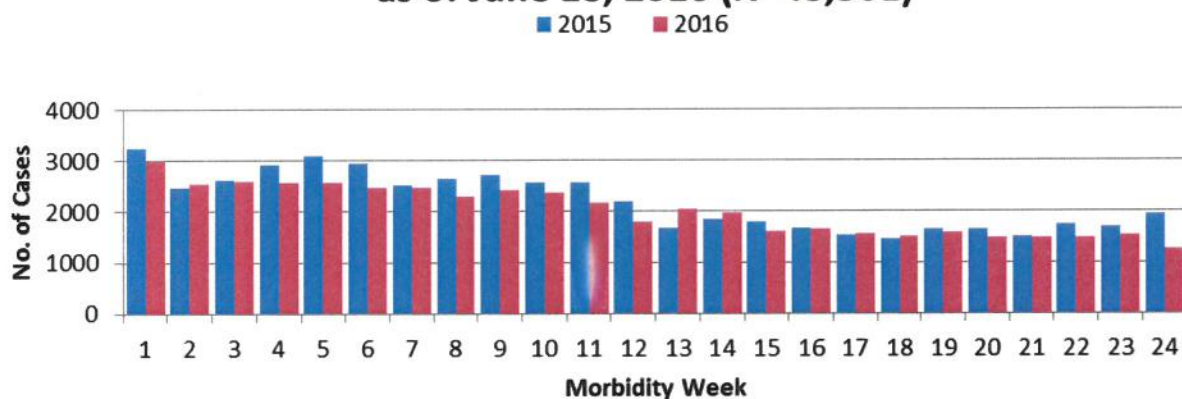




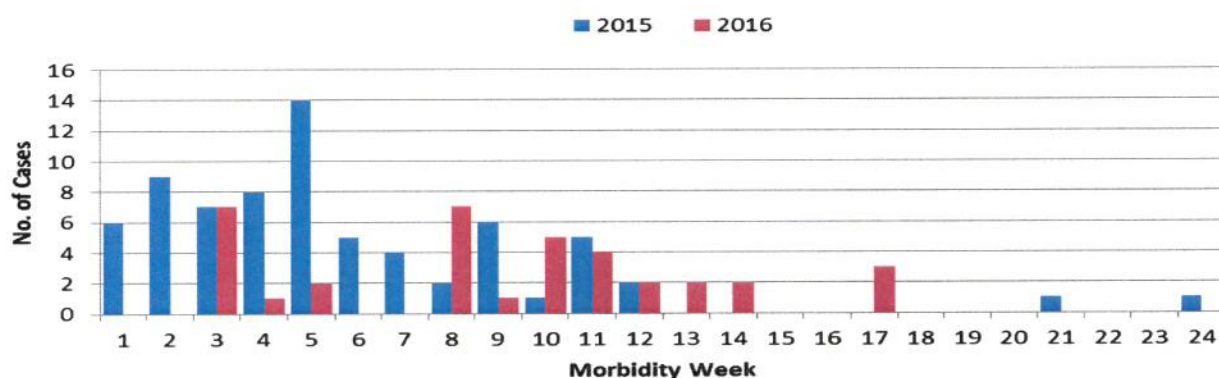
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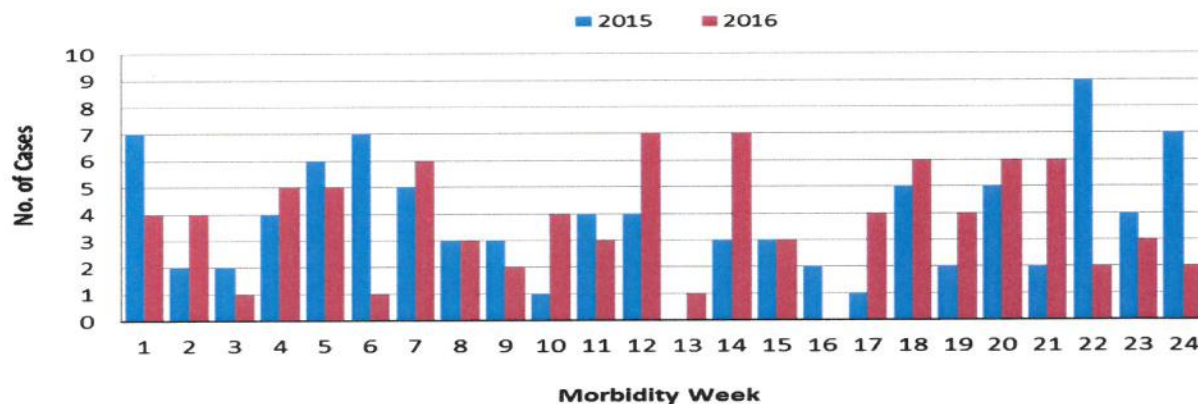
**Fig.7 Influenza-like Illness Cases

