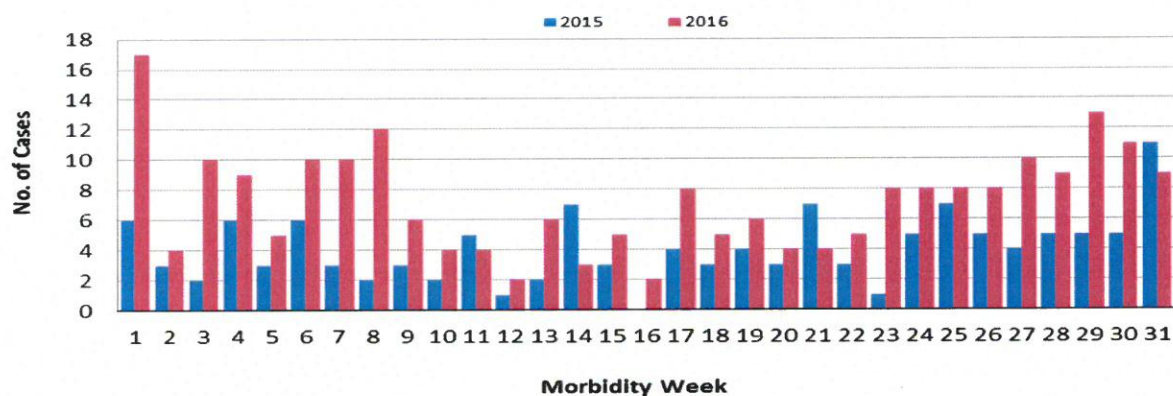


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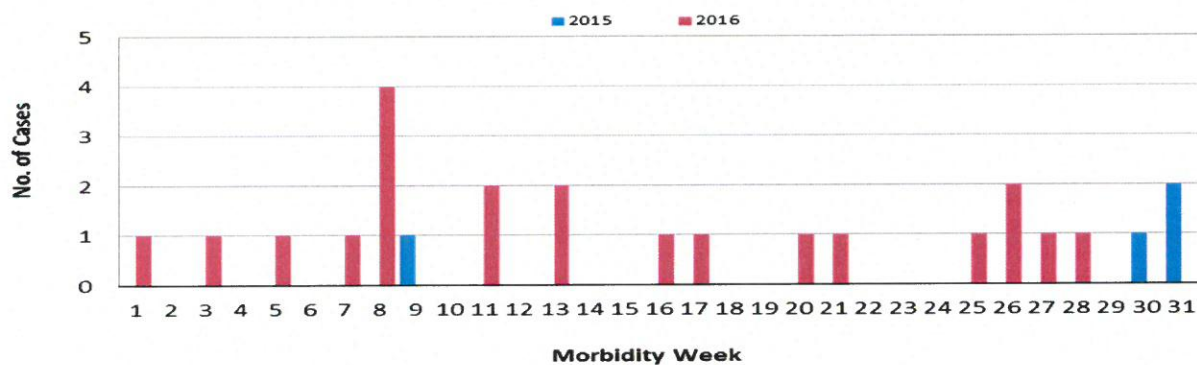

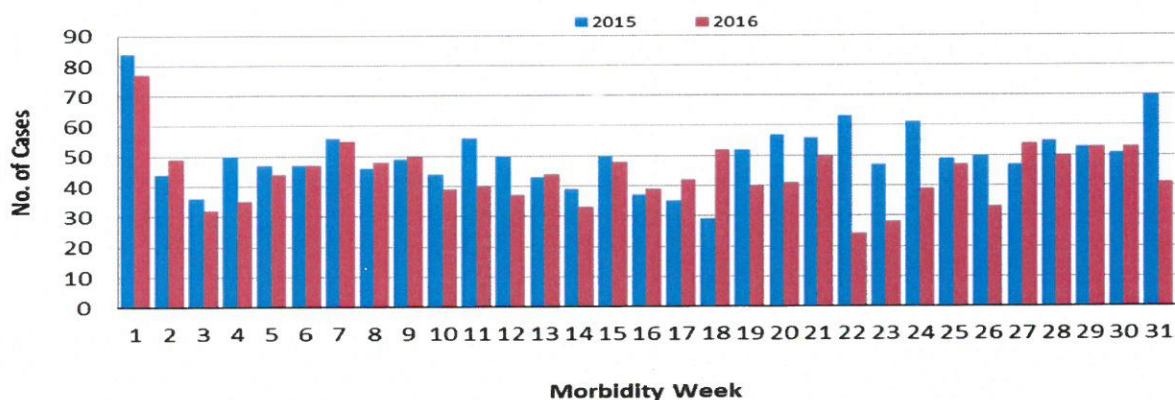
**Fig. 1 Suspect Acute Encephalitis Syndrome Cases

