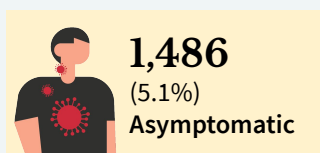

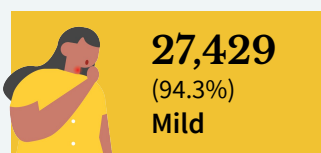

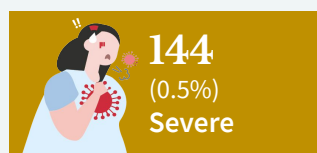
Breakdown of Active Cases



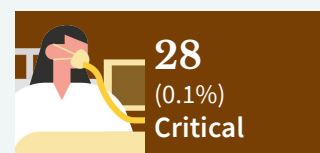
A patient with an RT-PCR confirmed case of COVID-19 without symptoms.



A patient with mild symptoms and stable vital signs. Unless the patient belongs to high-risk subgroups or has comorbidities, they are often not admitted to a treatment facility.



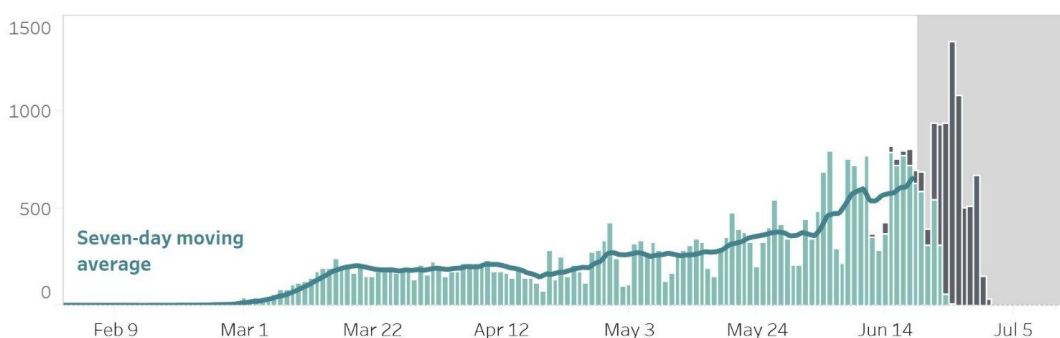
A patient with difficulty breathing, altered mental status, considered high-risk or in need of hospital care.



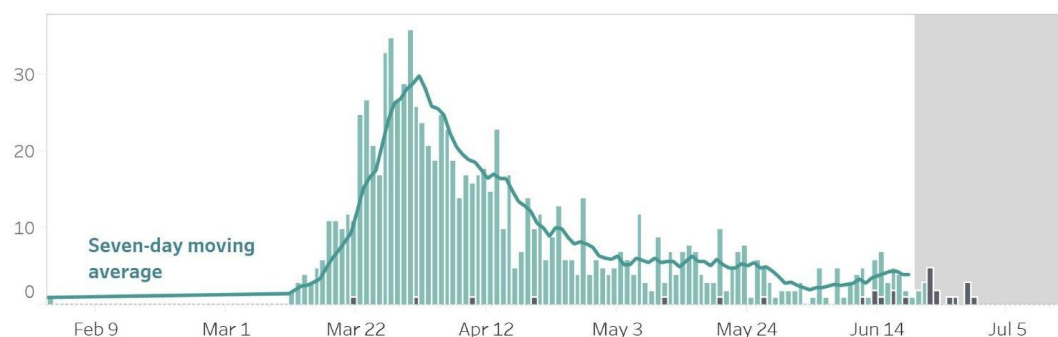
A patient with impending or ongoing respiratory failure, in need of mechanical ventilation, or with evidence of end-organ damage.

Note. A person who is classified as having a mild case of COVID-19 but is considered high-risk due to age or the presence of comorbidities must be admitted to a treatment facility. Severe or critical cases must be admitted to a treatment facility, regardless of inclusion in high-risk subgroups or presence of comorbidities.

1. Bars with dark green colors indicate the actual date of onset or date of death for cases reported from June 28 to July 4.
2. In cases where date of onset of illness is unreported, date of specimen collection was used as proxy. Cases that do not have both are not accounted for in the date of onset histogram. As of this situation report, around 10% of cases have unreported dates of specimen collection and onset of illness.
3. **Owing to delays in reporting, case counts in the gray shaded area are still most likely incomplete. Hence, we urge caution in interpreting data beyond this date.** Rest assured that the DOH continues to work tirelessly to ensure the timely reporting of accurate data.

