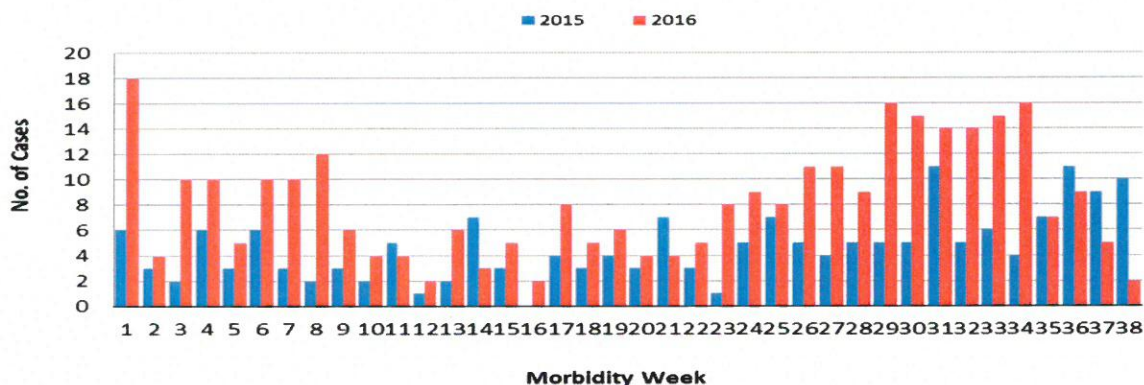

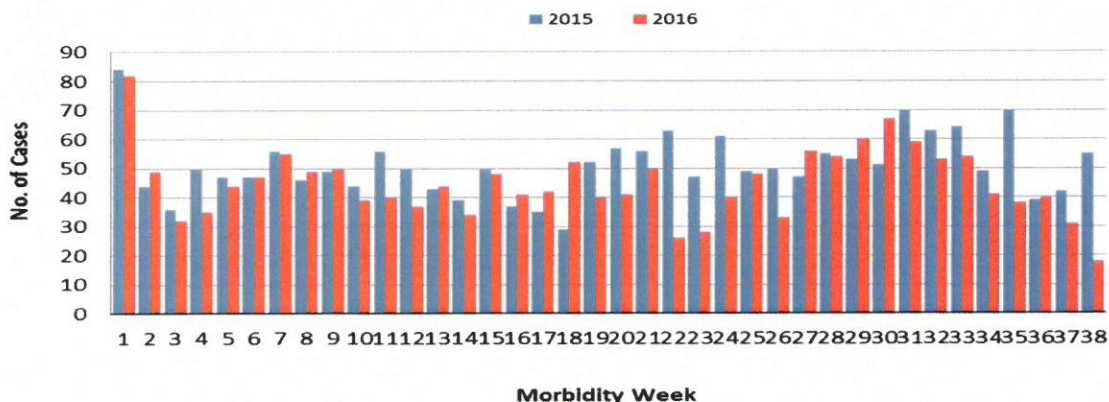
**Fig. 1 Suspect Acute Encephalitis Syndrome Cases

