Fig. 1 Suspect Acute Encephalitis Syndrome Cases as of October 8, 2016 (N=366)

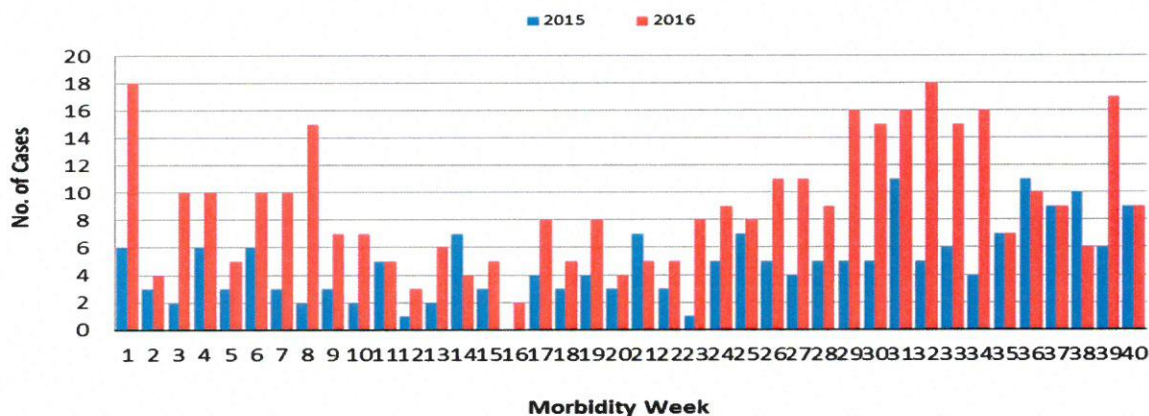


Fig. 2 Confirmed Acute Encephalitis Syndrome Cases as of October 8, 2016 (n=37)

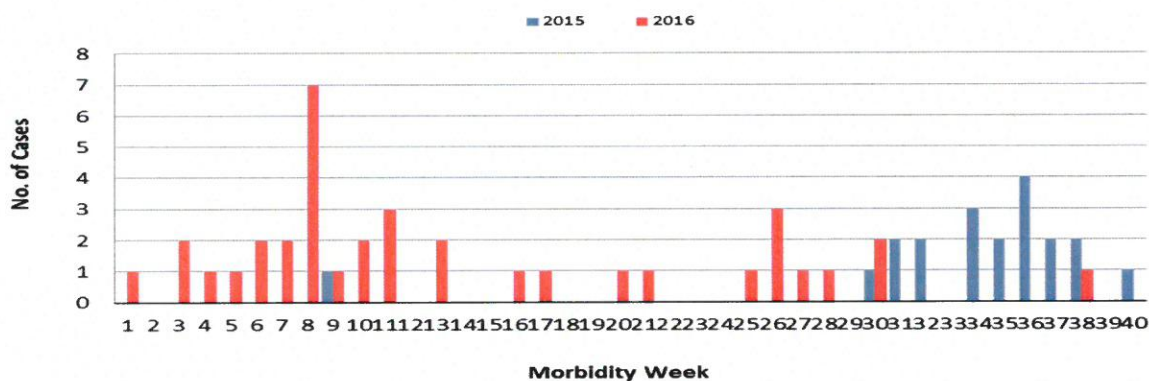
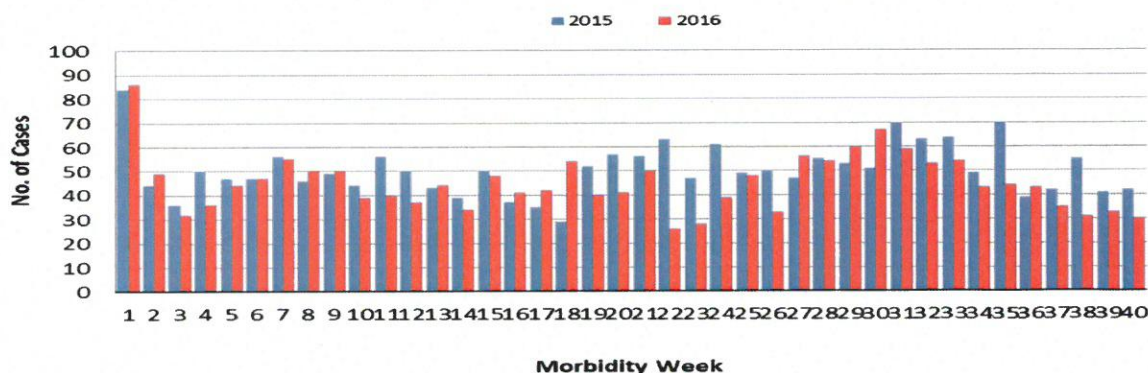


Fig. 3 Suspect Bacterial Meningitis Cases as of October 8, 2016 (N=1,795)

