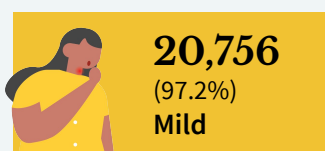


Breakdown of Active Cases



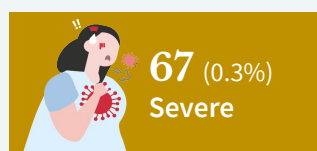

Asymptomatic

A patient with an RT-PCR confirmed case of COVID-19 without symptoms.



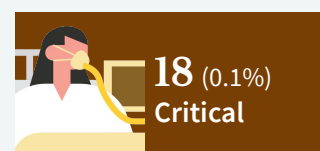

(97.2%)
Mild

A patient with mild symptoms and stable vital signs. Unless the patient belongs to high-risk subgroups or has comorbidities, they are often not admitted to a treatment facility.



67 (0.3%)
Severe

A patient with difficulty breathing, altered mental status, considered high-risk or in need of hospital care.



18 (0.1%)
Critical

A patient with impending or ongoing respiratory failure, in need of mechanical ventilation, or with evidence of end-organ damage.

Note. A person who is classified as having a mild case of COVID-19 but is considered high-risk due to age or the presence of comorbidities must be admitted to a treatment facility. Severe or critical cases must be admitted to a treatment facility, regardless of inclusion in high-risk subgroups or presence of comorbidities.

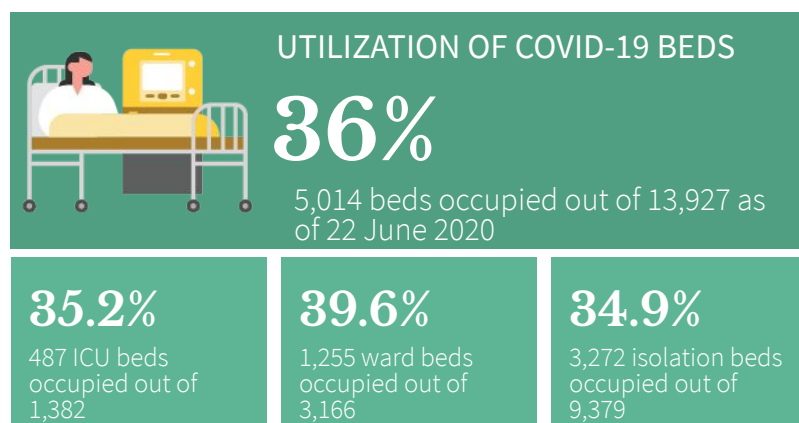

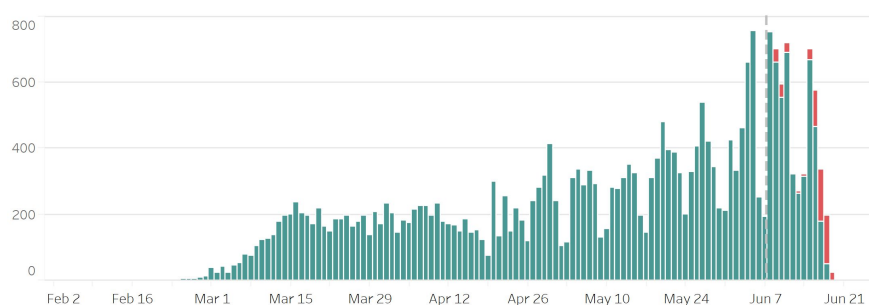

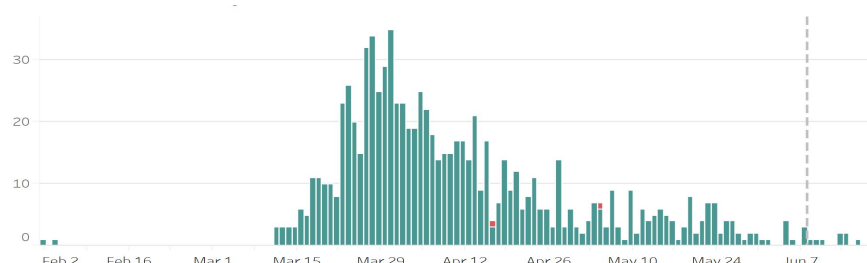

Notes.

- Bars with red colors indicate the actual date of onset or date of death for newly-reported cases.
- In cases where date of onset of illness is unreported, date of specimen collection was used as proxy. Cases that do not have both are not accounted for in the date of onset histogram. As of this situation report, around 10% of cases have unreported dates of specimen collection and onset of illness.
- Owing to delays in reporting, case counts after the dashed lines are still incomplete. Hence, we urge caution in interpreting data beyond this date. Rest assured that the DOH continues to work tirelessly to ensure the timely reporting of accurate data.

HIGHLIGHTS AND UPDATES ON COVID-19

As of June 22, 2020

- DOH has recorded **21,362 active cases** as of June 22, with the majority of the patients exhibiting **mild symptoms** (20,756; 97.2%) while the number of patients on critical condition is 18 or 0.1% of the total active cases).
- As of 22 June 2020, there are **3,145 healthcare workers** who have been infected by COVID-19, of which 2,299 have recovered, and 33 have died.
- As of reporting, **73,600 Returning Overseas Filipinos** (ROFs) have arrived (Land-based: 25,085; Sea-based: 48,515). Of this figure, 66,567 have been released from facility quarantine (Land-based: 21,080; Sea-based: 45,487). Among the ROFs, 1,910 were confirmed COVID-19 (Land-based: 993; Sea-based: 917). Among the confirmed COVID-19 ROF, 477 are currently admitted (Land-based: 332; Sea-based: 145); 1,215 recovered; and 1 died.
- During this time of pandemic, everyone can be **“Socially Connected but Physically Distant”** through text messaging and social or traditional media. Constant communication with families and other loved ones through texting, video phone calls can mitigate the various challenges and stressors brought about by COVID-19 to one's mental condition.
