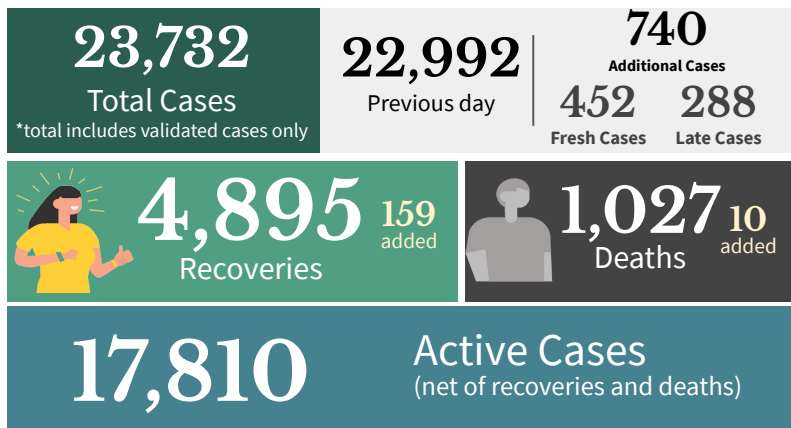

## Highlights and Recent Updates on COVID-19

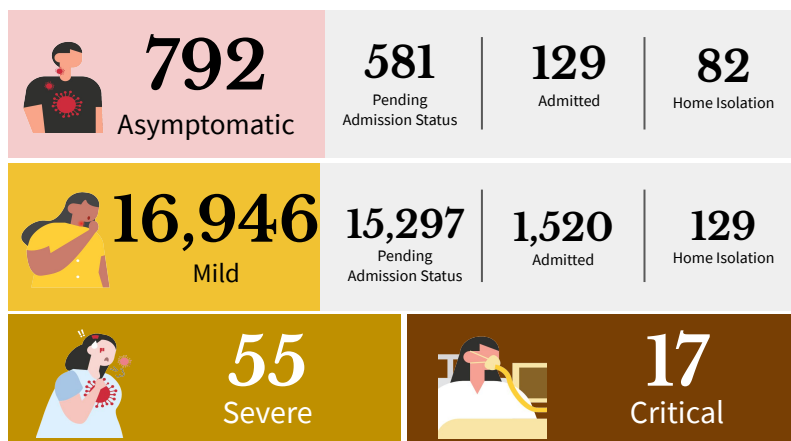
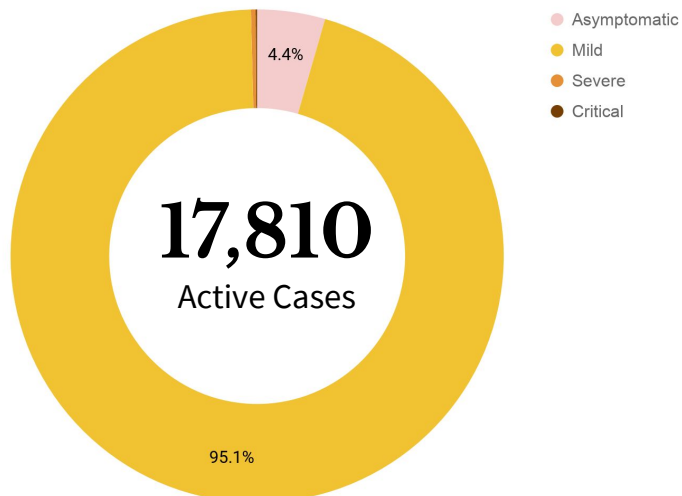
- DOH recorded **17,810 active cases** as of June 10, with the majority of the patients exhibiting **mild symptoms** (16,946; 95.1%).
- A total of **2,808 (12% of all cases) healthcare workers** have been affected by COVID-19, with **1,664 recoveries** and **33 deaths**.
- There are now **42 licensed laboratories** across the country equipped to perform the **RT-PCR test** for COVID-19 while there are **15 laboratories** licensed to perform COVID-19 testing using **GeneXpert cartridges**.
- Overall capacity to manage and admit COVID-19 patients is still adequate with **more than 50% beds and mechanical ventilators in ICU, isolation, and COVID wards available** based on data gathered from DOH *DataCollectApp*.
- DOH intensifies its advocacy on **voluntary blood donation** especially during this time. DOH calls for the public to **save lives by donating blood**.
- DOH urges the public to **take care of their mental health** as part of measures to protect themselves during this time. If you need a professional who can talk about your mental health, call the **National Center for Mental Health hotlines: 0917-899-USAP (8727) or (02) 7 989-USAP (8727)**.
- DOH underscores the importance of observing **minimum health standards** such as appropriate use of PPE, physical distancing, cough etiquette, and proper hygiene to **stay safe and healthy amidst the COVID-19 pandemic**.

