## Highlights and Recent **Updates on COVID-19**

- DOH recorded **15,905 active cases** as of June 5, with the majority of the patients exhibiting **mild symptoms** (15,131; 95.1%).
- A total of **2,734 (13% of all cases)** healthcare workers have been affected by COVID-19, with 1,504 recoveries and 32 deaths.
- With the country reaching an **output of** 10,000 tests per day, DOH has announced its plans to expand testing to include certain asymptomatic subgroups. In order to efficiently maximize the limited supply, criteria will be set for identifying which groups of asymptomatic population should be tested.
- DOH emphasizes that while testing is a vital part of the country's overall strategy against the pandemic, the ideal approach to combat the threat of COVID-19 remains to be prevention through increasing resilience. together with expanded targeted testing, contact tracing, isolation, and treatment and management.
- DOH reported that the country's COVID-19 positivity rate (percentage of the population that has been tested who turns out positive for COVID-19) of 7.2% is below **World Health Organization's 10%** benchmark. This is a good indicator that the country is sufficiently testing.
- To minimize the risk of being exposed to COVID-19, DOH cautions against going outside unless absolutely necessary. DOH also reminds the public to continue the proper use of PPEs, physical distancing, and good personal hygiene should they need to go outside.









Most of the confirmed cases are Male (11,884 or 56%). Most cases are within the 20-39 age group. Flfty-five cases (21-female; 34-male) with unspecified age are included in the total.



Average hospital length of stay for recovered patients is at **11 days.** 





A total of 490 (49%) deaths had known comorbidities: top 2 comorbidities are hypertension (292 or 60%) and diabetes (224 or 46%).

A total of 11,914 (56%) are confirmed cases from NCR. The proportion of cases in NCR decreased from 72% since January (start of case detection) to April 19, 2020 to 49% for the period of April 20 to June 6, 2020.

Meanwhile, cases in Region 7 increased in proportion from 2% to 20% for the similar period. On May 4, 2020, 123 (38%) out of the 321 confirmed cases nationwide (by date of onset), were reported from various barangay in Cebu City. Region 7 recorded a total of 3,273 (15%) confirmed cases, the second highest reported in the country.

Region 4-A has the third highest cases with a total of 1,802 (8%) confirmed cases as of yesterday. Since start of case detection to April 19, the proportion of cases in Region 4A decreased from 15% to 5% for the period of April 20 to June 6.




#### **BEHAVIORAL MESSAGES OF THE DAY**

As of June 6, 2020

- As the country ushers in the New Normal era, minimum health standards are essential to keep everyone healthy and safe. As a general precaution, everyone is advised to practice hand hygiene, proper coughing manners, physical distancing, and use of face masks.
- In the case where people need to go out for errands, the public is still advised to observe minimum health standards. In grocery, markets, and food retail settings, everyone is advised to avoid large groups of people and long queues. They are also advised to touch items/products only if sure to be purchased. In transportation settings, physical distancing among commuters should be strictly observed.
- To maintain a strong and healthy body, the public is also encouraged to exercise regularly, as long as minimum health standards such as physical distancing is observed.
- Everyone is enjoined in appreciating frontline health care workers, as they work tirelessly to battle the disease on the frontlines while the nation stays safe at home. In this regard, support and kind words go a long way to keep up the spirits of our modern day heroes.

#### HOW DO YOU REMAIN SAFE AND HEALTHY AMIDST THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC?

ALWAYS remember and practice the following:



Wash hands with soap and water for 20 seconds or more (Try singing the chorus of your favorite song while washing).



Use a hand sanitizer with 70% alcohol if you can't wash your hands for 20 seconds or more.



Avoid touching your face, especially your mouth, eyes, nose.



Make sure you keep 1 meter distance from other people.



Avoid touching things that many people touch like door handles, tables, chairs, etc.



Wear a mask while outside.



Frequently clean surfaces in your house, work or business. This includes tables, doorknobs, light switches, countertops, handles, desks, phones, keys, keyboards, toilets, faucets, and sinks.



Disinfect using a bleach solution (7 tablespoons [100 mL] bleach for 1 liter of clean water).




Disinfect your most used things (like phone, keys, eyeglasses, keyboard, etc.) with 70% alcohol solution.



The Philippine Health Insurance Corporation, pursuant to RA. No. 11469 or the "Bayanihan to Heal as One Act" has issued PhilHealth Advisory No. 2020-035¹ "Philhealth to Prioritize at Risk Individuals and Healthcare Workers for COVID-19 Testing".

Philhealth has partnered with Red Cross, a DOH licensed testing laboratory for the conduct of the expanded targeted testing for COVID-19 as embodied in DOH Memorandum No. 2020-180.

#### **POLICY IN-FOCUS**

In order to provide guidance, the Department of Health has issued Department Memorandum No. 2020-0186<sup>2</sup> "Interim Guidelines on the Operations of Converted Public and Private Spaces into Temporary Treatment and Monitoring Facilities for COVID-19".

This issuance covers all temporary treatment and monitoring facilities (TTMF) catering to suspect, probable, and confirmed COVID-19 cases with mild symptoms, and the Local Government Units (LGU) and other agencies managing them.
