Fig. 1 Suspect Acute Encephalitis Syndrome Cases as of February 13, 2016, (N=35)

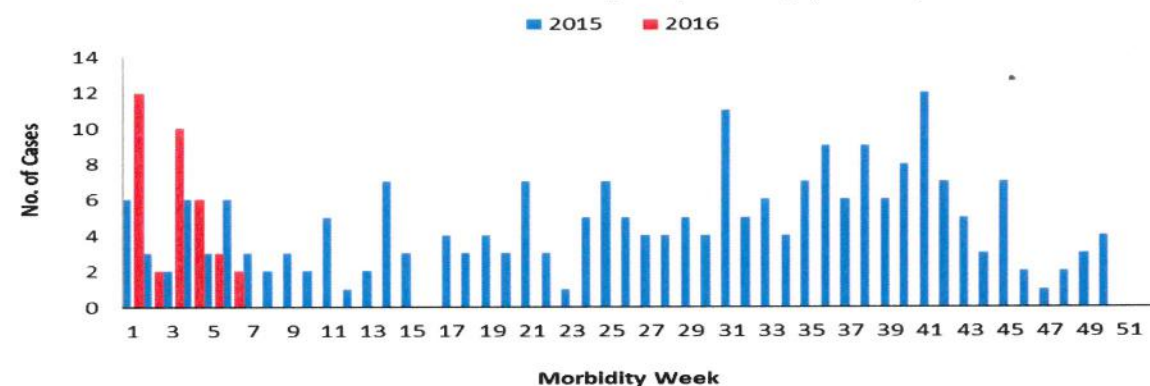


Fig. 2 Suspect Bacterial Meningitis Cases as of February 13, 2016 (N=113)

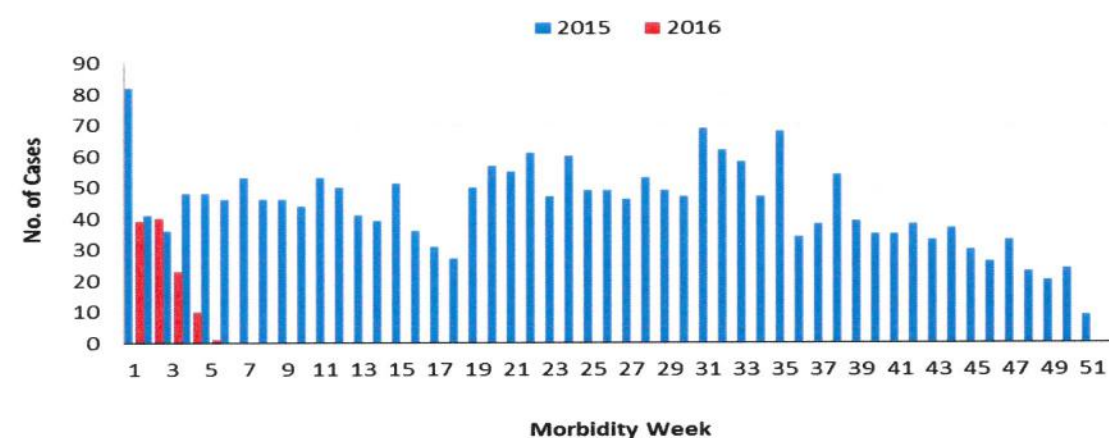
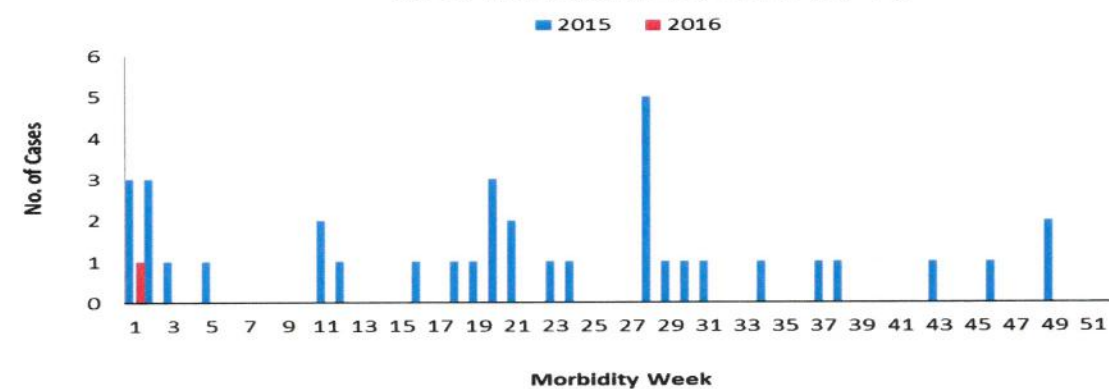


Fig. 3 Confirmed Bacterial Meningitis Cases as of February 13, 2016 (N=1)