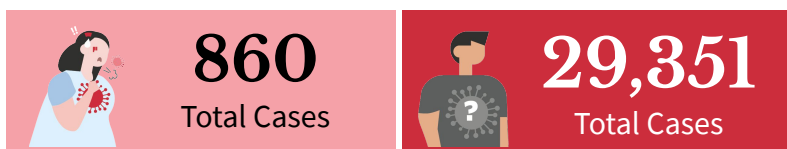


### Active Cases Breakdown

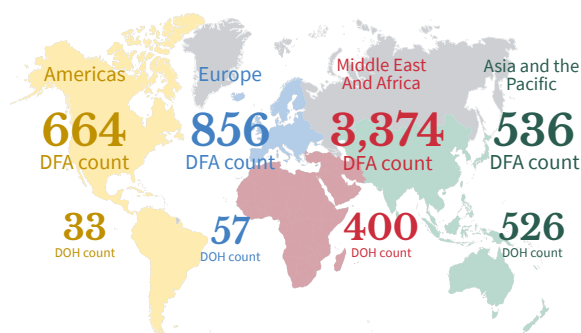

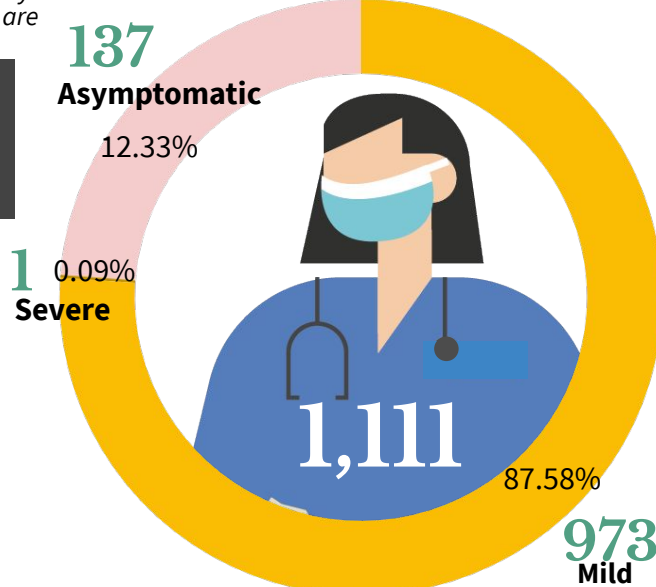

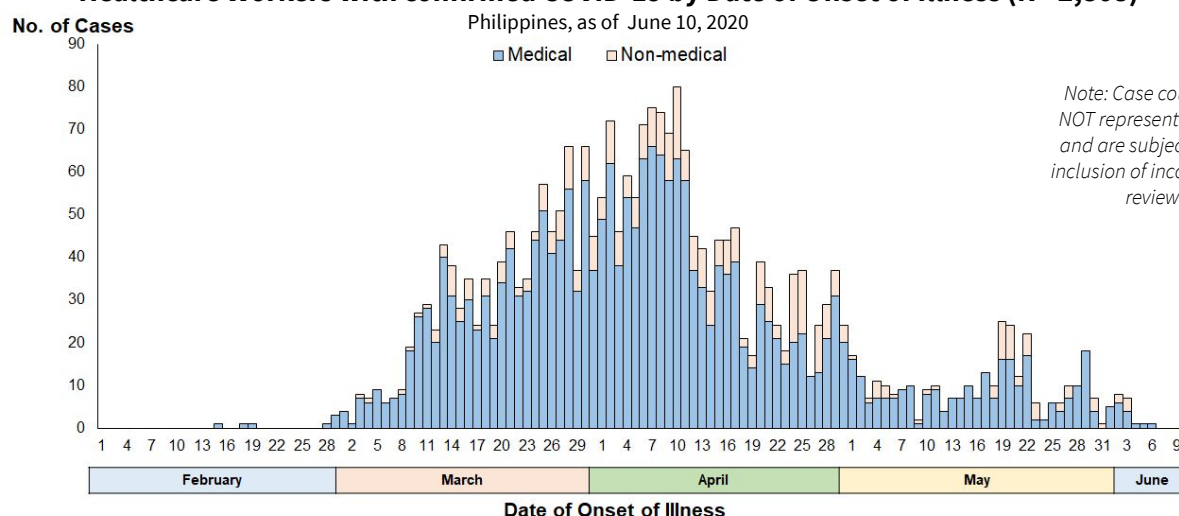

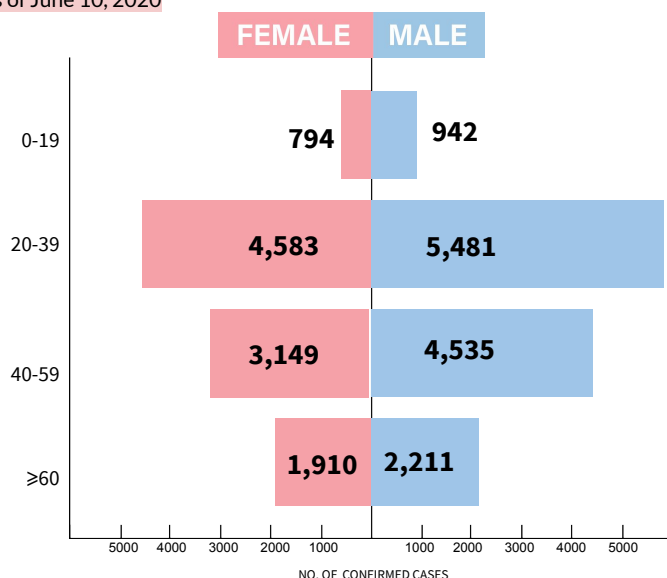
## Healthcare Workers with confirmed COVID-19 by Date of Onset of Illness (N= 2,808)



# Goal: Shortening Duration of Infectiousness

## Age and Sex Distribution of confirmed cases

As of June 10, 2020



