Fig. 1 Suspect Acute Encephalitis Syndrome Cases as of September 3, 2016 (N=283)

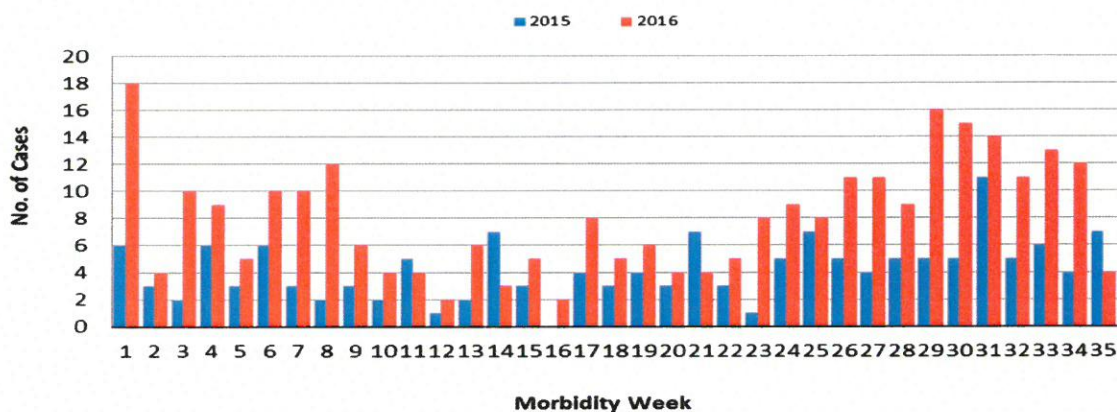


Fig. 2 Confirmed Acute Encephalitis Syndrome Cases as of September 3, 2016 (n=21)

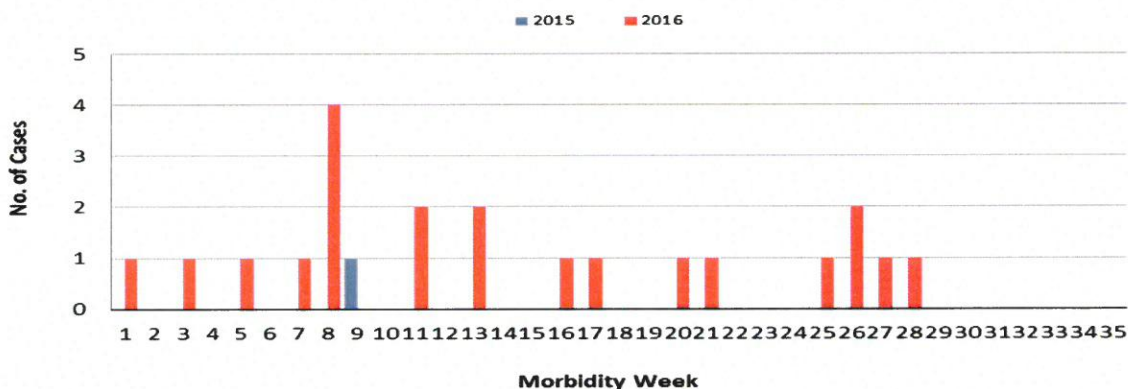
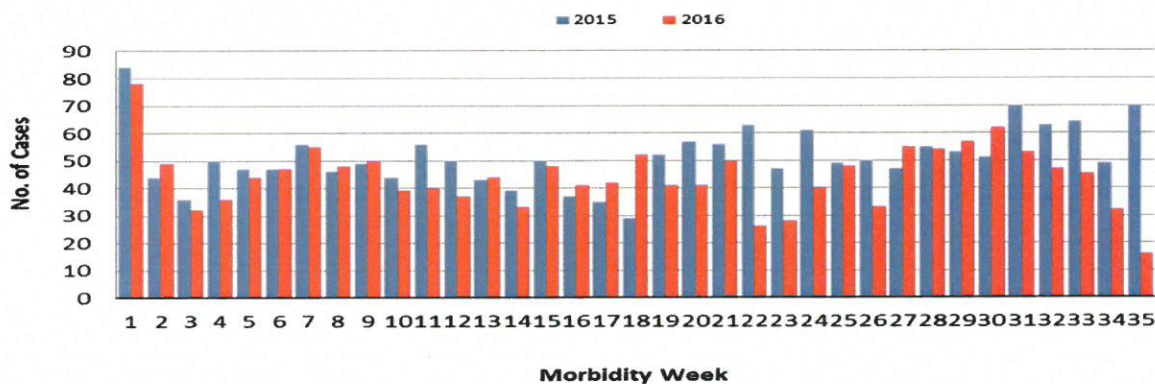


Fig. 3 Suspect Bacterial Meningitis Cases as of September 3, 2016 (N=1,543)