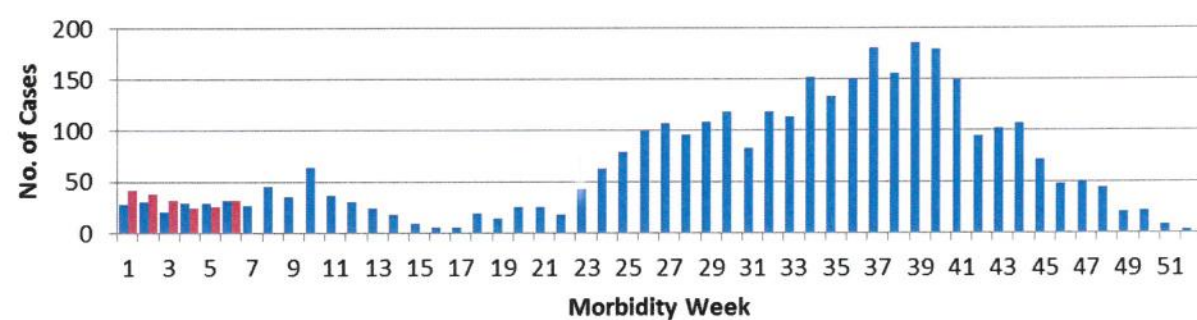

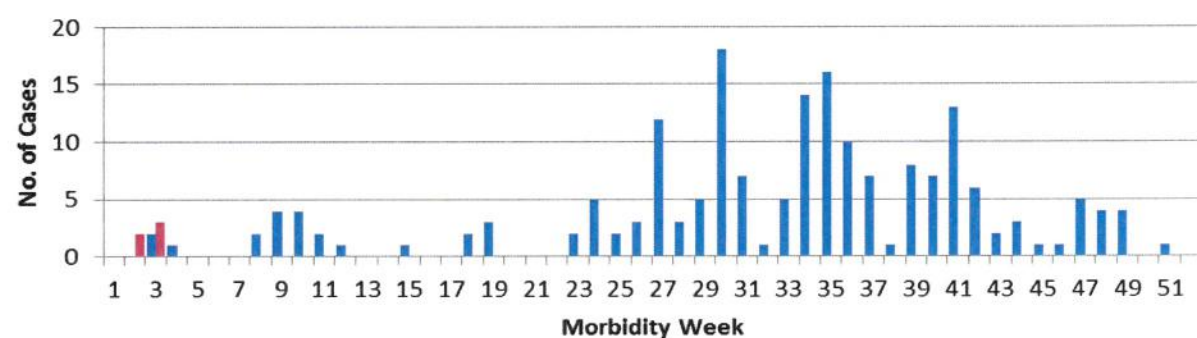
**Fig.4 Suspect Hand, Foot and Mouth Disease Cases

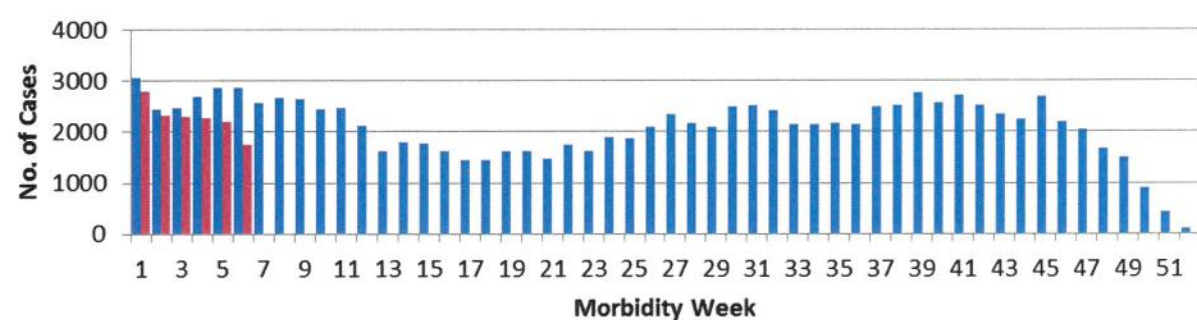
**Fig.5 Confirmed Hand, Foot and Mouth Disease Cases