CONFIRMED CASES BY DATE OF ONSET OF ILLNESS (DISAGGREGATED)



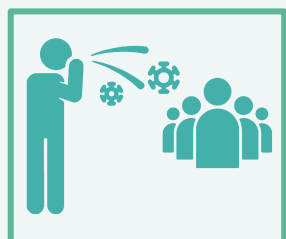

Reproduction number**



The time-varying **reproduction number (R_t)** indicates the possible number of people being infected by a sick person, at a specific time with control measures in place.

IMPORTANT NOTE. The reproduction number is measured using symptom onset, we do not include in the interpretation the past 14-16 days given the time between symptoms, health seeking, testing, and reporting. When interpreting the reproduction number keep in mind that it is a **lagging indicator (that is, it provides a snapshot of the situation two weeks ago)**. Please do not expect this number to change daily.

- The reproduction number (R_t) was around 2 early on in the outbreak. This meant that each confirmed person with COVID was infecting 2 other people.
- Based on the latest data, we are 95 percent confident that $R_t = 1.09 \pm 0.03$, which means each infected individual was infecting an average of 1.09 other persons **around two weeks ago**.
- **Lowering this value is made possible through efforts such as social distancing, wearing of PPE, and other means to stop the spread of the virus.**
- The goal is for R_t to be less than 1, which would mean that, on average, an infected person is infecting less than one person, eventually stopping the transmission of COVID-19.