as of June 18, 2016 (N=89)**

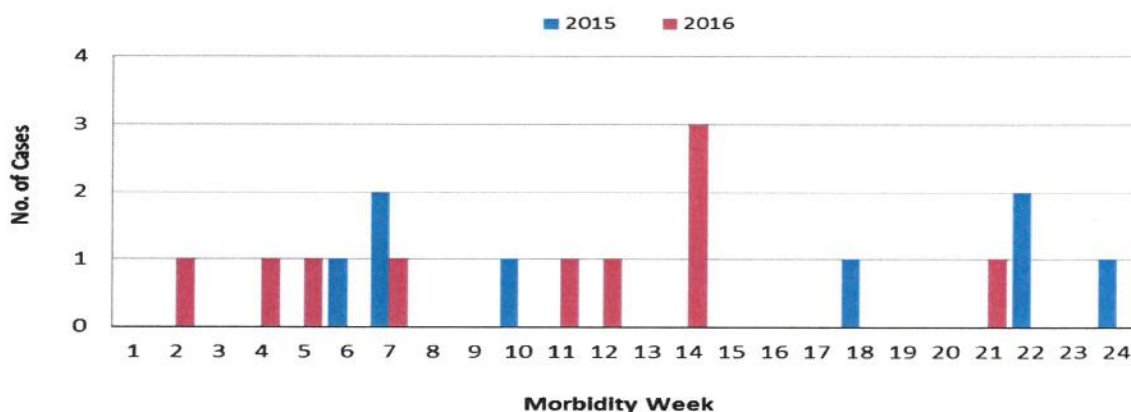




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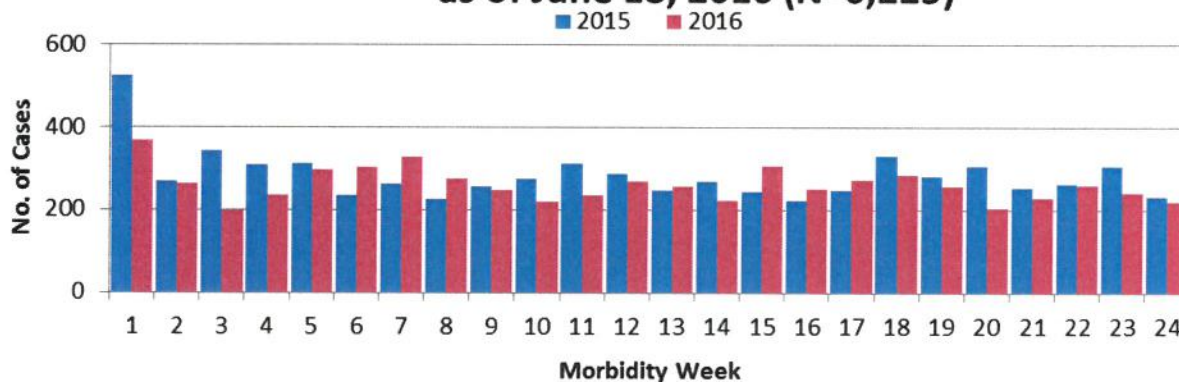
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**Fig. 10 Confirmed Meningococcal Disease Cases
as of June 18, 2016 (n=10)**

