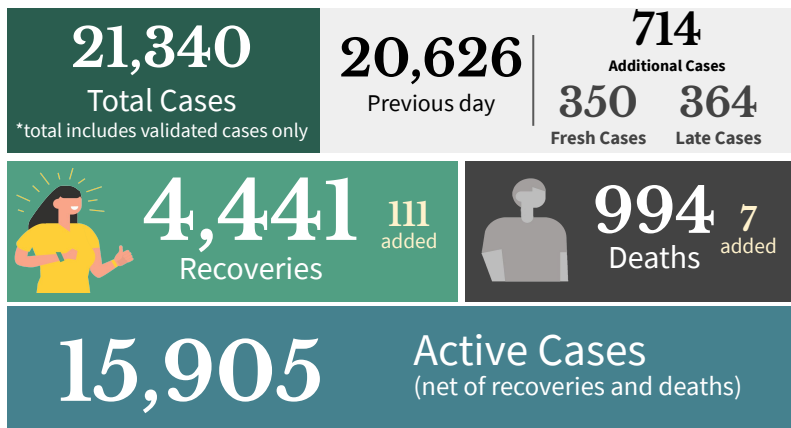

Highlights and Recent Updates on COVID-19

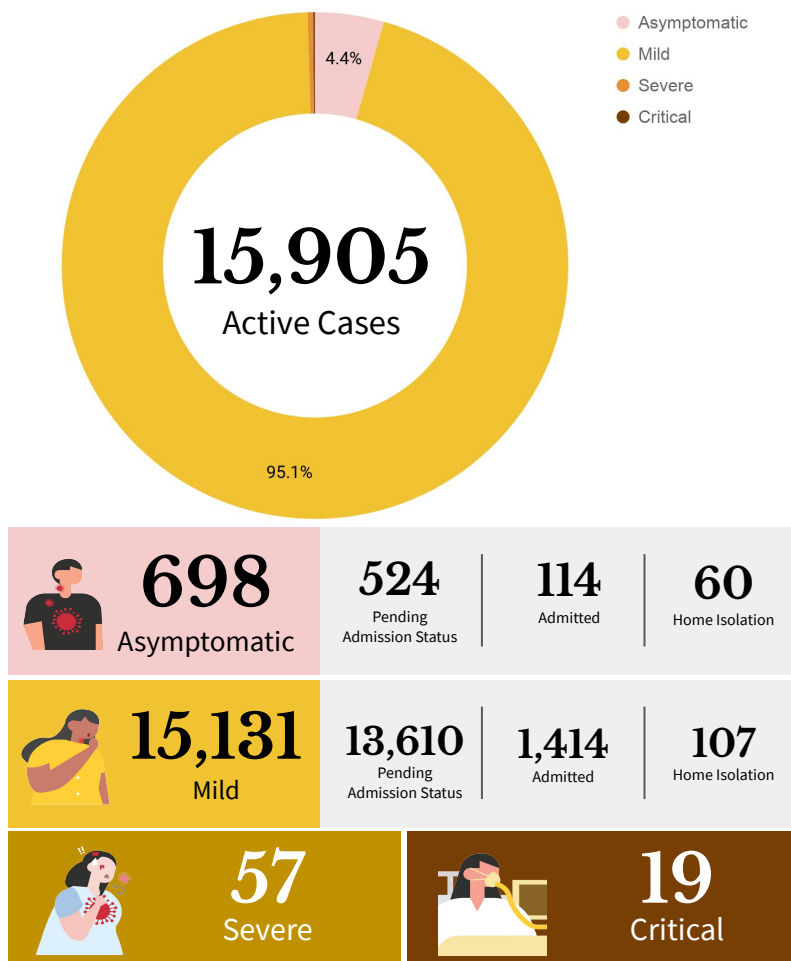
- DOH recorded **15,905 active cases** as of June 5, with the majority of the patients exhibiting **mild symptoms** (15,131; 95.1%).
- A total of **2,734 (13% of all cases) healthcare workers** have been affected by COVID-19, with **1,504 recoveries** and 32 deaths.
- With the country reaching an **output of 10,000 tests per day**, DOH has announced its plans to **expand testing to include certain asymptomatic subgroups**. In order to efficiently maximize the limited supply, criteria will be set for identifying which groups of asymptomatic population should be tested.
- DOH emphasizes that while testing is a vital part of the country's overall strategy against the pandemic, the ideal approach to combat the threat of COVID-19 remains to be **prevention through increasing resilience, together with expanded targeted testing, contact tracing, isolation, and treatment and management**.
- DOH reported that the country's **COVID-19 positivity rate** (percentage of the population that has been tested who turns out positive for COVID-19) **of 7.2% is below World Health Organization's 10% benchmark**. This is a good indicator that the country is sufficiently testing.
- To minimize the risk of being exposed to COVID-19, DOH cautions **against going outside unless absolutely necessary**. DOH also reminds the public to **continue the proper use of PPEs, physical distancing, and good personal hygiene** should they need to go outside.