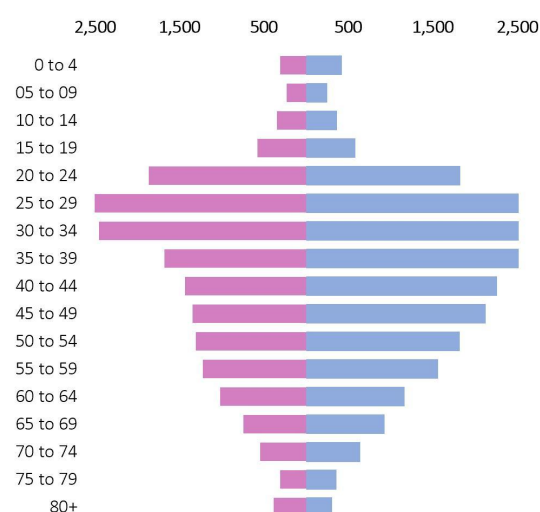

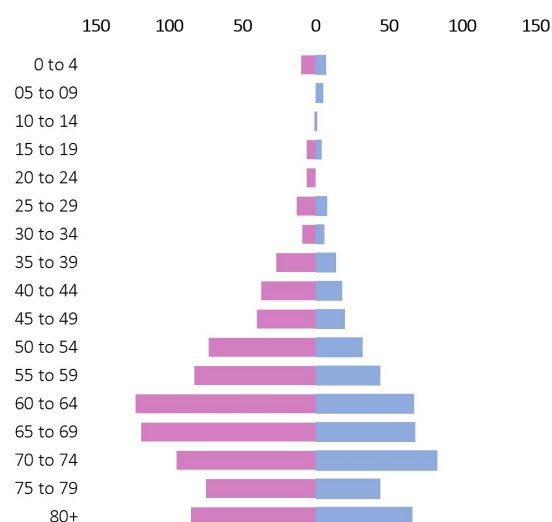

AGE AND SEX DISTRIBUTION: DEATHS

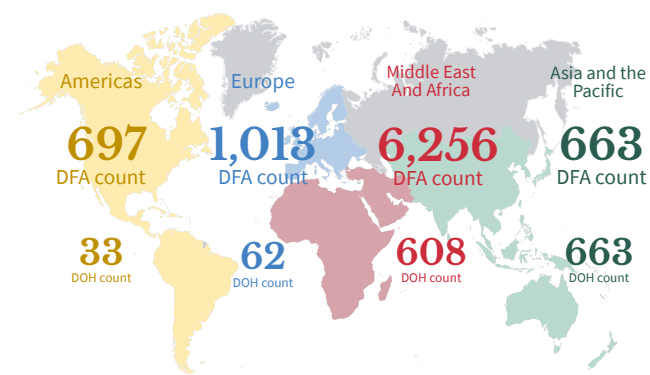

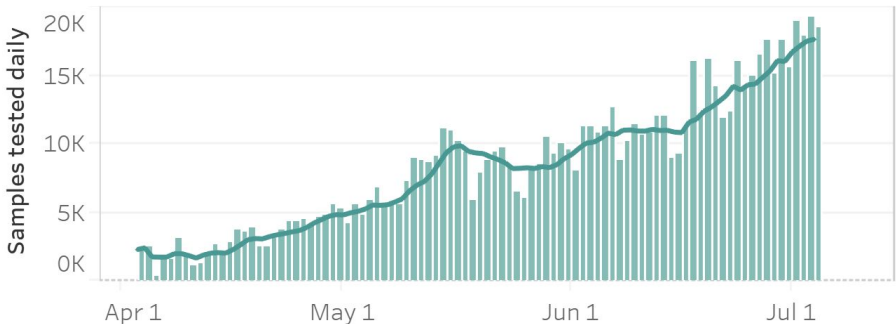

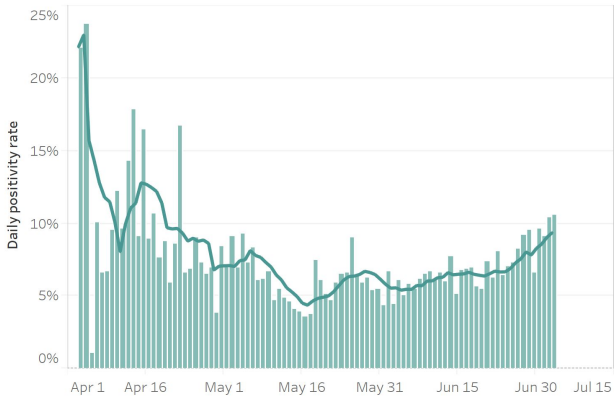

Note: The DOH is continuously validating the number of positive individuals as reported by the laboratories. When necessary, they are deduplicated. **As such, the discrepancy with the number of confirmed cases do not necessarily reflect backlogs in case validation.**

This week, an average of 17,652 samples were processed each day by 70 laboratories.

10,543 specimens tested positive, for a weekly positivity rate of 9.03 percent.

Of the 10,543 specimens that tested positive, 2,305 (22%) came from labs in Region VII, and 7,316 (69%) came from labs in NCR. In terms of positivity rates, 23% of individual specimens (2,305 out of 10,164) tested positive in Region VII labs, while 10% of individual specimens (7,316 out of 73,876) tested positive in NCR labs.

