Fig. 1 Suspect Acute Encephalitis Syndrome Cases as of October 1, 2016 (N=312)

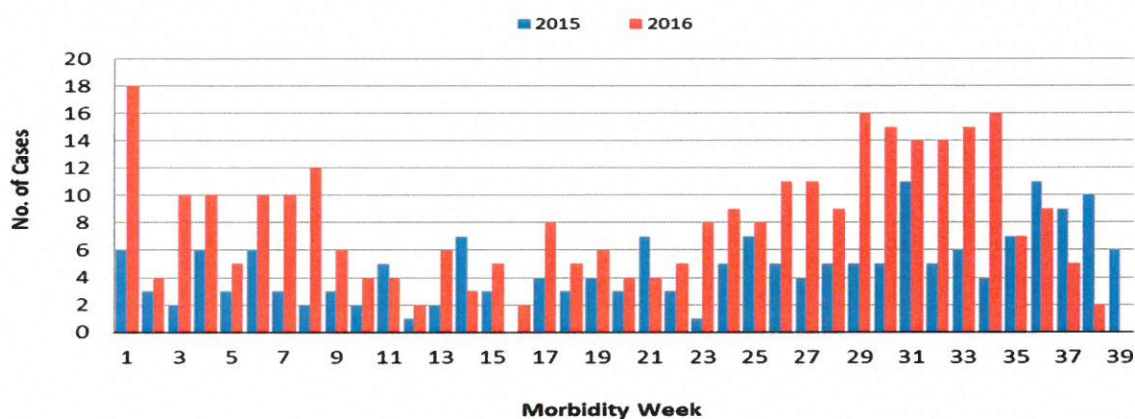


Fig. 2 Confirmed Acute Encephalitis Syndrome Cases as of October 1, 2016 (n=23)

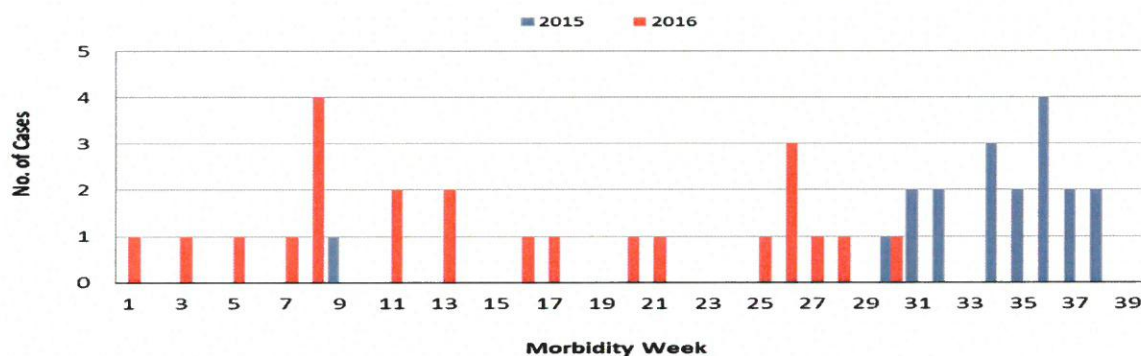
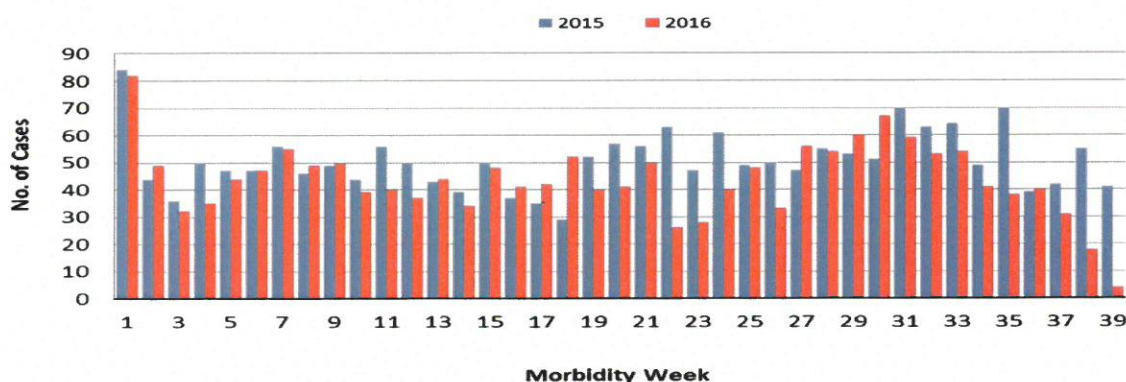


Fig. 3 Suspect Bacterial Meningitis Cases as of October 1, 2016 (N=1,701)