as of August 6, 2016 (N=1,364)**

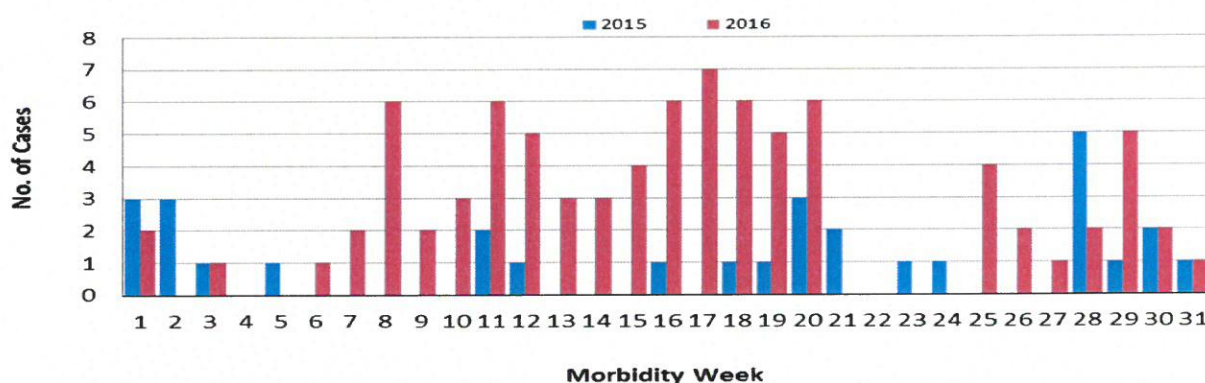




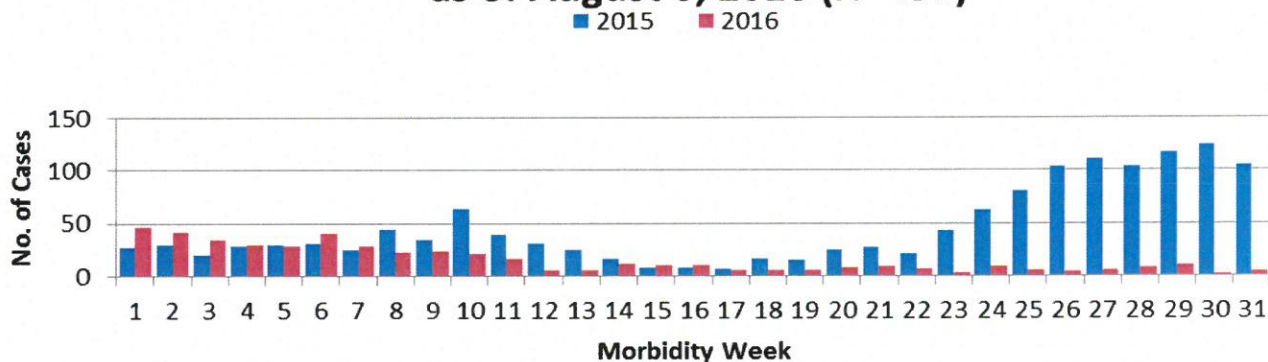
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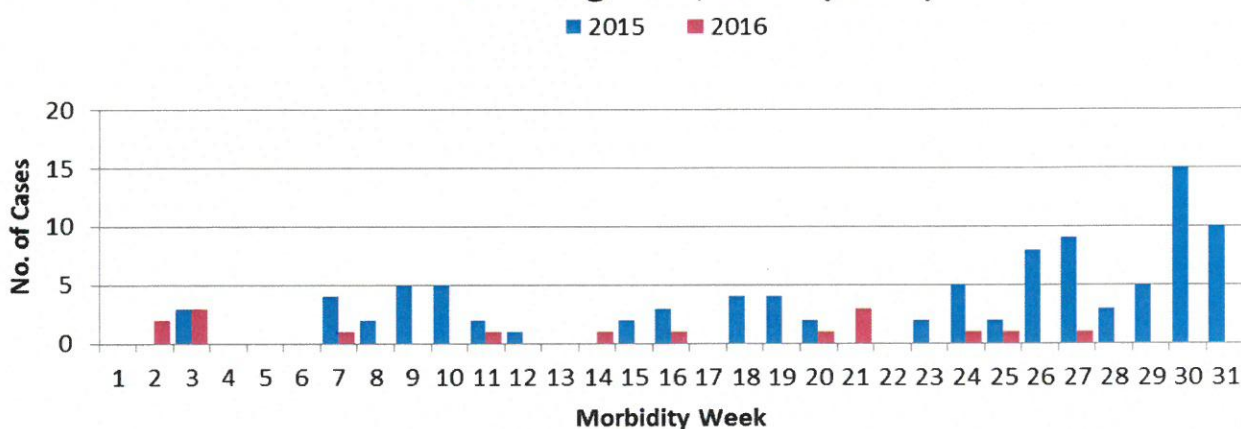
**Fig. 4 Confirmed Bacterial Meningitis Cases