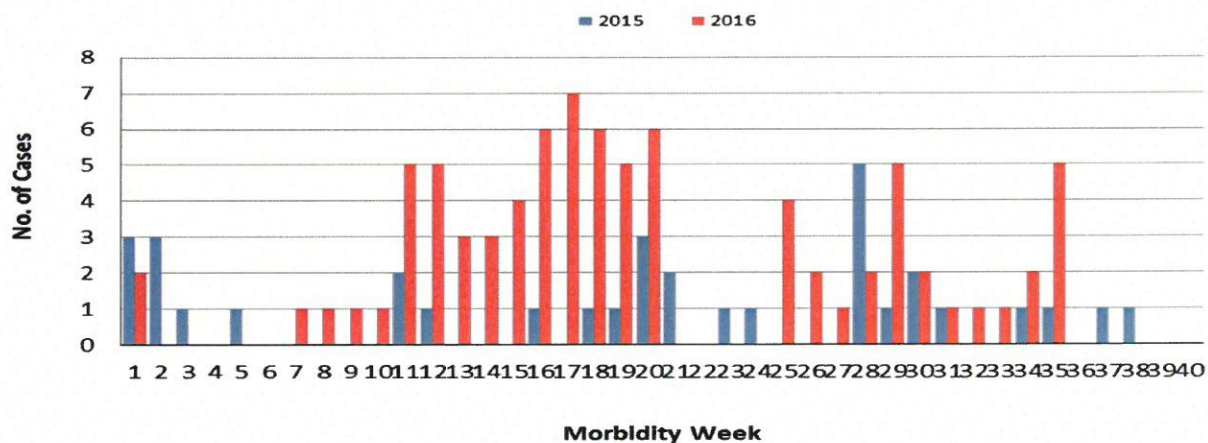




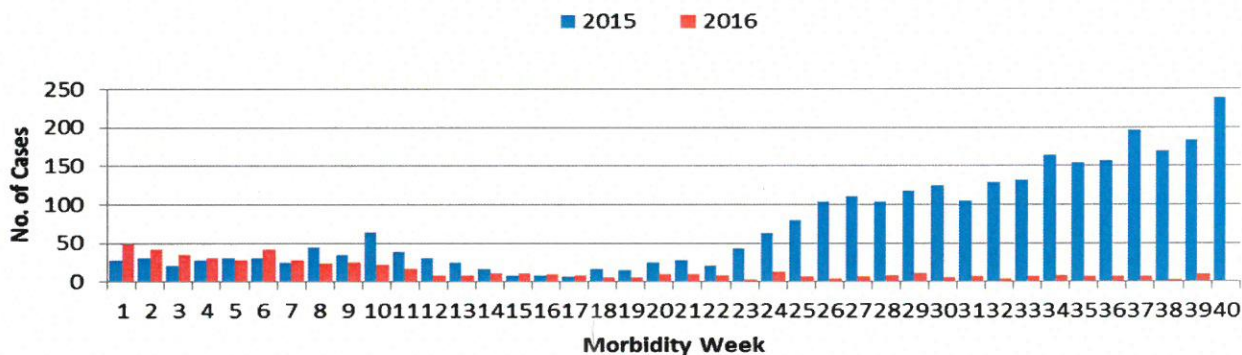
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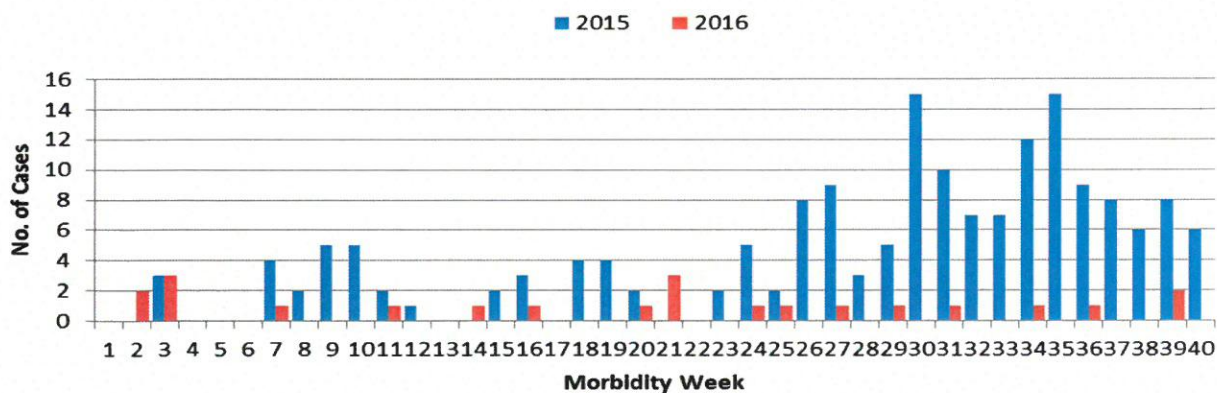
**Fig. 4 Confirmed Bacterial Meningitis Cases