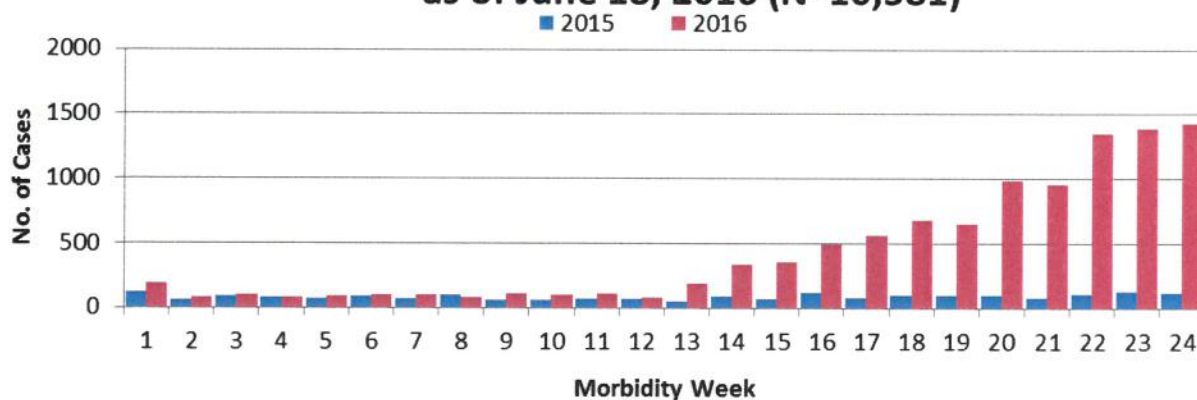

as of June 18, 2016 (N=10,581)**

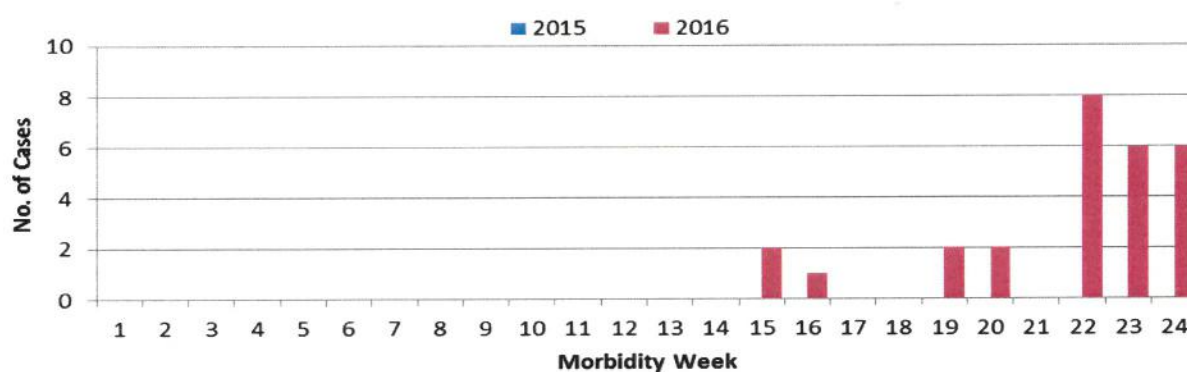




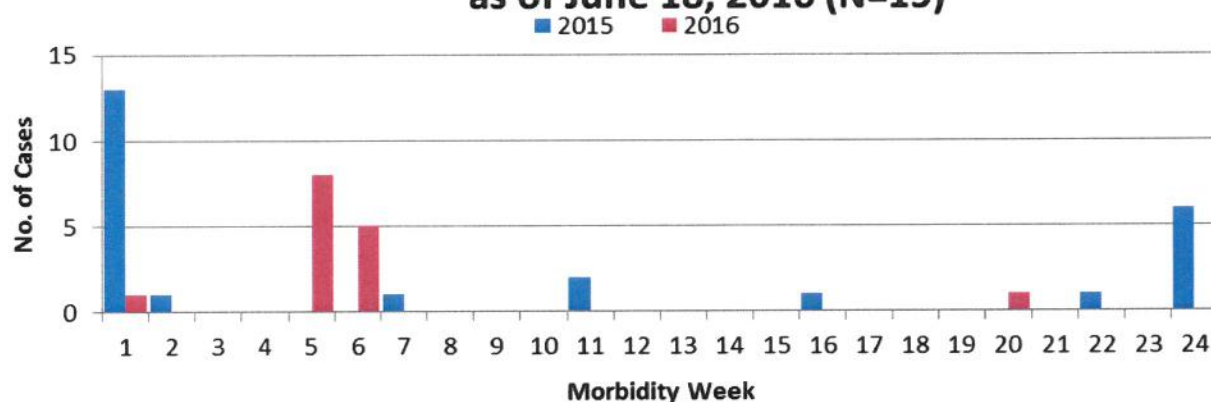
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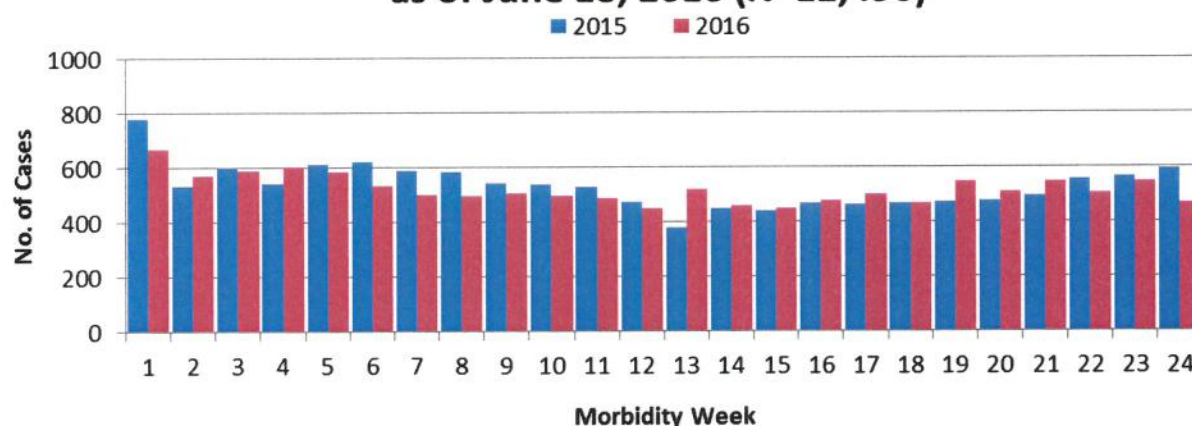
**Fig.13 Confirmed Cholera Cases