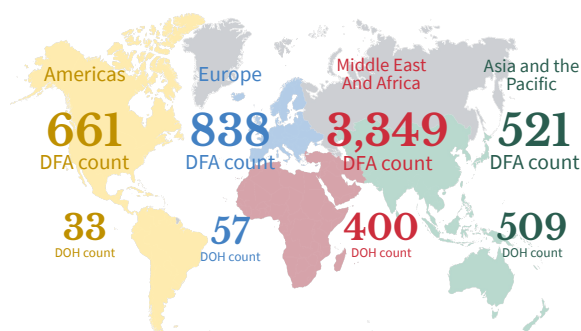

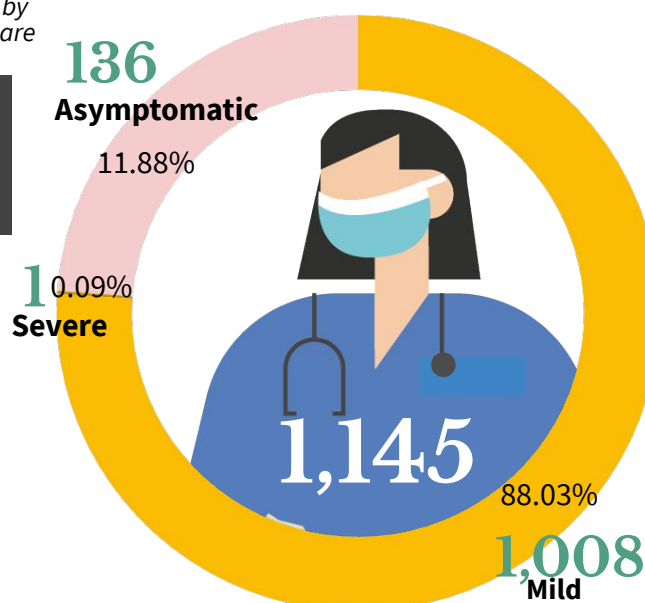
Healthcare Workers affected by COVID-19

Active Cases Breakdown



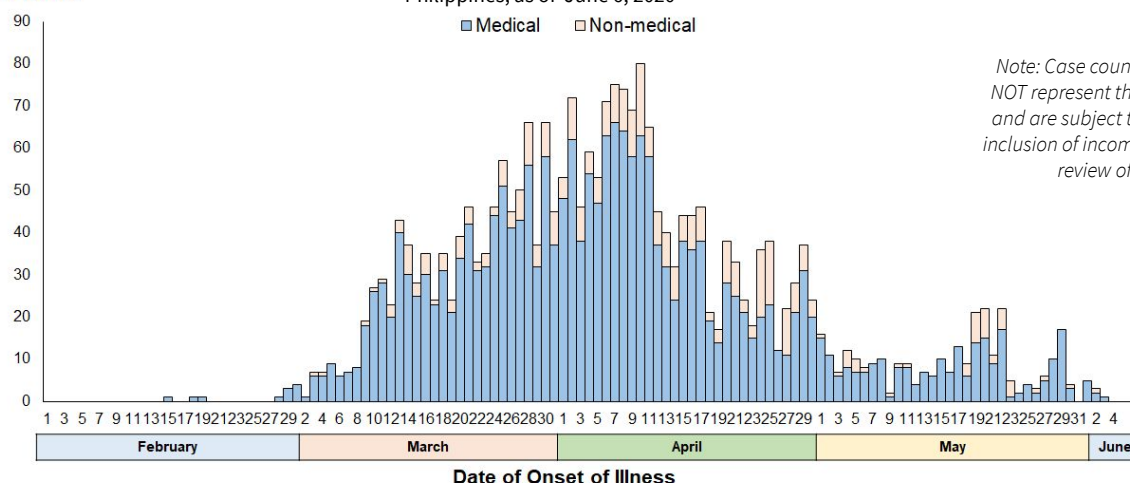

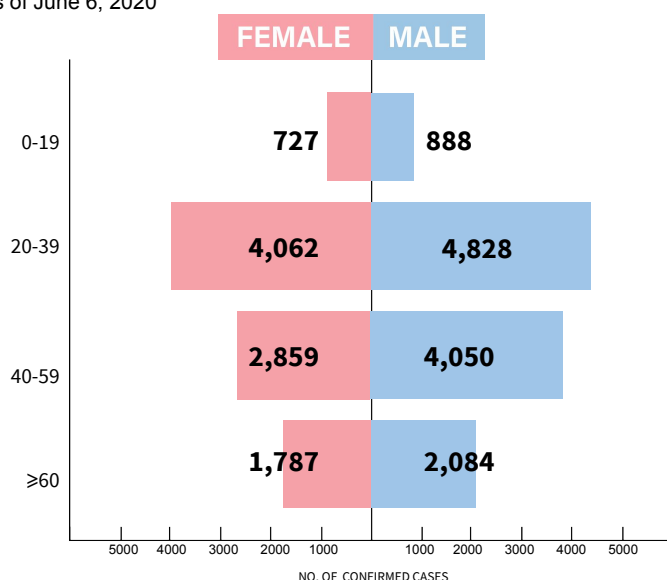

Most of the confirmed cases are Male (11,884 or 56%). Most cases are within the 20-39 age group. Fifty-five cases (21-female; 34-male) with unspecified age are included in the total.



Average hospital length of stay for recovered patients is at **11 days**.