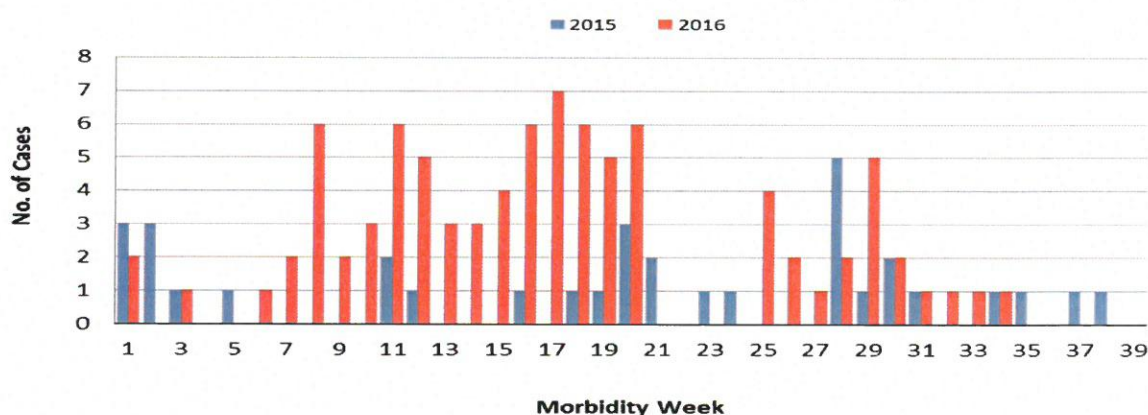




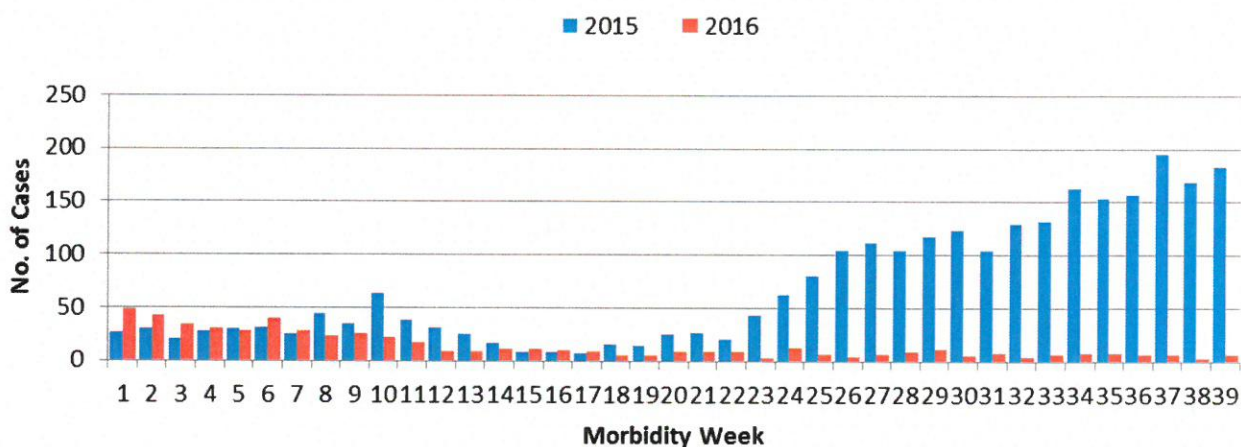

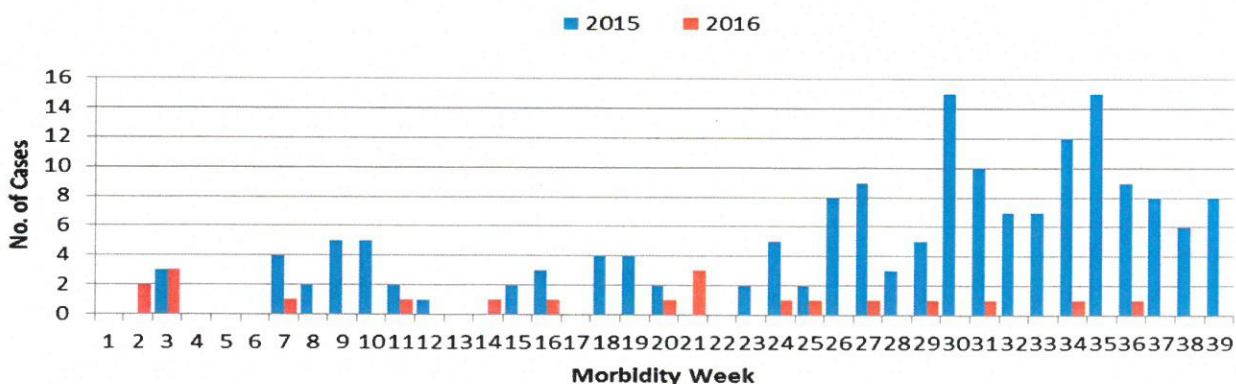
**Fig. 4 Confirmed Bacterial Meningitis Cases