as of September 24, 2016 (N=1,697)**

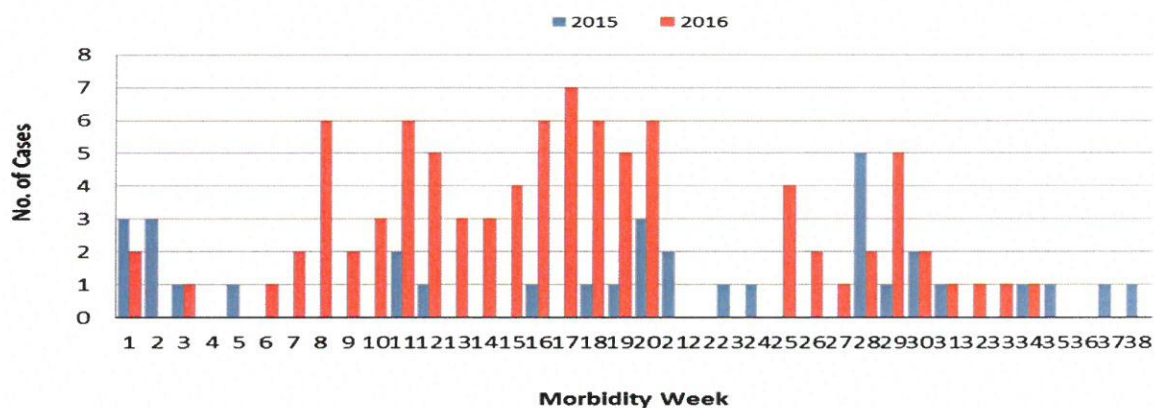




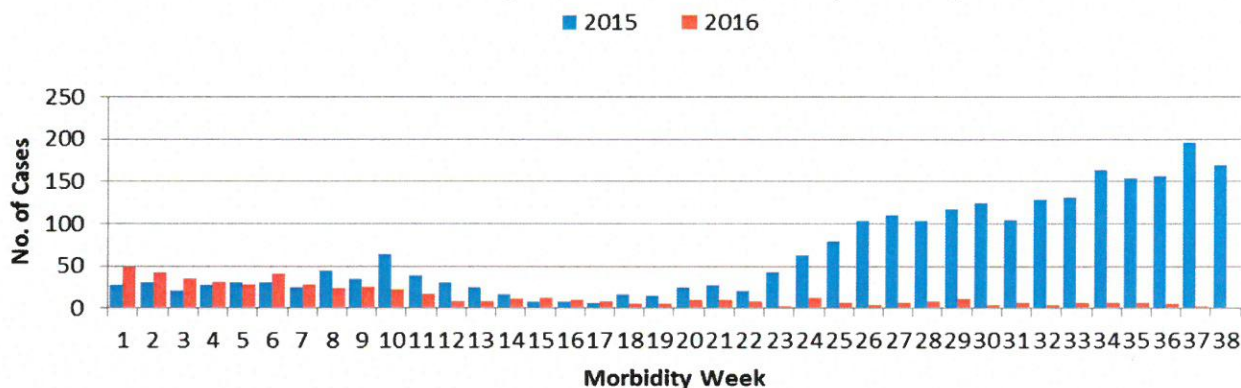

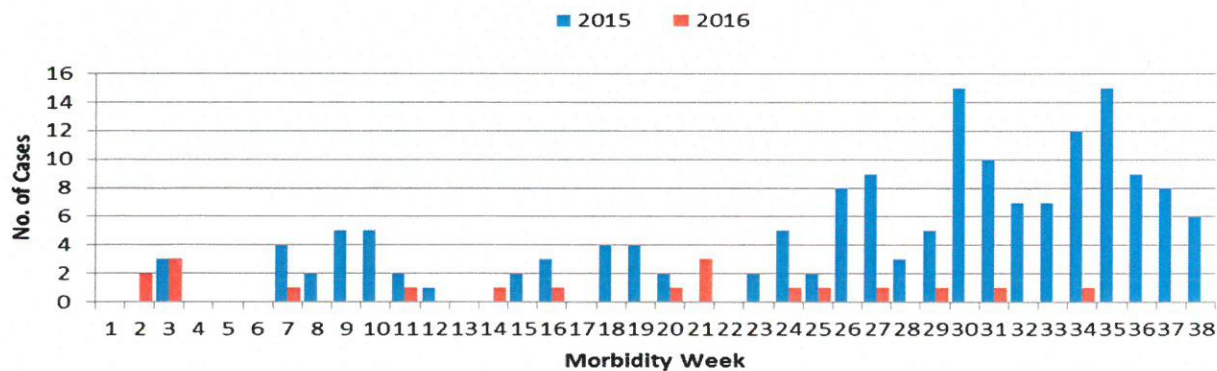
**Fig. 4 Confirmed Bacterial Meningitis Cases