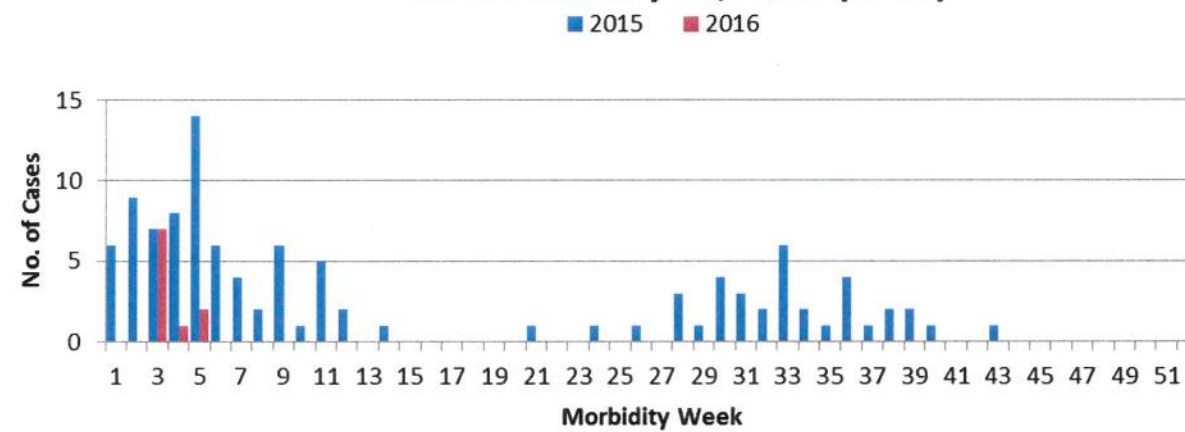




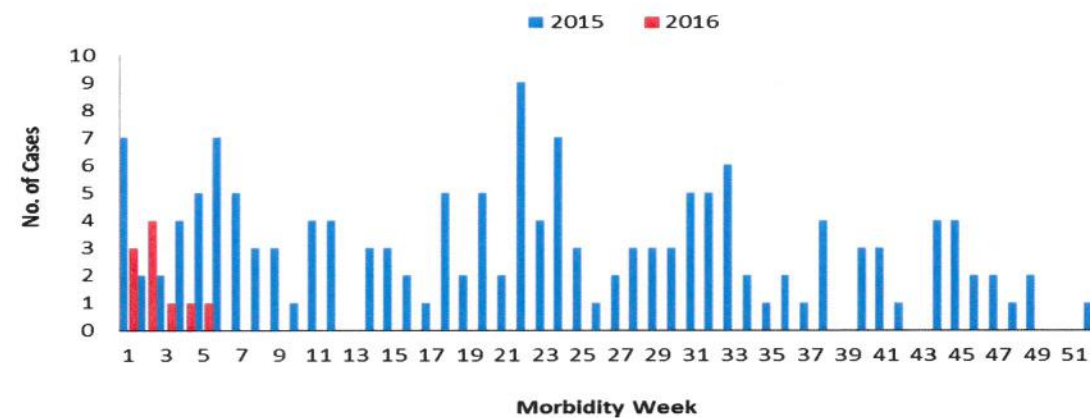

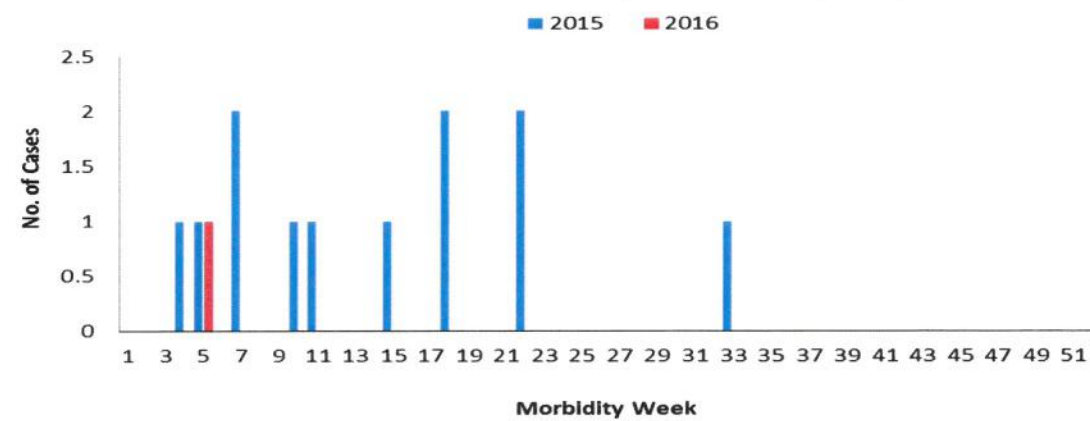
**Fig.7 Confirmed Influenza Cases

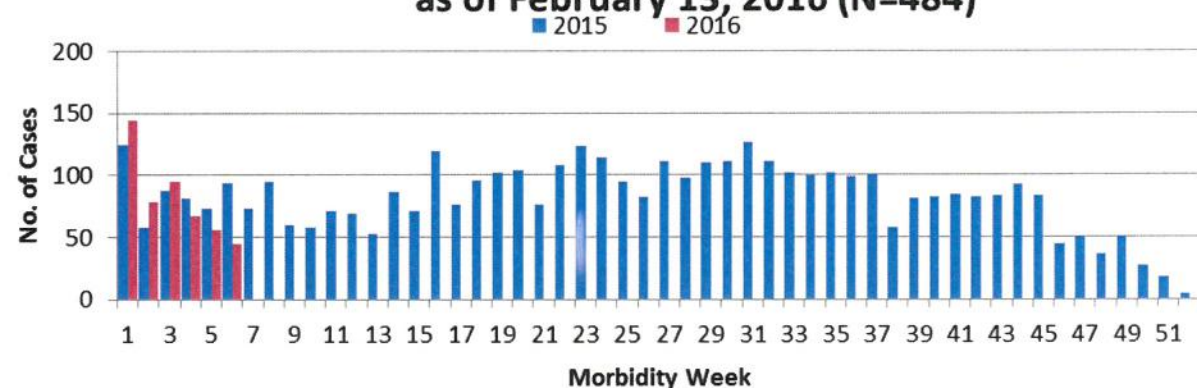

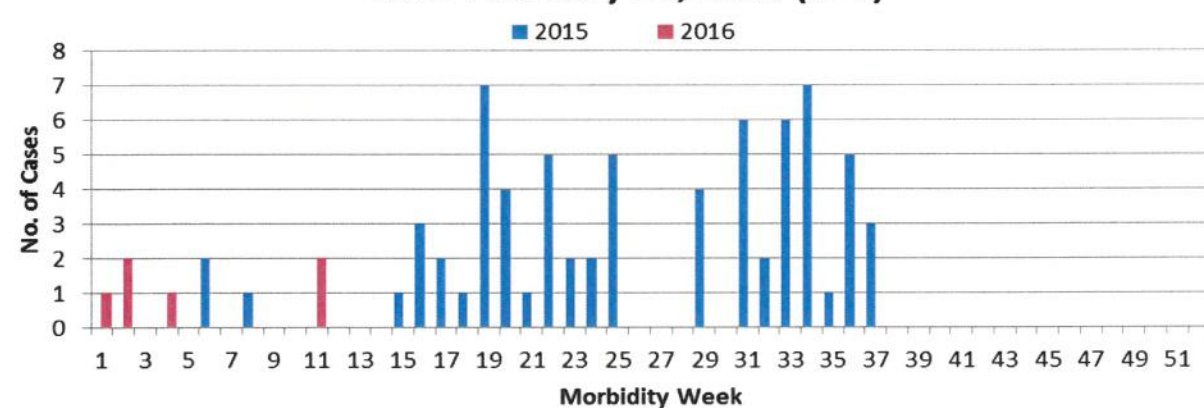
**Fig.10 Suspect Acute Bloody Diarrhea Cases