as of October 1, 2016 (n=20)**

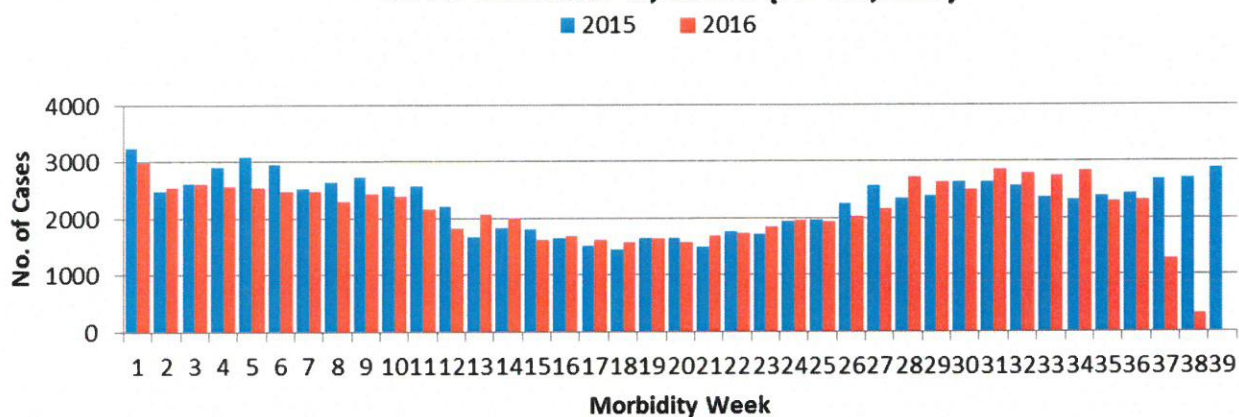




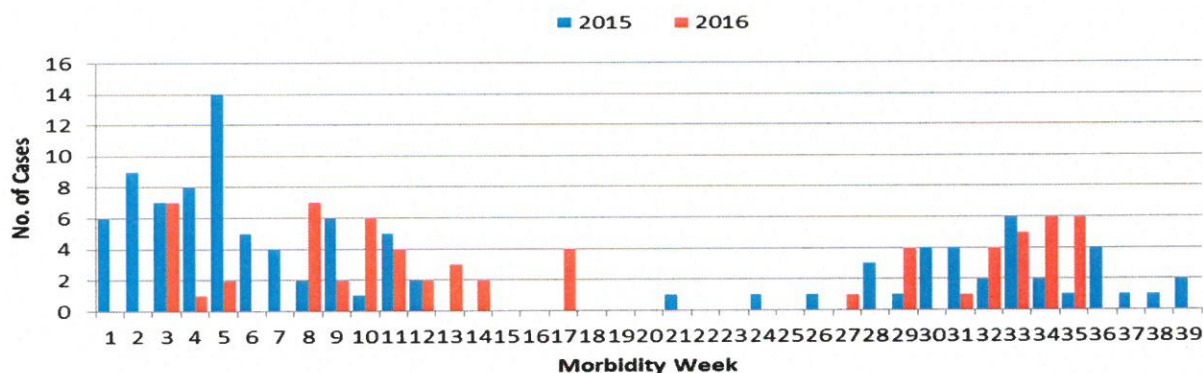

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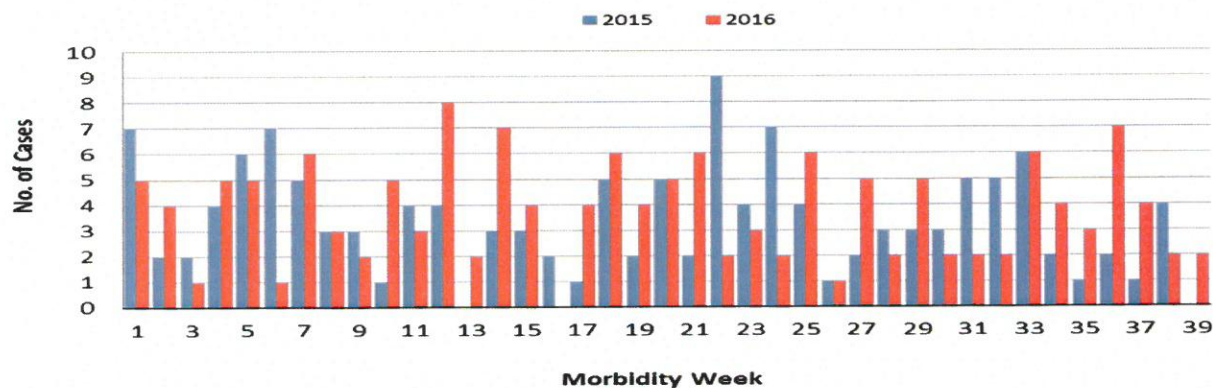
**Fig.7 Influenza-like Illness Cases