as of September 24, 2016 (n=19)**

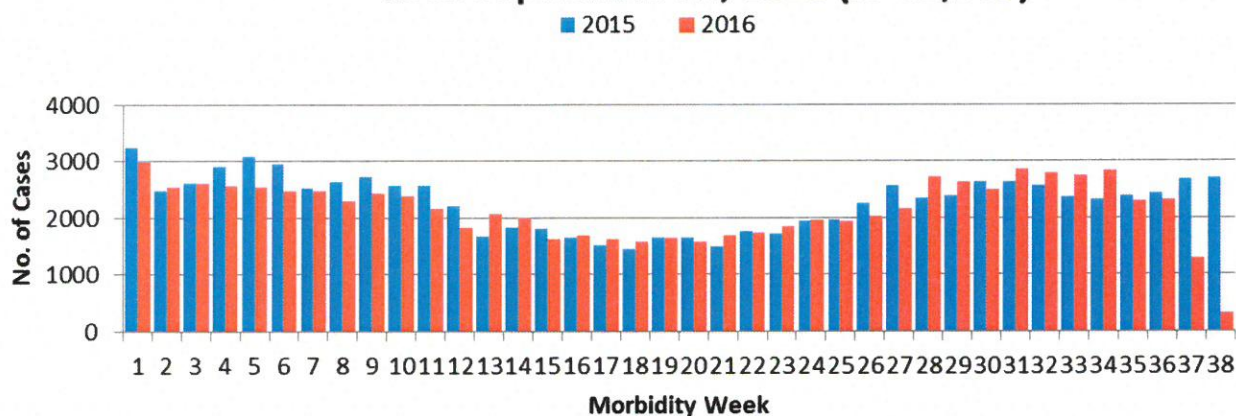




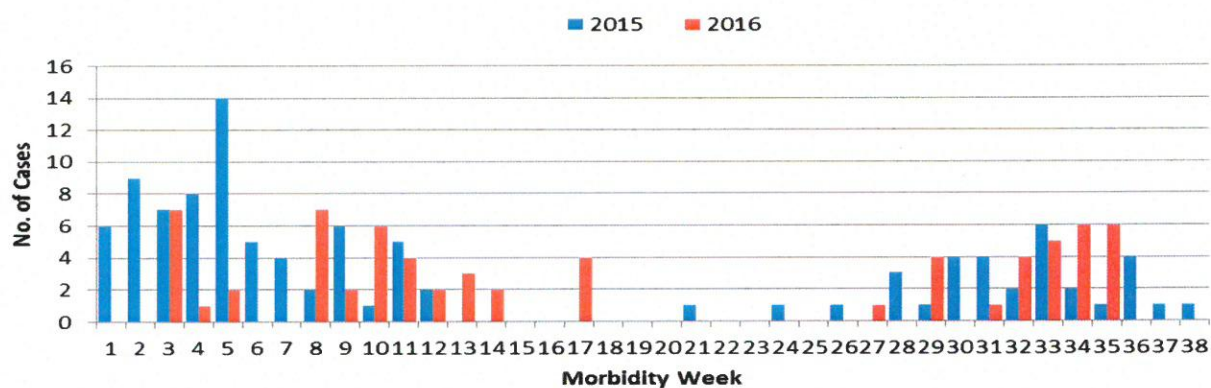

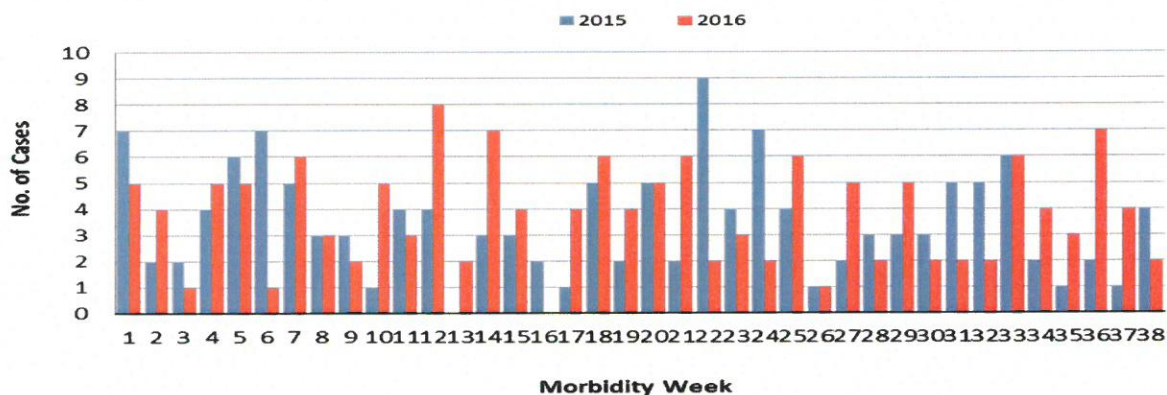
**Fig.7 Influenza-like Illness Cases

as of September 24, 2016 (N=144)**