 as of August 6, 2016 (n=16)**

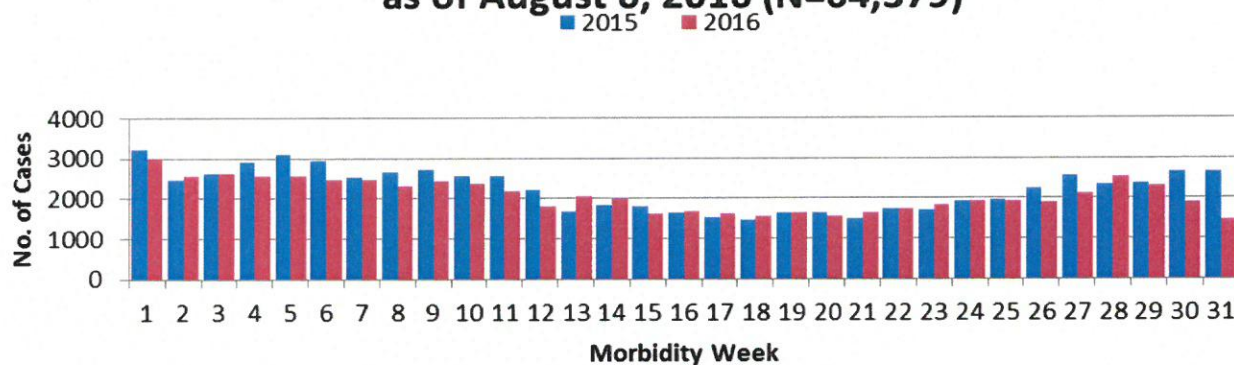




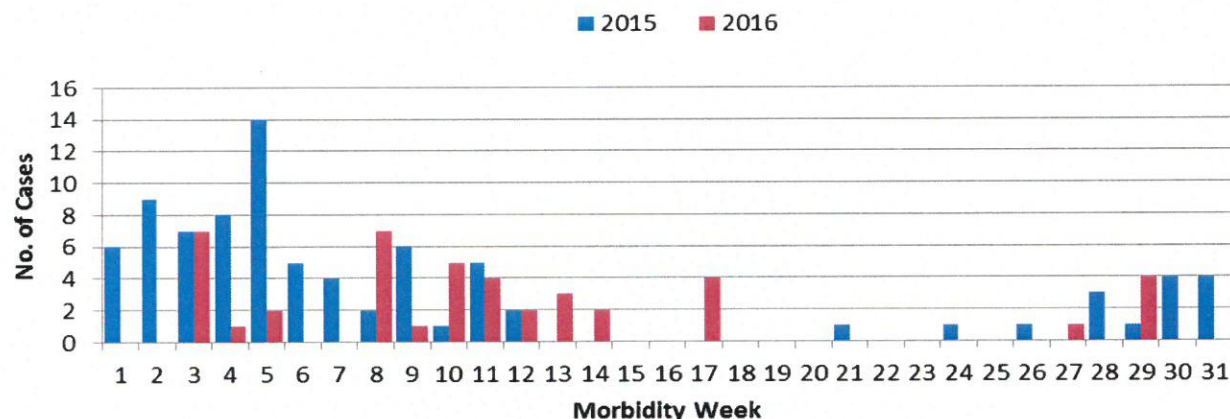
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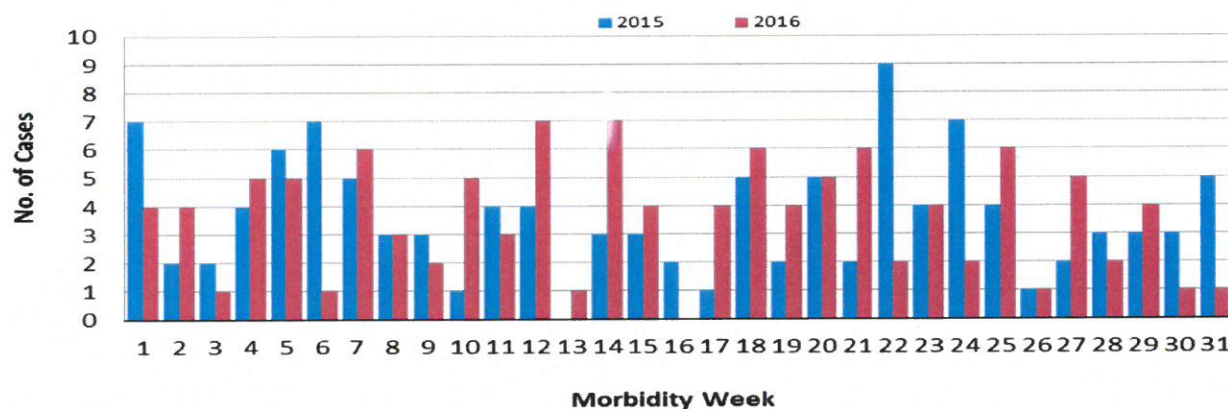
**Fig.7 Influenza-like Illness Cases

as of August 6, 2016 (N=111)**

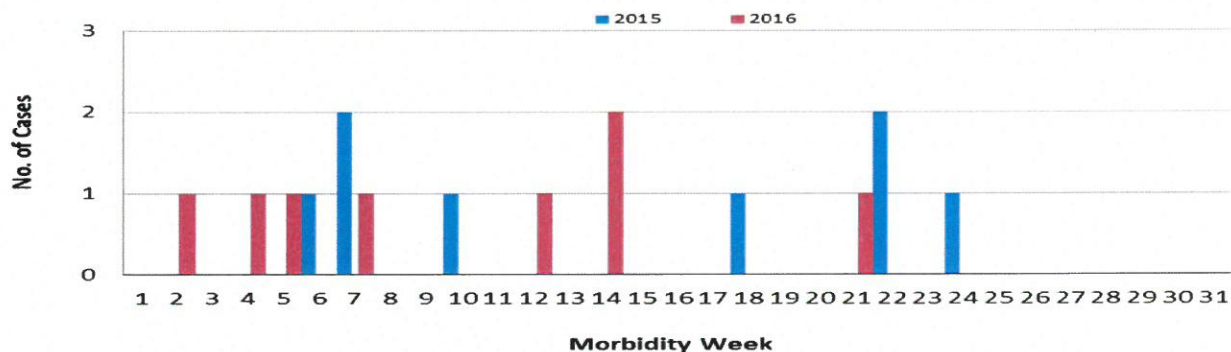




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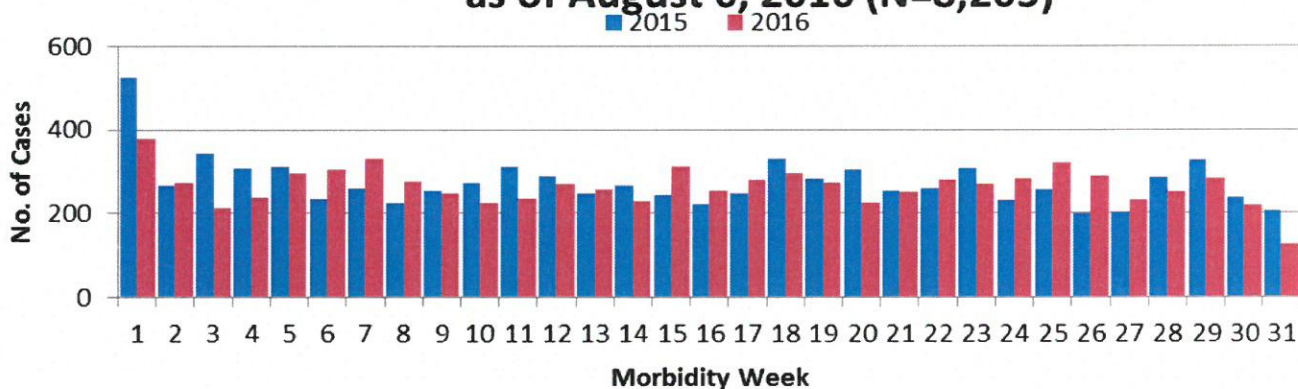
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**Fig. 10 Confirmed Meningococcal Disease Cases
as of August 6, 2016 (n=8)**