as of October 1, 2016 (N=146)**

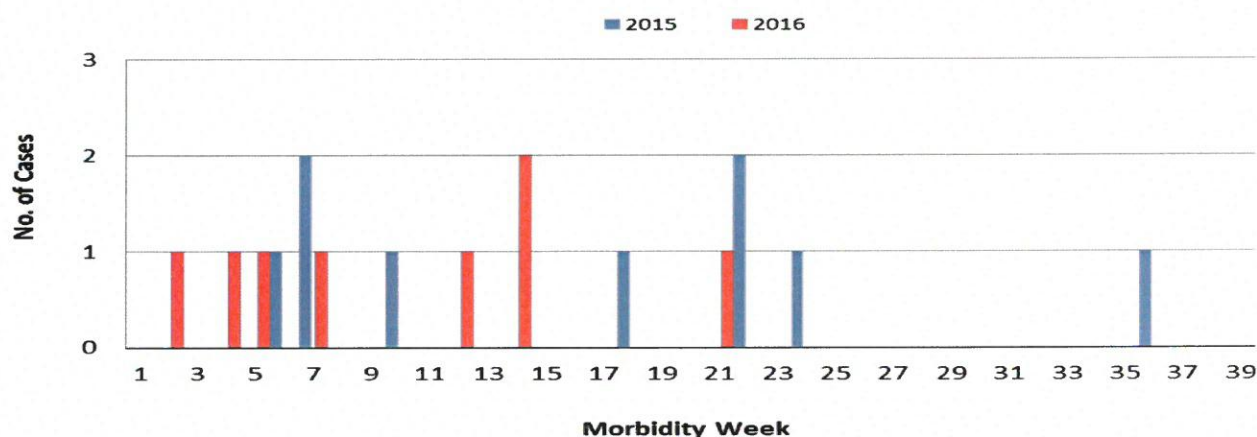

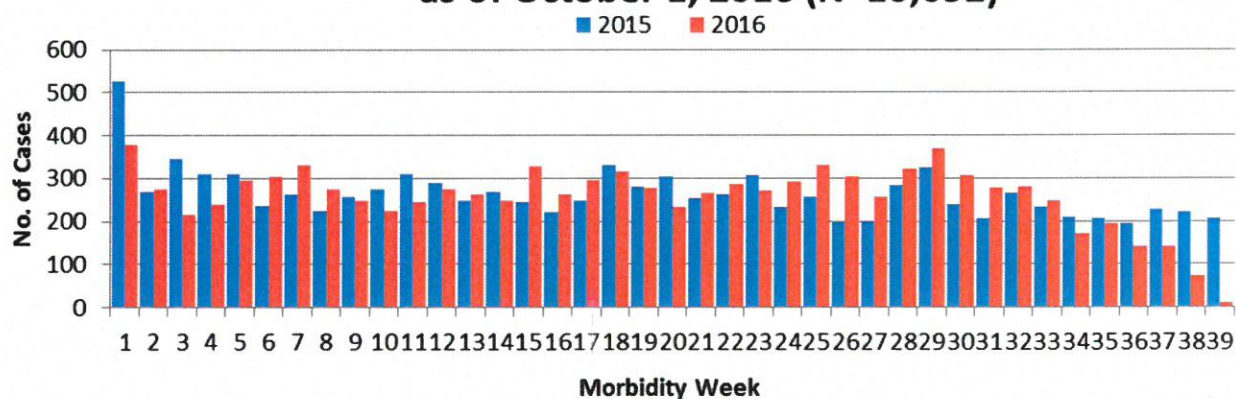
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**Fig. 10 Confirmed Meningococcal Disease Cases
as of October 1, 2016 (n=10)**

