51,058 (87.1%)Mild

A patient with mild symptoms and stable vital signs. Unless the patient belongs to high-risk subgroups or has comorbidities, they are often not admitted to a treatment facility.




A patient with difficulty breathing, altered mental status, considered high-risk or in need of hospital care.




A patient with impending or ongoing respiratory failure, in need of mechanical ventilation, or with evidence of end-organ damage.

Note. A person who is classified as having a mild case of COVID-19 but is considered high-risk due to age or the presence of comorbidities must be admitted to a treatment facility. Severe or critical cases must be admitted to a treatment facility, regardless of inclusion in high-risk subgroups or presence of comorbidities.








COVID-19'S CAPACITY TO SPREAD (R. VALUE)

The time-varying **reproduction number** (R_{\star}) indicates the possible number of people being infected by a sick person, at a specific time with control measures in place.

Reproduction number

IMPORTANT NOTE. The reproduction number is measured using symptom onset, we do not include in the interpretation the past 14-16 days given the time between symptoms, health seeking, testing, and reporting. When interpreting the reproduction number keep in mind that it is a lagging indicator (that is, it provides a snapshot of the situation two weeks ago). Please do not expect this number to change daily.



- The reproduction number (R,) was around 2 early on in the outbreak. This meant that each confirmed person with COVID was infecting 2 other people.
- Based on the latest data, we are 95 percent confident that $R_{\star} = 0.91 \pm 0.02$, which means each infected individual was infecting an average of 0.91 other persons around two weeks ago.
- Lowering this value is made possible through efforts such as social distancing, wearing of PPE, and other means to stop the spread of the virus.
- The goal is for R, to be less than 1, which would mean that, on average, an infected person is infecting less than one person, eventually stopping the transmission of COVID-19.





AGE AND SEX DISTRIBUTION: CASE COUNTS




AGE AND SEX DISTRIBUTION: DEATHS





DAILY POSITIVITY RATE



This week, an average of 34,376 samples were processed each day by 130 licensed COVID-19 testing laboratories.

From 27 September to 3 October 2020, a total of 18,474 specimens tested positive, which brings this week's positivity rate to 8.2%. Of these, 1,458 (8%) came from labs in CALABARZON, and 11,018 (60%) came from labs in NCR.

In terms of positivity rates, 13.2% of individual specimens (1,458 out of 11,046) tested positive in CALABARZON labs, while 8.6% of individual specimens (11,018 out of 127,516) tested positive in NCR labs.







Philippines, as of 3 October 2020





BEHAVIORAL MESSAGES

- As the country is now under the New Normal era, minimum health standards are essential to keep everyone healthy and safe. The government is continuously reminding the people to follow simple things that would reduce exposure to COVID-19 like wearing of face masks at all times, maintain physical distancing, practice hand hygiene and proper cough manners. Do this not just for yourselves, but also for the safety of your family and the community.
- In the office or workplace settings, before entering the workplace, employees or workers should see to it that they are checked for symptoms. All should maintain physical distancing or a 1-meter distance from others, always wear face mask and face shield, practice hand hygiene, and proper cough manners. The workplace must be regularly disinfected, especially frequently used objects such as keyboards, mouse, doorknobs, etc.
- The best way to reduce the exposure from COVID-19 is staying at home. People at home should avoid smoking, be physically healthy by eating nutritious food and exercise at least 15 minutes daily to boost the immune system against the virus. When ordering food online, it is advised to order healthy food items if available and limit consumption of fatty and salty food.





HOW DO YOU REMAIN SAFE AND HEALTHY AMIDST THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC?

ALWAYS remember and practice the following:



Wash hands with soap and water for 20 seconds or more (Try singing the chorus of your favorite song while washing).



Use a hand sanitizer with 70% alcohol if you can't wash your hands for 20 seconds or more.



Avoid touching your face, especially your mouth, eyes, nose.



Make sure you keep 1 meter distance from other people.



Avoid touching things that many people touch like door handles, tables, chairs, etc.



Wear a mask while outside.



Frequently clean surfaces in your house, work or business. This includes tables, doorknobs, light switches, countertops, handles, desks, phones, keys, keyboards, toilets, faucets, and sinks.



Disinfect using a bleach solution (7 tablespoons [100 mL] bleach for 1 liter of clean water).



Disinfect your most used things (like phone, keys, eyeglasses, keyboard, etc.) with 70% alcohol solution.

RECENT UPDATES ON COVID-19

As of October 3, 2020

- DOH recorded **58,606 active cases** with the majority of the patients exhibiting **mild symptoms** (51,058; 87.1%) while **1,650 patients** are in **critical condition** (2.8%).
- DOH recorded **9,822 health care workers** positive for COVID-19. Of these, **9,100** (92.6%) have recovered, 61 (0.6%) have died and **661** (6.7%) were active cases. Of these active cases, 405 (61.3%) were mild cases, 224 (33.9%) were asymptomatic, 20 (3.0%) in severe condition and 12 in critical condition (1.8%).
- A total of 411,141 Returning Overseas Filipinos (ROFs) have arrived in the country (Land-based: 225,989; Sea-based: 183,566; and Transferees from Sabah 1,586). Of these, 407,426 were released from facility quarantine (Land-based: 223,406; Sea-based: 182,434; and Sabah: 1,586). Among the ROFs, 8,780 were confirmed COVID-19 patients (Land-based: 4,634; Sea-based: 4,146). Among these, 677 are currently admitted, 7,973 have already recovered; and 5 have died.
- A total of **314 donations** to the Department of Health were facilitated by the Donations Team from both foreign and local donors. There were 215 transactions, representing 68.47%, which have already been completed. The team is currently facilitating 73 foreign donations and 26 local donations, while no transaction is on hold.

TREATMENT

For case management of COVID-19 patients, healthcare providers are advised to adhere to the existing <u>PSMID Guidelines</u>.

POLICY IN-FOCUS

The Department of Health has issued Department Memorandum (DM) Number 2020-0405¹ "Interim Guidelines on the Tagging of Suspect, Probable, and Confirmed COVID-19 Cases", to guide contact tracing and surveillance by respective local government units to ensure that accurate, complete, and timely COVID-19 information is available to initiate action.

These guidelines aim to provide protocols on identifying and tagging cases, particularly for patients with relevant travel history, including but not limited to locally stranded individuals (LSIs) and returning overseas Filipinos (ROFs), or individuals with multiple addresses.