as of February 13, 2016 (n=4)**

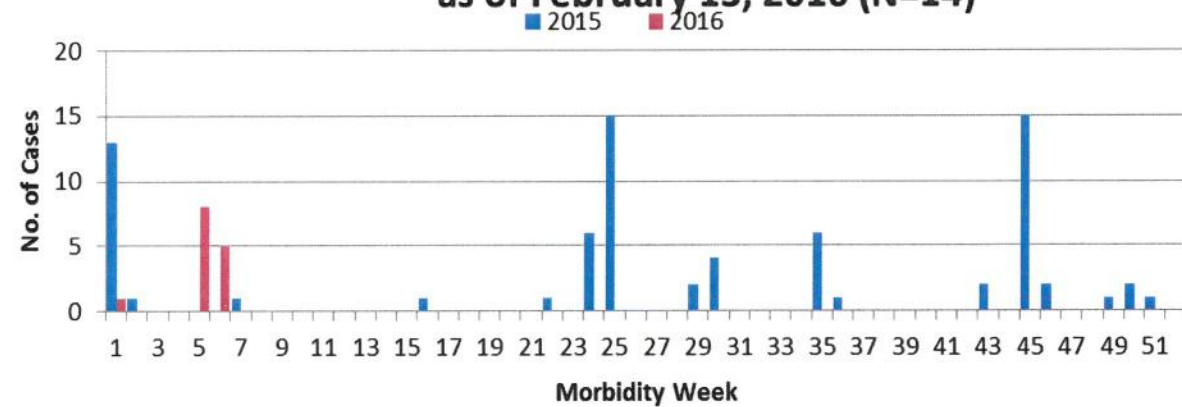




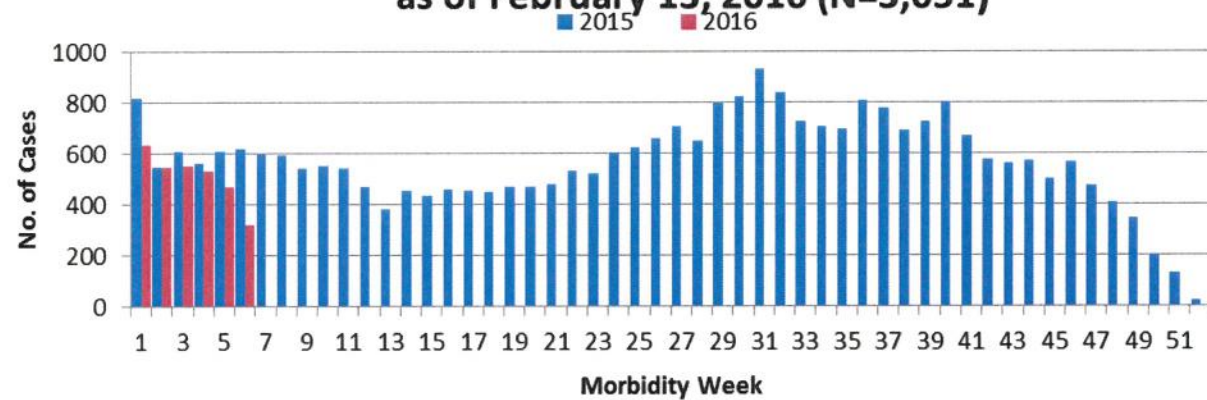

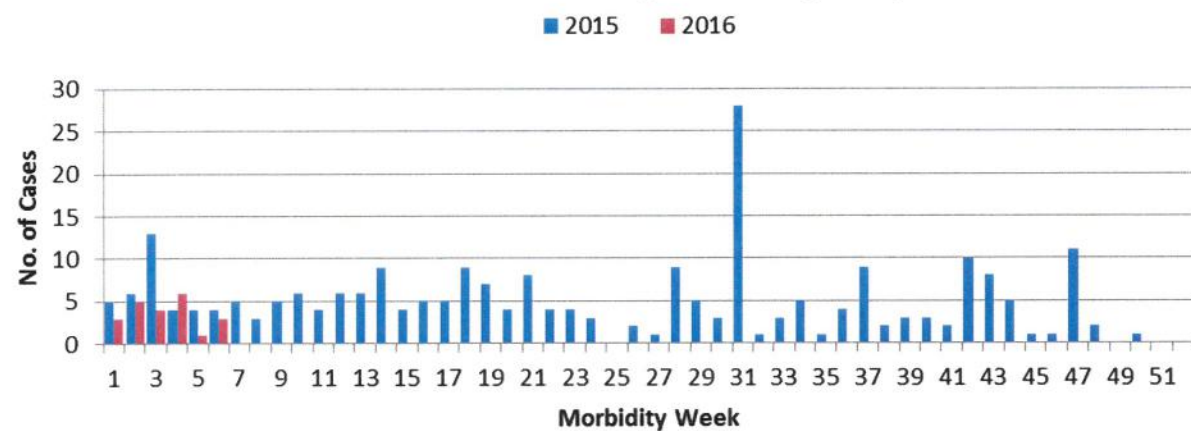
**Fig.13 Suspect Paralytic Shellfish Poisoning Cases