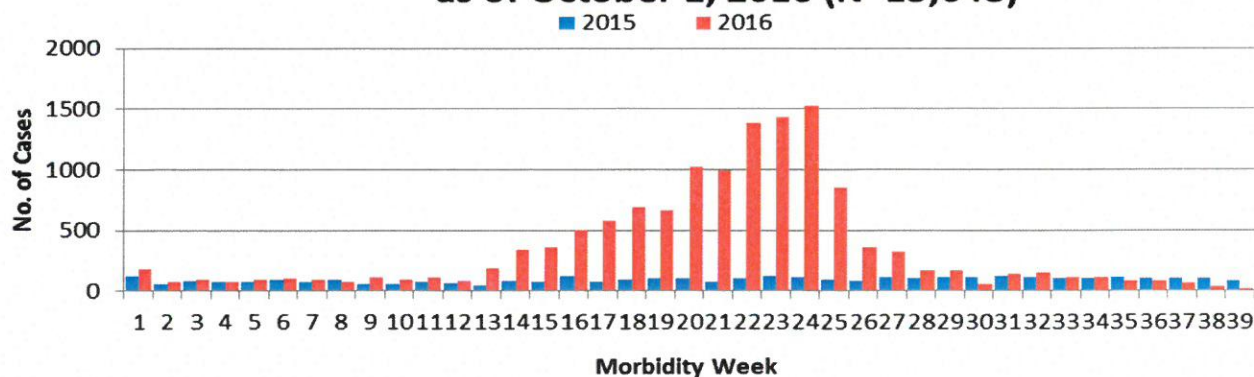

as of October 1, 2016 (N=13,648)**

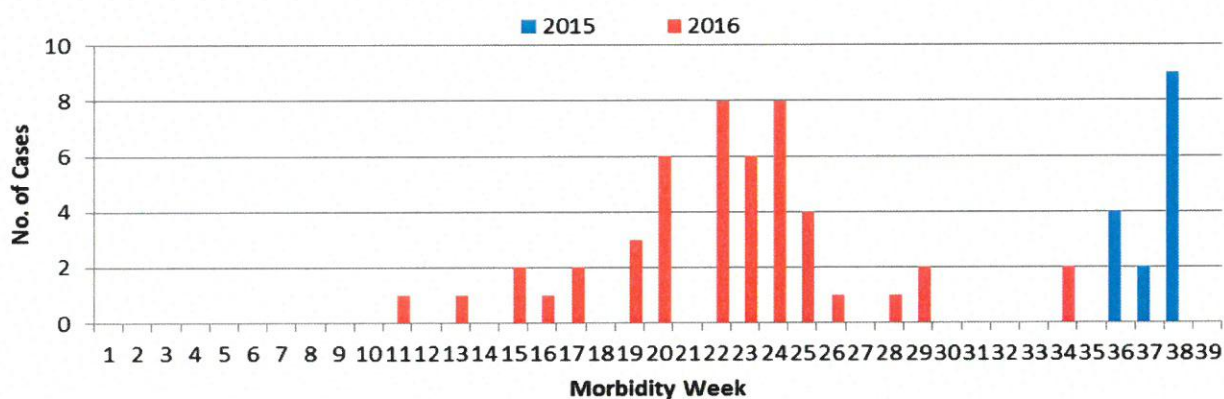




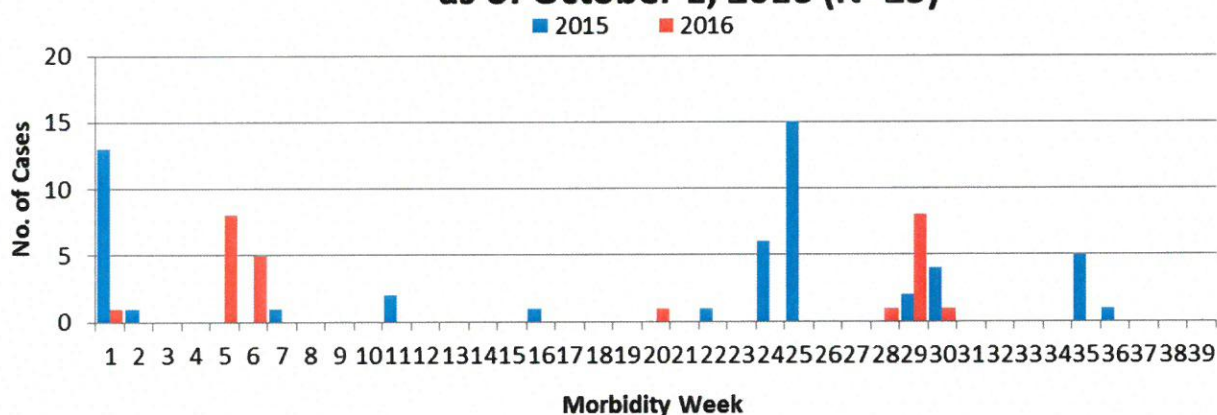

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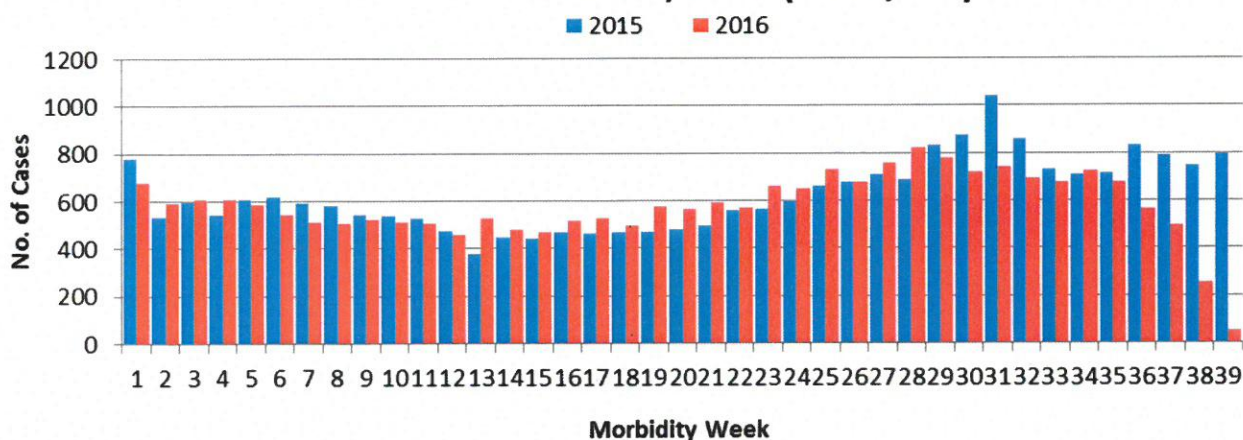
**Fig.13 Confirmed Cholera Cases

