




Breakdown of Active Cases




A patient with an RT-PCR confirmed case of COVID-19 without symptoms.



A patient with mild symptoms and stable vital signs. Unless the patient belongs to high-risk subgroups or has comorbidities, they are often not admitted to a treatment facility.




A patient with difficulty breathing, altered mental status, considered high-risk or in need of hospital care.




A patient with impending or ongoing respiratory failure, in need of mechanical ventilation, or with evidence of end-organ damage.

Note. A person who is classified as having a mild case of COVID-19 but is considered high-risk due to age or the presence of comorbidities must be admitted to a treatment facility. Severe or critical cases must be admitted to a treatment facility, regardless of inclusion in high-risk subgroups or presence of comorbidities.

1. Bars with red colors indicate the actual date of onset or date of death for cases reported from June 14 to June 20.
2. In cases where date of onset of illness is unreported, date of specimen collection was used as proxy. Cases that do not have both are not accounted for in the date of onset histogram. As of this situation report, around 10% of cases have unreported dates of specimen collection and onset of illness.
3. **Owing to delays in reporting, case counts after the dashed lines are still incomplete. Hence, we urge caution in interpreting data beyond this date.** Rest assured that the DOH continues to work tirelessly to ensure the timely reporting of accurate data.



Average hospital length of stay for recovered patients is at **14.3 days**. The average hospital length of stay has been going down significantly, from 15.4 days for patients admitted in March, 14.4 days for patients admitted in April, and 11.1 days for patients admitted in May.




A total of 523 (45%) deaths had known comorbidities: the top 2 comorbidities are hypertension (299 or 57%) and diabetes (229 or 44%).







CUMULATIVE POSITIVE INDIVIDUALS



This week, an average of 12,313 samples were processed each day by 59 laboratories. 5,045 specimens tested positive, for a weekly positivity rate of 6.5 percent. Of the 5,045 specimens that tested positive, 1,293 (26%) came from labs in Region VII, and 3,306 (66%) came from labs in NCR. In terms of positivity rates, 31 percent of individual specimens (1,293 out of 4,142) tested positive in Region VII labs, while 7 percent of individual specimens (3,306 out of 50,315) tested positive in NCR labs.



Healthcare Workers with confirmed COVID-19 by Date of Onset of Illness (N= 3,122)




BEHAVIORAL MESSAGES OF THE DAY

As of June 20, 2020

- As the country ushers into the a new normal, minimum health standards are essential to keep everyone healthy and safe. The best way to minimize the exposure from COVID-19 is staying at home. Everyone is enjoined to stay healthy both physically and mentally. Eating a well-balanced diet, that includes plenty of fruits, vegetable, and food rich in proteins, is the best way to get all the essential nutrients we need for good health and normal immune function. Avoid eating high-sodium and high-sugar food. Avoid smoking, drink lots of water to avoid dehydration, and get an average of seven to eight hours of sleep as recommended.
- Healthcare workers may be subjected to stigma due to the nature of their work at this time, notwithstanding their possible exposure to the virus itself. They may experience stigma from different sectors of society – even among their own families, close friends, co-workers and law enforcers. This will make an already challenging and stressful situation worse and can interfere with their ability to serve. We must care for them as we would any member of our society.
- Everyone is enjoined in appreciating and applauding frontline health care workers, and people must recognize that the HCWs themselves have emotions and limitations – they should not have to face discrimination.

HOW DO YOU REMAIN SAFE AND HEALTHY AMIDST THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC?

ALWAYS remember and practice the following:



Wash hands with soap and water for 20 seconds or more (Try singing the chorus of your favorite song while washing).



Use a hand sanitizer with 70% alcohol if you can't wash your hands for 20 seconds or more.



Avoid touching your face, especially your mouth, eyes, nose.



Make sure you keep 1 meter distance from other people.



Avoid touching things that many people touch like door handles, tables, chairs, etc.



Wear a mask while outside.



Frequently clean surfaces in your house, work or business. This includes tables, doorknobs, light switches, countertops, handles, desks, phones, keys, keyboards, toilets, faucets, and sinks.



Disinfect using a bleach solution (7 tablespoons [100 mL] bleach for 1 liter of clean water).



Disinfect your most used things (like phone, keys, eyeglasses, keyboard, etc.) with 70% alcohol solution.

RECENT UPDATES ON COVID-19

- DOH has recorded **20,600 active cases** as of June 20, with the majority of the patients exhibiting **mild symptoms** (19,963; 96.9%) while 18 patients are in critical condition (0.1%).
- As of 20 June 2020, there are 3,122 healthcare workers have been infected by COVID-19, of which 2,235 have recovered, and 33 have died.
- DOH cautions the public against the **non-prescribed purchase** and **unregulated use of dexamethasone** as either for prophylaxis or cure from COVID-19.
- In light of the National Safe Kids Week, DOH promotes **injury prevention and improved safety protocols for children** as they are spending more time at home due to the pandemic. Parents can prevent injuries by limiting their child's access to potentially harmful objects and areas. It is equally important for parents to keep a watchful eye as they play and move around to avoid potential injuries.
- The DOH reiterates the importance of observing **minimum health standards** such as appropriate use of PPE, and practicing physical distancing, cough etiquette, and proper hygiene to **stay safe and healthy amidst the COVID-19 pandemic**.

POLICY IN-FOCUS

The Department of Health has issued Department Memorandum N0. 2020-0258¹ "Updated Interim Guidelines on Expanded Testing for COVID-19" In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Inter-Agency Task Force on Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF-EID) National Action Plan set forth the "Detect, Isolate, and Treat" strategies to mitigate, identify, contain, and manage the disease.