as of June 18, 2016 (N=12,496)**

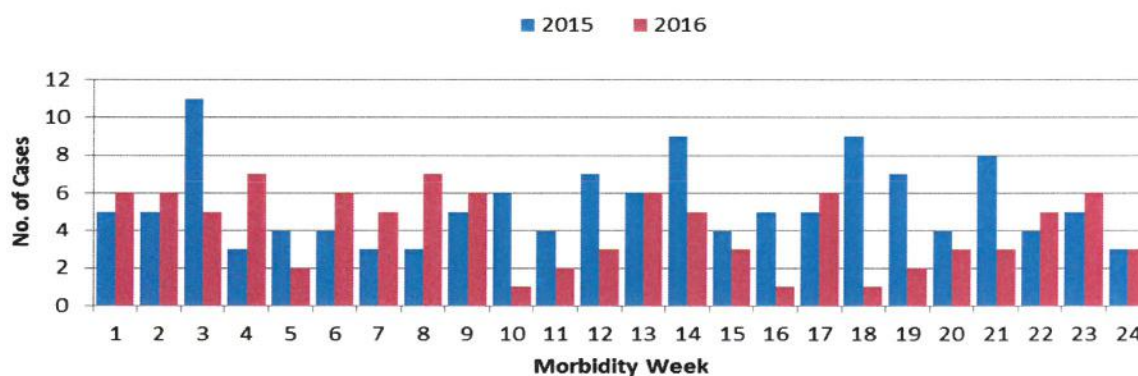




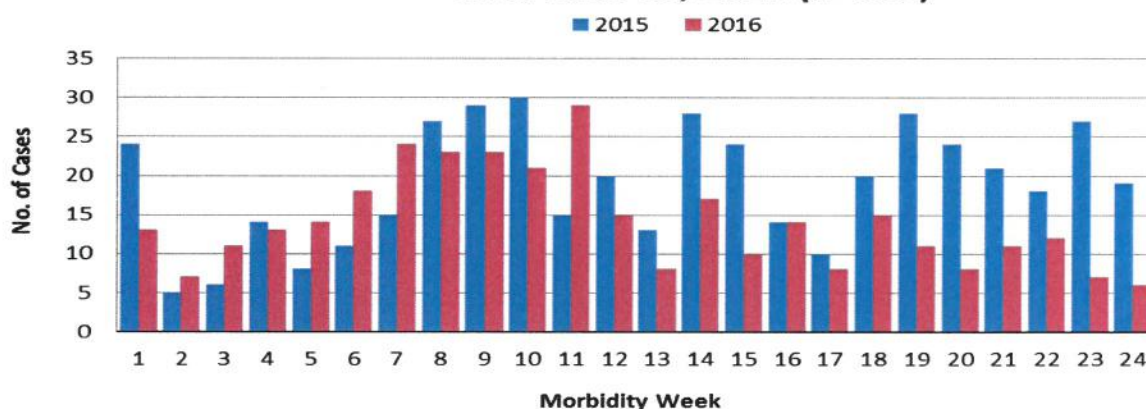
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**Fig.16 Confirmed Typhoid Cases
as of June 18, 2016 (n=100)**