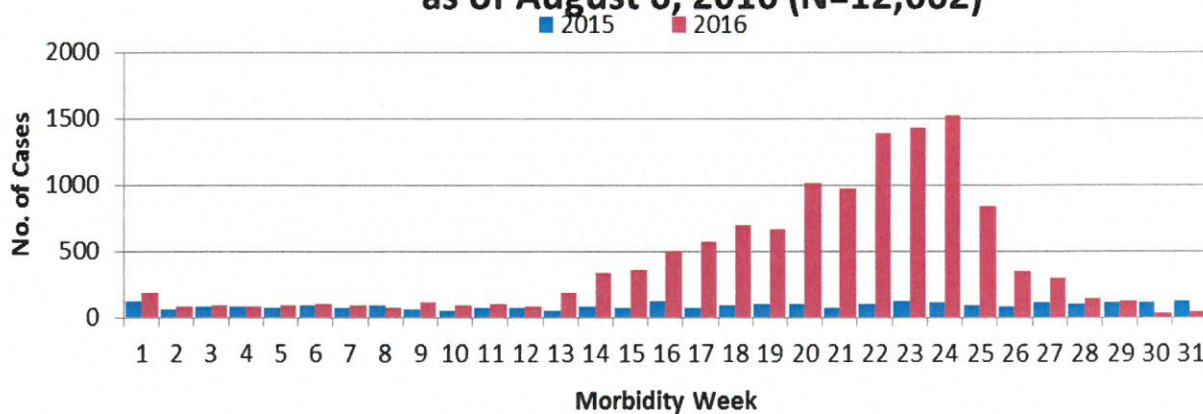

as of August 6, 2016 (N=12,662)**

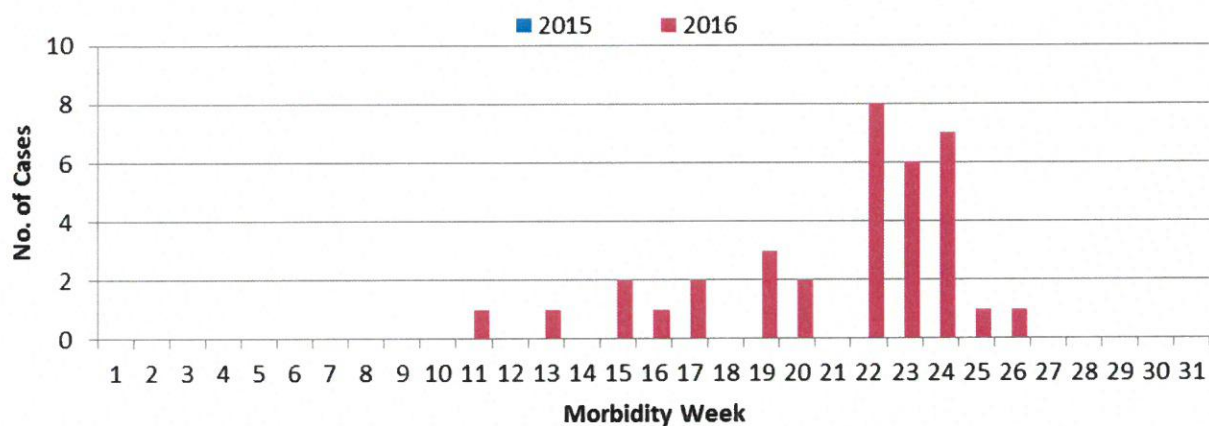




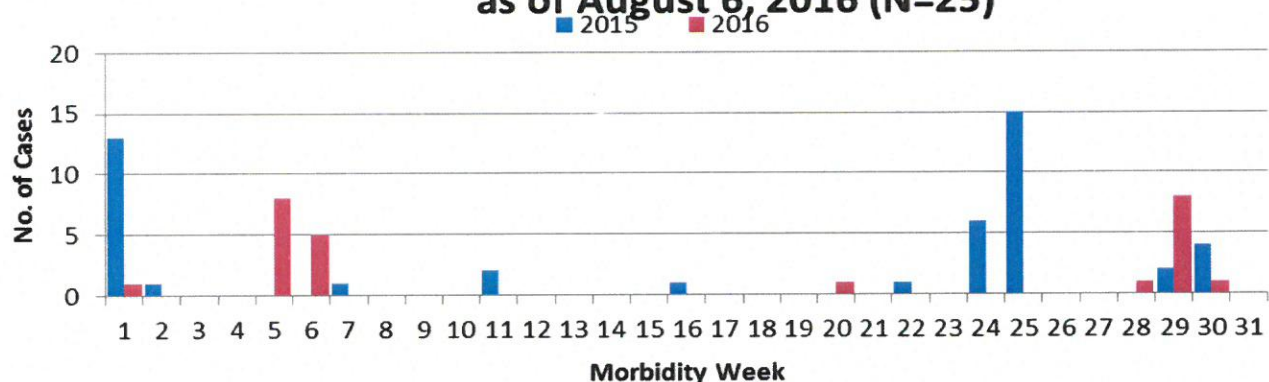
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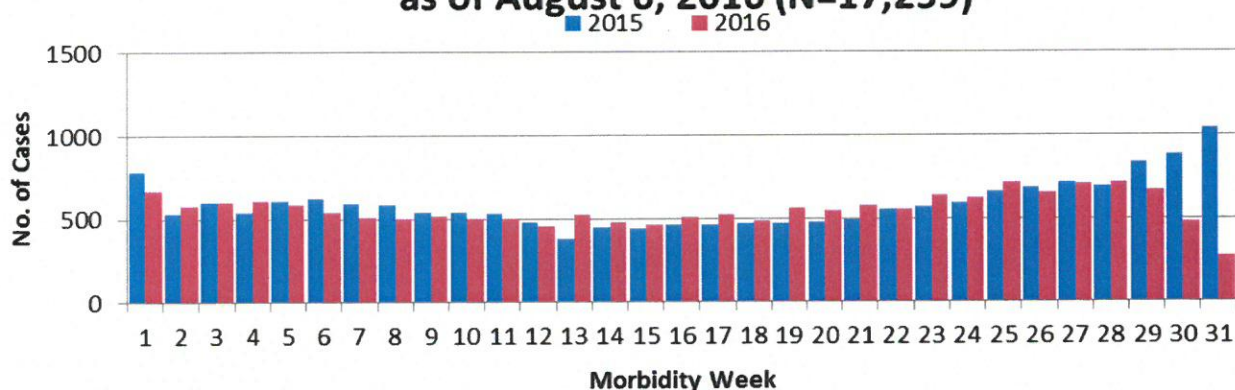