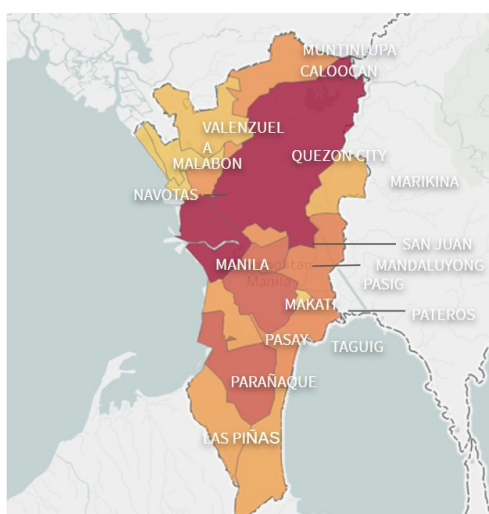
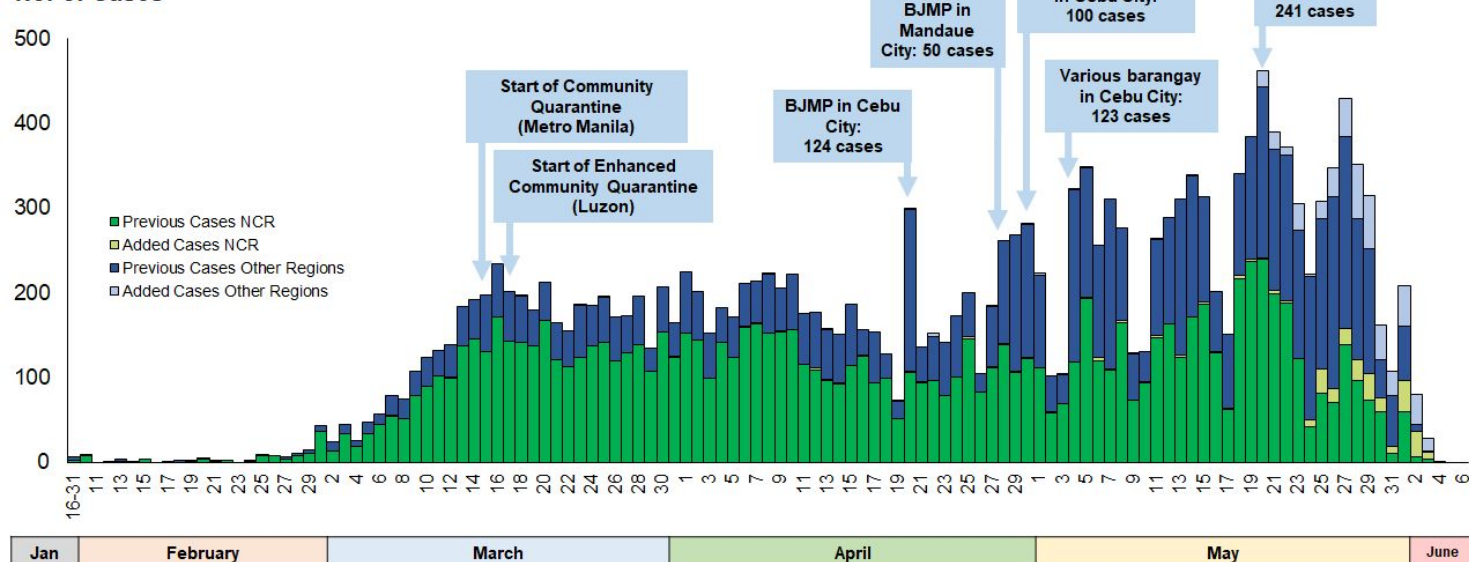
A total of 490 (49%) deaths had known comorbidities: top 2 comorbidities are hypertension (292 or 60%) and diabetes (224 or 46%).

A total of 11,914 (56%) are confirmed cases from NCR. The proportion of cases in NCR decreased from 72% since January (start of case detection) to April 19, 2020 to 49% for the period of April 20 to June 6, 2020.

Meanwhile, cases in Region 7 increased in proportion from 2% to 20% for the similar period. On May 4, 2020, 123 (38%) out of the 321 confirmed cases nationwide (by date of onset), were reported from various barangay in Cebu City. Region 7 recorded a total of 3,273 (15%) confirmed cases, the second highest reported in the country.

Region 4-A has the third highest cases with a total of 1,802 (8%) confirmed cases as of yesterday. Since start of case detection to April 19, the proportion of cases in Region 4A decreased from 15% to 5% for the period of April 20 to June 6.