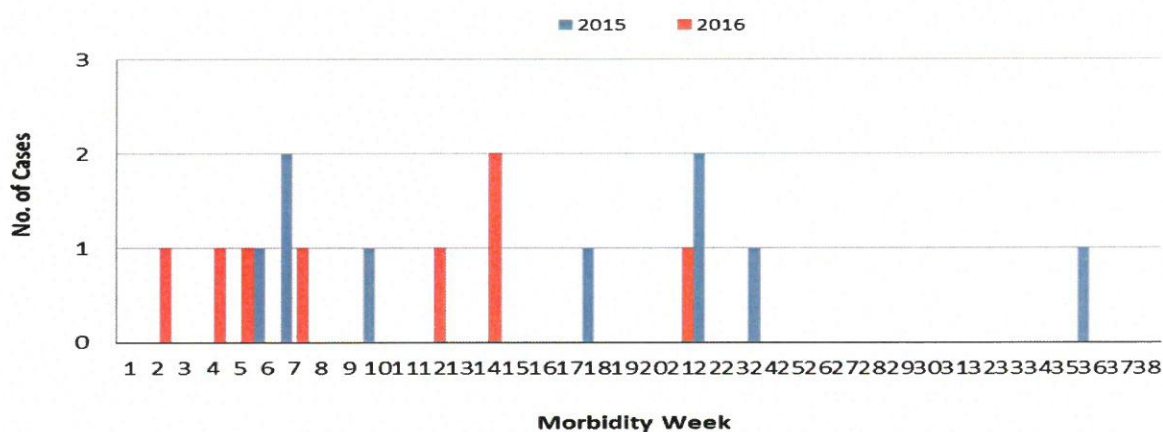

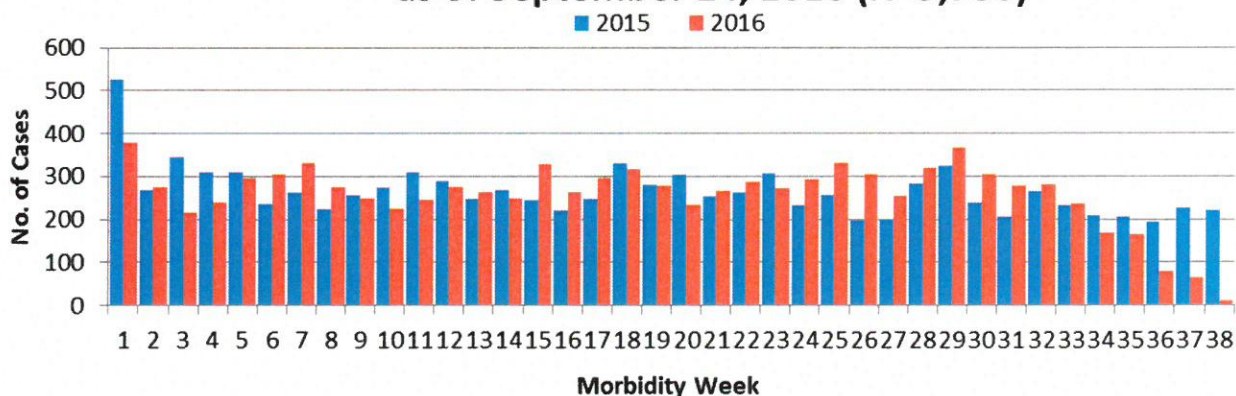

as of September 24, 2016 (n=8)**

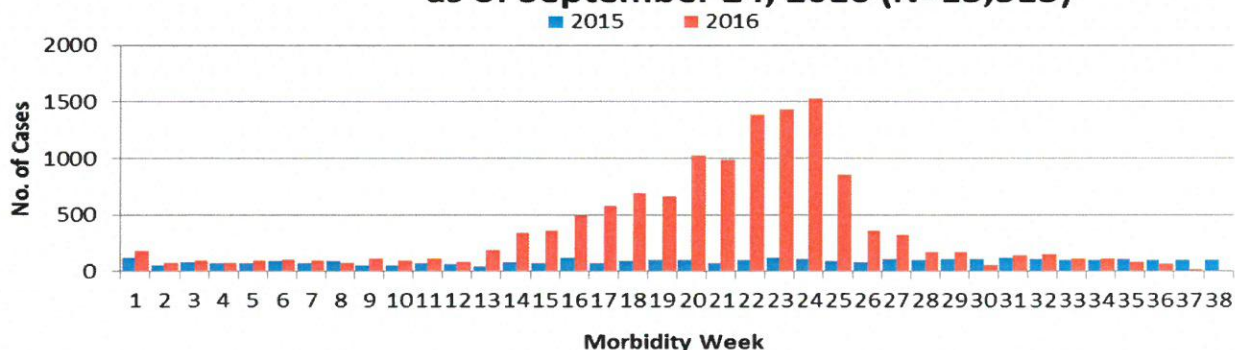

as of September 24, 2016 (N=13,513)**

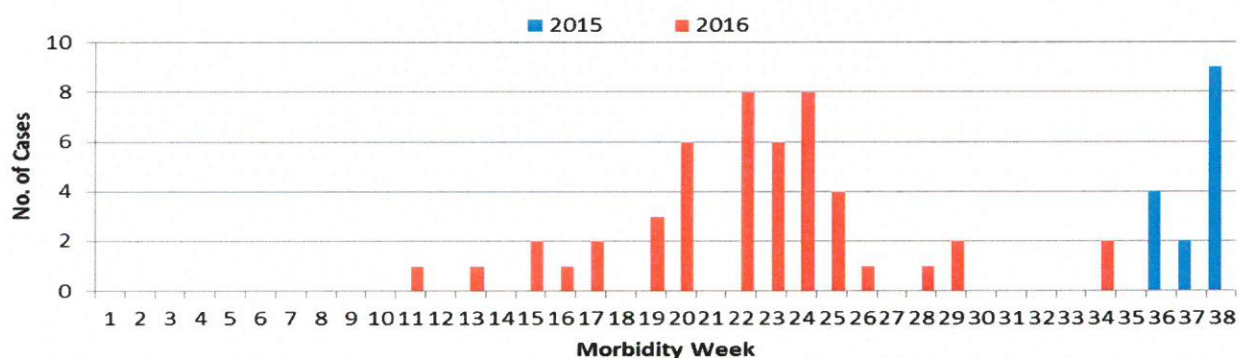




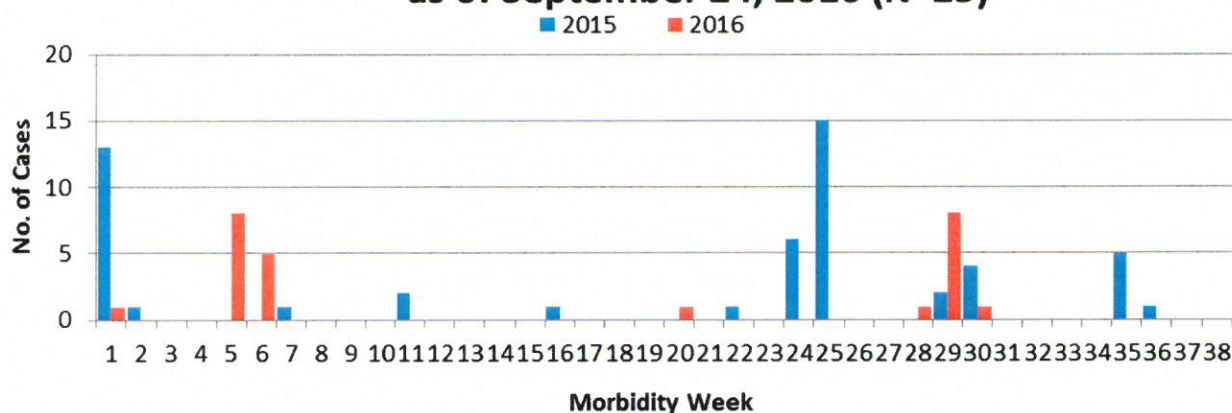