**Fig.13 Confirmed Cholera Cases

 as of August 6, 2016 (N=17,259)**

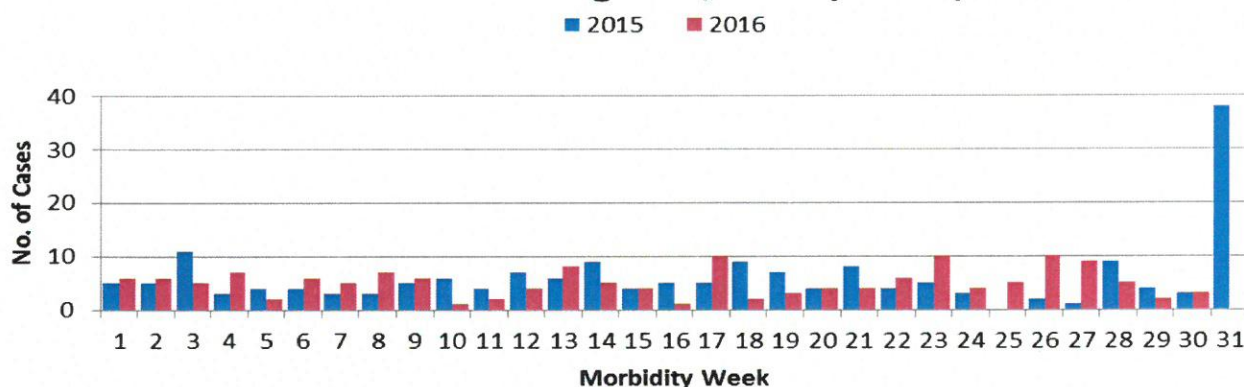




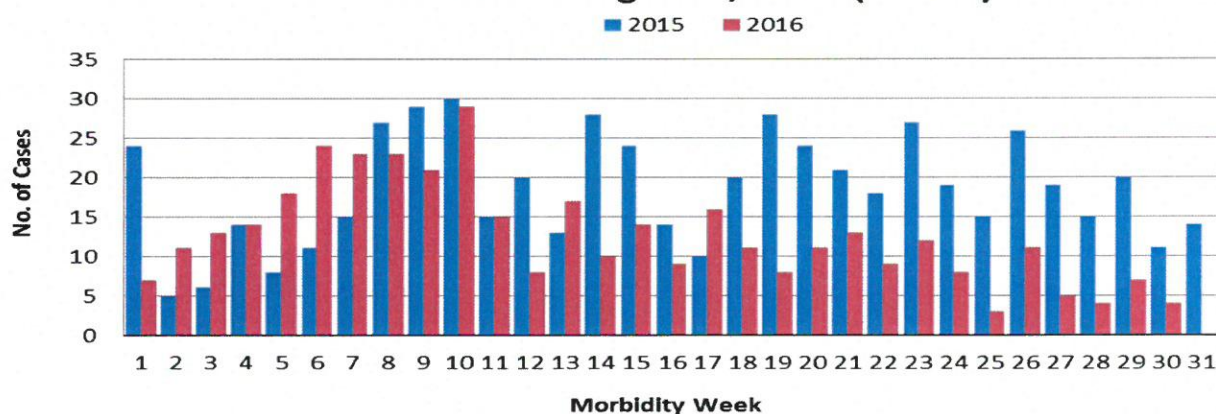
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**Fig.16 Confirmed Typhoid Cases
 as of August 6, 2016 (n=152)**

