




Breakdown of Active Cases




A patient with an RT-PCR confirmed case of COVID-19 without symptoms.



A patient with mild symptoms and stable vital signs. Unless the patient belongs to high-risk subgroups or has comorbidities, they are often not admitted to a treatment facility.




A patient with difficulty breathing, altered mental status, considered high-risk or in need of hospital care.




A patient with impending or ongoing respiratory failure, in need of mechanical ventilation, or with evidence of end-organ damage.

Note. A person who is classified as having a mild case of COVID-19 but is considered high-risk due to age or the presence of comorbidities must be admitted to a treatment facility. Severe or critical cases must be admitted to a treatment facility, regardless of inclusion in high-risk subgroups or presence of comorbidities.

1. Bars with dark green colors indicate the actual date of onset or date of death for cases reported from June 28 to July 4.
2. In cases where date of onset of illness is unreported, date of specimen collection was used as proxy. Cases that do not have both are not accounted for in the date of onset histogram. As of this situation report, around 10% of cases have unreported dates of specimen collection and onset of illness.
3. **Owing to delays in reporting, case counts in the gray shaded area are still most likely incomplete. Hence, we urge caution in interpreting data beyond this date.** Rest assured that the DOH continues to work tirelessly to ensure the timely reporting of accurate data.






CONFIRMED CASES BY DATE OF ONSET OF ILLNESS (DISAGGREGATED)









Reproduction number

The time-varying **reproduction number (R_t)** indicates the possible number of people being infected by a sick person, at a specific time with control measures in place.

IMPORTANT NOTE. The reproduction number is measured using symptom onset, we do not include in the interpretation the past 14-16 days given the time between symptoms, health seeking, testing, and reporting. When interpreting the reproduction number keep in mind that it is a **lagging indicator (that is, it provides a snapshot of the situation two weeks ago)**. Please do not expect this number to change daily.

- The reproduction number (R_t) was around 2 early on in the outbreak. This meant that each confirmed person with COVID was infecting 2 other people.
- Based on the latest data, we are 95 percent confident that $R_t = 1.59 \pm 0.03$, which means each infected individual was infecting an average of 1.59 other persons **around two weeks ago**.
- **Lowering this value is made possible through efforts such as social distancing, wearing of PPE, and other means to stop the spread of the virus.**
- The goal is for R_t to be less than 1, which would mean that, on average, an infected person is infecting less than one person, eventually stopping the transmission of COVID-19.







AGE AND SEX DISTRIBUTION: DEATHS





Note: The DOH is continuously validating the number of positive tests as reported by the laboratories. When necessary, they are deduplicated. **As such, the discrepancy with the number of confirmed cases do not necessarily reflect backlogs in case validation.**

This week, an average of **26,352** samples were processed each day by laboratories.

From July 19 to 25, a total of **20,161** specimens tested positive, which brings this week's positivity rate to **11.8%**. Of these, 15,505 (77%) came from labs in NCR, and 1,815 (9%) came from labs in Region VII.

In terms of positivity rates, 15.7% of individual specimens (15,505 out of 98,834) tested positive NCR labs, while 12.6% of individual specimens (1,492 out of 12,002) tested positive in Region VII.







Top Healthcare workers affected by COVID-19 as of 25 July 2020



No. of cases





BEHAVIORAL MESSAGES OF THE DAY

As of July 25, 2020

- As the country ushers into the New Normal era, minimum health standards should be observed to keep everyone safe and healthy, represented by the **BIDA** acronym:
 - B.** Bawal walang mask.
 - I.** I-sanitize ang mga kamay.
 - D.** Dumistansya ng isang metro.
 - A.** Alamin ang totoong impormasyon.
- While quarantine measures have eased out in some areas, **going outside for non-essential reasons is still discouraged**. If truly needed (such as running errands or reporting to work), **everyone is advised to observe minimum health standards**.
- The public is reminded that **gargling warm water with vinegar or salt is NOT proven to kill off the virus** that causes COVID-19. While gargling warm water can provide temporary comfort when symptoms persist, it is important to know that there is still no cure for COVID-19.
- Frequent handwashing remains one of the most essential precautions to avoid the disease**. Always bring alcohol or sanitizer when going outside, and try not to touch objects and surfaces as much as possible. If your hands are visibly soiled, wash them properly with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.
- The public is enjoined in **applauding and supporting our frontline health care workers** who have been working tirelessly to attend to COVID-19 patients all over the country.