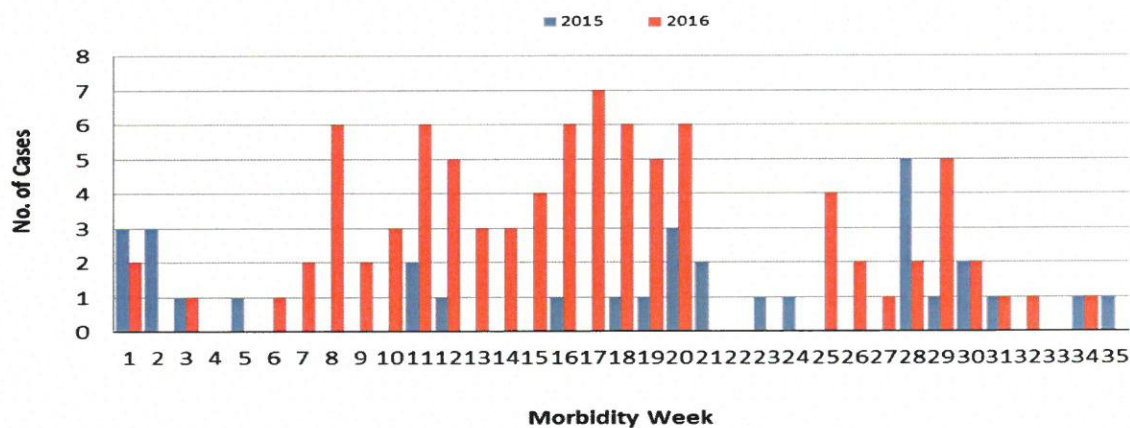




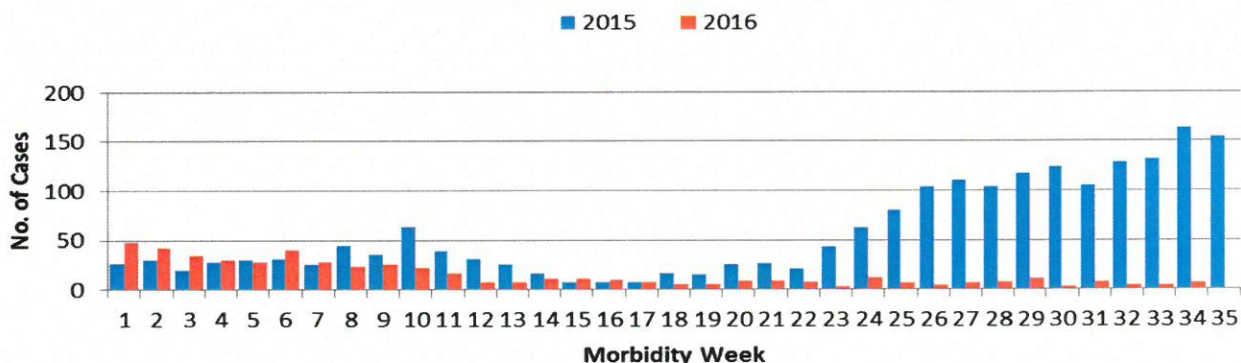
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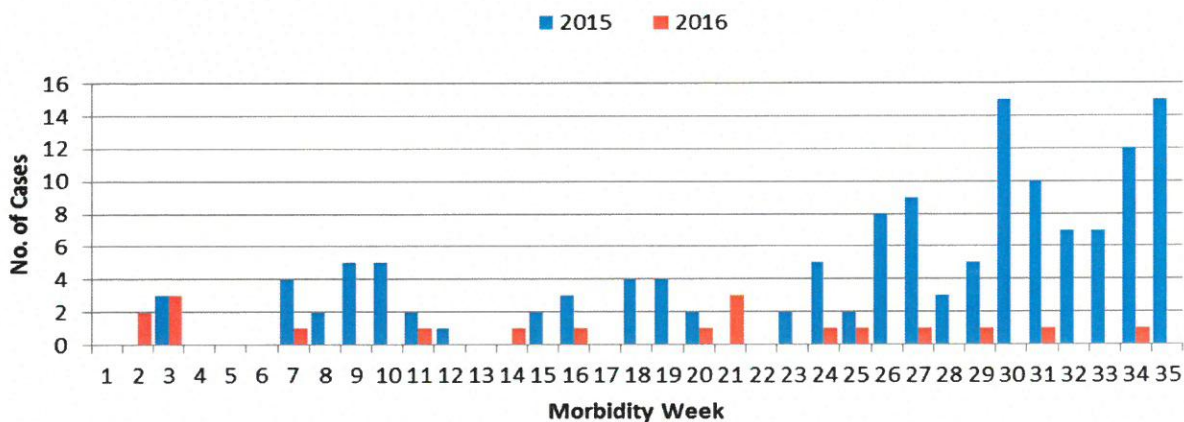
**Fig. 4 Confirmed Bacterial Meningitis Cases