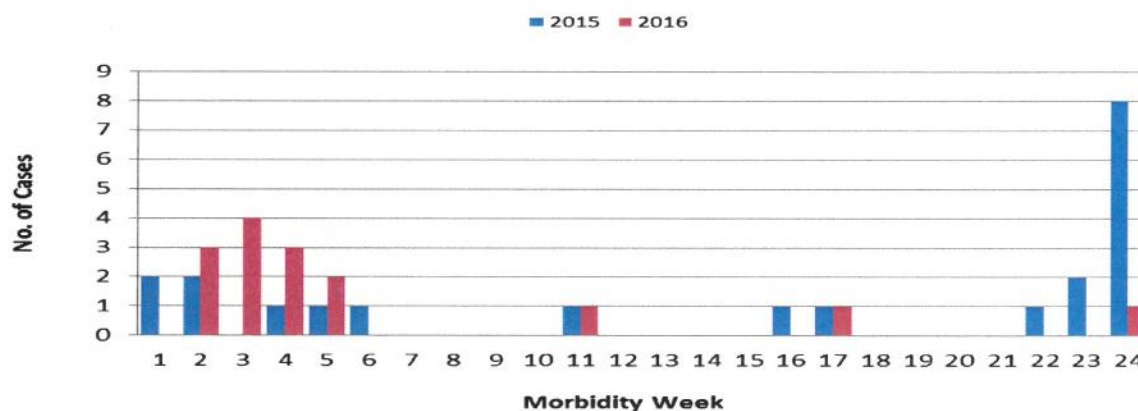


**Fig. 17 Confirmed Hepatitis A Cases

as of June 18, 2016 (N=15)**

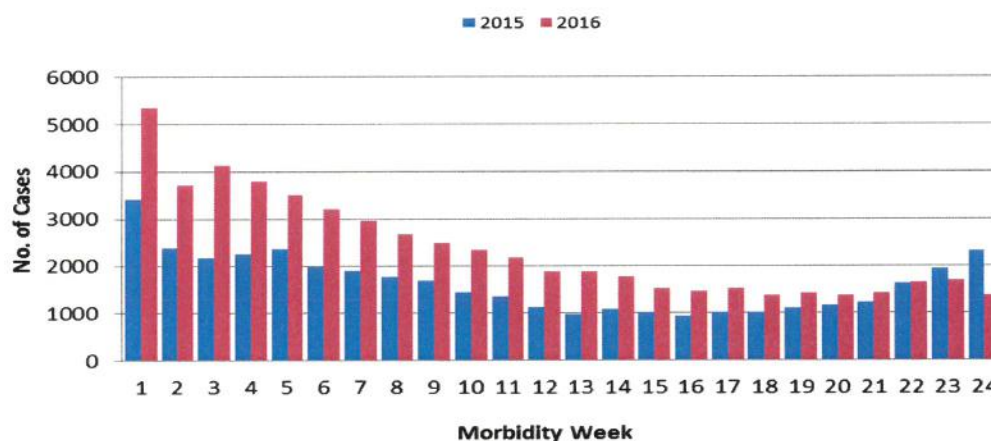




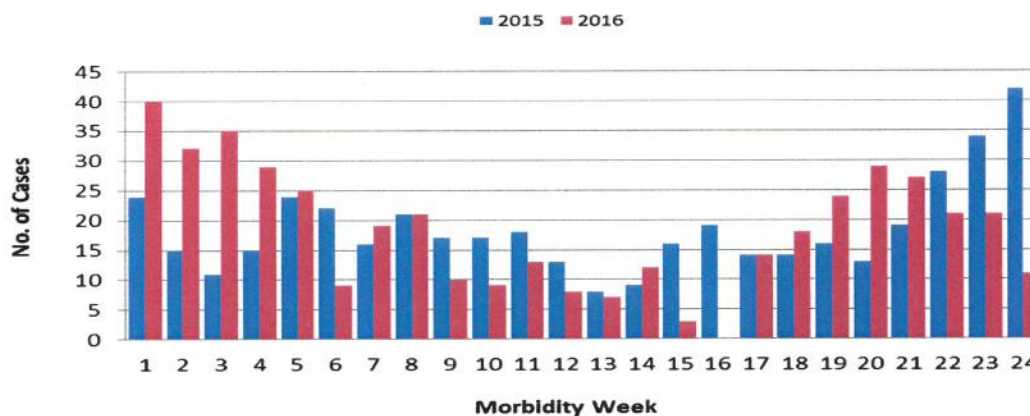
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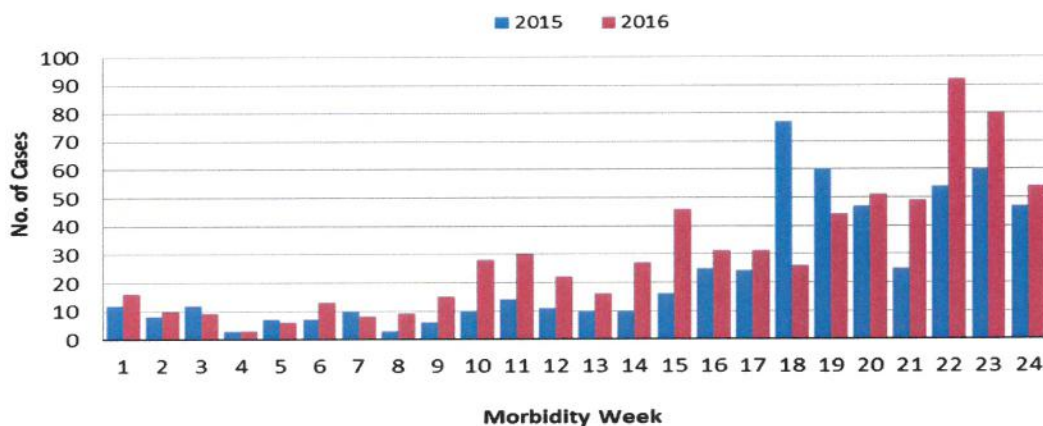
**Fig. 19 Suspect Dengue Cases