Most of the confirmed cases are Male (13,264 or 56%). Most cases are within the 20-39 age group. Two-hundred one cases (65-female; 136-male) with unspecified age are included in the total.



Average hospital length of stay for recovered patients is at **11 days**.



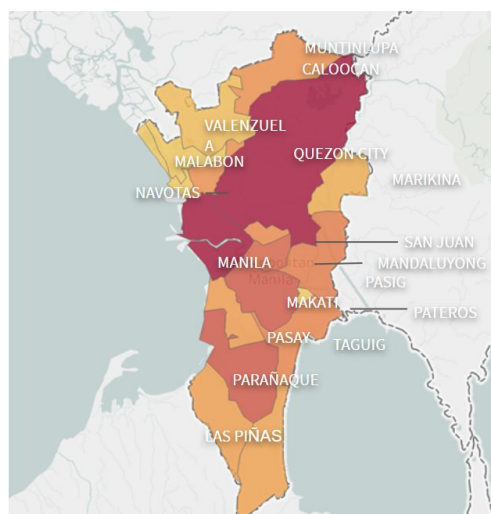
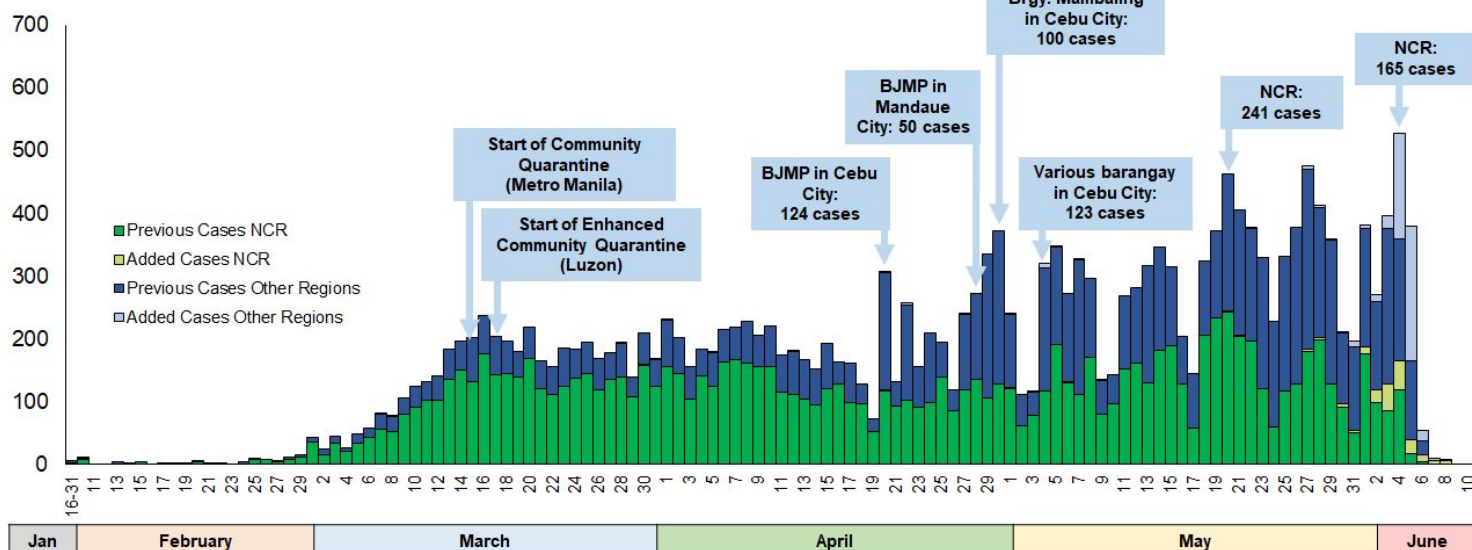
A total of 491 (48%) deaths had known comorbidities: top 2 comorbidities are hypertension (292 or 60%) and diabetes (225 or 46%).