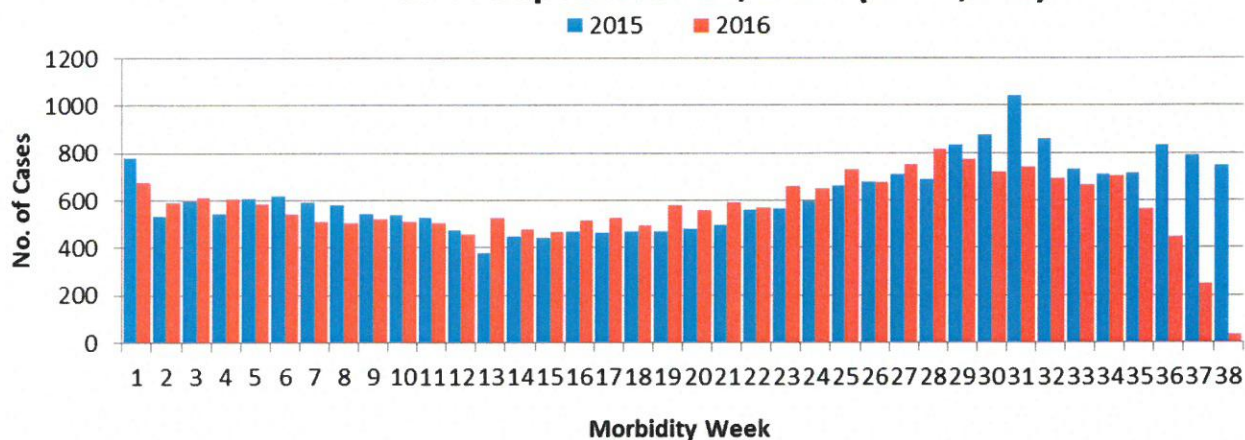
**Fig.13 Confirmed Cholera Cases

as of September 24, 2016 (N=21,881)**

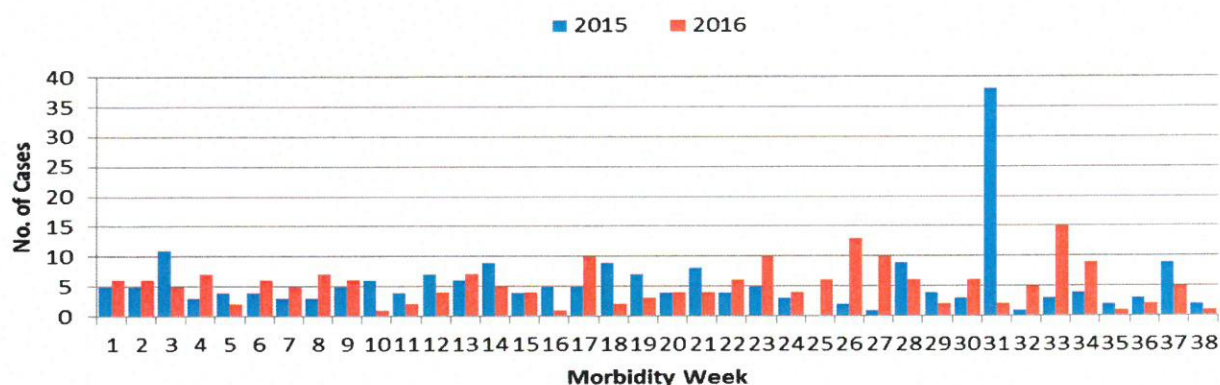




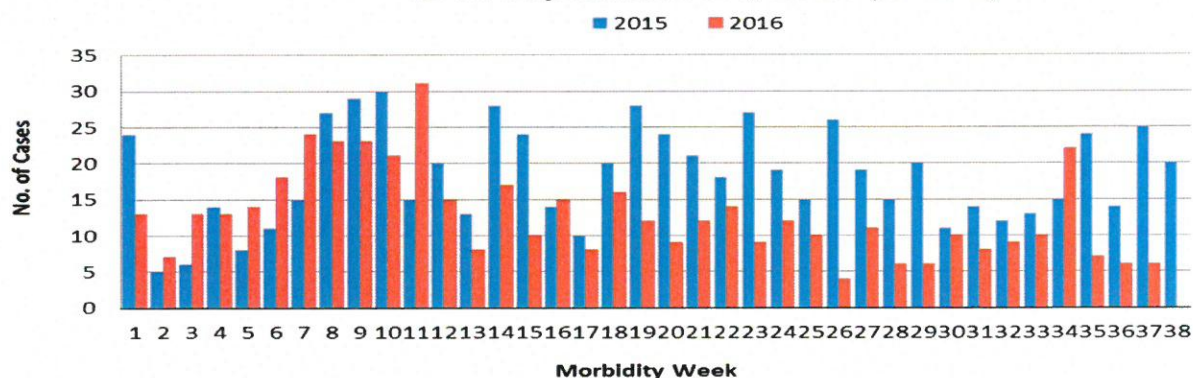

as of September 24, 2016 (n=200)**