as of June 18, 2016 (N=716)**



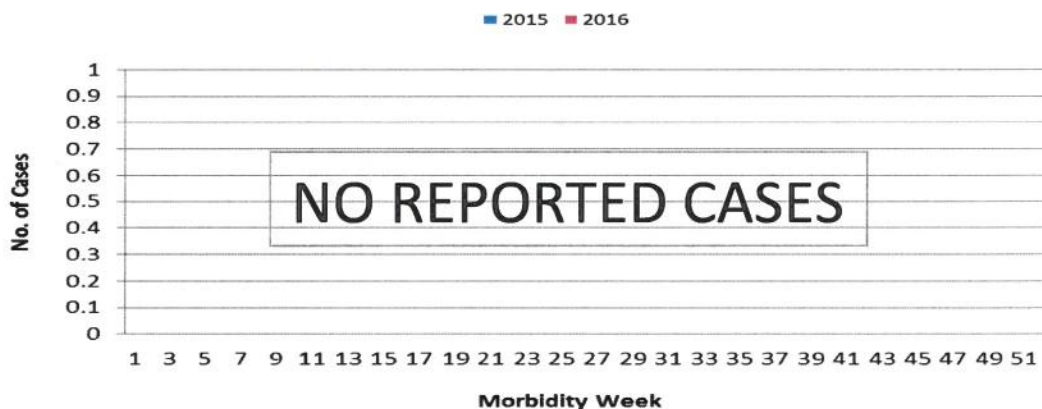


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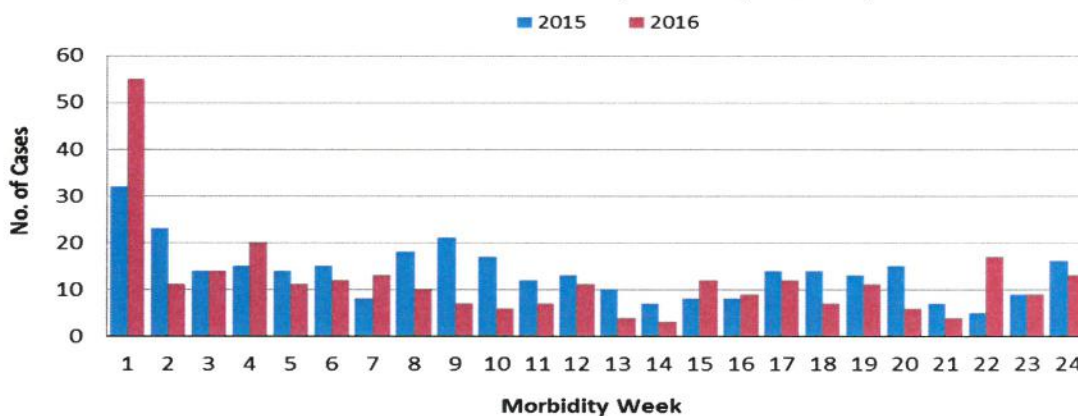