## No. of Cases



A total of 12,831 (54%) are confirmed cases from NCR. The proportion of cases in NCR decreased from 62% since January (start of case detection) to May 19, 2020 to 39% for the period of May 20 to June 10, 2020.

Meanwhile, cases in Region 7 increased in proportion from 13% to 21% for the similar period. On May 4, 2020, 123 (38%) out of the 323 confirmed cases nationwide (by date of onset), were reported from various barangay in Cebu City. Region 7 recorded a total of 3,810 (16%) confirmed cases, the second highest reported in the country.

Region 4-A has the third highest cases with a total of 1,919 (8%) confirmed cases as of yesterday. Since start of case detection to May 19, the proportion of cases in Region 4A decreased from 11% to 4% for the period of May 20 to June 10.

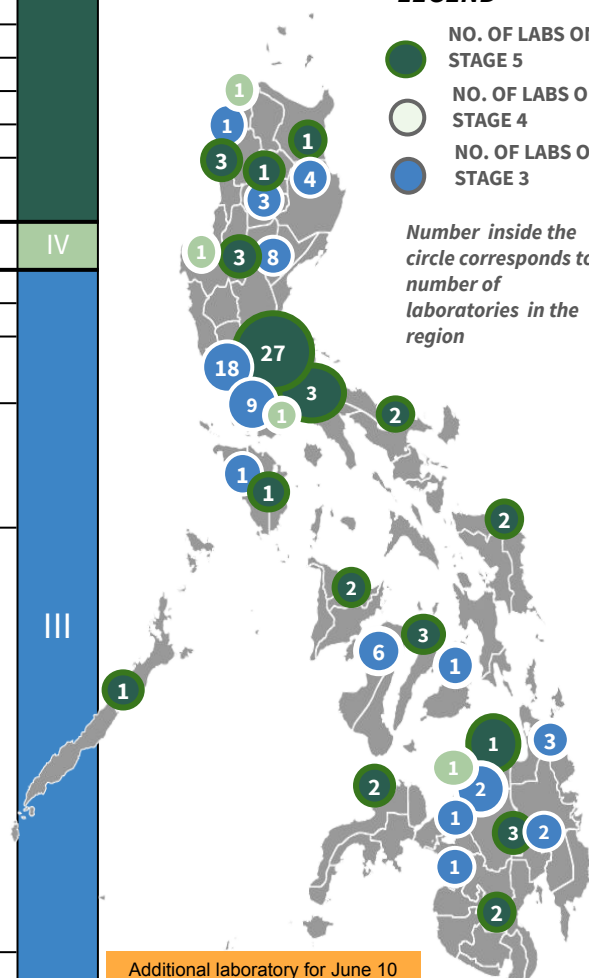

## BEHAVIORAL MESSAGES OF THE DAY

As of June 10, 2020

- Healthcare workers may face to stigma due to the nature of their work, notwithstanding their possible exposure to the virus itself. They may experience stigma from different sectors of society—even among their own families, close friends, co-workers, and law enforcers. This will make an already challenging and stressful situation worse and can interfere with their ability to serve. We must care for them as we would any member of our society.
- Everyone is enjoined in appreciating and applauding frontline health care workers, and people must recognize that the HCWs themselves have emotions and limitations – they should not have to face discrimination.

- As per IATF Resolution No. 38, for areas under the General Community Quarantine or GCQ, outdoor non-contact sports such as walking, jogging, running, biking, and swimming are permitted. But people are reminded to wear face masks at all times, practice hand hygiene and proper coughing manners, and maintain one-meter distance from others. Mass gatherings and sporting events are still prohibited.