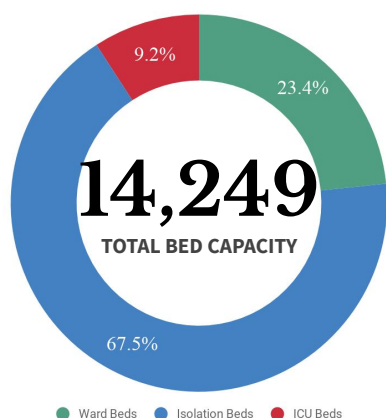

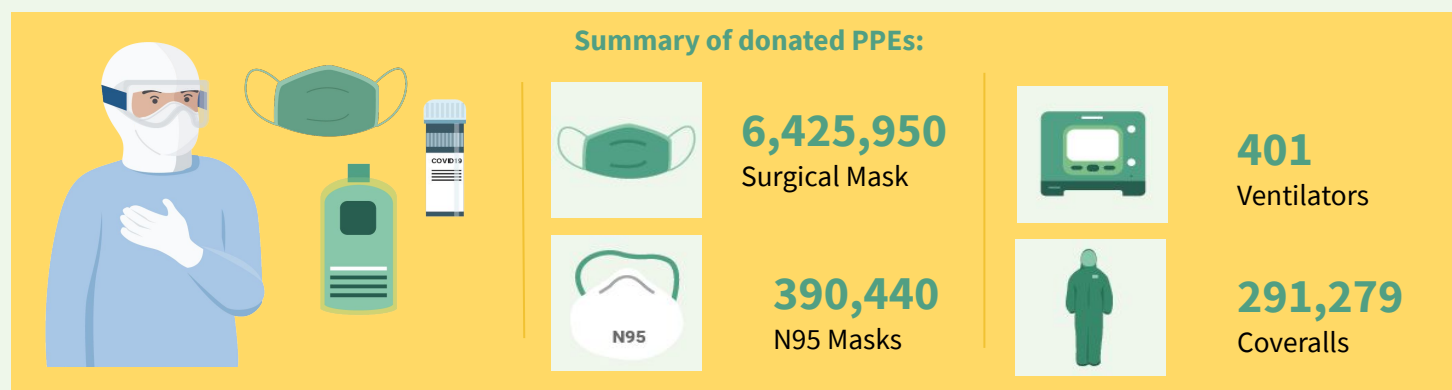

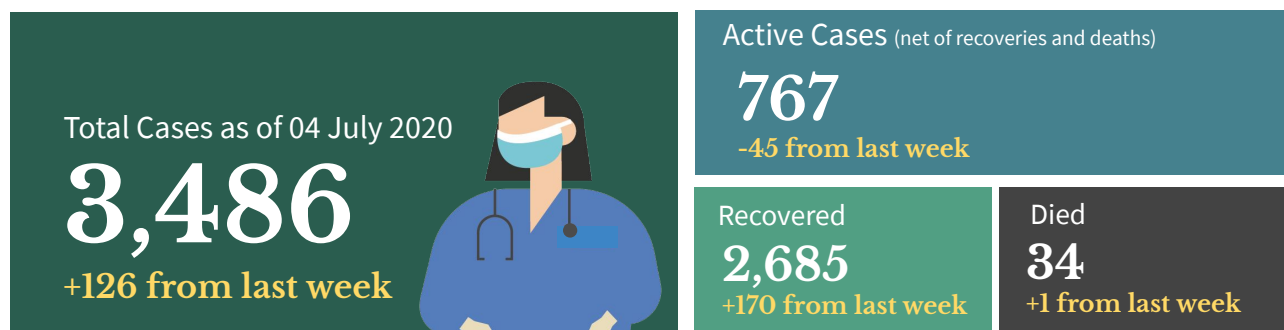

Top Healthcare workers affected by COVID-19 as of 04 July 2020

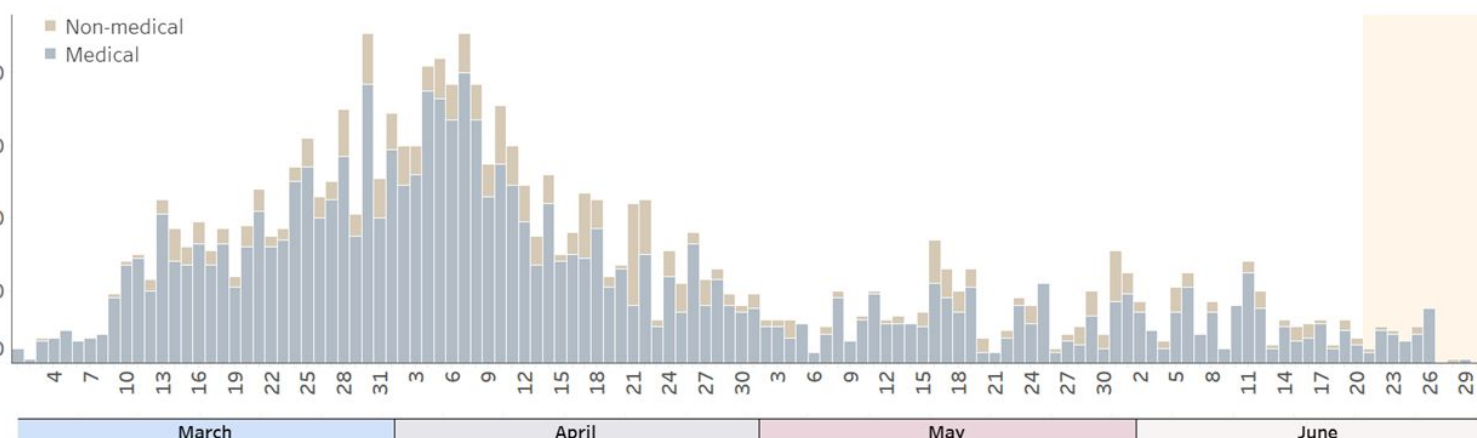

No. of cases



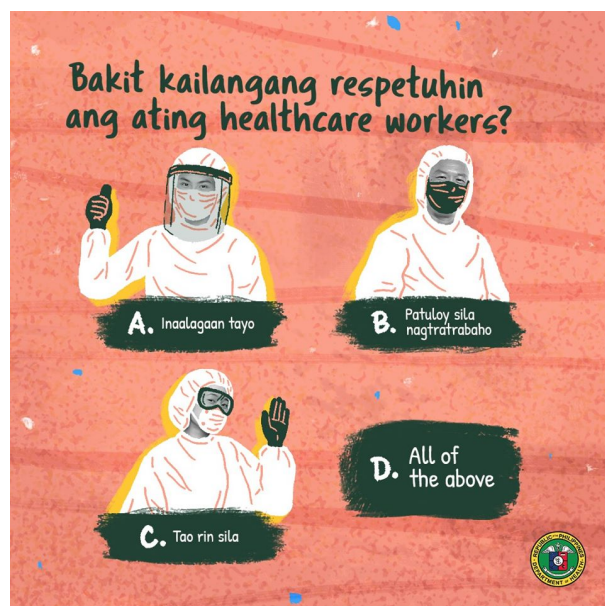

BEHAVIORAL MESSAGES OF THE DAY

As of July 04, 2020

- As the country ushers into the New Normal era, minimum health standards are essential to keep everyone healthy and safe. The best way to minimize the exposure from COVID-19 is staying at home. Everyone is enjoined to stay healthy both physically and mentally. Eating a well-balanced diet, that includes plenty of fruits, vegetables and food rich in proteins is the best way to get all the essential nutrients we need for good health and normal immune system. Avoid eating high-sodium and high-sugar food. Avoid smoking, drink lots of water to avoid dehydration, and get an average of seven to eight hours of sleep as recommended.
- Healthcare workers may be subjected to stigma due to the nature of their work at this time, notwithstanding their possible exposure to the virus itself. They may experience stigma from different sectors of society – even among their own families, close friends, co-workers and law enforcers. This will make an already challenging and stressful situation worse and can interfere with their ability to serve. We must care for them as we would for any member of our society.
- Everyone is enjoined in appreciating and applauding frontline health care workers, and people must recognize that the HCWs themselves have emotions and limitations – they should not have to face discrimination.

HOW DO YOU REMAIN SAFE AND HEALTHY AMIDST THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC?

ALWAYS remember and practice the following:



Wash hands with soap and water for 20 seconds or more (Try singing the chorus of your favorite song while washing).



Use a hand sanitizer with 70% alcohol if you can't wash your hands for 20 seconds or more.



Avoid touching your face, especially your mouth, eyes, nose.



Make sure you keep 1 meter distance from other people.