HOW DO YOU REMAIN SAFE AND HEALTHY AMIDST THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC?

ALWAYS remember and practice the following:



Wash hands with soap and water for 20 seconds or more (Try singing the chorus of your favorite song while washing).



Use a hand sanitizer with 70% alcohol if you can't wash your hands for 20 seconds or more.



Avoid touching your face, especially your mouth, eyes, nose.



Make sure you keep 1 meter distance from other people.



Avoid touching things that many people touch like door handles, tables, chairs, etc.



Wear a mask while outside.



Frequently clean surfaces in your house, work or business. This includes tables, doorknobs, light switches, countertops, handles, desks, phones, keys, keyboards, toilets, faucets, and sinks.



Disinfect using a bleach solution (7 tablespoons [100 mL] bleach for 1 liter of clean water).



Disinfect your most used things (like phone, keys, eyeglasses, keyboard, etc.) with 70% alcohol solution.

RECENT UPDATES ON COVID-19

As of July 25, 2020

- DOH recorded **50,763 active cases**, with the majority of the patients exhibiting **mild symptoms** (45,629; 90%) while 219 patients are in critical condition (0.4%).
- DOH recorded **4,443 health care workers** positive for COVID-19. Of which, **3,456** have recovered (78%), 709 (16%) are mild cases, 240 are asymptomatic (5%), 2 in severe condition (0.2%), and 36 (0.8%) have died.
- A total of **185,662 Returning Overseas Filipinos (ROFs) have arrived** (Land-based: 91,422; Sea-based: 93,845; and Transferees from Sabah 395). Of these, 179,130 were released from facility quarantine (Land-based: 86,938; Sea-based: 91,797; and Sabah: 395). Among the ROFs, 4,091 were confirmed COVID-19 positive (Land based: 2,150; Sea-based: 1,941). Among the confirmed COVID-19 ROFs, 810 are currently admitted, 3,174 already recovered; and 2 deaths reported.
- There are now **6,002 Human Resources for Health (HRH) hired** out of the 8,810 approved slots for emergency hiring in 336 health facilities. Of these, 42.2% are hired in DOH hospitals, 16.3% in COVID-19 diagnostic facility, 14% in Temporary Treatment and Monitoring Facility, 13% in LGU and other hospitals, 5.6% in COVID-19 referral facility, 3.5% in private health facilities, 3.1% in Bureau of Quarantine managed quarantine facilities and airport units, 0.8% in Mega LIGTAS COVID-19 Centers, 0.7% in Epidemiology and Surveillance Units, 0.5% for other healthcare facilities, and 0.4% in Primary Care Facility.
- Meanwhile, a total of 312 donations to the Department of Health were facilitated by the Donations Team from both foreign and local donors. A total of 214 transactions, representing 68.59%, have already been completed. The team is currently facilitating 72 foreign donations and 26 local donations, while no transaction is on hold.

In line with the COVID-19 pandemic situation, the Department of Health, on behalf of the Interagency Task Force for Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF-EID) and in coordination with the Presidential Communications Operations Office (PCOO), is enjoining every Filipino to take an active role in the fight against COVID-19 through DOH Department Memorandum No. 2020-0280.

The campaign promotes the active role of individuals in the fight against COVID-19 by practicing the following behaviors simplified into 4 letters:

- B** - Bawal walang mask
- I** - I-sanitize ang mga kamay, iwas-hawak sa mga bagay
- D** - Dumistansya ng isang metro
- A** - Alamin ang totoong impormasyon.
