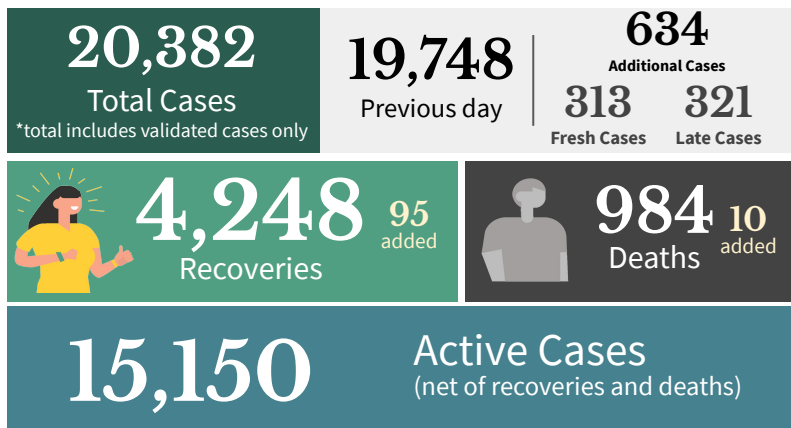

Highlights and Recent Updates on COVID-19

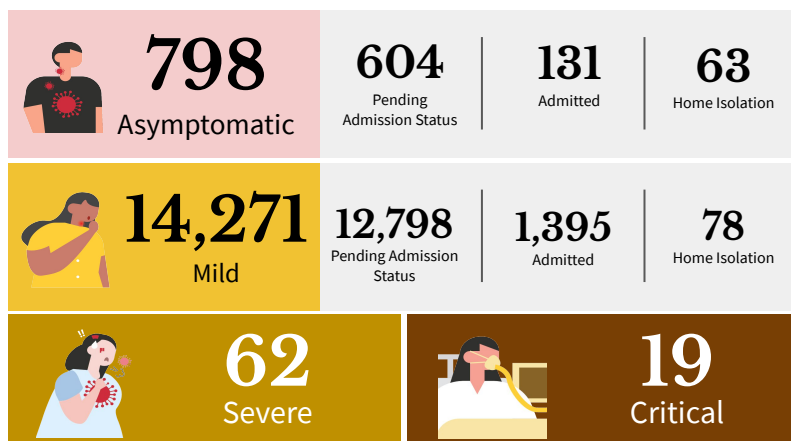
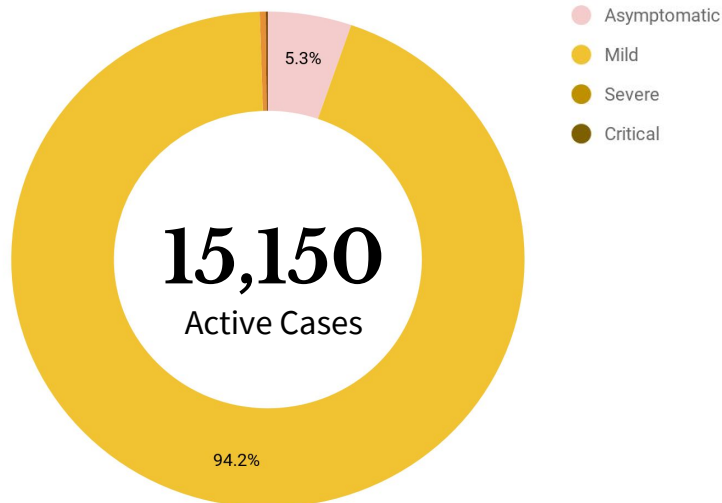
- DOH recorded **15,150 active cases** as of June 4, with the majority of the patients exhibiting **mild symptoms** (14,271; 94.2%).
- There are now **41 licensed laboratories** across the country equipped to perform the **RT-PCR test** for COVID-19 while there are **13 laboratories** licensed to perform COVID-19 testing using **GeneXpert cartridges**.
- A total of **2,707** (13% of all reported cases) are **healthcare workers**, with **1,481 recoveries** and **32 deaths**.
- Most of the confirmed COVID-19 cases are **male** (10,947; 55%). Most of these cases are within the **20-39 age group**.
- DOH reported that the **COVID-19 mortality rate** in the country continues to be on a **downward trend** after the country recorded on June 1 its lowest number of single-day mortalities since early March.
- DOH explains that the observed steady decrease in the number of recorded deaths per day is an indicator that the country's health system is successfully **coping with the pandemic**. This decline shows that different hospitals and facilities are now able to **manage cases more effectively** thereby preventing more patients from progressing to severe disease and expiring.
- DOH reiterates the importance of observing **minimum health standards** such as appropriate use of PPE, physical distancing, cough etiquette, and proper hygiene to **stay safe and healthy amidst the COVID-19 pandemic**.