as of September 3, 2016 (n=19)**

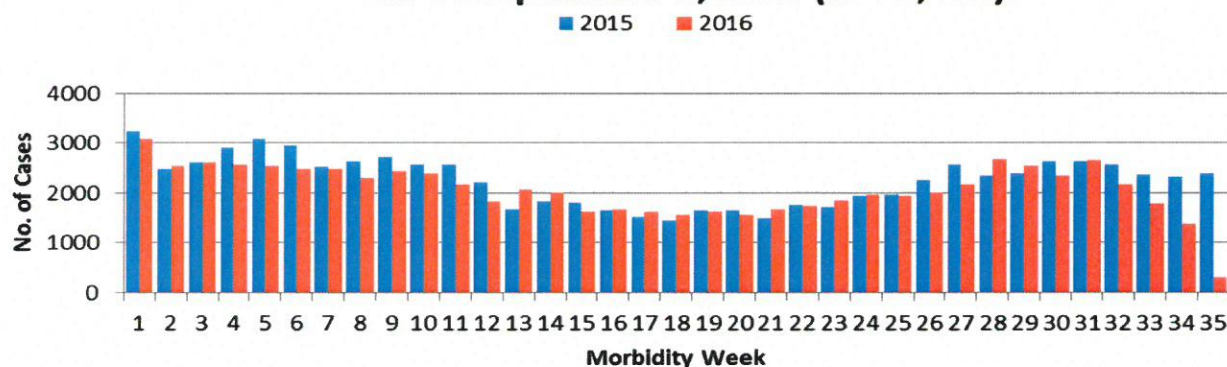




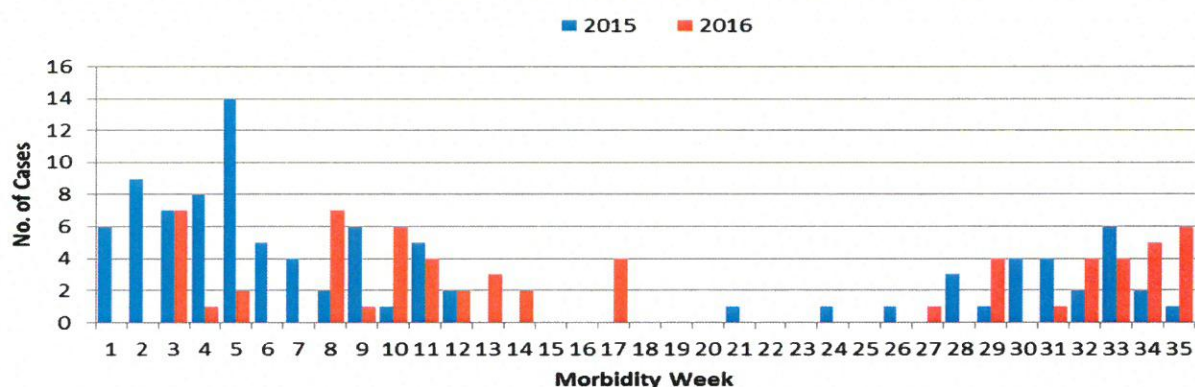
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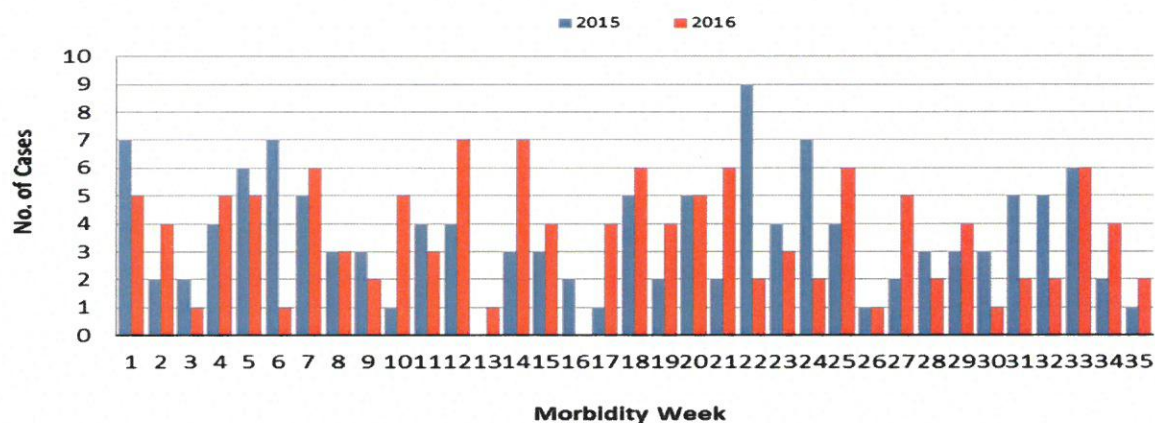
**Fig.7 Influenza-like Illness Cases

as of September 3, 2016 (N=126)**

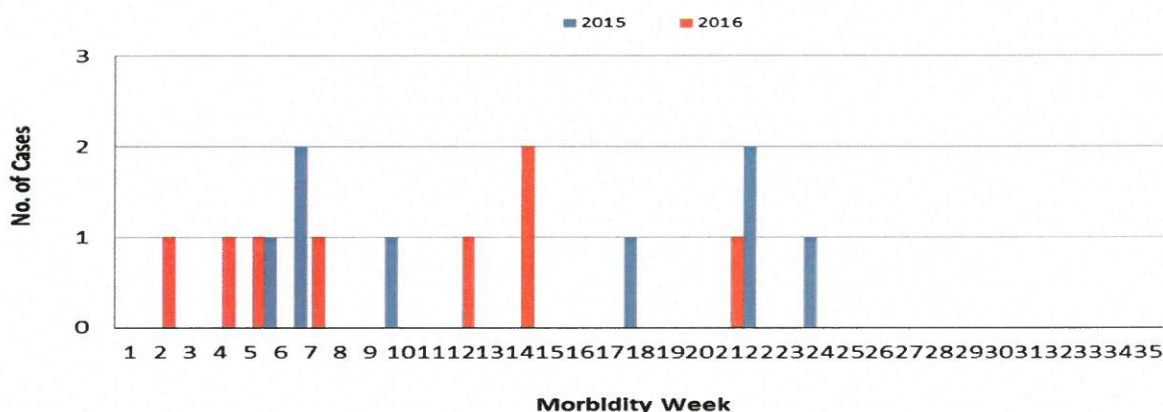




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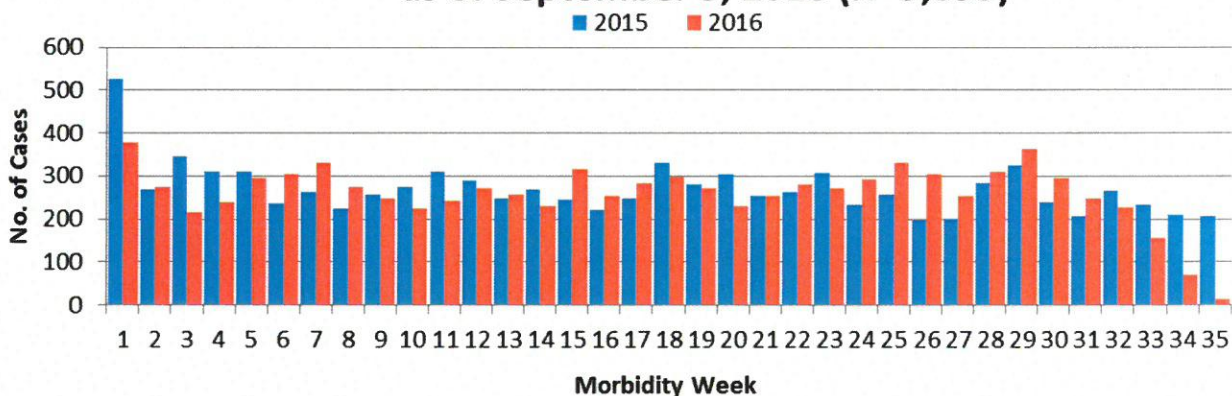
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**Fig. 10 Confirmed Meningococcal Disease Cases
as of September 3, 2016 (n=8)**