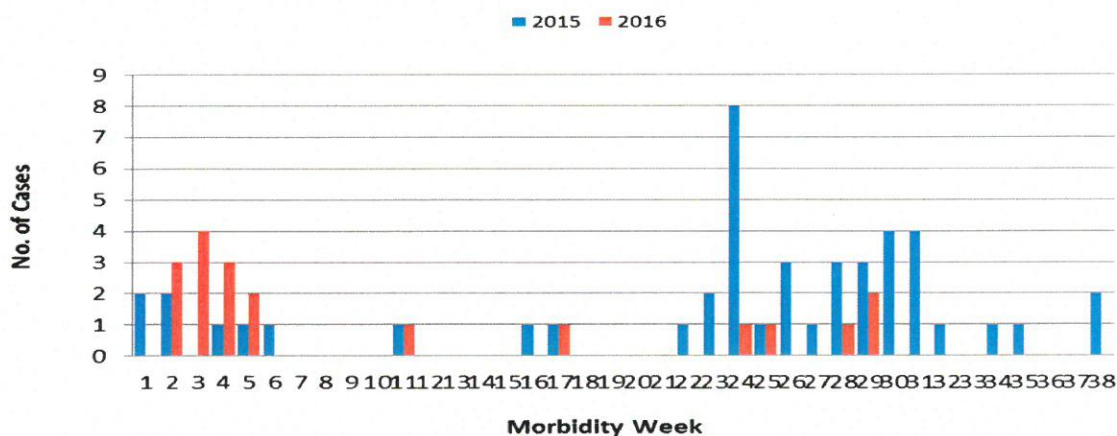


**Fig. 17 Confirmed Hepatitis A Cases

as of September 24, 2016 (N=19)**

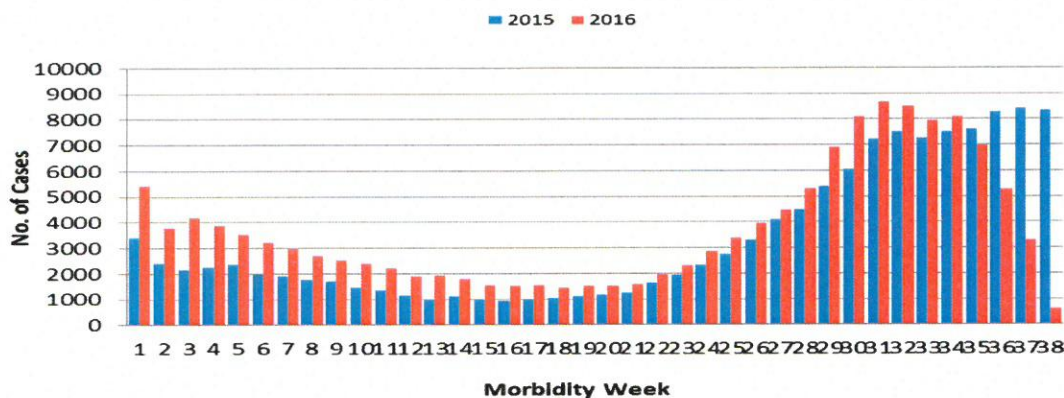




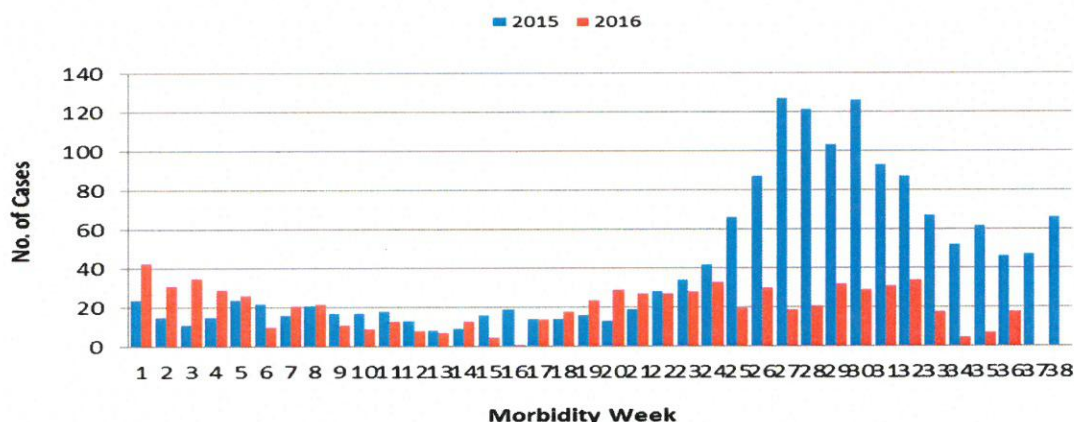

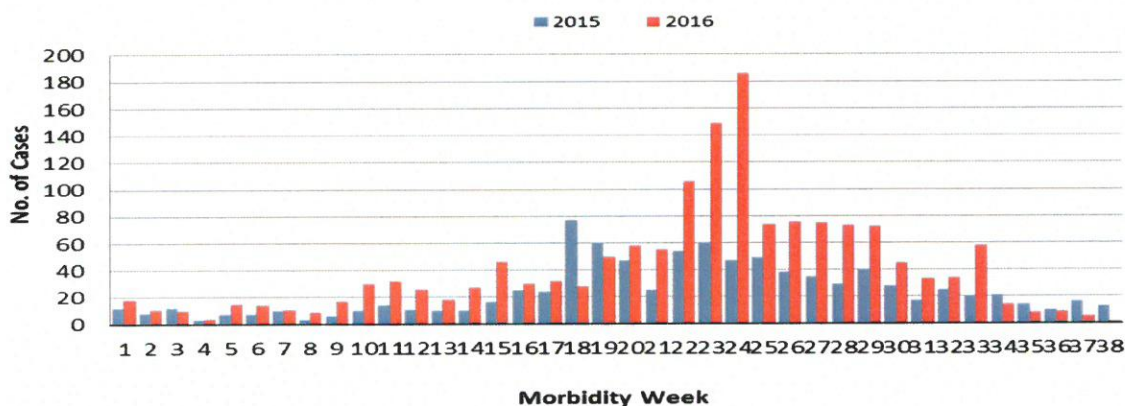