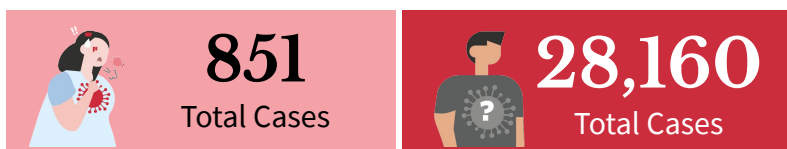


Active Cases Breakdown

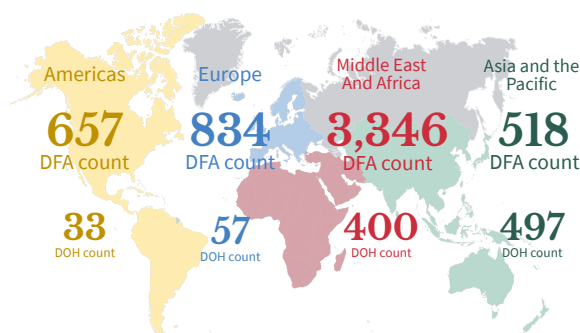
Case Summary of Overseas Filipinos (OFs)

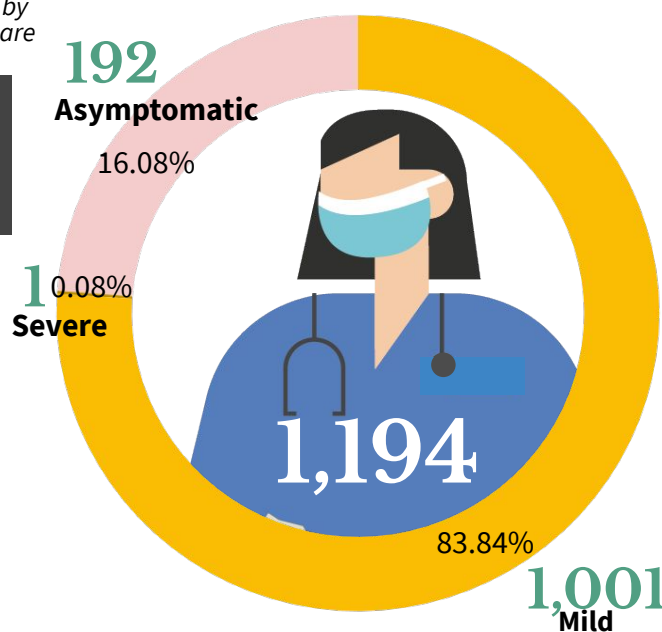
Healthcare Workers affected by COVID-19

Active Cases Breakdown

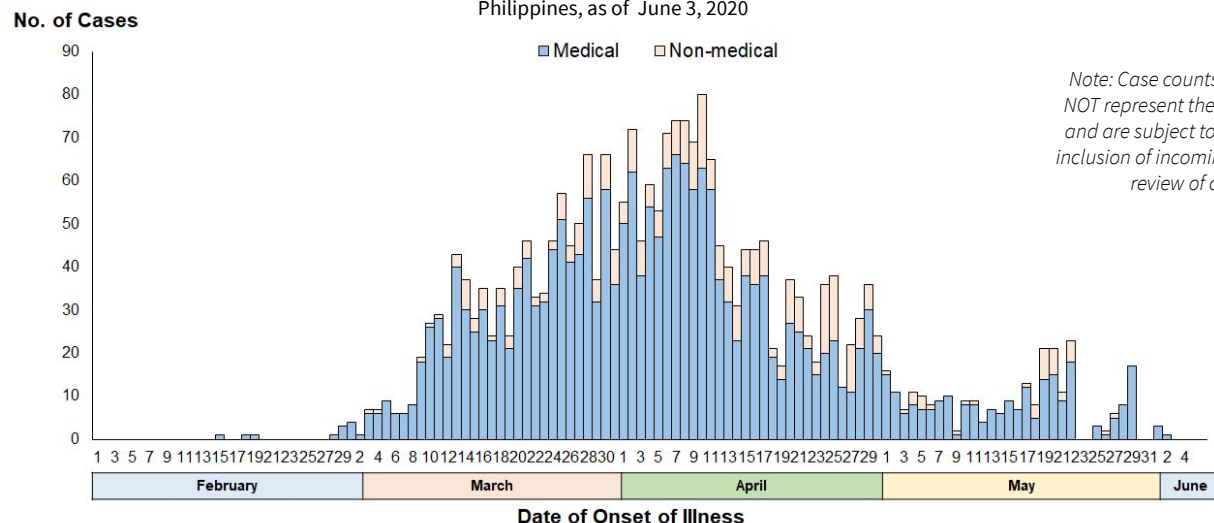

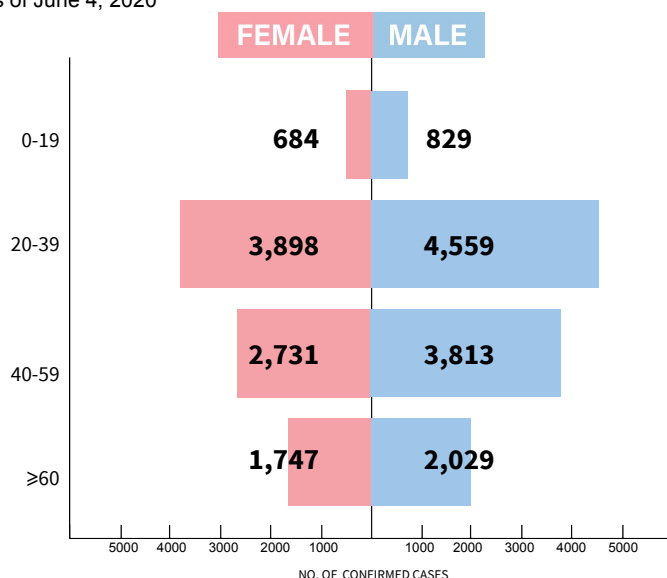

Most of the confirmed cases are Male (10,947 or 55%). Most cases are within