as of February 13, 2016 (n=22)**

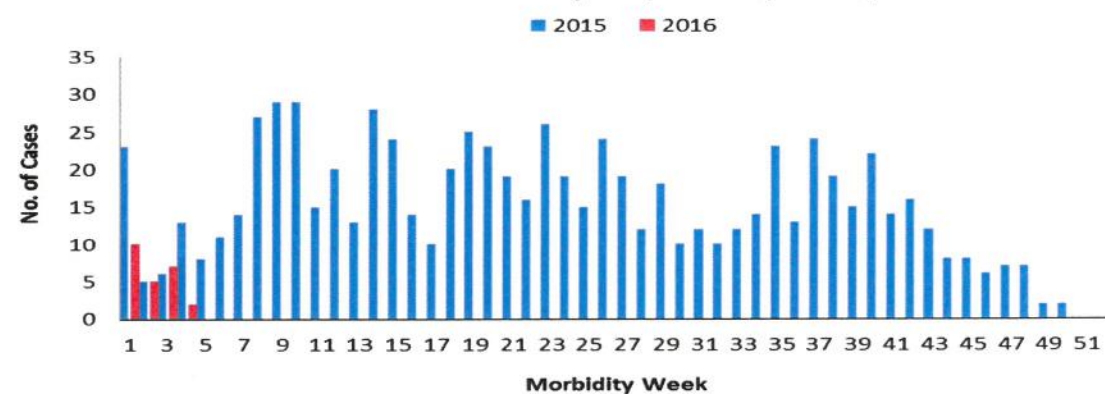

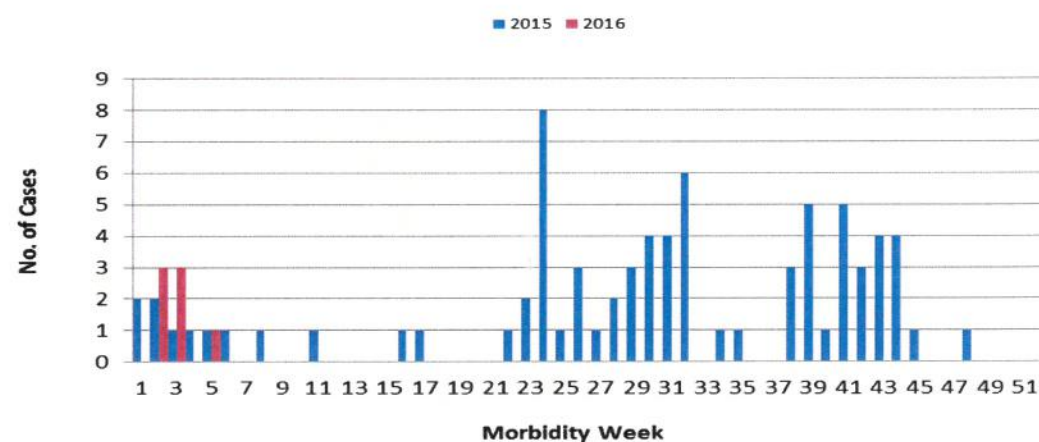

as of February 13, 2016 (N=24)**

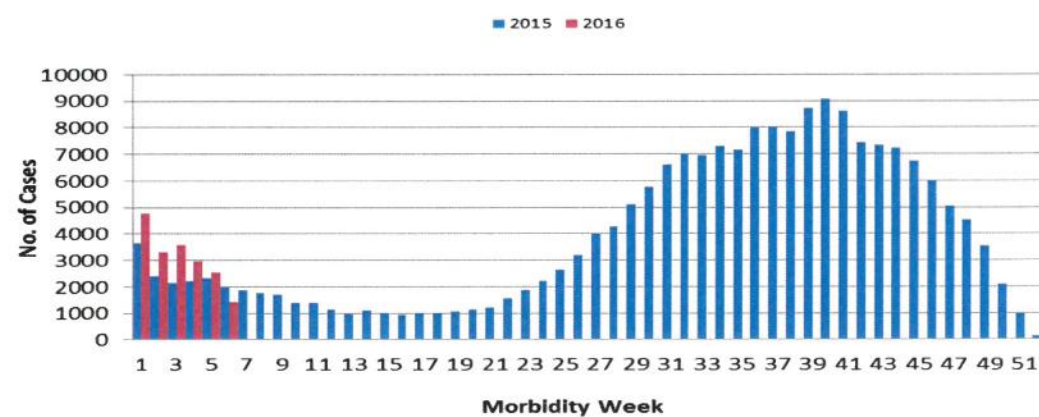

as of February 13, 2016 (N=18,536)**