**Fig. 19 Suspect Dengue Cases

as of September 24, 2016 (N=1,559)**



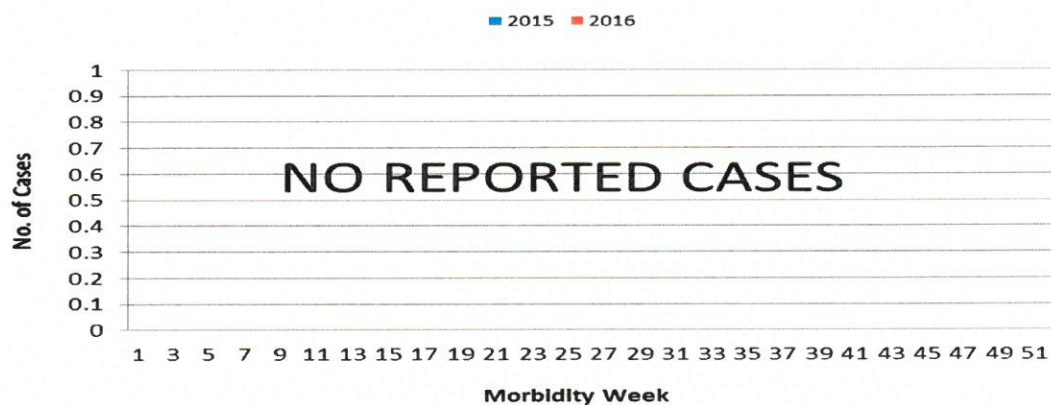

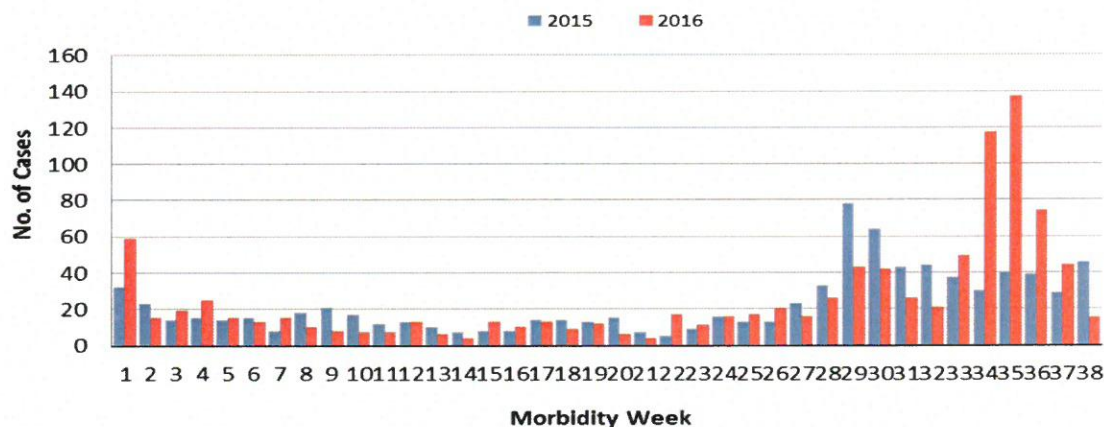

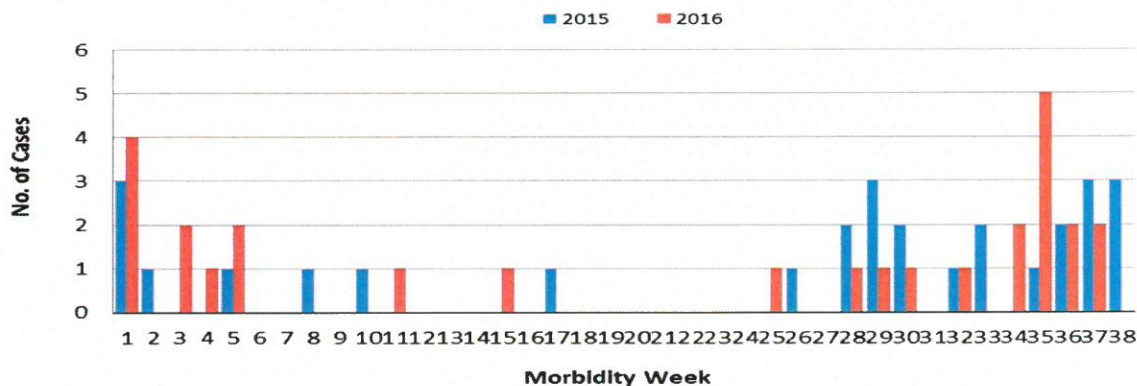
**Fig. 22 Suspect Anthrax Cases

as of September 24, 2016 (n=27)**