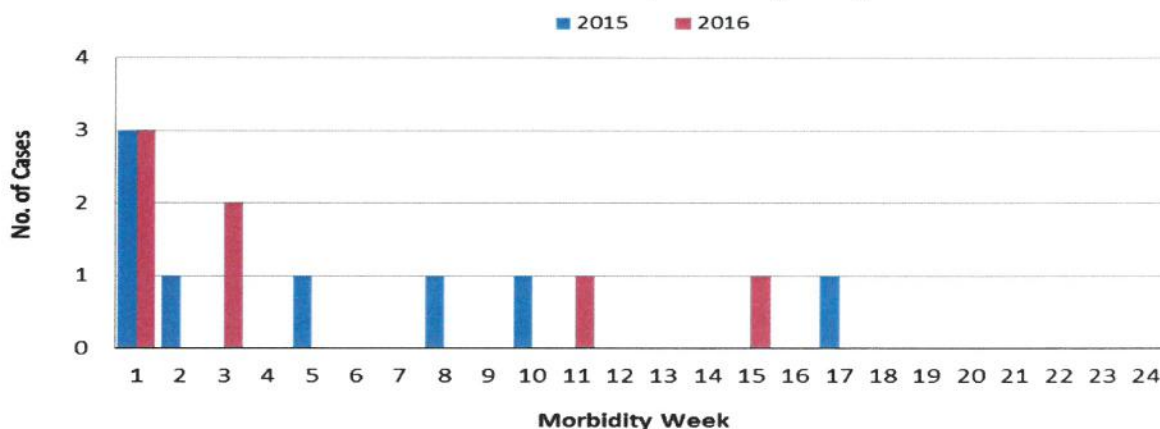
**Fig. 22 Suspect Anthrax Cases

as of June 18, 2016 (n=7)**

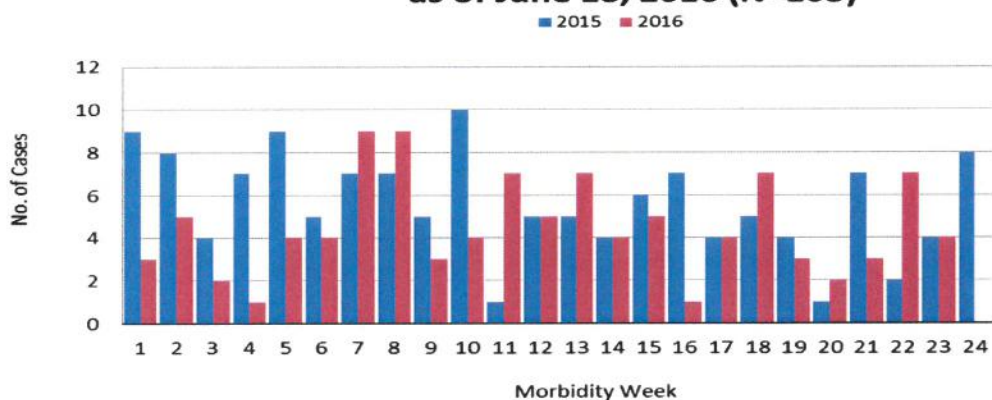




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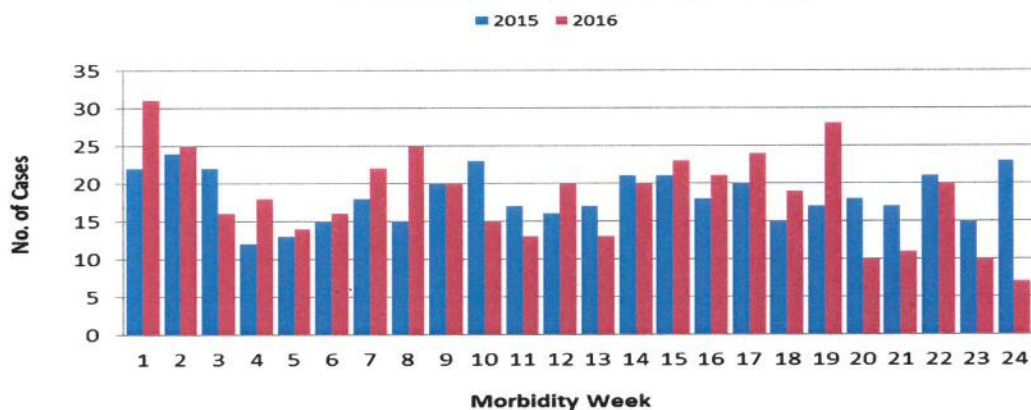
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**Fig. 25 Probable Rabies Cases
as of June 18, 2016 (N=103)**