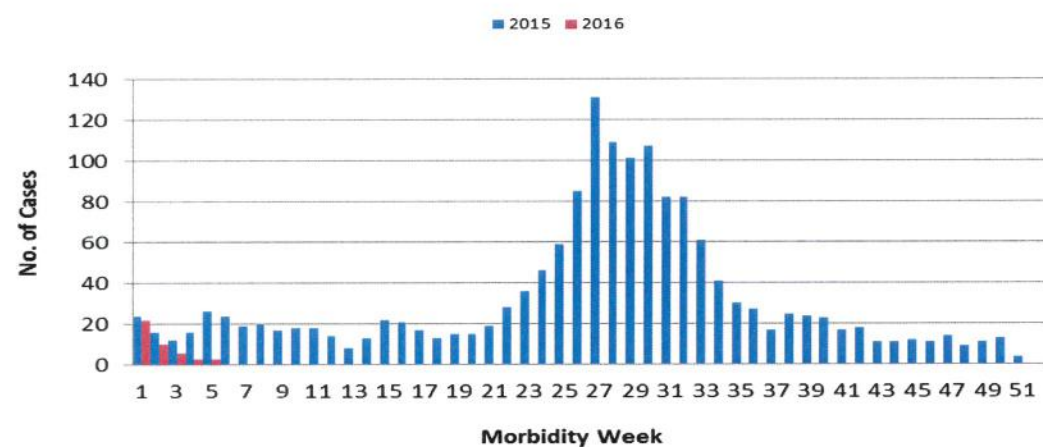




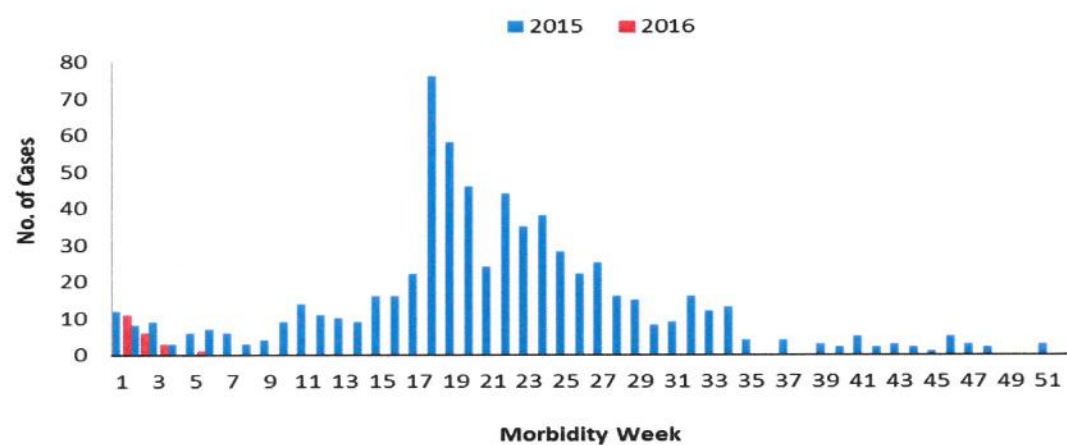

as of February 13, 2016 (n=44)**

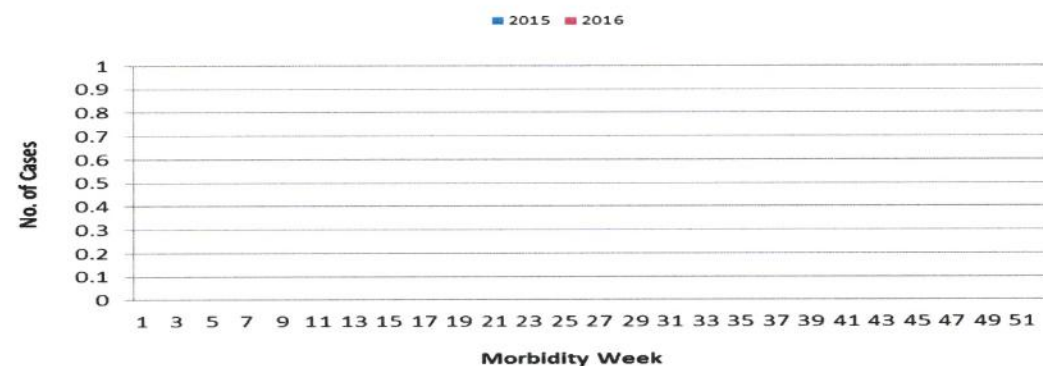


**Fig. 20 Suspect Malaria Cases

as of February 13, 2016 (N=0)**