as of October 8, 2016 (n=22)**

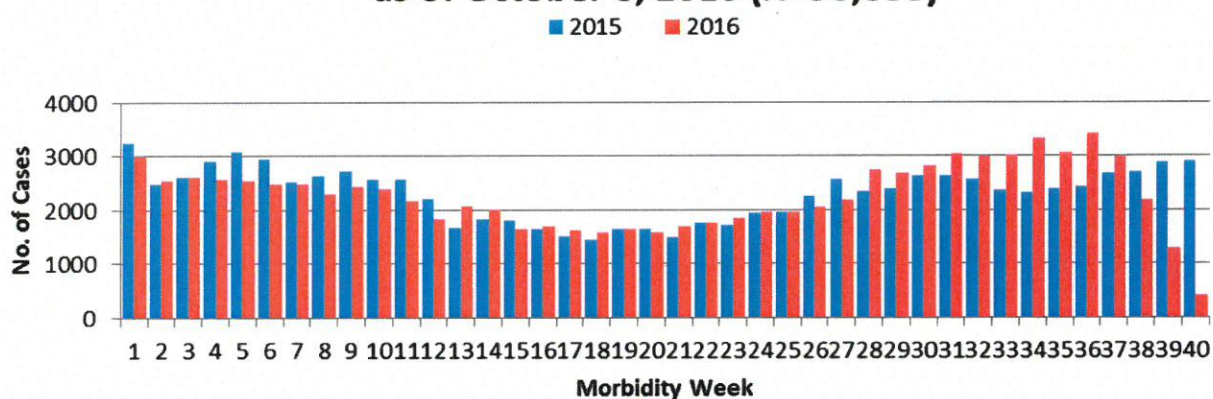




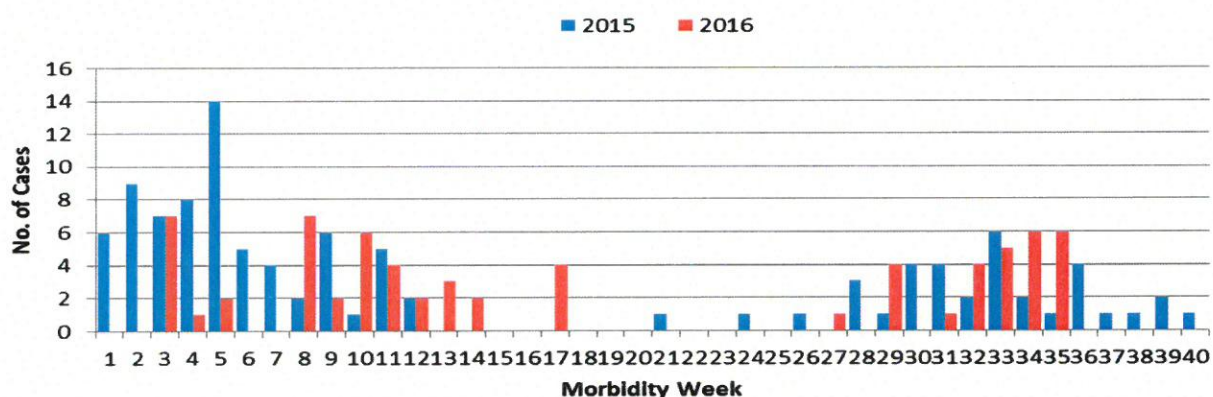
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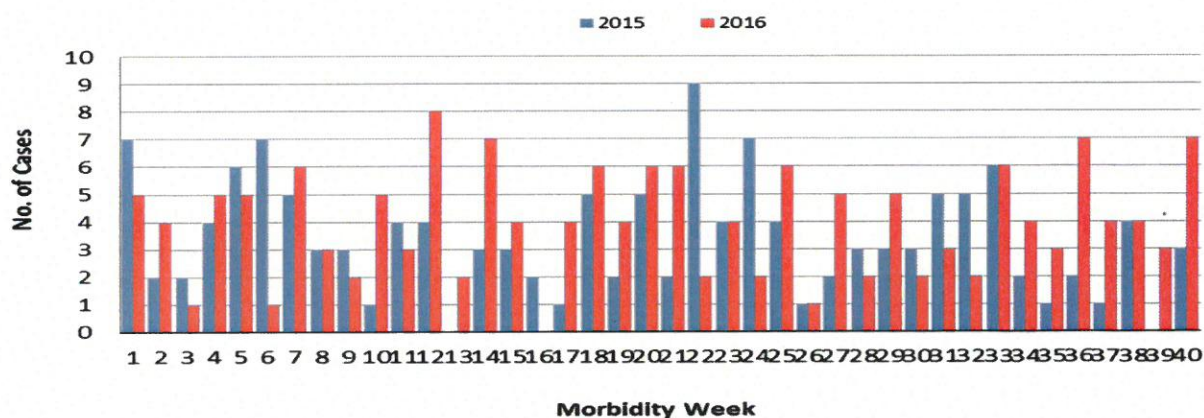
**Fig.7 Influenza-like Illness Cases

as of October 8, 2016 (N=151)**

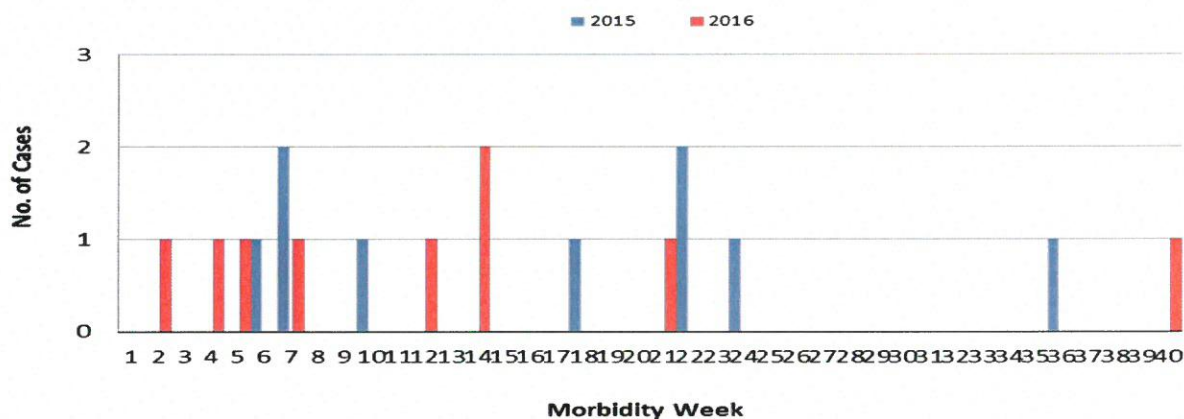




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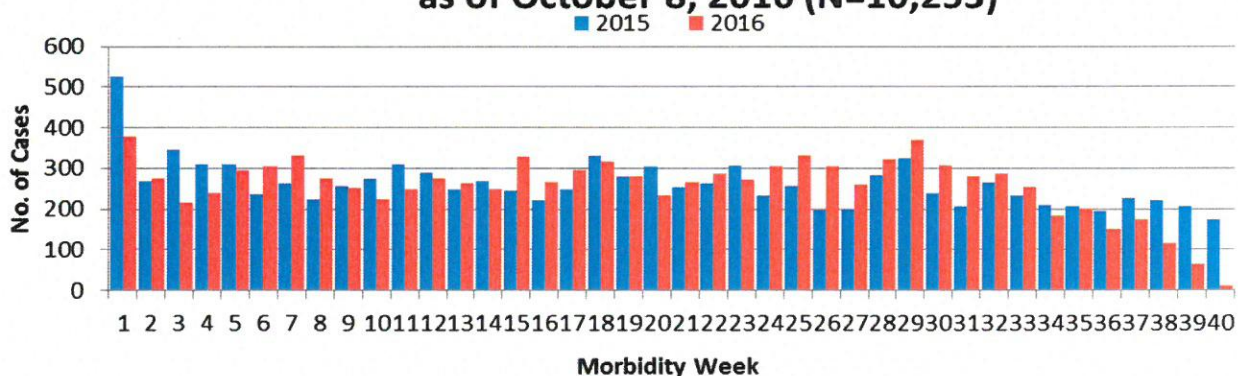
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**Fig. 10 Confirmed Meningococcal Disease Cases
as of October 8, 2016 (n=9)**

