Highlights and Recent **Updates on COVID-19**

- DOH recorded **15,309 active cases** as of June 5, with the majority of the patients exhibiting mild symptoms (14,439; 94.3%).
- A total of **2,710 (13% of all cases)** healthcare workers have been affected by COVID-19, with 1,504 recoveries and 32 deaths.
- There are a total of **53,439 calls** that have been attended by **Telemedicine**. Of these, 25,634 are COVID-19 related calls
- The use of a **bicycle** can be be both transportation and health solution. With many Filipino commuters returning to road after the transition to GCQ in Manila, there is a need to balance safety against COVID-19 and available public transportation. The DOH, together with Department of Transportation (DOTr) and cycling advocates, discussed the benefits of cycling as a mode of transportation during the quarantine.
- Yesterday, June 5, the DOH has released the first of 32 checks for the loved ones of our fallen health care heroes. The remaining checks are ready for pick-up and delivery to the recipients, and its distribution will be prioritized in the next two days.
- DOH emphasized that staying at home is the best way to minimize the exposure from COVID-19. But staying at home for a long time has lessened regular movements and activities. Everyone is encouraged to exercise or work out for at least 15 minutes daily.



TOP COUNTRIES WITH COVID-19








Healthcare Workers with confirmed COVID-19 by Date of Onset of Illness (N= 2,710)

Most of the confirmed cases are Male (11,430 or 55%). Most cases are within the 20-39 age group. Ninety-two cases (33-female; 59-male) with unspecified age are included in the total.



Average hospital length of stay for recovered patients is at **11 days.**





A total of 487 (49%) deaths had known comorbidities: top 2 comorbidities are hypertension (292 or 60%) and diabetes (224 or 46%).

A total of 11,656 (57%) are confirmed cases from NCR. The proportion of cases in NCR decreased from 72% since January (start of case detection) to April 19, 2020 to 50% for the period of April 20 to June 5, 2020.

Meanwhile, cases in Region 7 increased in proportion from 2% to 20% for the similar period. On May 4, 2020, 123 (38%) out of the 321 confirmed cases nationwide (by date of onset), were reported from various barangay in Cebu City. Region 7 recorded a total of 3,102 (15%) confirmed cases, the second highest reported in the country.

Region 4-A has the third highest cases with a total of 1,781 (9%) confirmed cases as of yesterday. Since start of case detection to April 19, the proportion of cases in Region 4A decreased from 15% to 5% for the period of April 20 to June 5.



BEHAVIORAL MESSAGES OF THE DAY

As of June 5, 2020

- As the country ushers in the New Normal era, minimum health standards in places of worship are essential to keep everyone healthy and safe. To minimize the risk of exposure to COVID-19, religious gatherings are still discouraged. People are advised to watch masses or church services online or in television.
- Religious denominations that will host services and faith-based activities are reminded to take steps to limit the size of gatherings in accordance with the IATF guidelines. They have to ensure that physical distancing, will be observed by the clergy, staff, choir, volunteers and attendees to lessen the risk of acquiring the virus. Attendees should be checked for symptoms before entering the places of worship.
- Those with mild symptoms are advised to stay at home and to consult through telemedicine, while those with severe symptoms must contact local BHERT or the DOH hotline.
 Everyone should wear face masks, practice hand hygiene and proper coughing manners, and maintain a 1-meter distance with others to protect self from the virus.
- Staying at home is the best way to minimize the exposure from COVID-19. But staying at home for a long time has lessened regular movements and activities, so it is encouraged to exercise or work out together with your family at least 15 minutes daily.
 <u>Staying physically active</u> is one of the best ways to keep your mind and body healthy.





HOW DO YOU MAKE 0.05% DISINFECTANT SOLUTION FOR CLEANING HOUSEHOLD ITEMS?

900mL

tubig

100 mL bleach



1. Gather all materials needed: disinfectant container, bleach/chlorine, water, personal protective equipment



- 2. Wear appropriate personal protective equipment (gloves, googles, apron and boots) when handling and preparing bleach solutions.




- **3.** When preparing the solution, pour the amount of water required into a plastic container then add the bleach (and not the other way around):
- **4.** If you are using household bleach (5% active chlorine), mix:
 - a) 1 ml bleach + 9 ml water, or
 - b) 100 ml bleach + 900 ml water
 - For chlorine powder/granules/tablet (60-70%) active chlorine, dissolve: 1 tbsp of chlorine + 20L of water
- **5.** Do not forget to label your disinfectant containers and specify chlorine concentration.



The Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth) announced that they partnered with the Philippine Red Cross (PRC), a DOH-licensed testing laboratory, for the conduct of expanded testing for COVID-19. As per DOH Department Memorandum No. 2020-0180, the PRC shall provide COVID-19 testing to priority individuals and health workers, which will be paid for by PhilHealth.

POLICY IN-FOCUS

The Department of Health has issued Department Circular No. 2020-01922 "Ensuring that people in Geographically-Isolated and Disadvantaged Areas (GIDAs), Indigenous Cultural Communities/Indigenous Peoples (ICCs'IPs) are well-informed on COVID-19 and have access to Temporary Treatment and Monitoring Facilities and Referral Hospitals" to to coordinate with the different Local Government Units (LGUs)in ensuring that the people living in GIDAs and the ICCs/IPs are also well informed on COVID-19.
