## Advisory No. 12

## <u>Dissemination of the Guidelines on the Implementation of the Second Tranche</u> of COVID-19 Vaccine Delivery Support (CDS)

In line with the PinasLakas Campaign, this advisory is being issued to provide guidance to Regional and Local Vaccination Operation Centers (R/LVOCs), Implementing Units, and Vaccination Sites regarding the Second Tranche of COVID-19 Vaccine Delivery Support (CDS).

From November 2021 until June 2022, UNICEF supported the implementation of CDS Phase 1 with Relief International (RI) as its implementing partner, supported by WHO, and DOH. The CDS 1 project for RI was implemented in nine (9) priority regions (Regions 4A, 4B, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 11, 12) of the country with high cases of COVID-19 reported and high number of unvaccinated individuals.

To further intensify and scale-up COVID-19 vaccine deployment including routine immunization in various regions, the second phase of this project is going to be implemented from June 22, 2022 to December 31, 2022. The project shall cover the support for the salaries of additional vaccinators, encoders and social mobilizers, as well as support the following activities: (1) development and production of DOH-approved materials and collaterals for social mobilization activities, (2) orientation and monitoring expenses of social mobilizers, and the (3) payment for the developer of data insight platforms.