as of October 1, 2016 (N=22,667)**

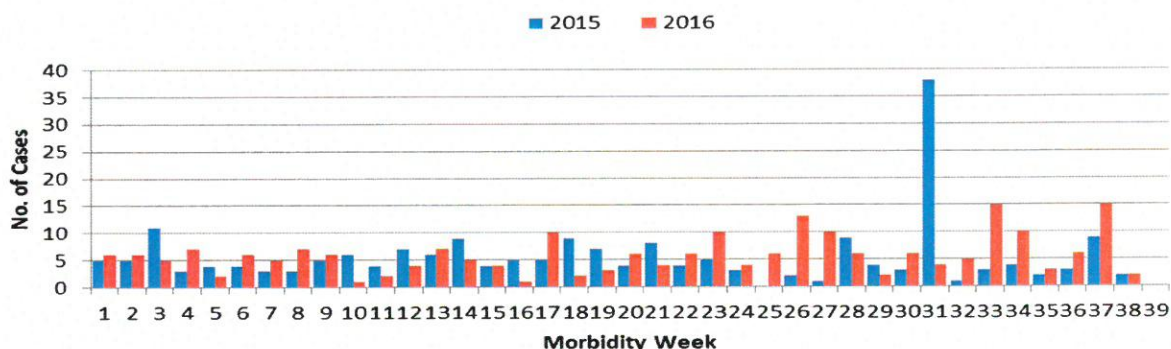




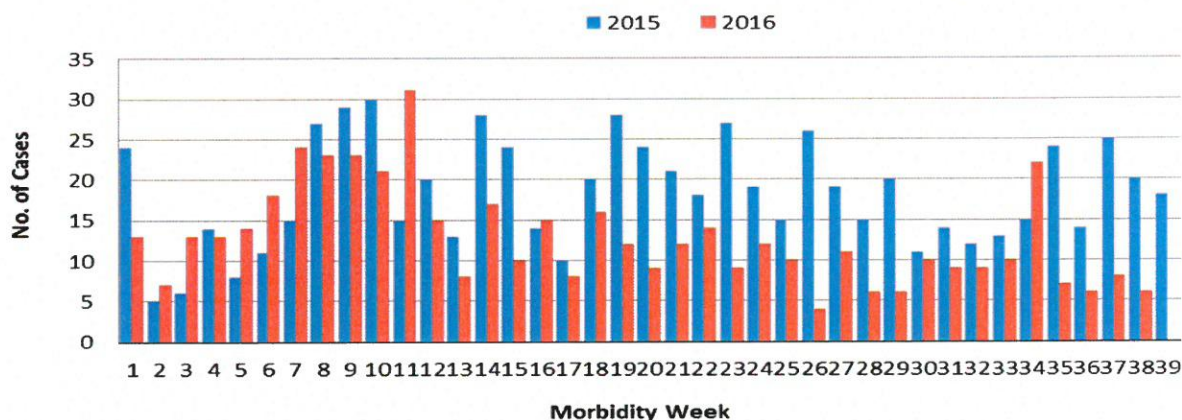

as of October 1, 2016 (n=222)**

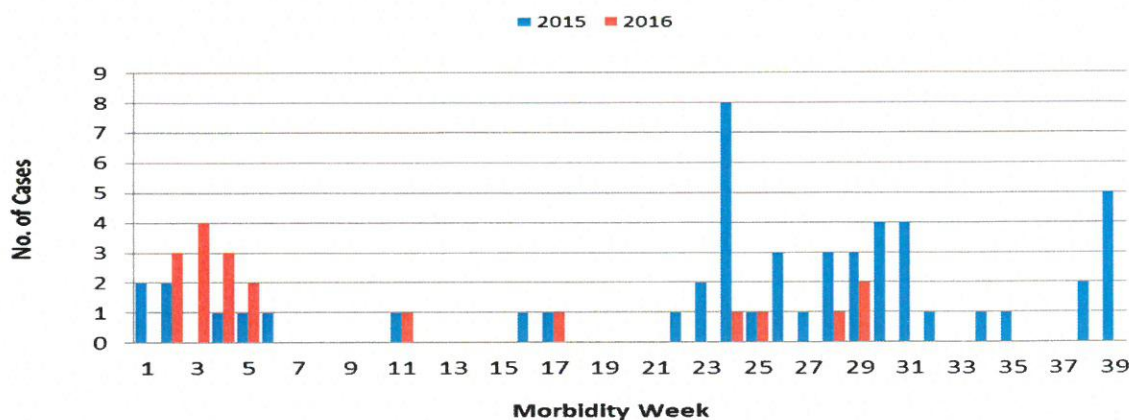


**Fig. 17 Confirmed Hepatitis A Cases

as of October 1, 2016 (N=19)**

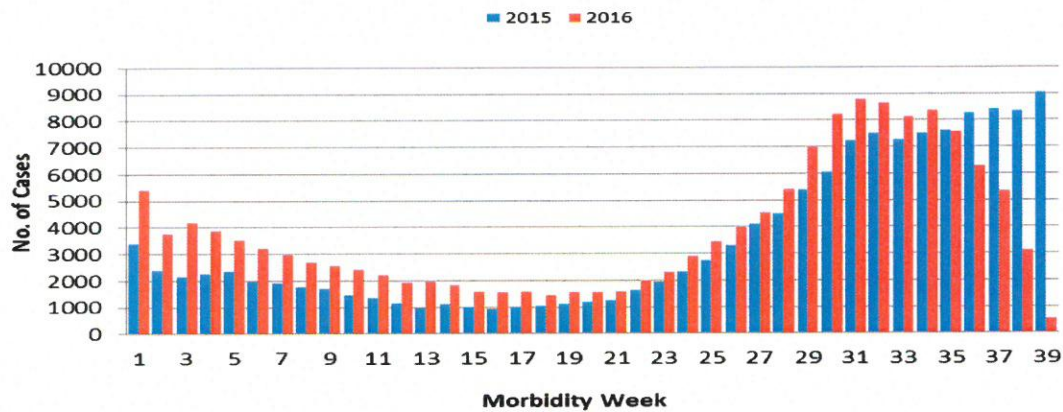




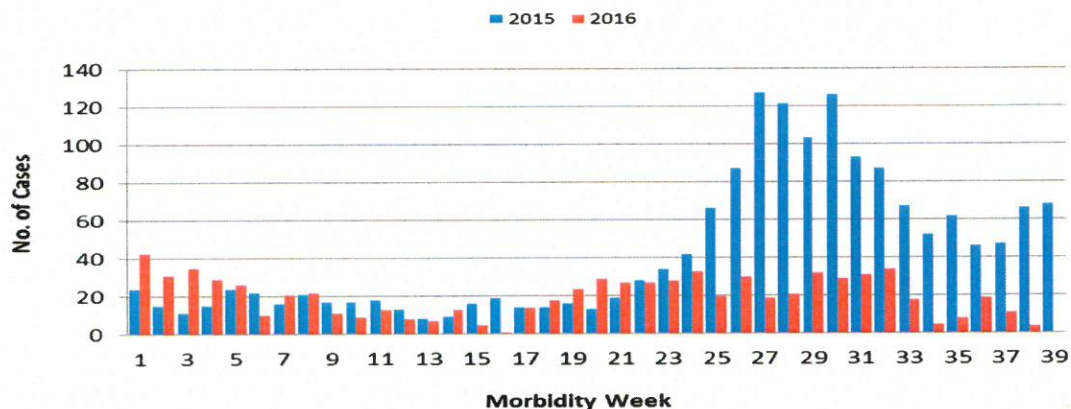

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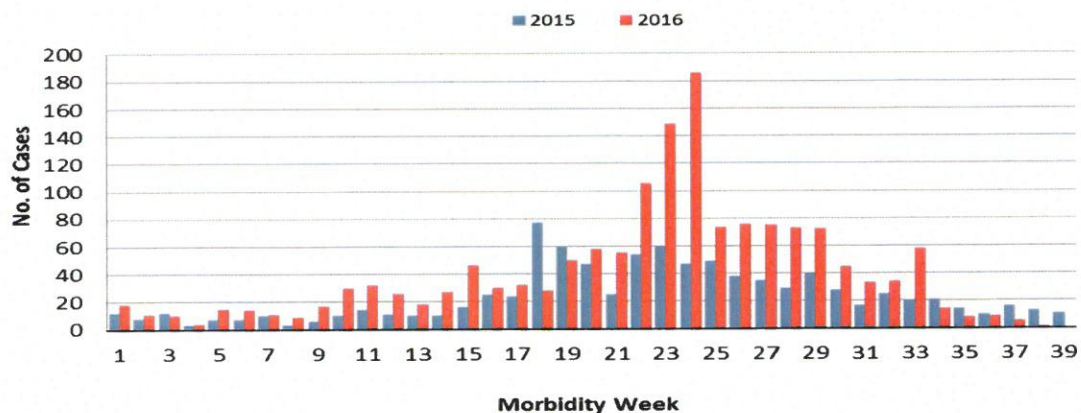
**Fig. 19 Suspect Dengue Cases