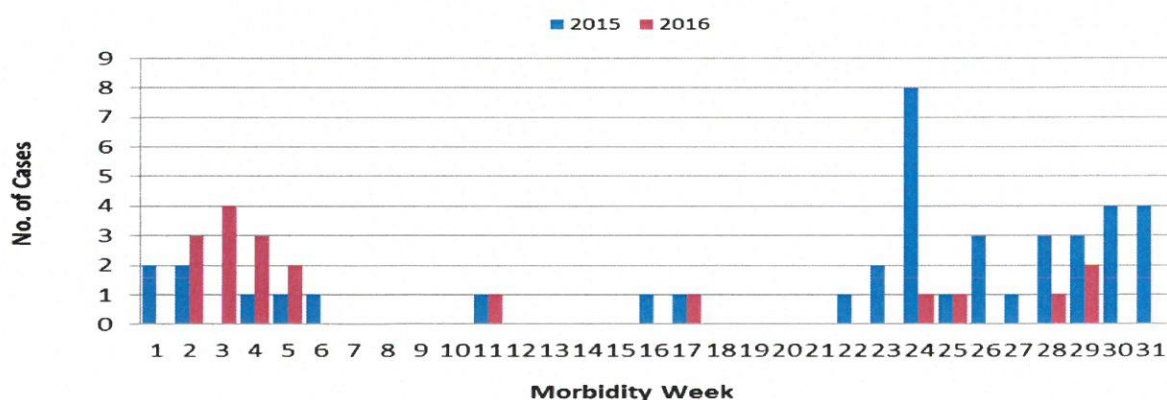


**Fig. 17 Confirmed Hepatitis A Cases

 as of August 6, 2016 (N=19)**

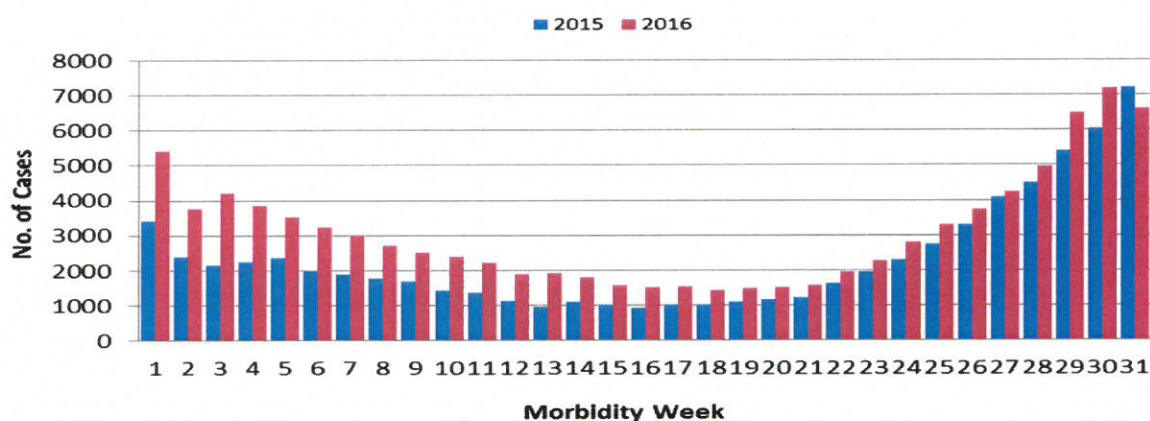




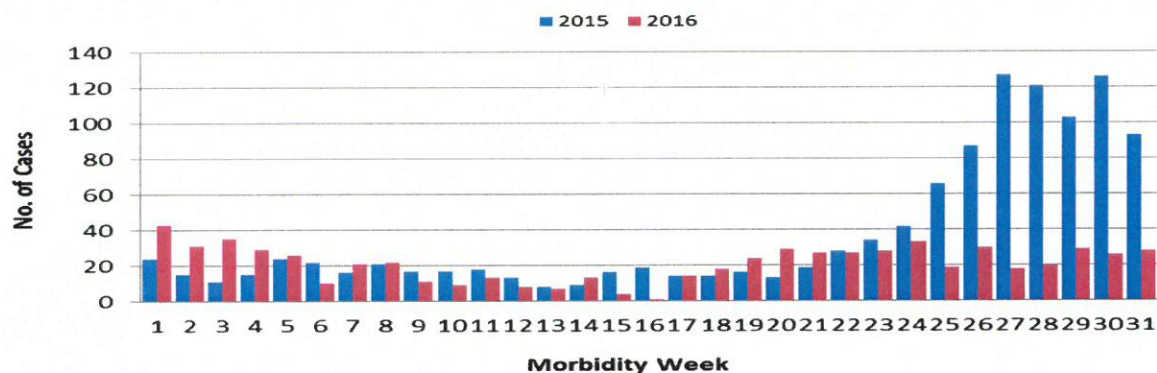
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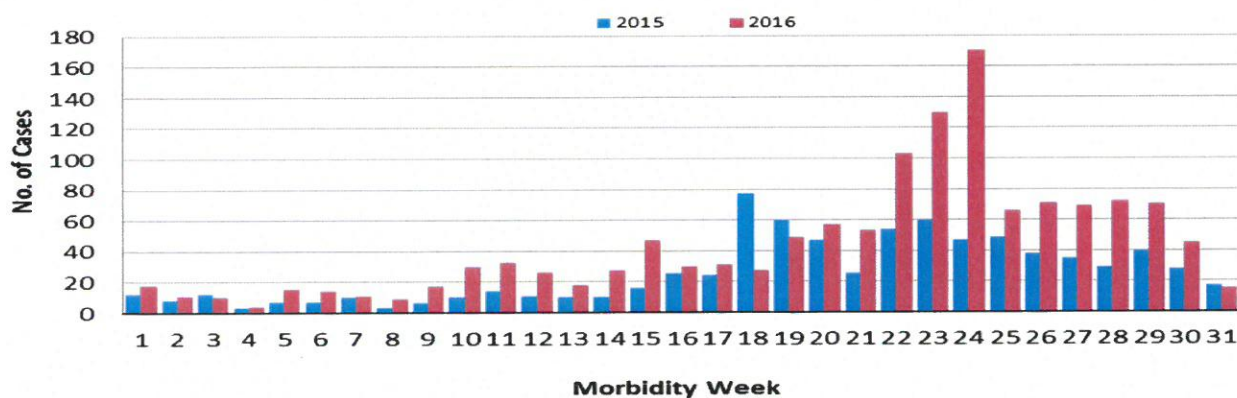
**Fig. 19 Suspect Dengue Cases