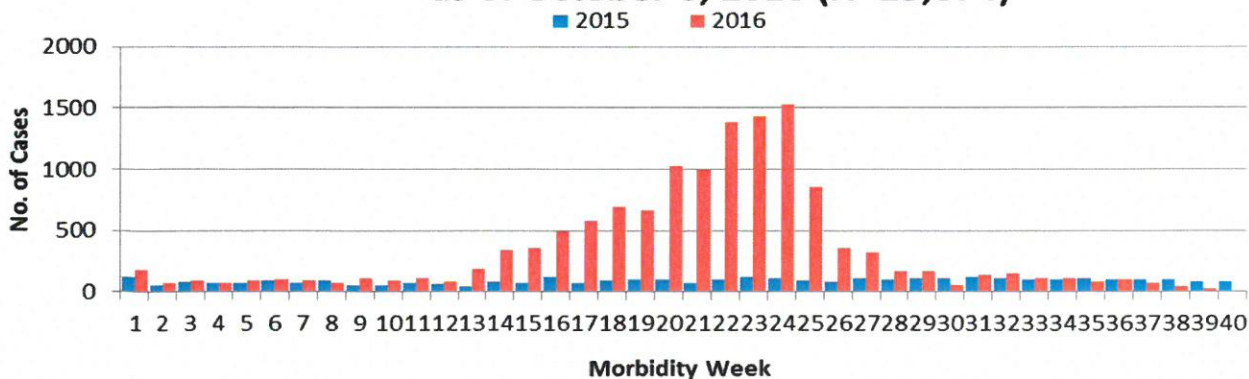

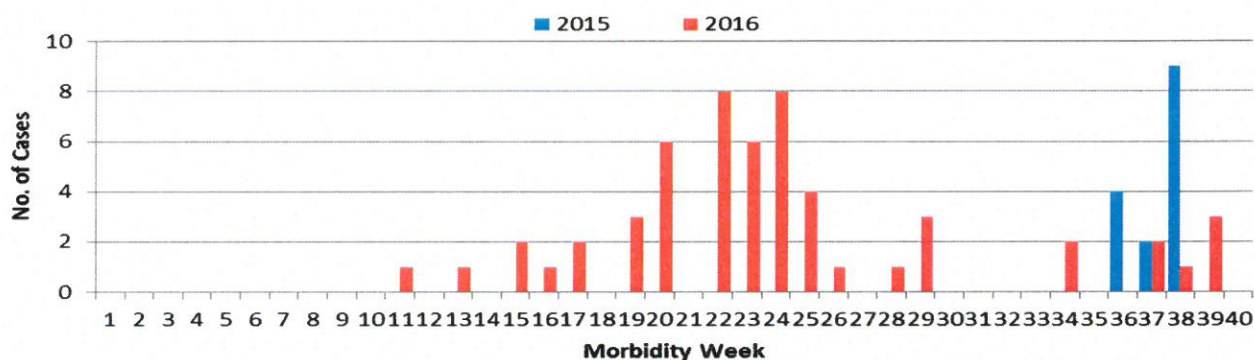




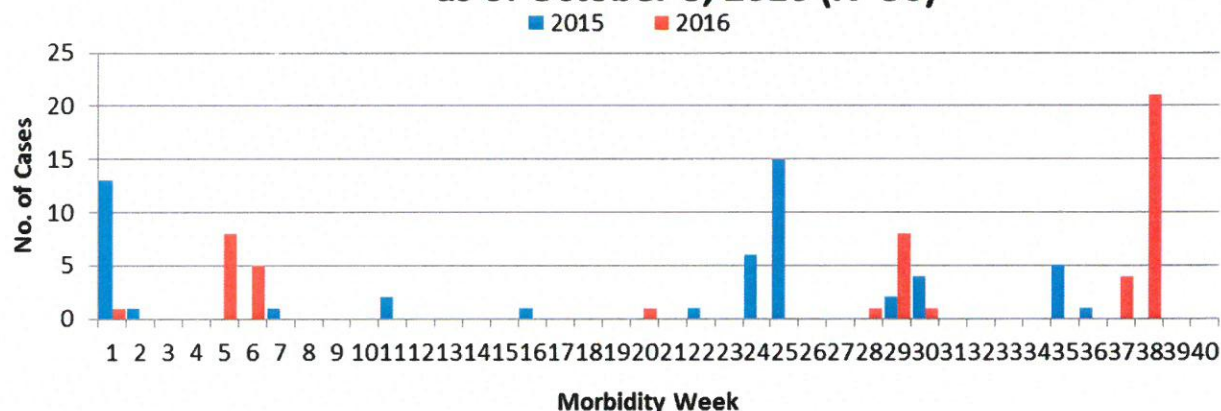
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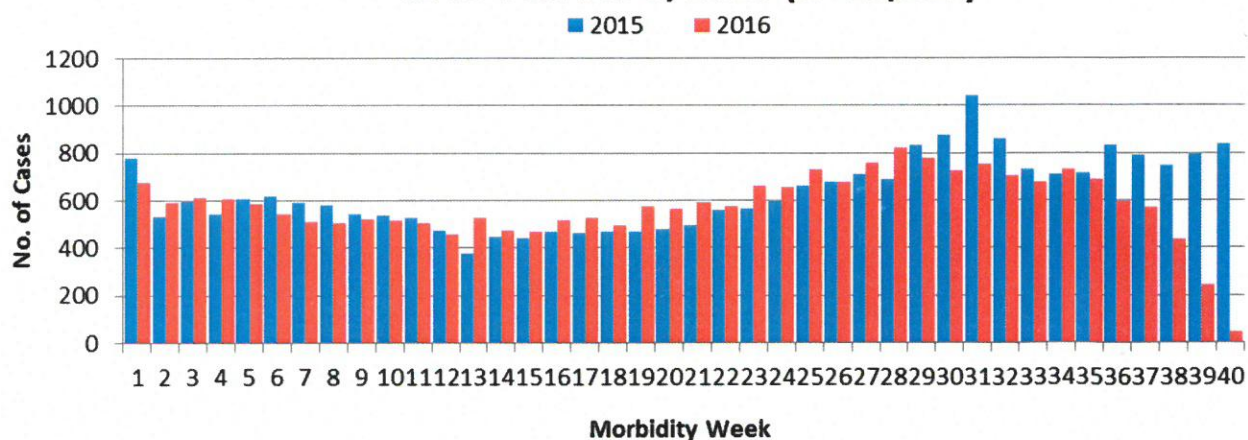
**Fig.13 Confirmed Cholera Cases