Avoid touching things that many people touch like door handles, tables, chairs, etc.



Wear a mask while outside.



Frequently clean surfaces in your house, work or business. This includes tables, doorknobs, light switches, countertops, handles, desks, phones, keys, keyboards, toilets, faucets, and sinks.



Disinfect using a bleach solution (7 tablespoons [100 mL] bleach for 1 liter of clean water).



Disinfect your most used things (like phone, keys, eyeglasses, keyboard, etc.) with 70% alcohol solution.

RECENT UPDATES ON COVID-19

- As of 04 July 2020, DOH has recorded **29,087 active cases**, with the majority of the patients exhibiting **mild symptoms** (27,429; 94.3%) while 28 patients are in critical condition (0.1%).
- As of 04 July 2020, there are **3,486 healthcare workers** who have been infected by COVID-19, of which 2,685 have recovered, and 34 have died.
- As of 04 July 2020, a total of 104,486 Returning Overseas Filipino (ROF) arrived (Land-based: 45,783; Sea-based: 58,703). Of these, 97,954 were released from facility quarantine (Land-based: 41,299; Sea-based: 56, 655). Among the ROF, 2,656 were confirmed COVID-19 (Land-based:1,388; Sea-based: 1,268). Among the confirmed COVID-19 ROF, 750 are currently admitted (Land-based: 484; Sea-based: 266); 1,841 recovered; and 1 died.

TREATMENT

For case management of COVID-19 patients, healthcare providers are advised to adhere to the existing [PSMID Guidelines](#).

POLICY IN-FOCUS

The Department of Health has issued Department Memorandum No. 2020-0246¹ “Interim Guidelines on Tobacco Control in light of COVID-19 Pandemic.” Tobacco is known to damage various organ systems in the body including the respiratory system and has been known to cause around 40 diseases including infectious diseases. As the body’s immune and respiratory systems are weakened from toxic substances inherent and produced in the process of burning and/or heating tobacco and novel tobacco—related products, people are at increased risk of contracting COVID-19 and having a more severe form of illness, and may even result in death.
