

Breakdown of Active Cases



A patient with an RT-PCR confirmed case of COVID-19 without symptoms.



A patient with mild symptoms and stable vital signs. Unless the patient belongs to high-risk subgroups or has comorbidities, they are often not admitted to a treatment facility.



A patient with difficulty breathing, altered mental status, considered high-risk or in need of hospital care.




A patient with impending or ongoing respiratory failure, in need of mechanical ventilation, or with evidence of end-organ damage.

Note. A person who is classified as having a mild case of COVID-19 but is considered high-risk due to age or the presence of comorbidities must be admitted to a treatment facility. Severe or critical cases must be admitted to a treatment facility, regardless of inclusion in high-risk subgroups or presence of comorbidities.





COVID-19'S CAPACITY TO SPREAD (R, VALUE)



The time-varying **reproduction number** (R_t) indicates the possible number of people being infected by a sick person, at a specific time with control measures in place.


IMPORTANT NOTE. The reproduction number is measured using symptom onset, we do not include in the interpretation the past 14-16 days given the time between symptoms, health seeking, testing, and reporting. When interpreting the reproduction number keep in mind that it is a **lagging indicator (that is, it provides a snapshot of the situation two weeks ago)**. Please do not expect this number to change daily.

- The reproduction number (R_t) was around 2 early on in the outbreak. This meant that each confirmed person with COVID was infecting 2 other people.
- Based on the latest data, we are 95 percent confident that $R_t = 1.23 \pm 0.03$, which means each infected individual was infecting an average of 1.23 other persons **around two weeks ago**.
- Lowering this value is made possible through efforts such as social distancing, wearing of PPE, and other means to stop the spread of the virus.
 - <u>The goal is for **R**</u> to be less than 1, which would mean that, on average, an infected person is infecting less than one person, eventually stopping the transmission of COVID-19.


AGE AND SEX DISTRIBUTION: CASE COUNTS





Total positive individuals Note: The DOH is continuously validating the number of positive individuals as reported by the laboratories. When necessary, they are deduplicated. As such, the discrepancy with the number of confirmed cases do not necessarily reflect backlogs in case validation.

This week, an average of 20,966 samples were processed each day by 85 laboratories.

14,894 specimens tested positive, for a weekly positivity rate of 10.81 percent.

Of the 14,894 specimens that tested positive, 2,052 (14%) came from labs in Region VII, and 11,325 (76%) came from labs in NCR. In terms of positivity rates, 17% of individual specimens (2,052 out of 12,216) tested positive in Region VII labs, while 13% of individual specimens (11,325 out of 88,243) tested positive in NCR labs.







BEHAVIORAL MESSAGES OF THE DAY

As of July 11, 2020

- As the country ushers into the New Normal era, minimum health standards should be observed to keep everyone safe and healthy. Part of these precautions include **physical distancing**, as highlighted in the **BIDA** acronym:
 - **B**. Bawal walang mask.
 - I. I-sanitize ang mga kamay.
 - D. Dumistansya ng isang metro.
 - **A**. Alamin ang totoong impormasyon.
- While quarantine measures have eased out in some areas, going outside for non-essential reasons is still discouraged. If truly needed (such as running errands or reporting to work), everyone is advised to observe minimum health standards. As part of the New Normal, activities such as exercising outdoors should adhere to the precaution of physical distancing.
- The public is enjoined in applauding and appreciating our frontline health care workers who have been working tirelessly in attending to COVID-19 patients in hospitals and other health and quarantine facilities across the country.
- The public is reminded to educate themselves on how to take care of house members with sickness. If symptoms worsen, contact your local BHERT immediately.
- COVID-19 poses difficulties for many people, especially when it comes to nursing infants. Thus, <u>breastfeeding in the context of</u> <u>the pandemic</u> must be carefully done to ensure safety.





HOW DO YOU REMAIN SAFE AND HEALTHY AMIDST THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC? ALWAYS remember and practice the following:



Wash hands with soap and water for 20 seconds or more (Try singing the chorus of your favorite song while washing).



Use a hand sanitizer with 70% alcohol if you can't wash your hands for 20 seconds or more.



Avoid touching your face, especially your mouth, eyes, nose.




Make sure you keep 1 meter distance from other people.



Avoid touching things that many people touch like door handles, tables, chairs, etc.





Frequently clean surfaces in your house, work or business. This includes tables, doorknobs, light switches, countertops, handles, desks, phones, keys, keyboards, toilets, faucets, and sinks.



Disinfect using a bleach solution (7 tablespoons [100 mL] bleach for 1 liter of clean water).



Disinfect your most used things (like phone, keys, eyeglasses, keyboard, etc.) with 70% alcohol solution.

RECENT UPDATES ON COVID-19 As of July 11, 2020

- DOH recorded **38,813 active cases**, with the majority of the patients exhibiting **mild symptoms** (35,594; 92%) while 106 patients are in critical condition (0.3%).
- A total of 124,446 Returning Overseas Filipino (ROF) arrived (Land-based: 55,795; Sea-based: 68,256 and 395 transferees from Sabah) Of these, 117,519 were released from facility quarantine (Land-based: 51,311; Sea-based: 66,208). Among the ROF, 2,995 were confirmed COVID-19 (Land-based: 1,568; Sea-based: 1,427). Among the confirmed COVID-19 ROF, 739 are currently admitted, 2,202 already recovered; and 1 death reported.
- Also, there is a total of **1,398 cases of Filipinos staying overseas** who have been tested positive for COVID-19 and has been reported to DOH. This represents 16% of the total 8,804 confirmed cases reported by the DFA.
- On the other hand, there are **146 Foreign Nationals** who have been confirmed of having COVID-19 in the Philippines.
- Lastly, a total of **291 donations** to the DOH were facilitated by the Donations Team from both foreign and local donors. The team is currently facilitating 68 foreign donations and 24 local donations, while no transaction is on hold.

TREATMENT

For case management of COVID-19 patients, healthcare providers are advised to adhere to the existing <u>PSMID Guidelines</u>.

POLICY IN-FOCUS

In line with the COVID-19 pandemic situation, the Department of Health, on behalf of the Interagency Task Force for Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF-EID) and in coordination with the Presidential Communications Operations Office (PCOO), through DOH Department Memorandum No. 2020-0280, is encouraging all Filipino to take an active role in the fight against our common enemy: COVID19 (the "contrabida").

The campaign promotes the active role of individuals in the fight against COVID-19 by practicing the following behaviors simplified into 4 letters:

- B Bawal walang mask
- I I-sanitize ang mga kamay, iwas-hawak sa mga bagay
- D Dumistansya ng isang metro
- A- Alamin ang totoong impormasyon.