the 20-39 age group. Twenty-seven cases (10-female; 17-male) with unspecified age are included in the total.



Average hospital length of stay for recovered patients is at **11 days**.



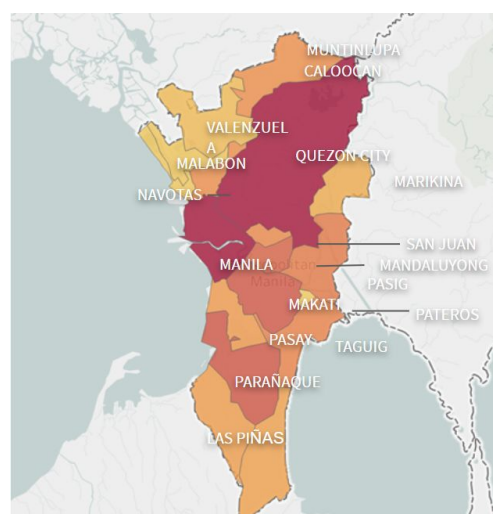
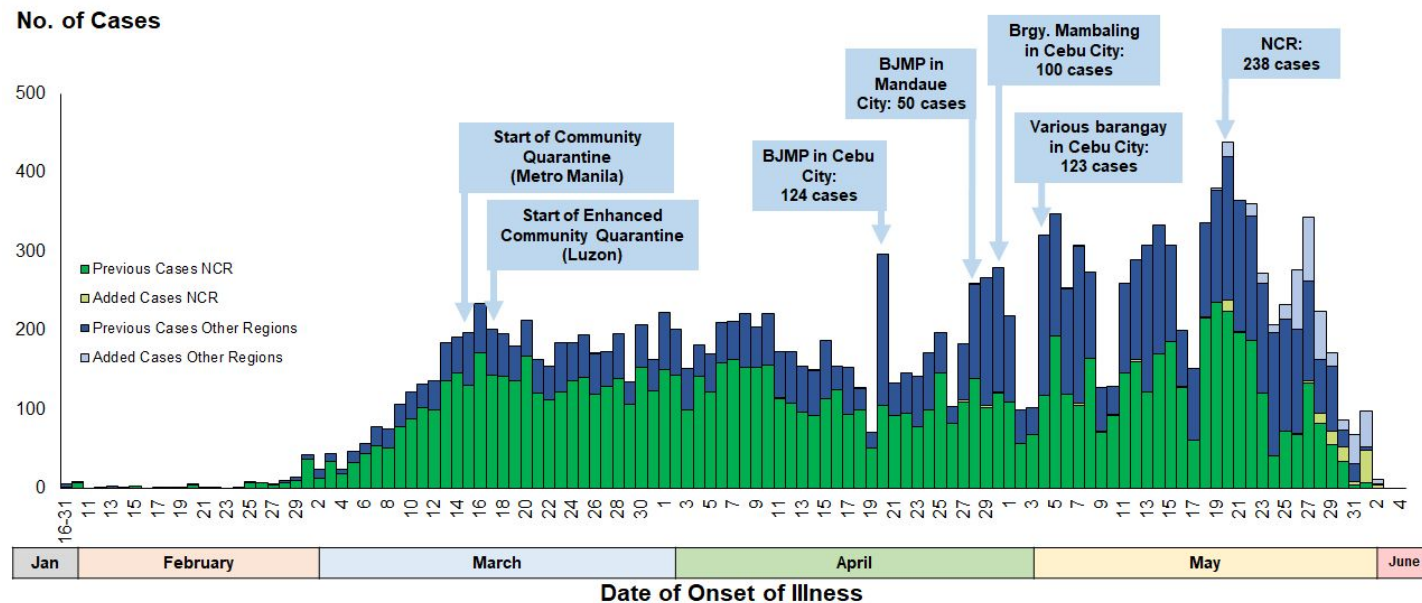
A total of **487 (49%)** deaths had known comorbidities: top 2 comorbidities are **hypertension (292 or 60%)** and **diabetes (224 or 46%)**

