

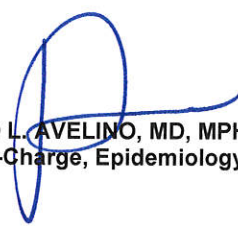


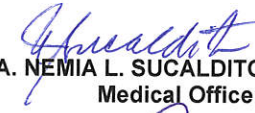
This report provides data for notifiable diseases reported in PIDSR from the period of January 1 to January 26, 2019 or Morbidity Weeks 1 to 4.