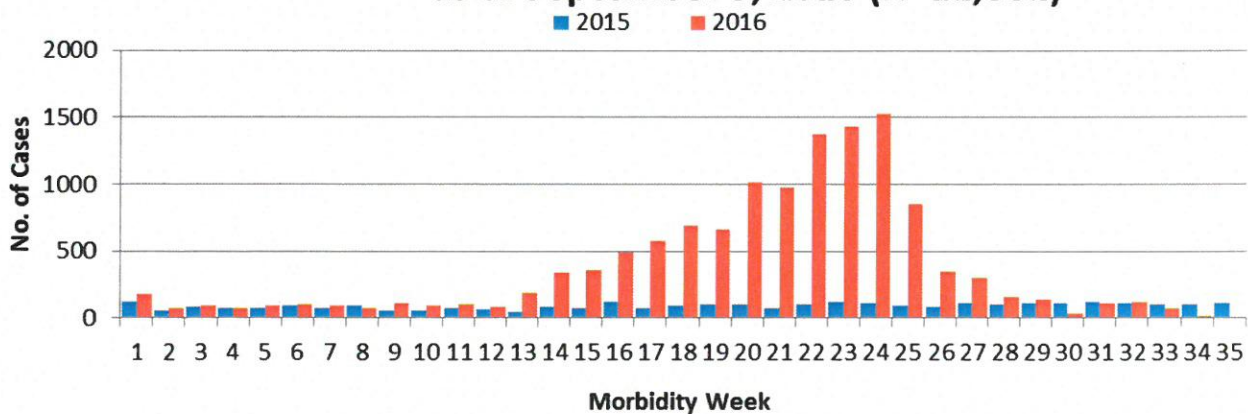

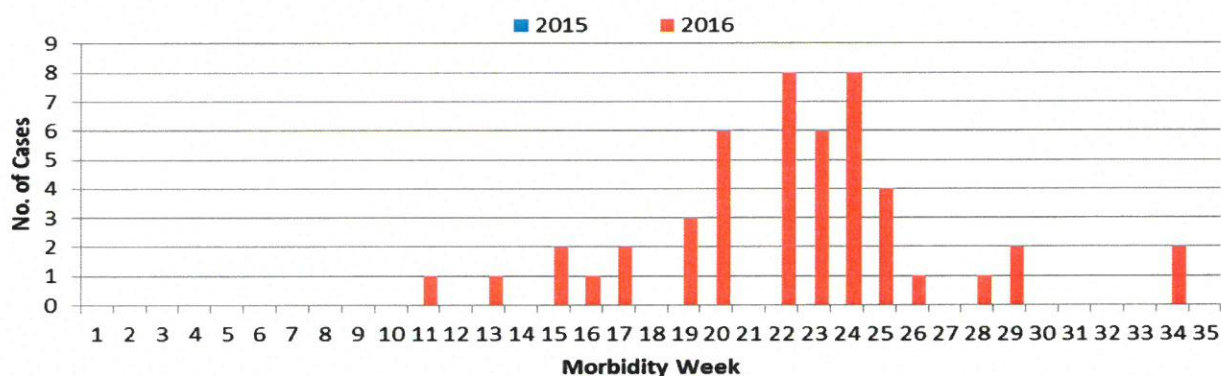




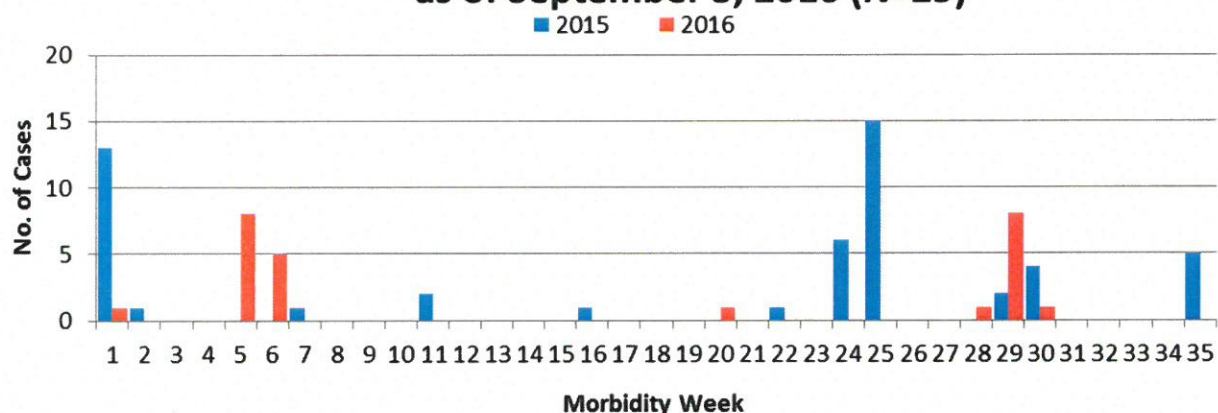
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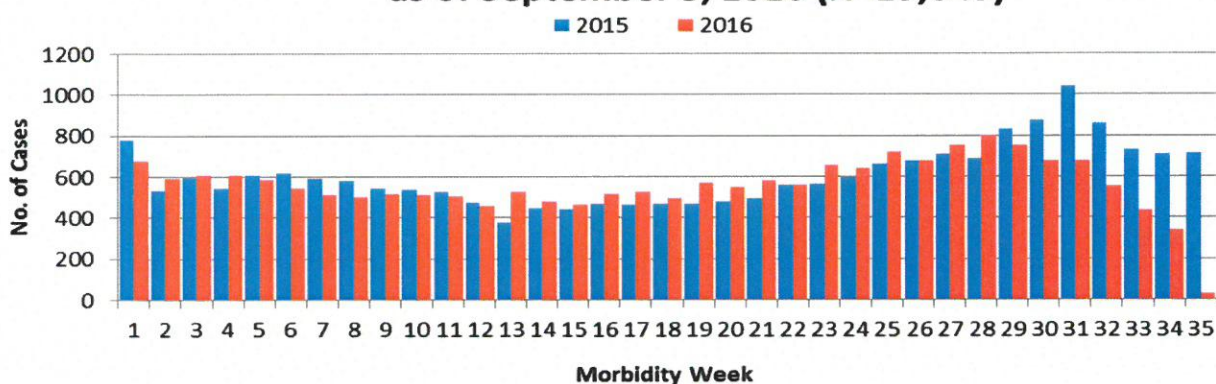