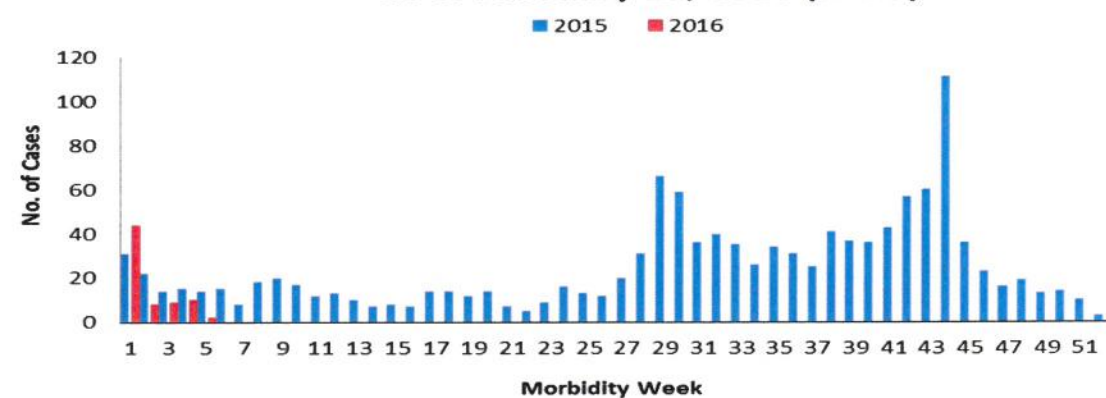




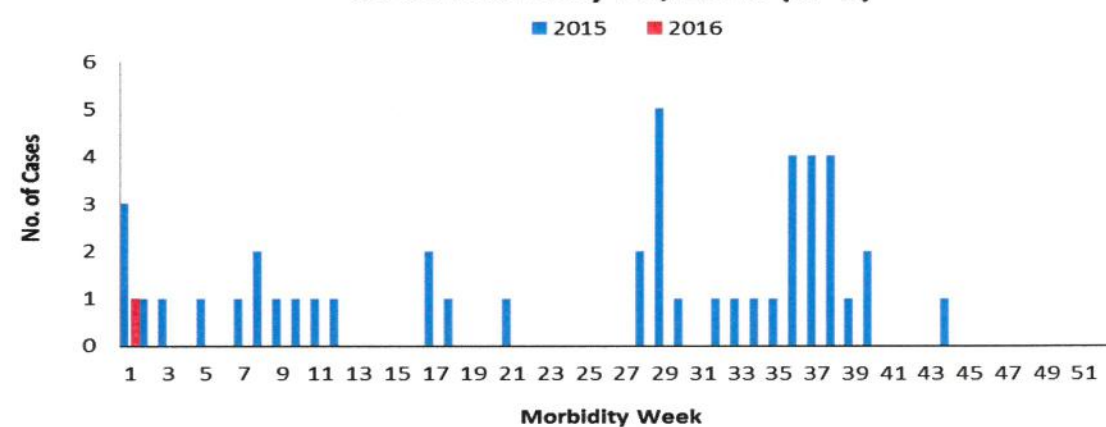

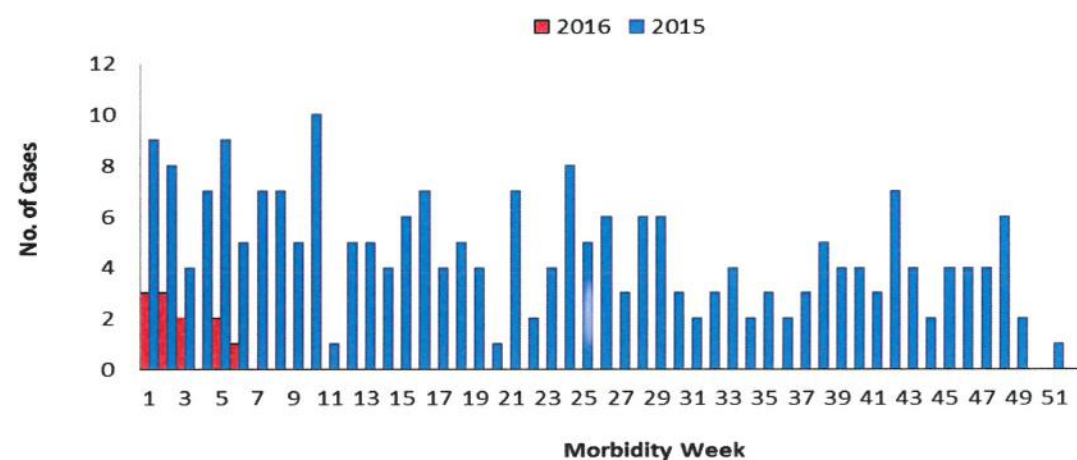
**Fig. 22 Suspect Leptospirosis Cases

as of February 13, 2016 (N=11)**