as of October 8, 2016 (N=23,257)**

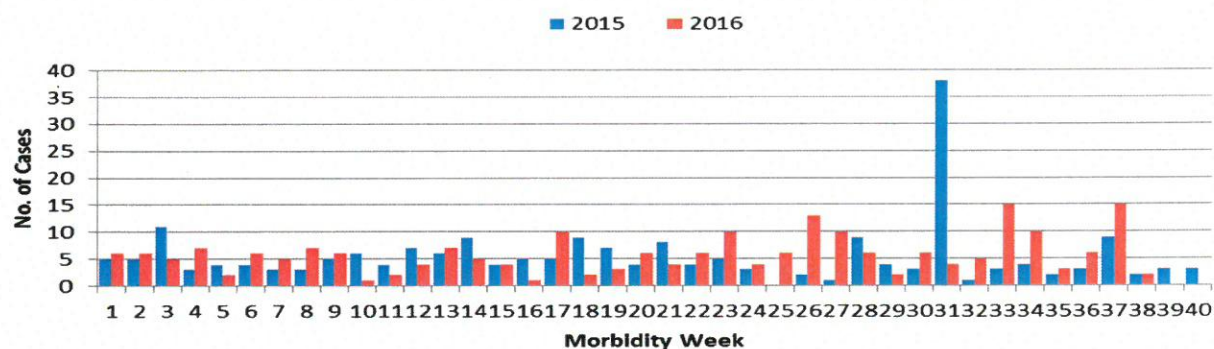




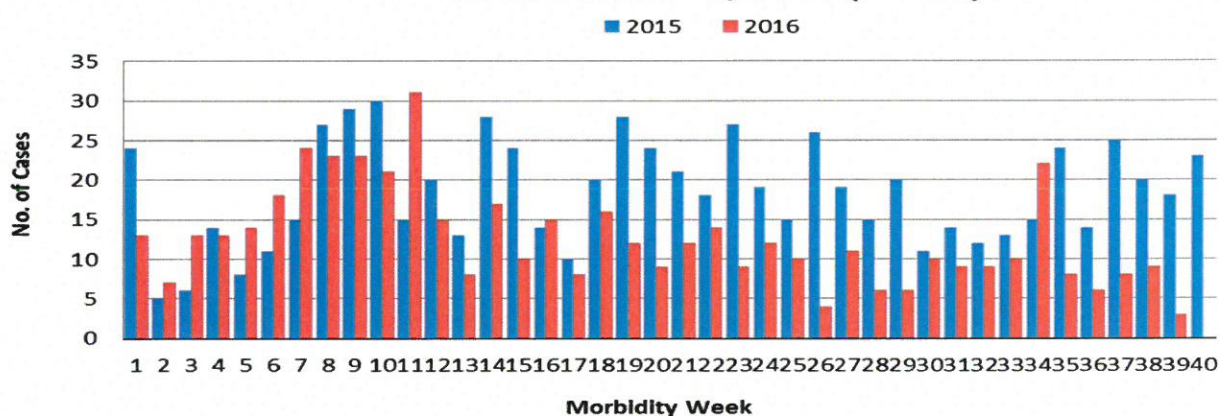
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**Fig.16 Confirmed Typhoid Cases
as of October 8, 2016 (n=222)**