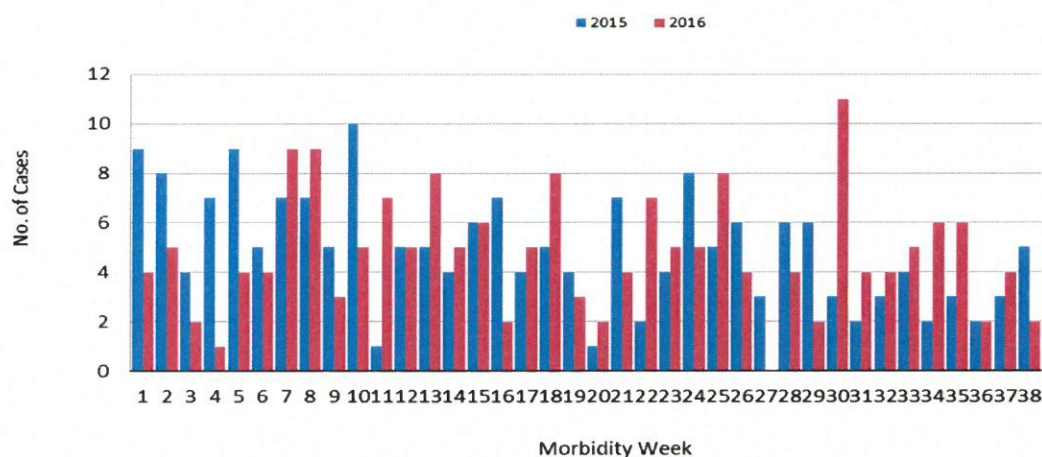

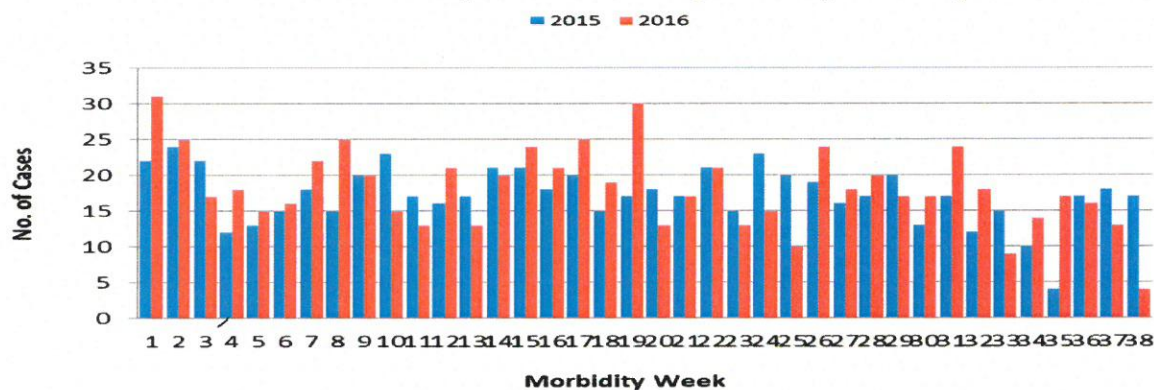

as of September 24, 2016 (N=180)**

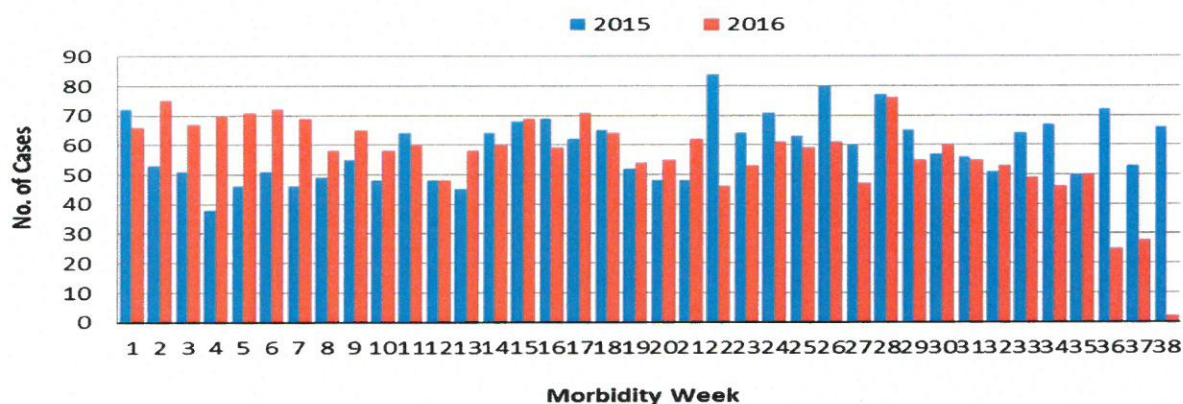

as of September 24, 2016 (n=2157)**

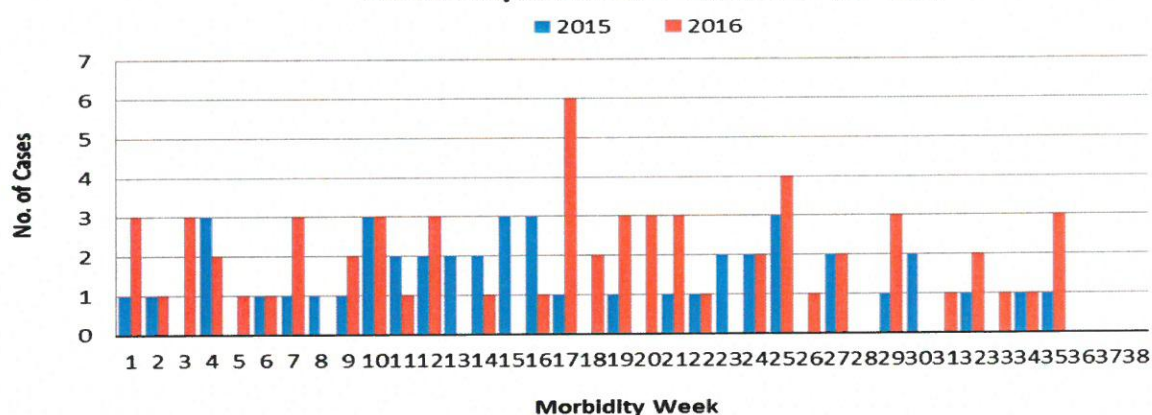