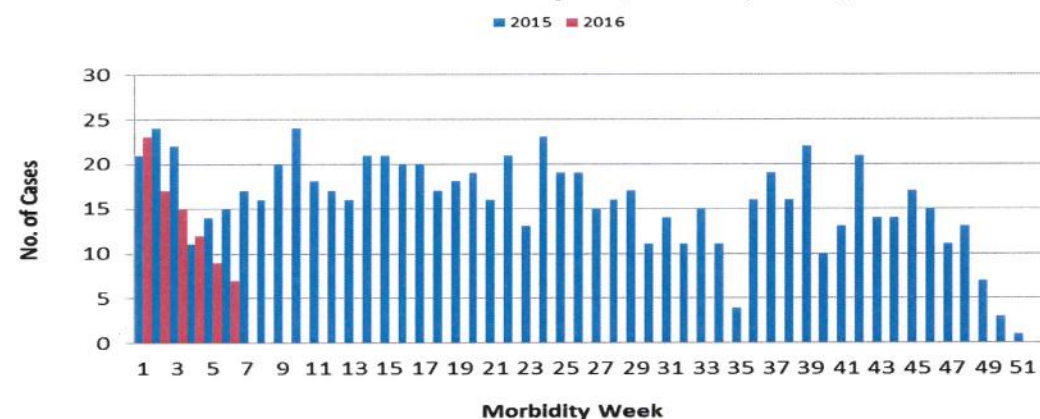

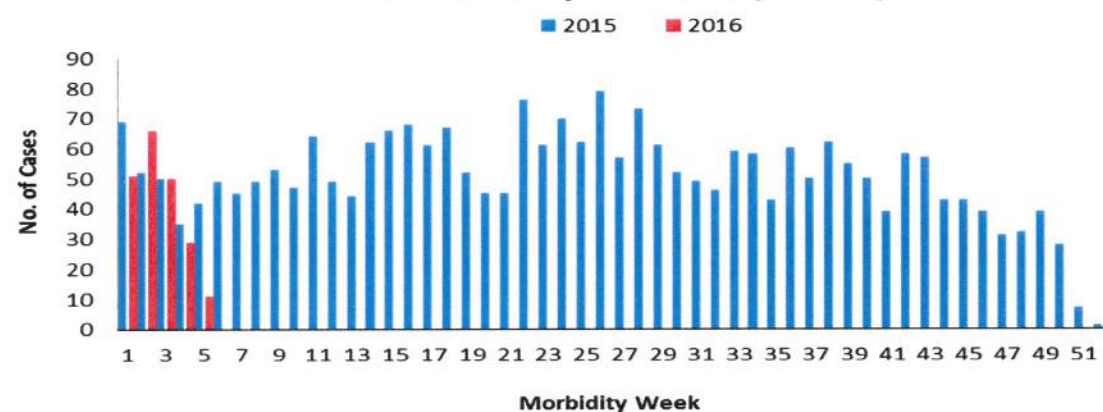

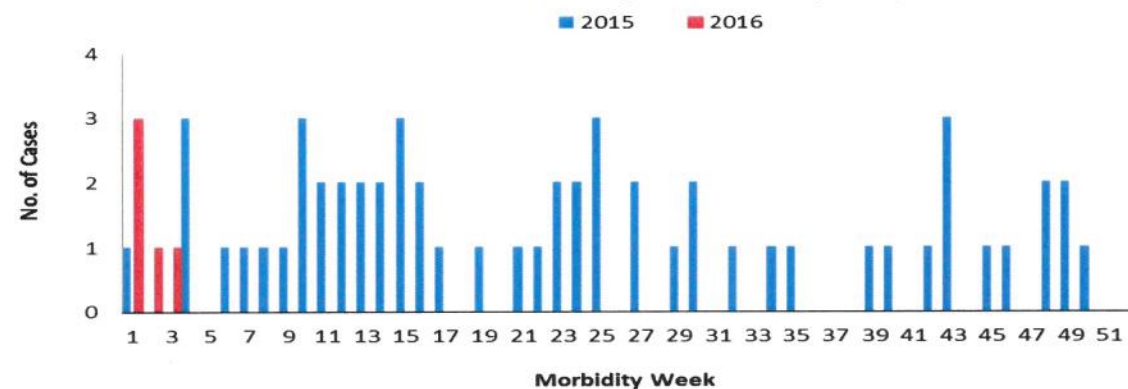
**Fig. 25 Confirmed Non-neonatal Tetanus Cases

as of February 13, 2016 (N=5)**