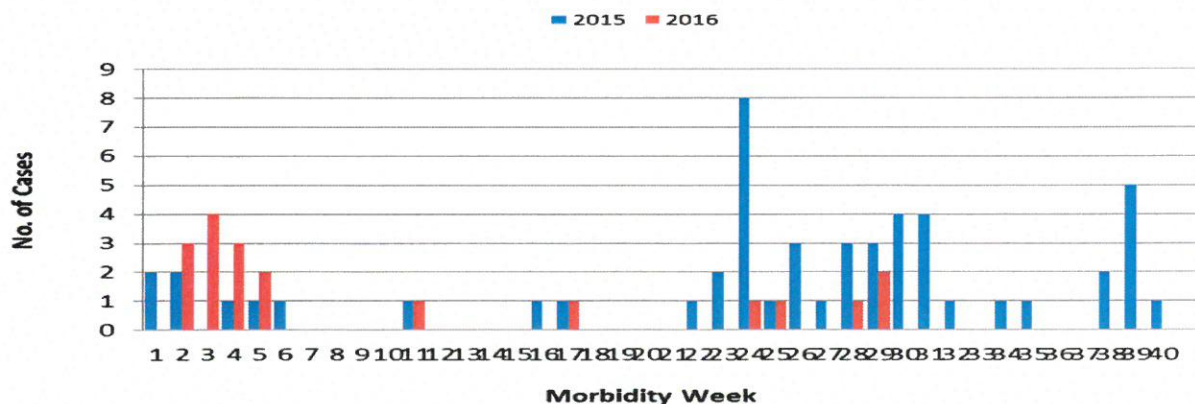


**Fig. 17 Confirmed Hepatitis A Cases

as of October 8, 2016 (N=19)**

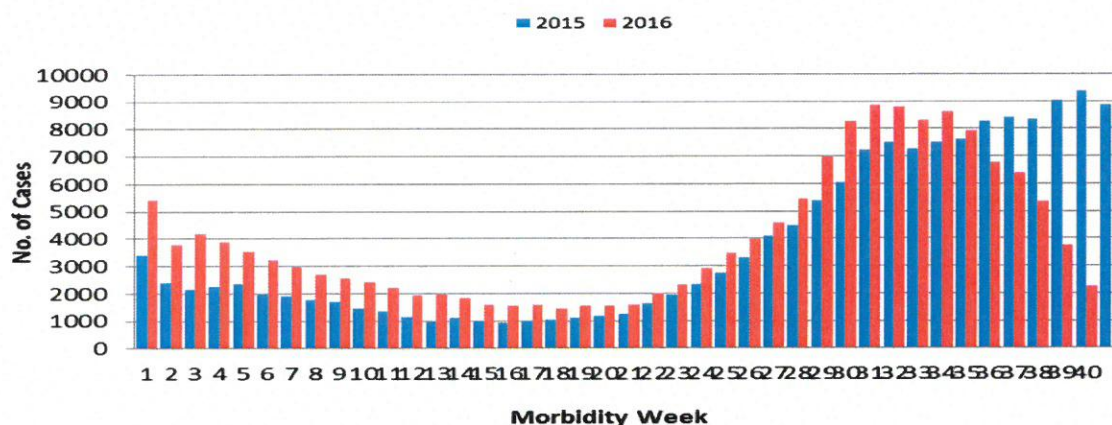




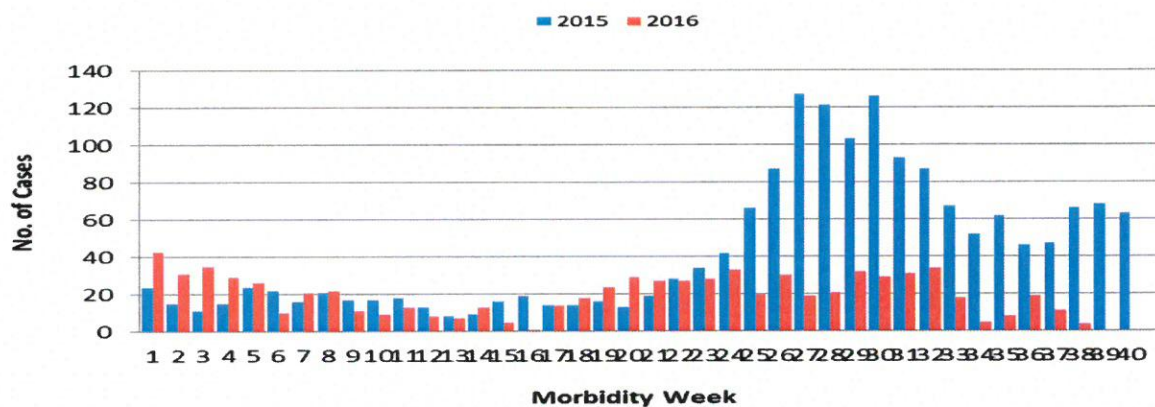
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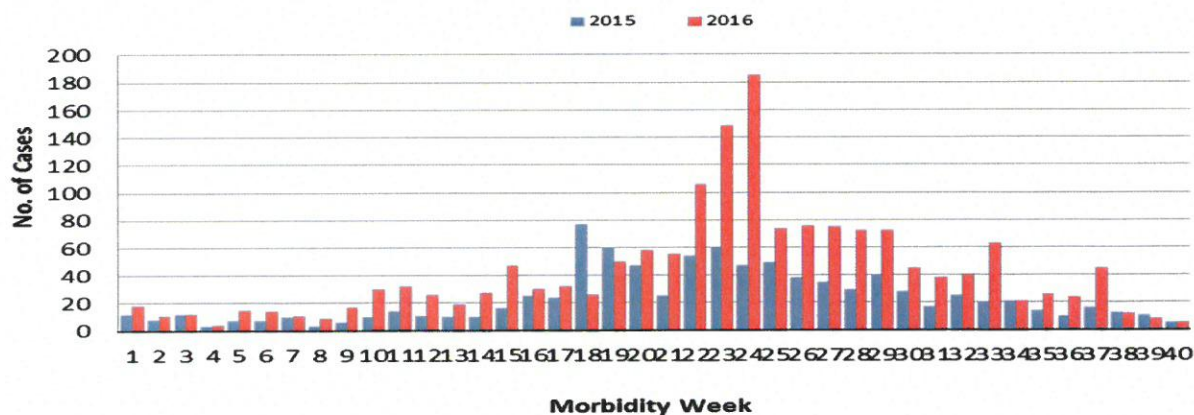
**Fig. 19 Suspect Dengue Cases