A total of 11,609 (57%) are confirmed cases from NCR. The proportion of cases in NCR decreased from 72% since January (start of case detection) to April 19, 2020 to 50% for the period of April 20 to June 4, 2020.

Meanwhile, cases in Region 7 increased in proportion from 2% to 19% for the similar period. On May 4, 2020, 123 (38%) out of the 321 confirmed cases nationwide (by date of onset), were reported from various barangay in Cebu City. Region 7 recorded a total of 2,957 (15%) confirmed cases, the second highest reported in the country.

Region 4-A has the third highest cases with a total of 1,781 (9%) confirmed cases as of yesterday. Since start of case detection to April 19, the proportion of cases in Region 4A decreased from 15% to 5% for the period of April 20 to June 4.

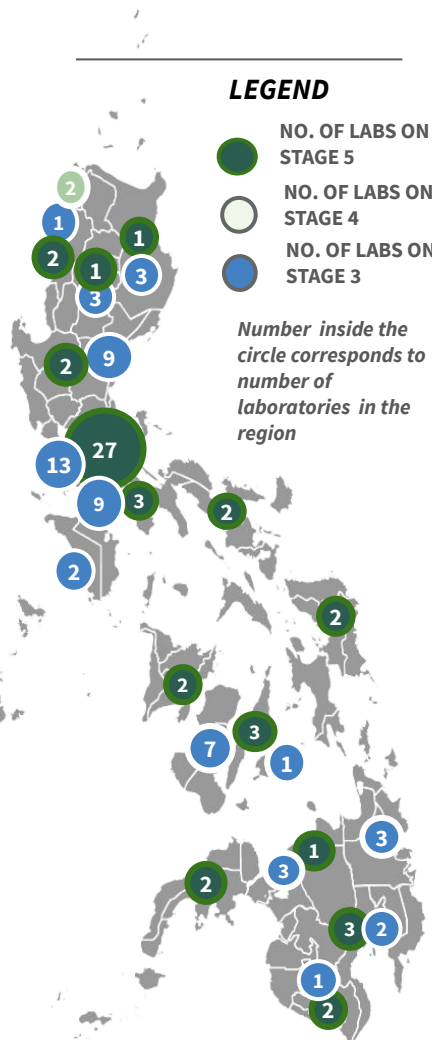

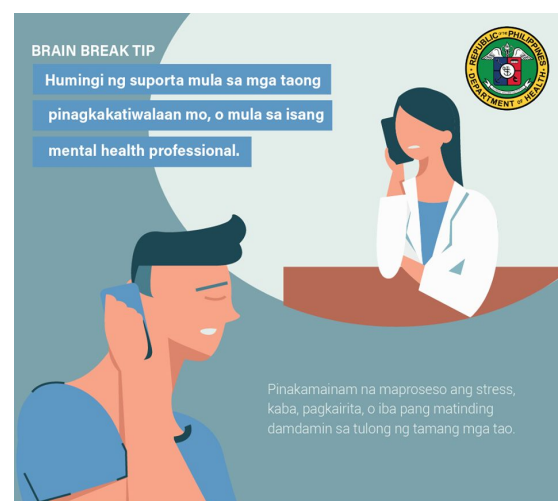

BEHAVIORAL MESSAGES OF THE DAY

As of June 4, 2020

- As the country ushers into the New Normal era, minimum health standards are essential to keep everyone healthy and safe. The public is continuously reminded to follow simple precautions that would reduce exposure to COVID-19. Taking care of ourselves is also taking care of our families and communities.
- In [markets and groceries](#), minimum health standards should be observed. These include hand hygiene, proper coughing manners, wearing face masks and other PPEs, physical distancing, and checking for symptoms before entering the dining area, among others. Shoppers are advised to touch only the products they are sure to purchase.
- In [food and dining](#) settings, the same minimum health standards should be observed. Touching surfaces and objects should be avoided as much as possible.
- It is okay not to feel okay. In situations of extreme stress, one can expect not to feel okay. Venting feelings to somebody you trust is helpful in overcoming negative feelings due to stress. Talking with a mental health professional is also okay – people should not be afraid of feeling judged and stigmatized for doing so.