**Fig.13 Confirmed Cholera Cases

 as of September 3, 2016 (N=19,645)**

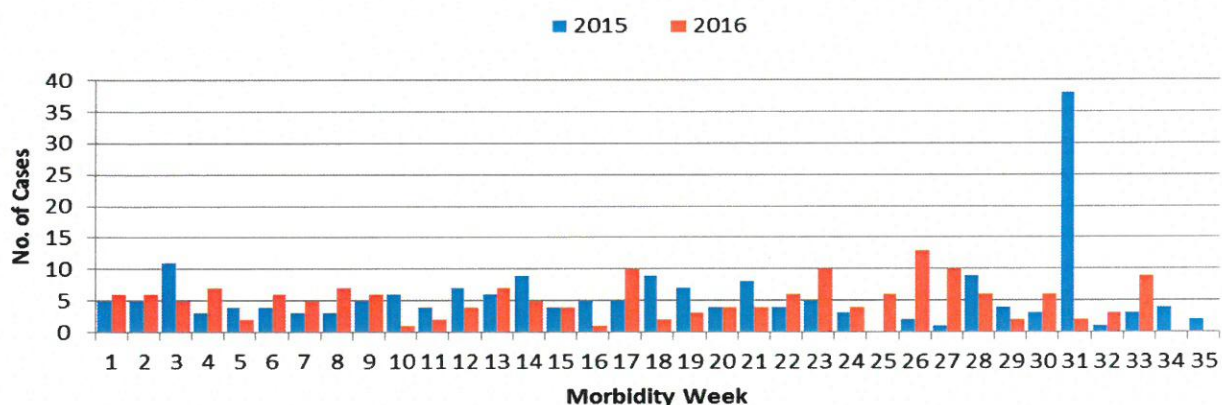




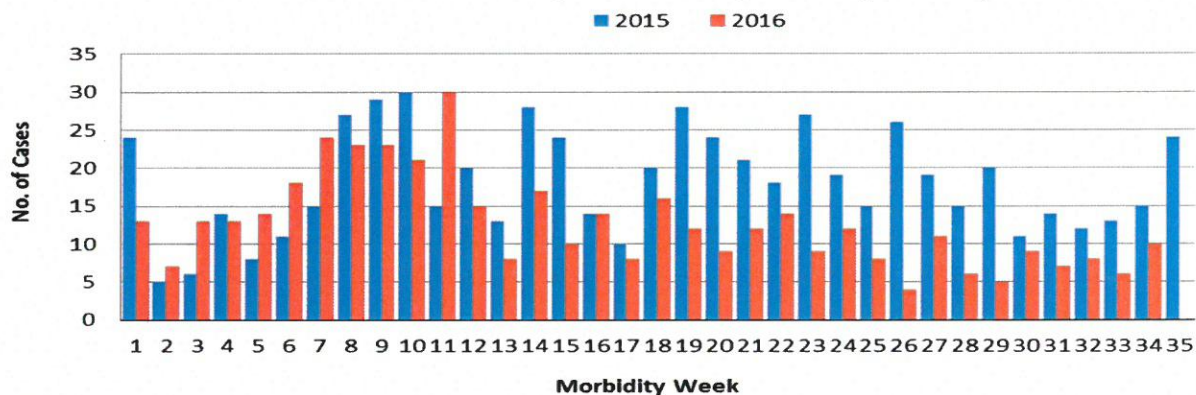
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**Fig.16 Confirmed Typhoid Cases
as of September 3, 2016 (n=174)**