as of October 8, 2016 (N=1,678)**



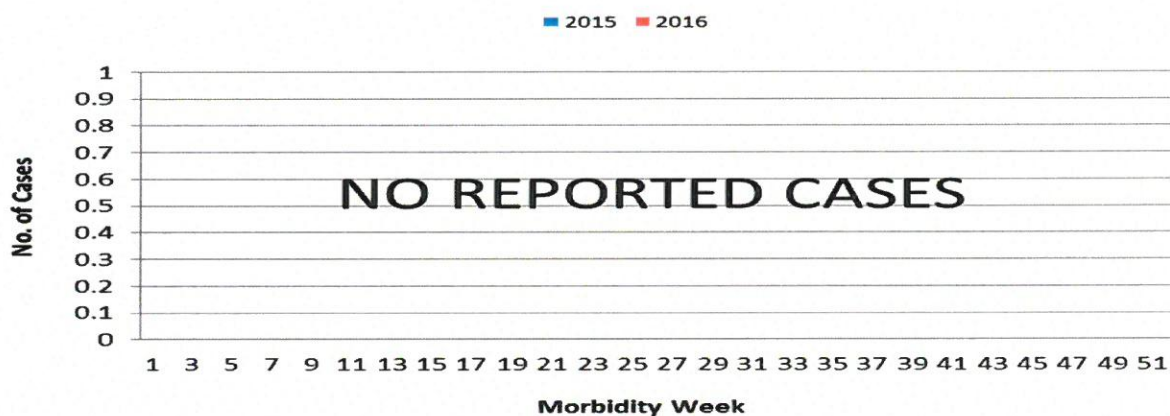


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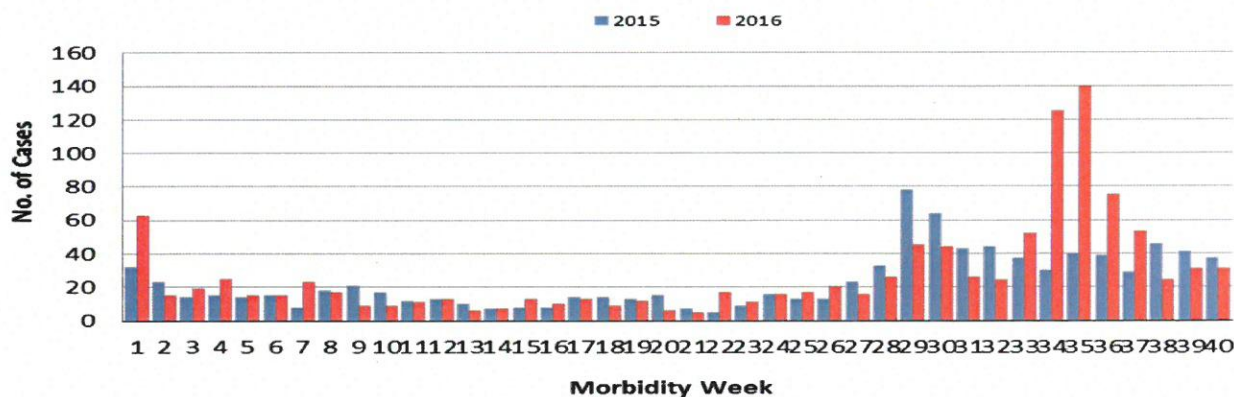