- The call for blood donors is also reiterated to help patients in need, especially in these crucial times.

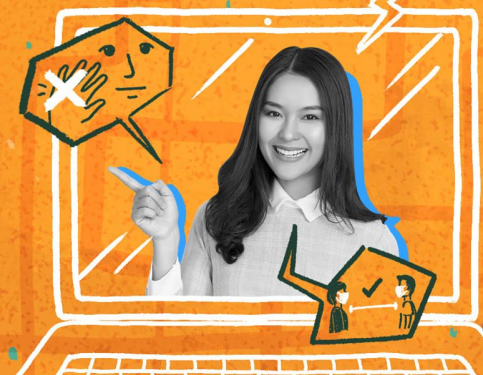

## HOW DO YOU MAKE 0.05% DISINFECTANT SOLUTION FOR CLEANING HOUSEHOLD ITEMS?

**1. Gather all materials needed: disinfectant container, bleach/chlorine, water, personal protective equipment**



**2. Wear appropriate personal protective equipment (gloves, goggles, apron and boots) when handling and preparing bleach solutions.**



100 mL bleach + 900mL tubig

1 kutsara (20g) ng chlorine + 20 L tubig



**3. When preparing the solution, pour the amount of water required into a plastic container then add the bleach (and not the other way around):**

**4. If you are using household bleach (5% active chlorine), mix:**

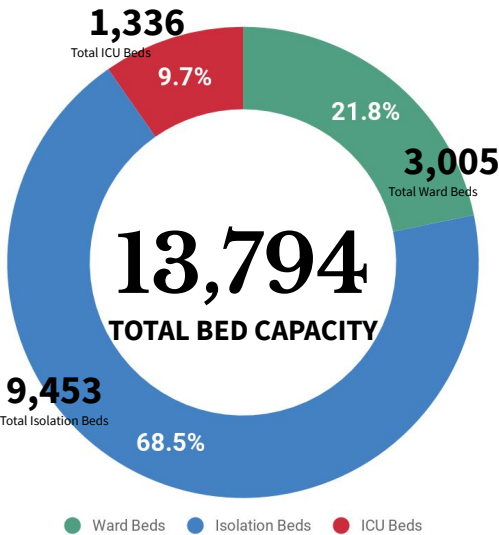
- 1 ml bleach + 9 ml water, or
- 100 ml bleach + 900 ml water
- For chlorine powder/granules/tablet (60-70%) active chlorine, dissolve: 1 tbsp of chlorine + 20L of water

**5. Do not forget to label your disinfectant containers and specify chlorine concentration.**

## PHILHEALTH FOR ALL

In order to ease the financial burden being suffered by all Filipinos during the coronavirus pandemic, the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation has issued PhilHealth Advisory No. 2020-037<sup>1</sup> otherwise known as Payment deadlines of PhilHealth Contributions for OFWs. This rule may be observed by OFWs affected by the enforcement of RA 11223 otherwise known as the Universal Health Care Act of 2019.

## POLICY IN-FOCUS

The Department of Health has issued Department Memorandum No. 2020-0198<sup>2</sup> "Interim Guidelines on Reintegration into the Community of Close Contacts, Suspect, Probable, and Confirmed COVID-19 Cases" to provide guidance for the reintegration of close contacts and suspect, probable, and confirmed cases of COVID-19 back to their communities.