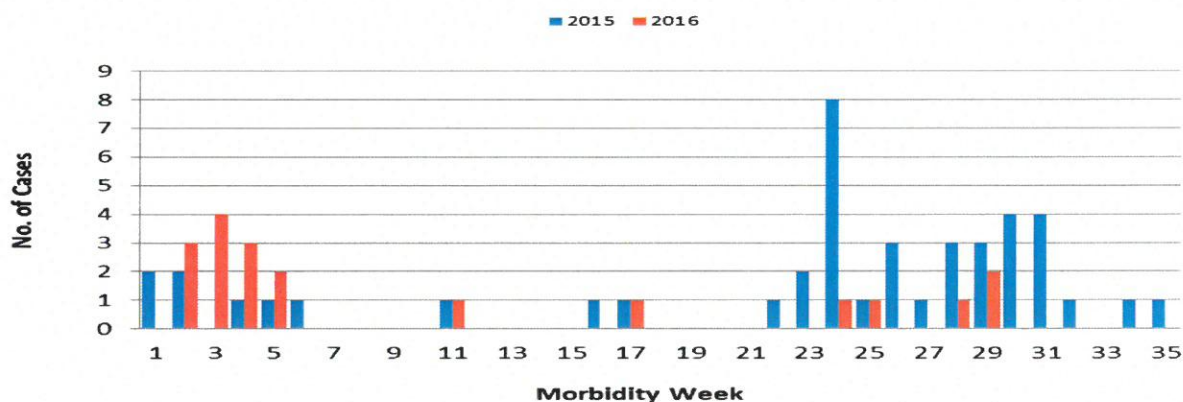


**Fig. 17 Confirmed Hepatitis A Cases

as of September 3, 2016 (N=19)**

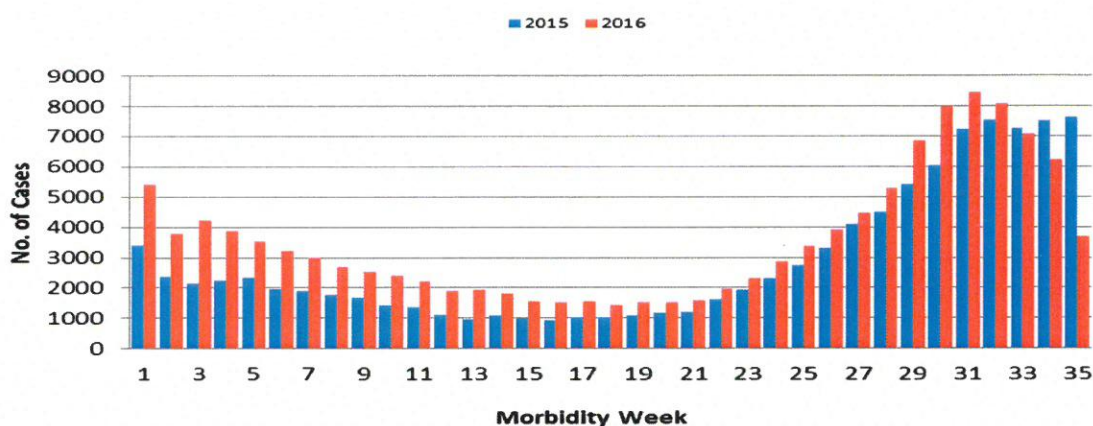




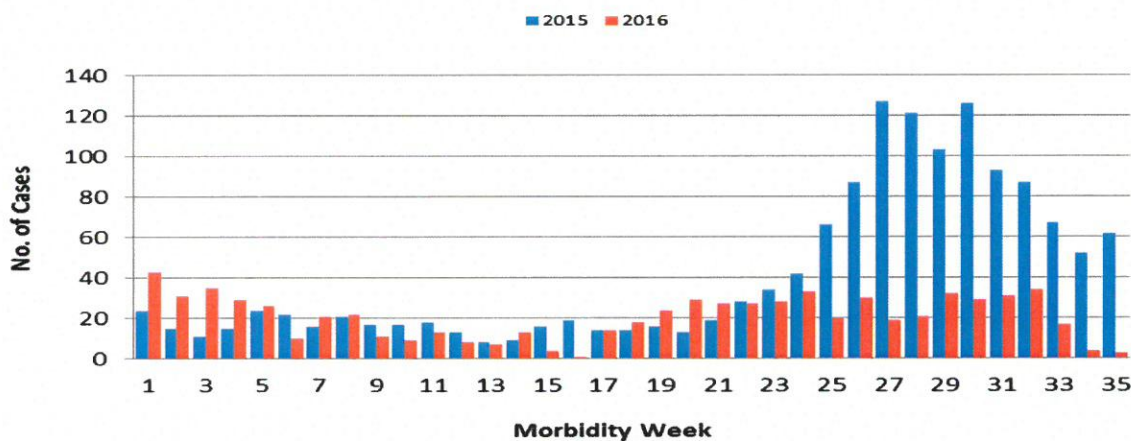
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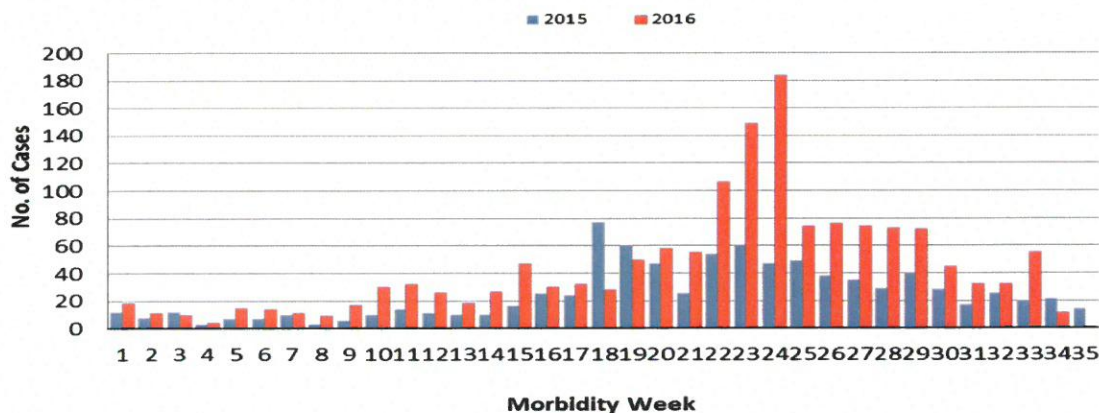
**Fig. 19 Suspect Dengue Cases