as of August 6, 2016 (N=1,347)**



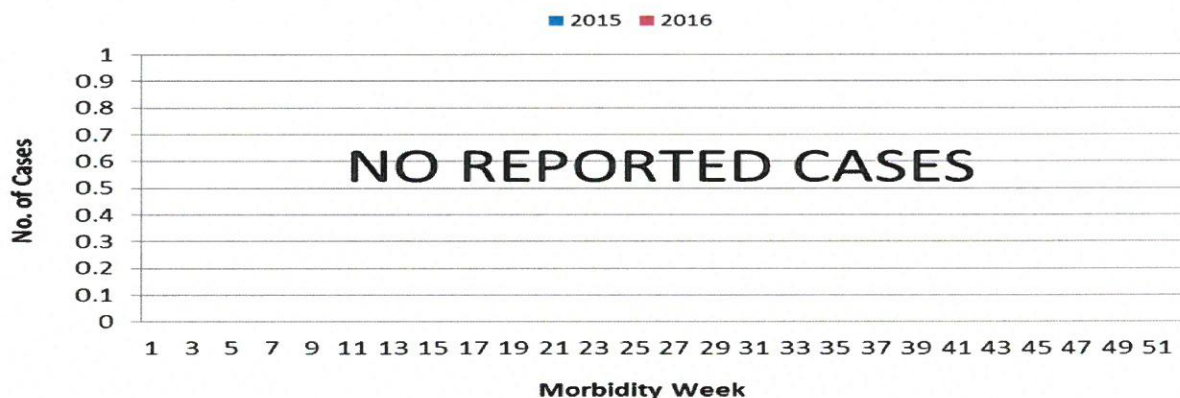


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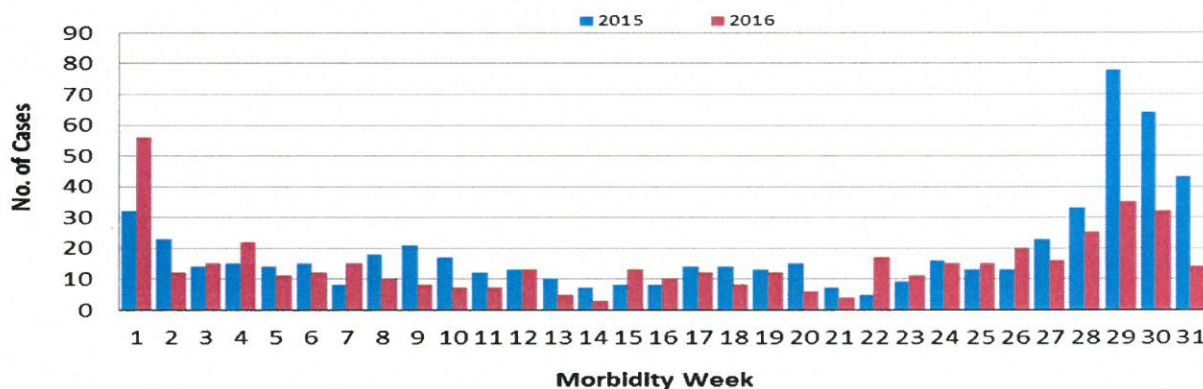