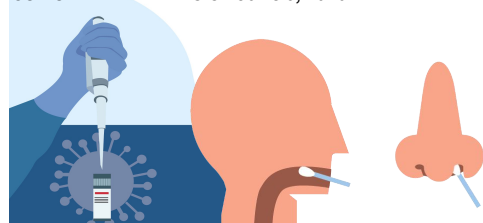

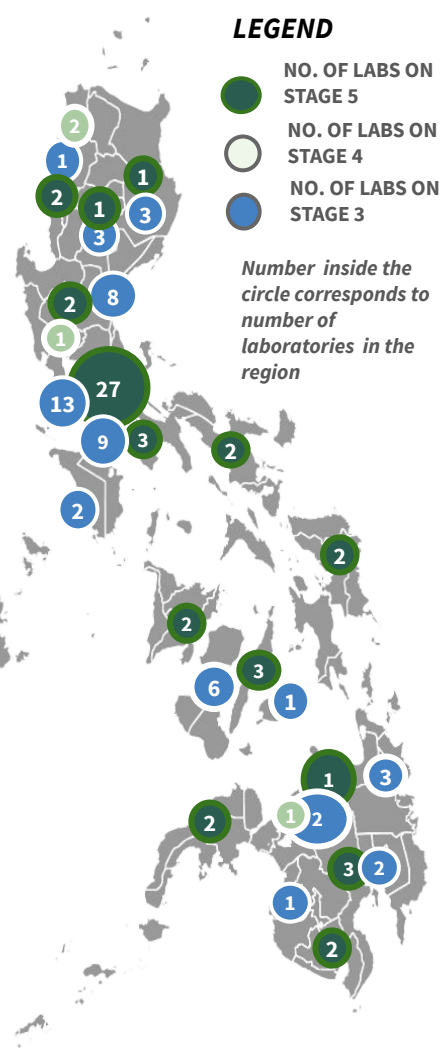

ALWAYS remember and practice the following:



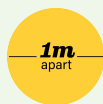
Wash hands with soap and water for 20 seconds or more (Try singing the chorus of your favorite song while washing).



Use a hand sanitizer with 70% alcohol if you can't wash your hands for 20 seconds or more.



Avoid touching your face, especially your mouth, eyes, nose.



Make sure you keep 1 meter distance from other people.



Avoid touching things that many people touch like door handles, tables, chairs, etc.



Wear a mask while outside.



Frequently clean surfaces in your house, work or business. This includes tables, doorknobs, light switches, countertops, handles, desks, phones, keys, keyboards, toilets, faucets, and sinks.



Disinfect using a bleach solution (7 tablespoons [100 mL] bleach for 1 liter of clean water).



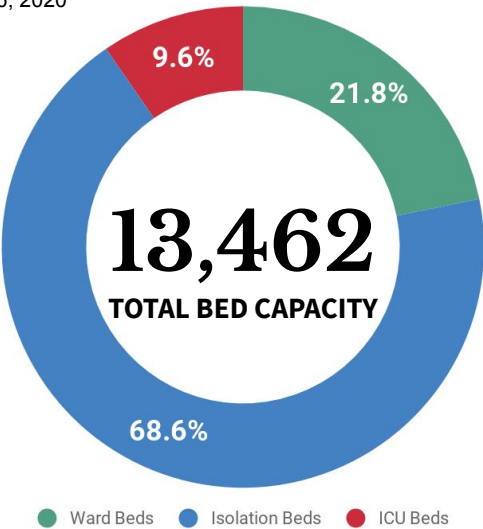
Disinfect your most used things (like phone, keys, eyeglasses, keyboard, etc.) with 70% alcohol solution.

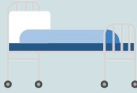

The Philippine Health Insurance Corporation, pursuant to RA. No. 11469 or the “Bayanihan to Heal as One Act” has issued PhilHealth Advisory No. 2020-035¹ “Philhealth to Prioritize at Risk Individuals and Healthcare Workers for COVID-19 Testing”. .

Philhealth has partnered with Red Cross, a DOH licensed testing laboratory for the conduct of the expanded targeted testing for COVID-19 as embodied in DOH Memorandum No. 2020-180.

POLICY IN-FOCUS

In order to provide guidance, the Department of Health has issued Department Memorandum No. 2020-0186² “Interim Guidelines on the Operations of Converted Public and Private Spaces into Temporary Treatment and Monitoring Facilities for COVID-19”.

This issuance covers all temporary treatment and monitoring facilities (TTMF) catering to suspect, probable, and confirmed COVID-19 cases with mild symptoms, and the Local Government Units (LGU) and other agencies managing them.