as of September 3, 2016 (N=1,526)**



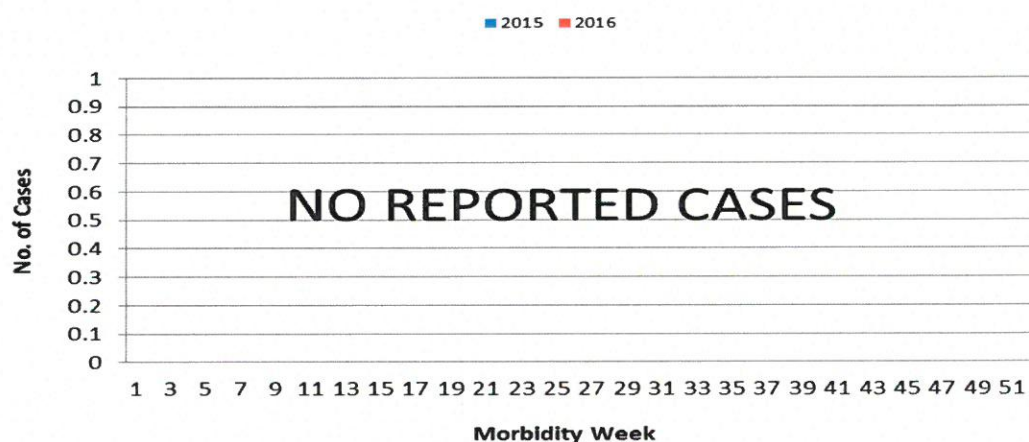


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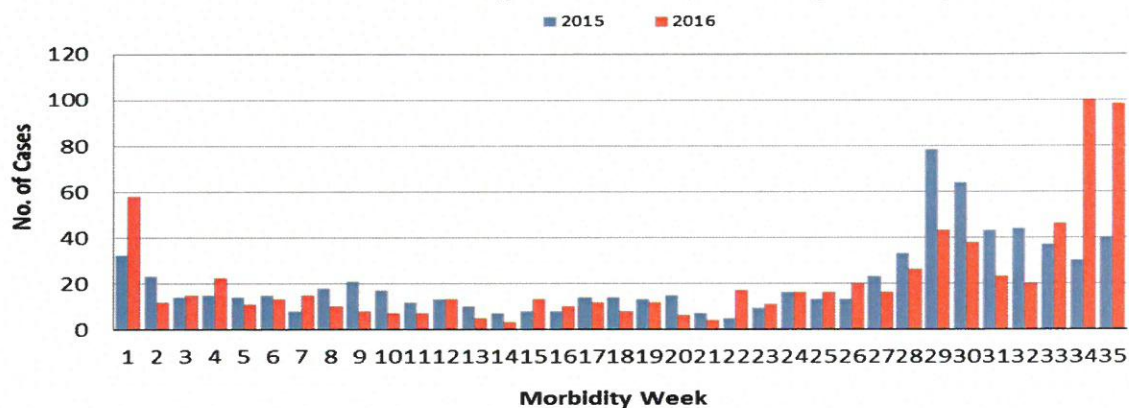