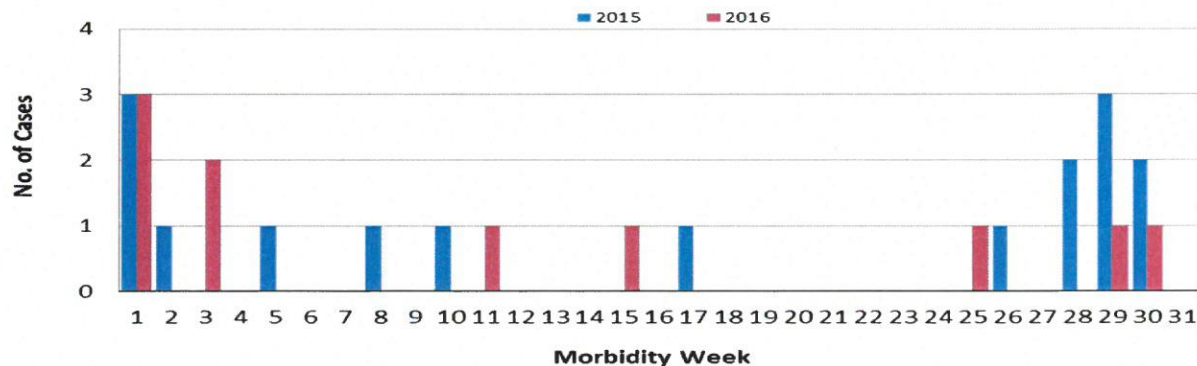
**Fig. 22 Suspect Anthrax Cases

as of August 6, 2016 (n=10)**

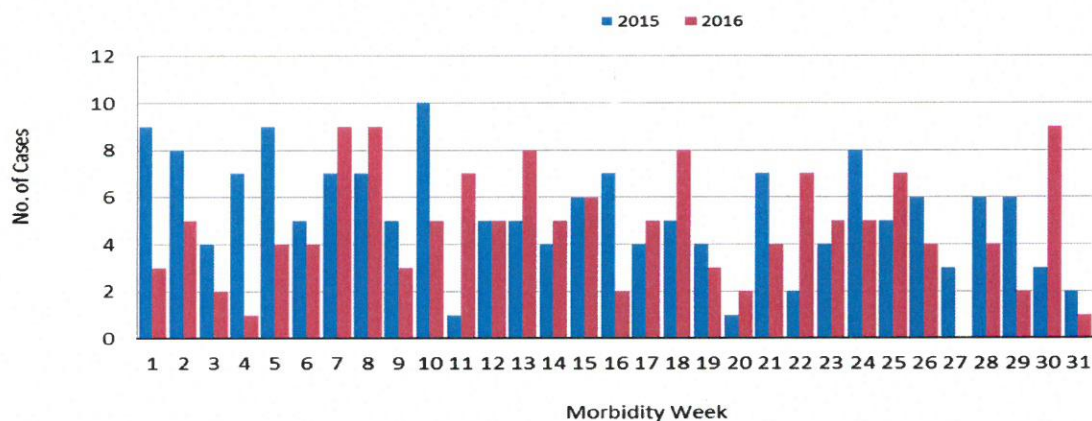




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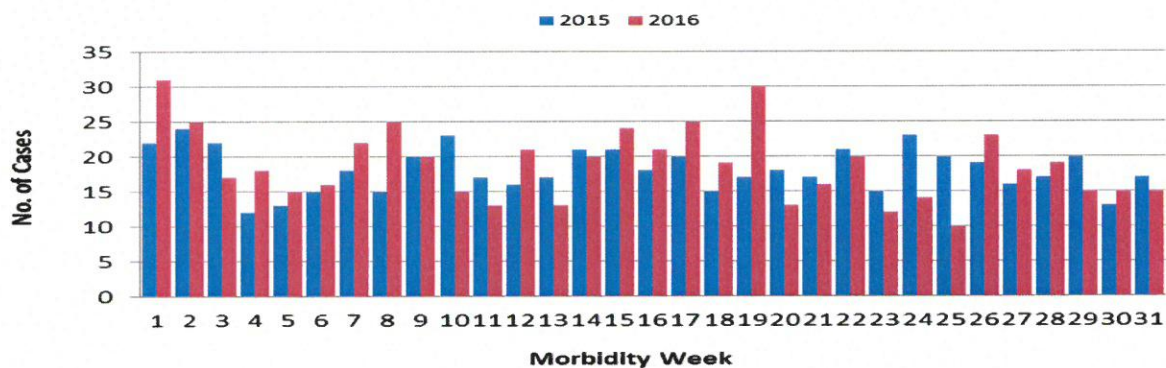
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**Fig. 25 Probable Rabies Cases
as of August 6, 2016 (N=144)**

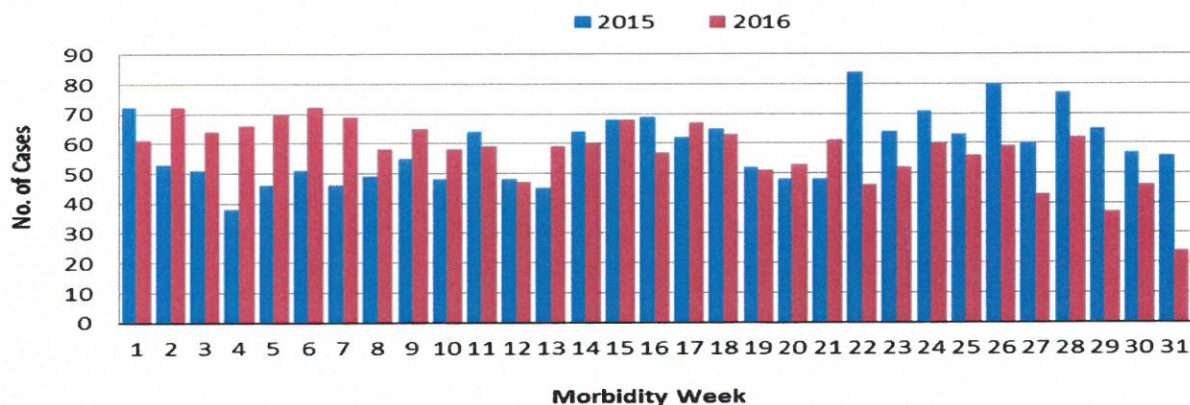

as of August 6, 2016 (n=1785)**

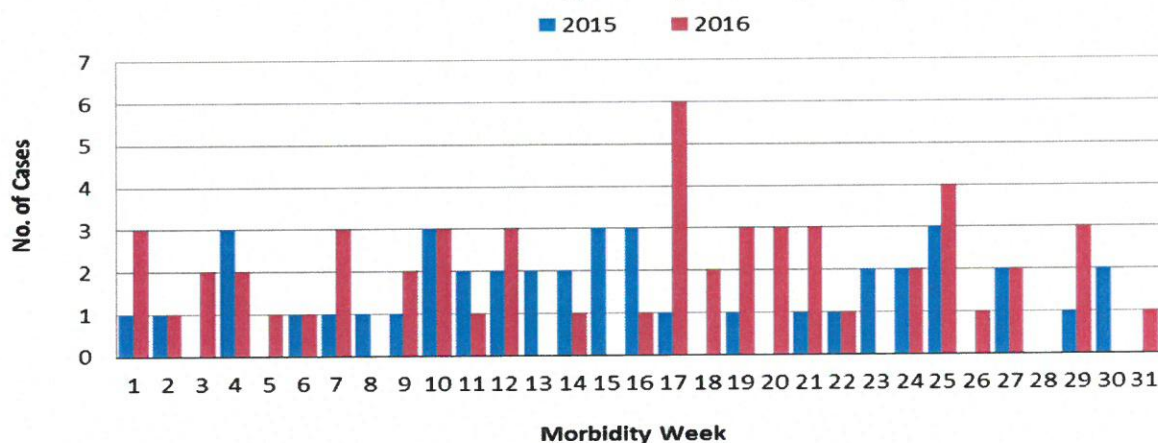




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
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**Fig. 28 Confirmed Hepatitis C Cases
as of August 6, 2016 (n=55)**





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
