

A patient with an RT-PCR confirmed case of COVID-19 without any symptoms. A patient with mild symptoms and stable vital signs. Unless the patient belongs to high-risk subgroups or has comordibities, they are often

not admitted to a treatment



A patient with difficulty breathing, altered mental status, considered high-risk or in need of hospital care.



A patient with impending or ongoing respiratory failure, in need of mechanical ventilation, or with evidence of end-organ damage.

Note. A person who is classified as having a mild case of COVID-19 but is considered high-risk due to age or the presence of comorbidities must be admitted to a treatment facility. Severe or critical cases must be admitted to a treatment facility, regardless of inclusion in high-risk subgroups or presence of commordibities.



1. Bars with **red** colors indicate the actual date of onset or date of death for newly-reported cases.

2. In cases where date of onset of illness is unreported, date of specimen collection was used as proxy. Cases that do not have both are not accounted for in the date of onset histogram. As of this situation report, around 10% of cases have unreported dates of specimen collection and onset of illness.

3. Owing to delays in reporting, case counts after the **dashed lines** are still incomplete. Hence, we urge caution in interpreting data beyond this date. Rest assured that the DOH continues to work tirelessly to ensure the timely reporting of accurate data.

HIGHLIGHTS AND RECENT UPDATES ON COVID-19

As of June 16, 2020

- DOH recorded **19,126 active cases** as of June 16, with the majority of the patients exhibiting **mild symptoms** (18,639; 97.4%) while the number of patients on critical stage remains the same from yesterday's data (17; 0.1%).
- There are now **64,533 Returning Overseas Filipinos (ROF) who have arrived** (Land-based: 21,124; Sea-based: 43,409). Of these, 56,805 were released from facility quarantine (Land-based: 16,722; Sea-based: 40,083). Among the ROFs, 1,601 were confirmed COVID-19 (Land-based: 829; Sea-based: 772). Among the confirmed COVID-19 ROF, 772 are currently admitted (Land-based: 478; Sea-based: 294); 543 recovered; and 1 death.
- As of reporting, a total of **77 donations** (of surgical masks, N95 masks, ventilators, PPEs/medical coveralls) to the DOH were facilitated by the Donations Team from both foreign and local donors.
- Though quarantine measures have eased up in some areas, everyone is still advised to **stay at home**.

HOW DO YOU REMAIN SAFE AND HEALTHY AMIDST THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC?

ALWAYS remember and practice the following:



Wash hands with soap and water for 20 seconds or more (Try singing the chorus of your favorite song while washing).



Use a hand sanitizer with 70% alcohol if you can't wash your hands for 20 seconds or more.



Avoid touching your face, especially your mouth, eyes, nose.



Make sure you keep 1 meter distance from other people.



Avoid touching things that many people touch like door handles, tables, chairs, etc.

Wear a mask while outside.

Frequently clean surfaces in your house, work or business. This includes tables, doorknobs, light switches, countertops, handles, desks, phones, keys, keyboards, toilets, faucets, and sinks.




Disinfect using a bleach solution (7 tablespoons [100 mL] bleach for 1 liter of clean water).



Disinfect your most used things (like phone, keys, eyeglasses, keyboard, etc.) with 70% alcohol solution.
