- Vaccine for COVID-19 and Other Emerging Diseases in the Unprogrammed Appropriation (UA)

#### 2. Unprogrammed Appropriations:

- PhP 52.96B for Public Health Emergency Benefits and Allowance for HCW and non-HCWs for payment of arrears reckoning 2020 (PhP 4B for PS and PhP 48.96B for MOOE).
- PhP 3.5B MOOE for Vaccine for COVID-19 and Other Emerging

#### 3. Devolution Transition Plan-related Provisions in the 2023 GAA:

- Php 820B National Tax Allotment (NTA) of LGUs which is lower than the 2022 GAA amounting to PhP 959B.
- Php 1B Growth Equity Fund (GEF) which is lower than the 2022 GAA amounting to PhP 1.25B.
- Waived PS cap limitations of LGUs is still embodied in Section 95 of the General Provision.

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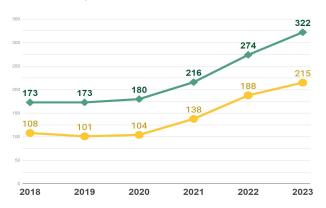

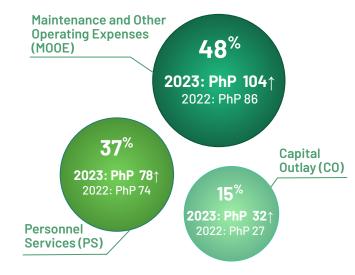

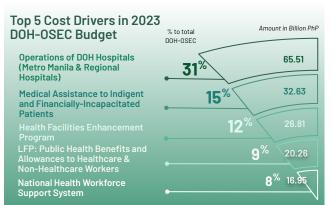