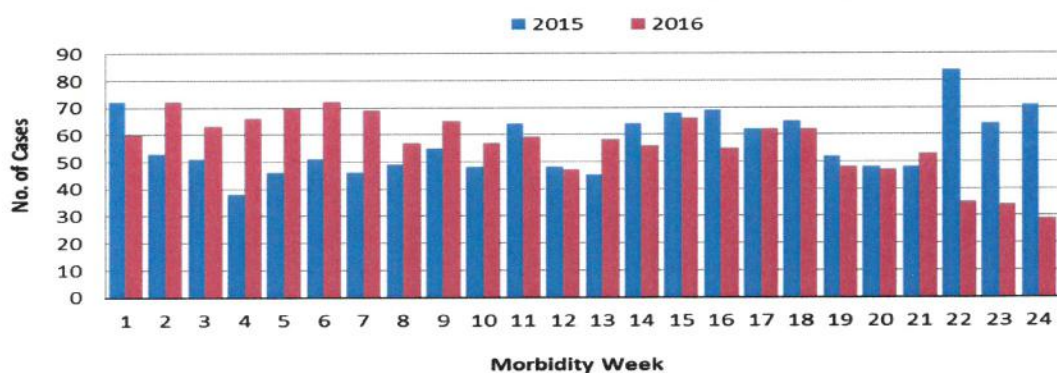

as of June 18, 2016 (n=1362)**

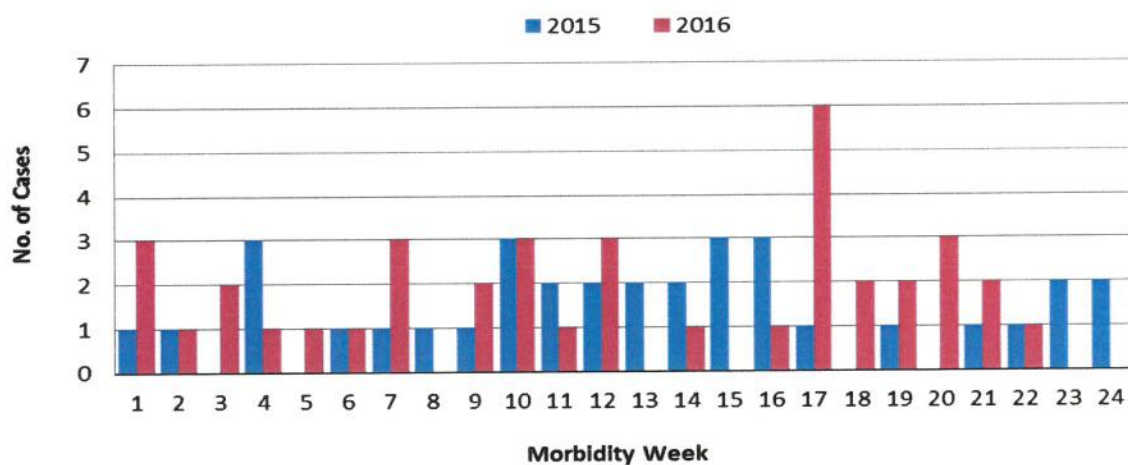




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
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**Fig. 28 Confirmed Hepatitis C Cases
as of June 18, 2016 (n=39)**




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
