OBJECTIVE

QUALIFICATIONS

- Must be a Filipino citizen
- · Students of moral character
- Graduate of secondary education (High School or Senior High whichever is applicable)
- Preference shall be given to applicants from:
 - -Low income families
 - -Geographically isolated and disadvantaged municipalities / provinces or from top 20 poorest provinces / municipalities / cities
 - -Indigenous communities / minority sects
 - -Children / dependents of government employees, victims of calamity / tragedy, police / military injured / fatally wounded while on duty, Barangay Health Workers / traditional birth attendants / with chronic diseases

APPLICATION PROCESS

1.Initial Screening

Students shall apply directly to the DOH partner school of choice and should meet the minimum requirements / criteria

2. Final Screening

Evaluation, validation and approval of accepted applicants by the concerned CHD based on set criteria