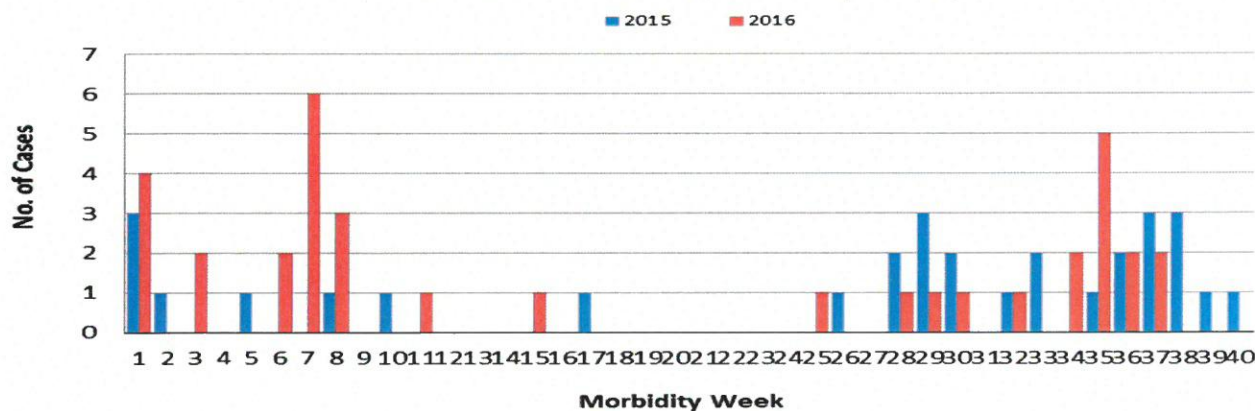
**Fig. 22 Suspect Anthrax Cases

as of October 8, 2016 (n=35)**

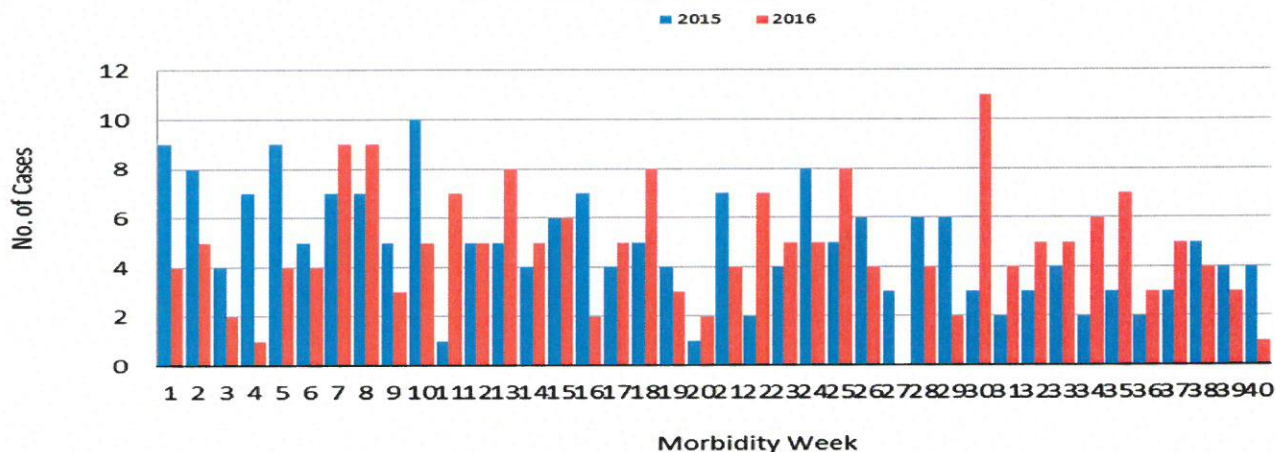




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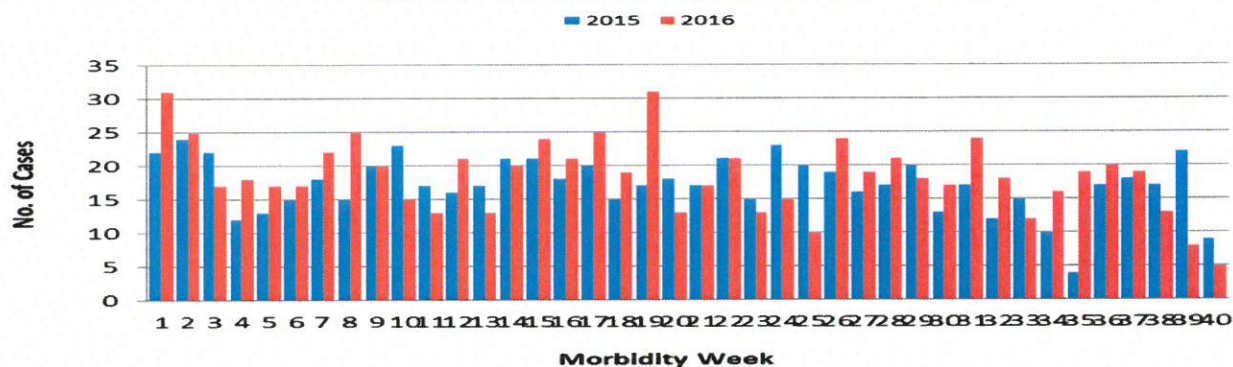
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**Fig. 25 Rabies Cases
as of October 8, 2016 (N=190)**

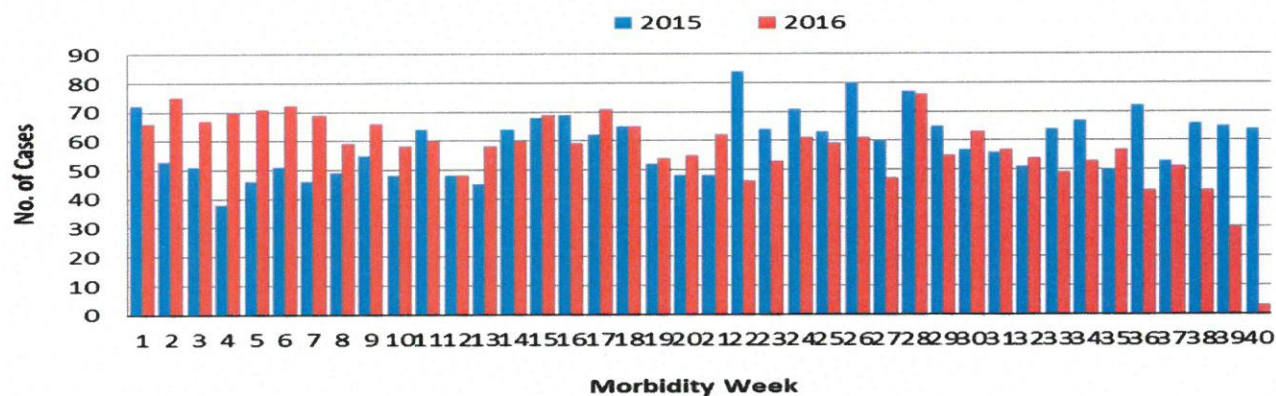

as of October 8, 2016 (n=2295)**

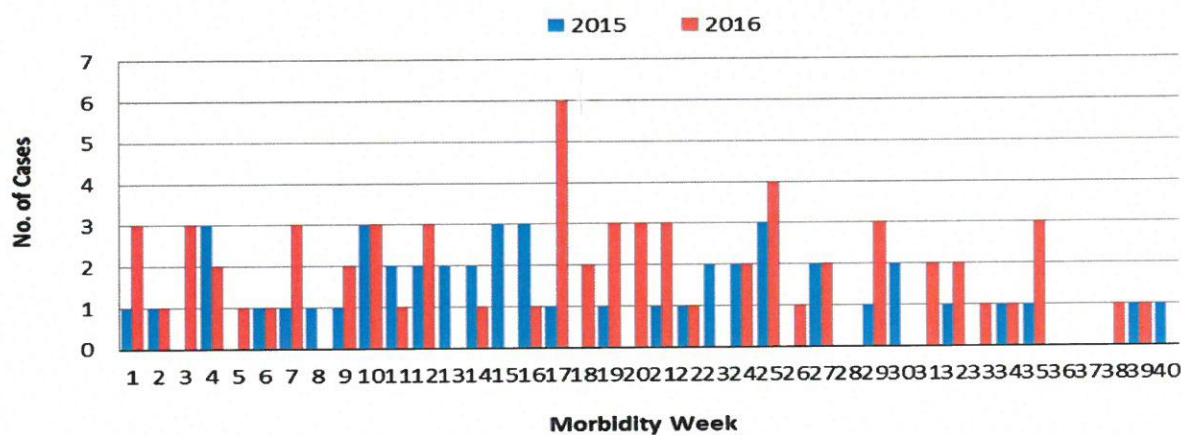





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
**Fig. 28 Confirmed Hepatitis C Cases