as of October 1, 2016 (N=1,559)**



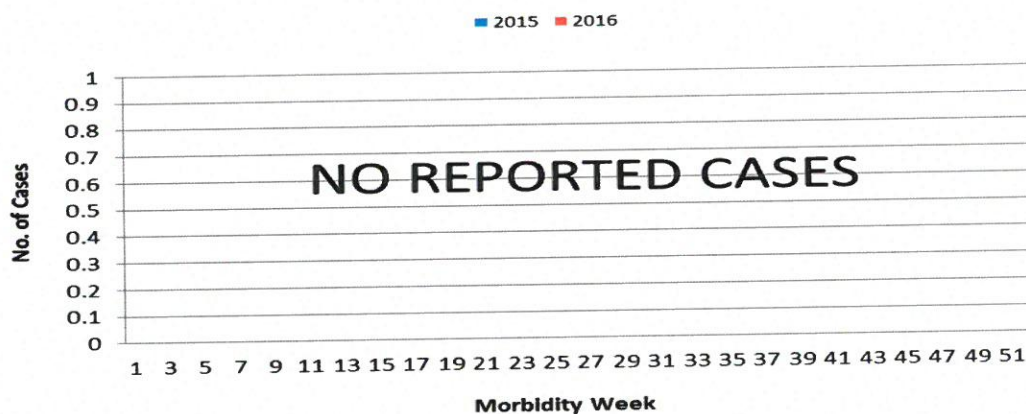

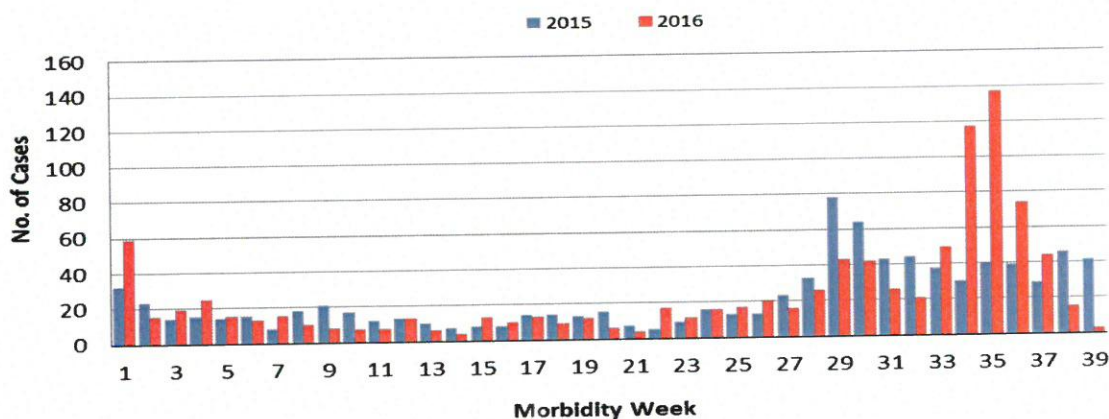

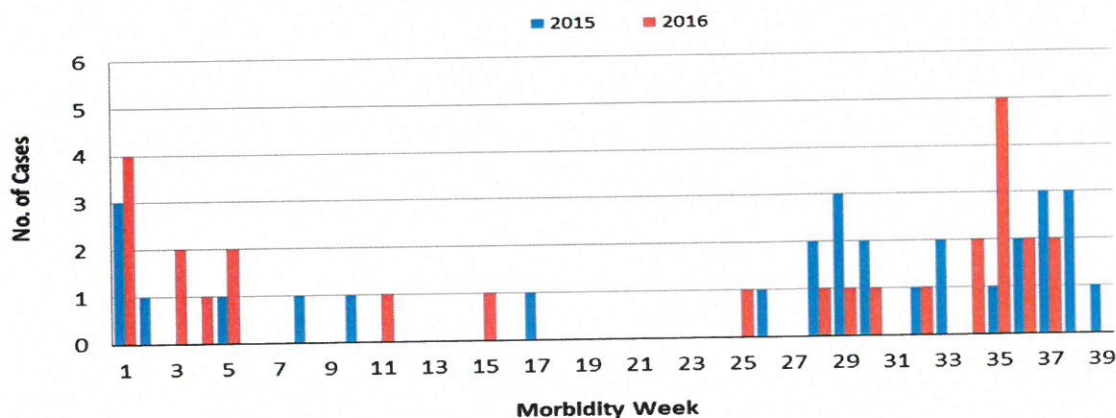
**Fig. 22 Suspect Anthrax Cases

as of October 1, 2016 (n=27)**

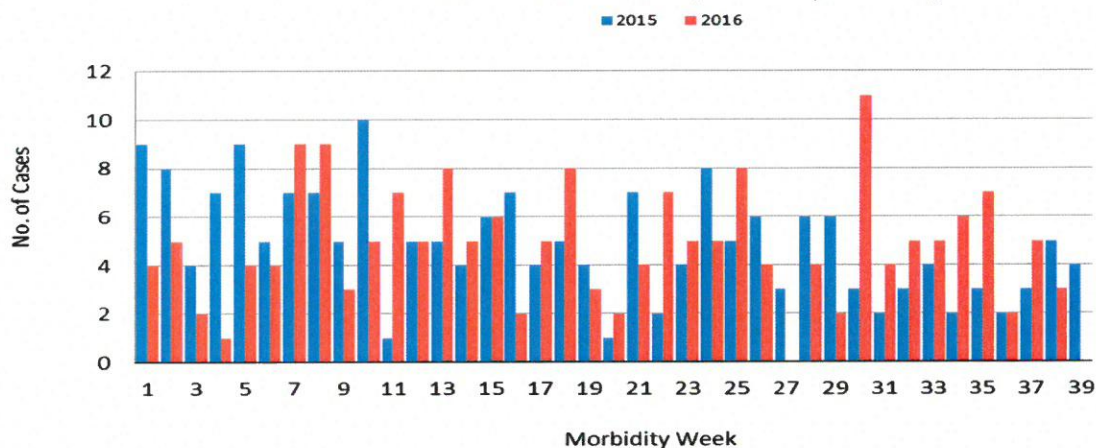




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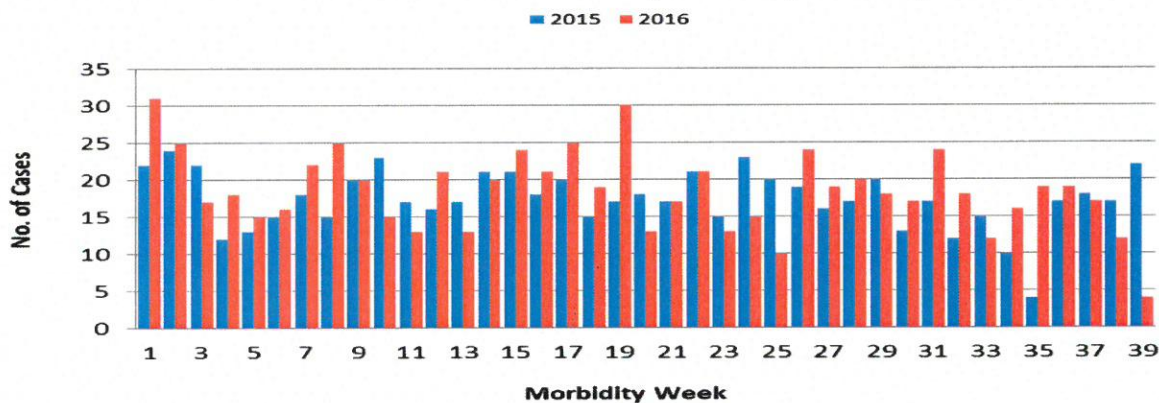
