# **Breakdown of Active Cases**



586 (2.8%) Asymptomatic

A patient with an RT-PCR confirmed case of COVID-19 without symptoms.



A patient with mild symptoms and stable vital signs. Unless the patient belongs to high-risk subgroups or has comorbidities, they are often not admitted to a treatment facility.



A patient with difficulty breathing, altered mental status, considered high-risk or in need of hospital care.



A patient with impending or ongoing respiratory failure, in need of mechanical ventilation, or with evidence of end-organ damage.

**Note.** A person who is classified as having a mild case of COVID-19 but is considered high-risk due to age or the presence of comorbidities must be admitted to a treatment facility. Severe or critical cases must be admitted to a treatment facility, regardless of inclusion in high-risk subgroups or presence of comorbidities.

#### **HIGHLIGHTS AND UPDATES ON COVID-19**

As of June 21, 2020

- DOH has recorded **20,990 active cases** as of June 21, with the majority of the patients exhibiting mild symptoms (20.317; 96.8%) while the number of patients on critical stage is 19 or 0.1% of the total active cases).
- As of 21 June 2020, there are **3,132** healthcare workers who have been infected by COVID-19, of which 2,266 have recovered, and 33 have died.
- As of 21 June 2020, a total of 70,380 Returning Overseas Filipinos (ROFs) have arrived (Land-based: 24,219; Sea-based: 46,161). Of these, 56,805 were already released from facility quarantine (Land-based: 16,722; Sea-based: 40,083). Among the Returning Overseas Filipino, 1,849 were confirmed COVID-19 (Land-based: 960; Seabased: 889). Among the confirmed COVID-19 ROFs, 467 are currently admitted (Land-based: 323; Sea-based: 144); 1,095 have recovered; and 1 died.
- As of 21 June 2020, 5 PM, the DOH has approved a total of 8,553 slots for hiring in 286 health facilities. Of these, 49.0% are hired in DOH Hospitals, 13.8% in DOH Designated Diagnostic Facility, 13.0% in National and Local TTMF, 9.4% in LGU Hospitals, 8.3% in COVID referral hospitals, 4.5% in quarantine facilities and airport units managed by BOQ, 1.0% in RESU/PESU, and 0.8% in Private Diagnostic Facility.