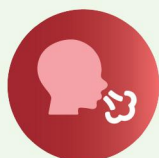

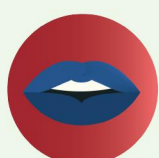

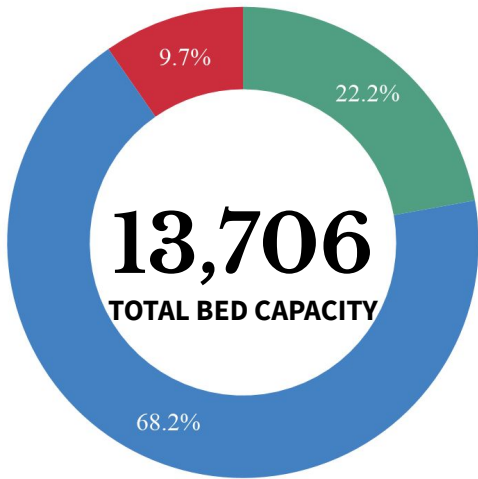

HOSPITAL BEDS AND MECHANICAL VENTILATORS DEDICATED TO COVID-19 CASES

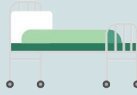

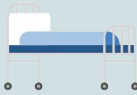


Ward beds for confirmed COVID-19 cases



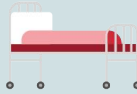

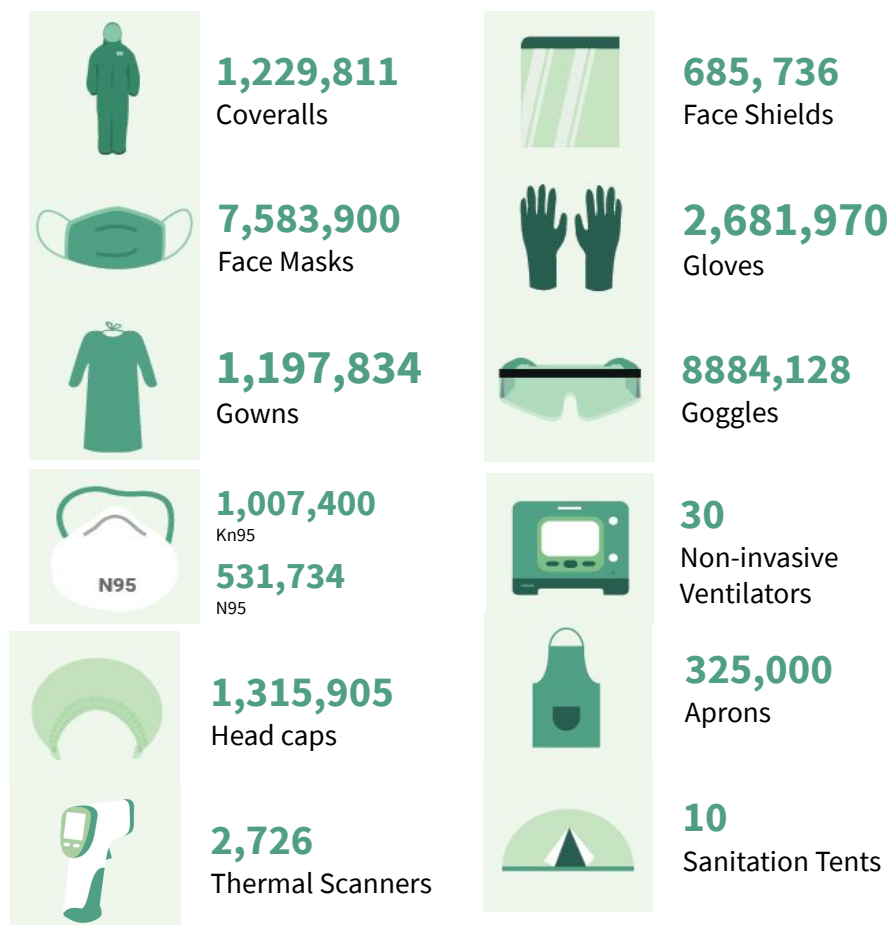