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**Fig. 25 Probable Rabies Cases
as of October 1, 2016 (N=184)**

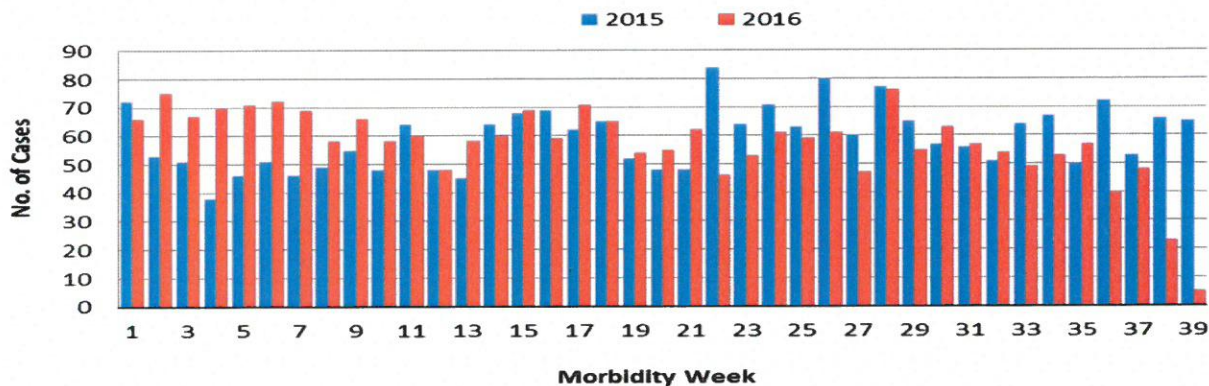

as of October 1, 2016 (n=2,240)**

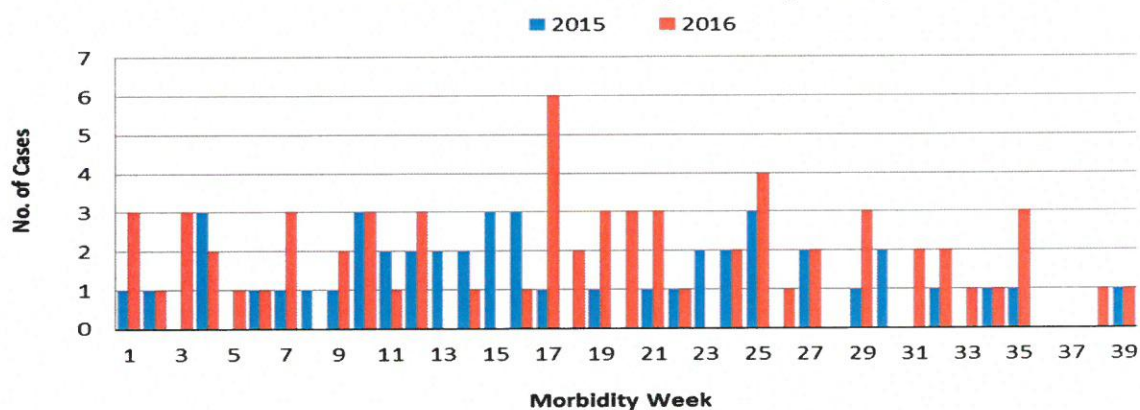


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**Fig. 28 Confirmed Hepatitis C Cases
as of October 1, 2016 (n=66)**





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