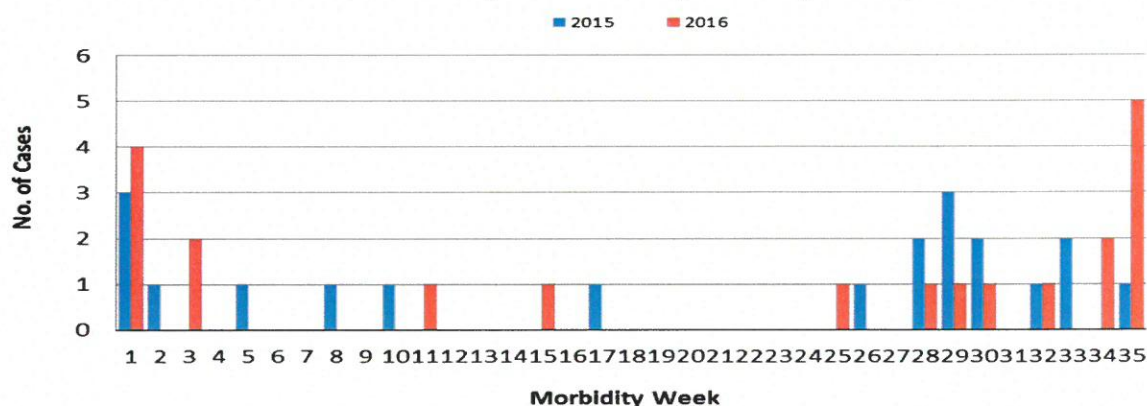
**Fig. 22 Suspect Anthrax Cases

as of September 3, 2016 (n=20)**

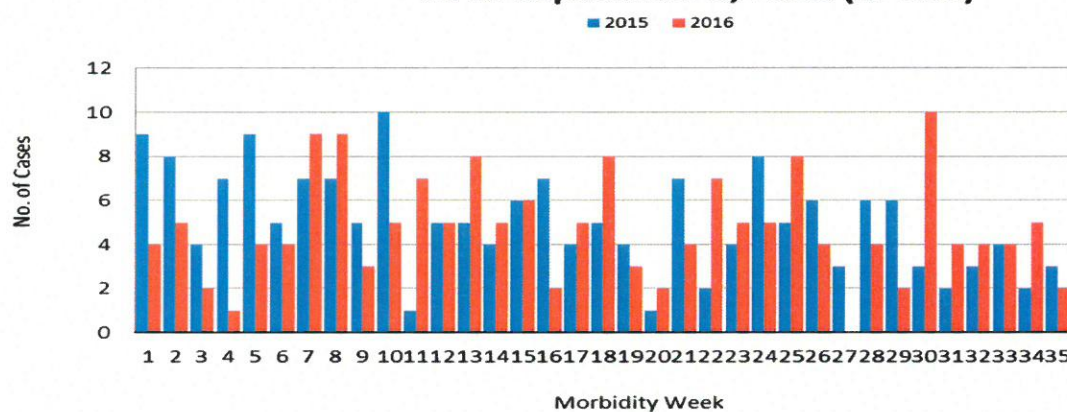




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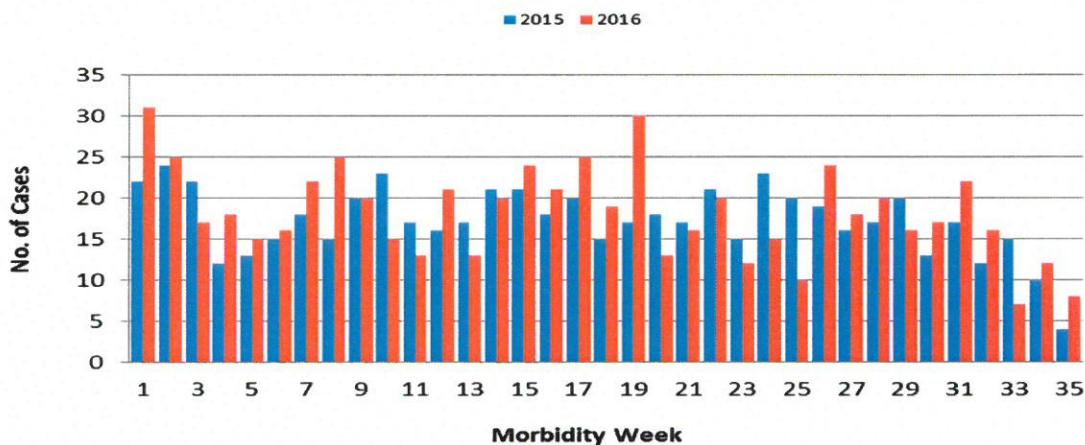
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**Fig. 25 Probable Rabies Cases
as of September 3, 2016 (N=165)**

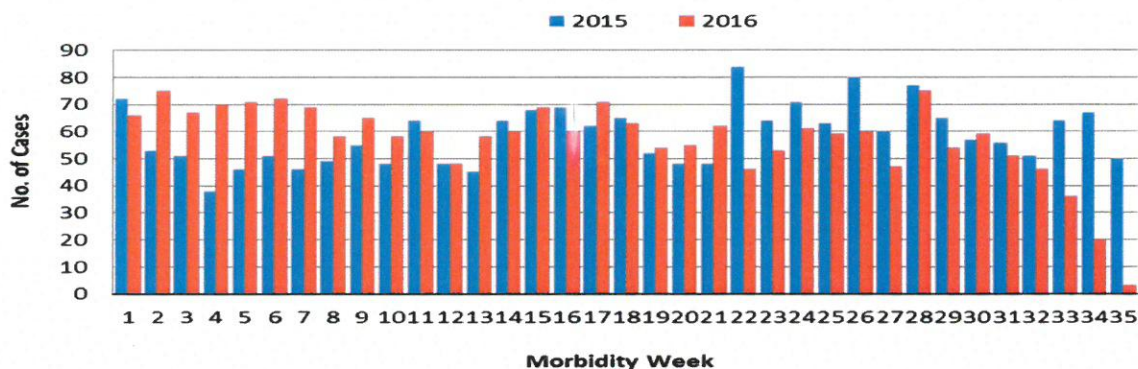

as of September 3, 2016 (n=2001)**

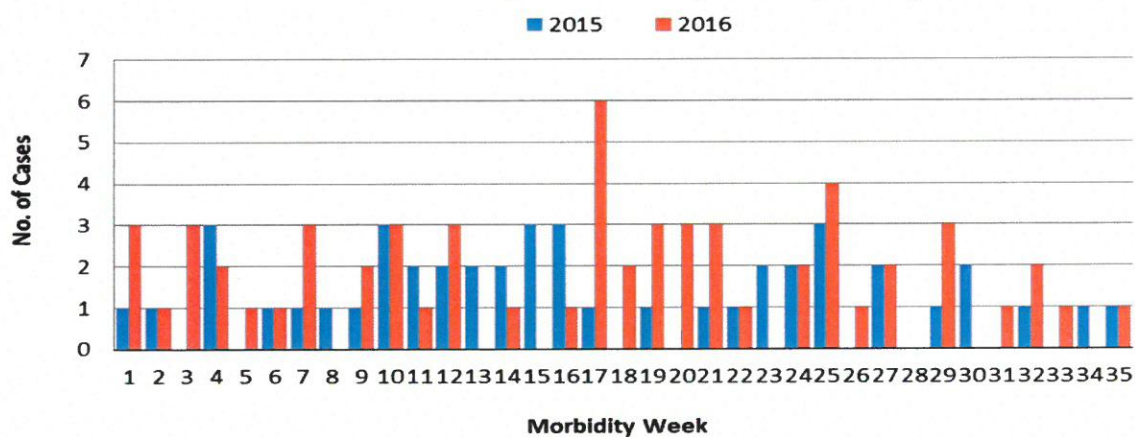





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
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**Fig. 28 Confirmed Hepatitis C Cases
as of September 3, 2016 (n=60)**




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
