A patient with mild symptoms and stable vital signs. Unless the patient belongs to high-risk subgroups or has comorbidities, they are often not admitted to a treatment facility.




A patient with difficulty breathing, altered mental status, considered high-risk or in need of hospital care.




A patient with impending or ongoing respiratory failure, in need of mechanical ventilation, or with evidence of end-organ damage.

Note. A person who is classified as having a mild case of COVID-19 but is considered high-risk due to age or the presence of comorbidities must be admitted to a treatment facility. Severe or critical cases must be admitted to a treatment facility, regardless of inclusion in high-risk subgroups or presence of comorbidities.





COVID-19'S CAPACITY TO SPREAD (R, VALUE)



The time-varying **reproduction number** (R_t) indicates the possible number of people being infected by a sick person, at a specific time with control measures in place.


IMPORTANT NOTE. The reproduction number is measured using symptom onset, we do not include in the interpretation the past 14-16 days given the time between symptoms, health seeking, testing, and reporting. When interpreting the reproduction number keep in mind that it is a **lagging indicator (that is, it provides a snapshot of the situation two weeks ago)**. Please do not expect this number to change daily.

- The reproduction number (R_t) was around 2 early on in the outbreak. This meant that each confirmed person with COVID was infecting 2 other people.
- Based on the latest data, we are 95 percent confident that $R_t = 0.89 \pm 0.02$, which means each infected individual was infecting an average of 0.89 other persons **around two weeks ago**.
- Lowering this value is made possible through efforts such as social distancing, wearing of PPE, and other means to stop the spread of the virus.
 - <u>The goal is for **R**</u> to be less than 1, which would mean that, on average, an infected person is infecting less than one person, eventually stopping the transmission of COVID-19.


AGE AND SEX DISTRIBUTION: CASE COUNTS







This week, an average of **28,293** samples were processed each day by 138 licensed COVID-19 testing laboratories.

From 18 October to 24 October 2020, a total of 13,088 specimens tested positive, which brings this week's positivity rate to 7.1%. Of these, 1,208 (9%) came from labs in Central Luzon, and 5,190 (40%) came from labs in NCR.

In terms of positivity rates, 5.9% of individual specimens (1,208 out of 20,470) tested positive in CALABARZON labs, while 6.6% of individual specimens (5,190 out of 78,796) tested positive in NCR labs.





HEALTHCARE WORKERS AFFECTED BY COVID-19 as of 24 October 2020





BEHAVIORAL MESSAGES

- To protect the lives of children from highly contagious diseases like measles, rubella, and polio which can all lead to death. The Department of Health, with support from the World Health Organization and UNICEF, will be conducting a nationwide measles, rubella, and polio supplemental immunization activity (MR-OPV SIA) campaign. Parents and guardians are encouraged to get their child vaccinated (< 5 years old) from measles, rubella, and polio. On October 26 to November 25, there will be an extensive vaccination in Regions 1, 2, MIMAROPA, CAR, 5, and whole of Mindanao for free.
- While areas in the Philippines are easing movement restrictions, a general community quarantine will still be in some places. Quarantine helps limit the spread of COVID-19, everyone should wear face masks, practice hand hygiene and proper coughing manners, and maintain a 1-meter distance from others at all times.
- In the office/workplace settings, before entering the workplace, employees/workers should see to it that they are screened for symptoms. All should maintain physical distancing or a 1-meter distance from others, always wear face masks, and practice hand hygiene and proper coughing manners.
- It is advised that you remove your shoes when you enter your house, wash your hands with soap and water, and immediately change clothes or take a bath when you return home from work. Separate dirty clothes, don't shake it to minimize the possibility of dispersing the virus through the air. Wash items with detergent and bleach, using the warmest appropriate water setting and dry items completely — both steps help kill the virus.






HOW DO YOU REMAIN SAFE AND HEALTHY AMIDST THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC?

ALWAYS remember and practice the following:



Wash hands with soap and water for 20 seconds or more (Try singing the chorus of your favorite song while washing).





Avoid touching your face, especially your mouth, eyes, nose.



Make sure you keep 1 meter distance from other people.



Avoid touching things that many people touch like door handles, tables, chairs, etc.



Wear a mask while outside.

Frequently clean surfaces in your house, work or business. This includes tables, doorknobs, light switches, countertops, handles, desks, phones, keys, keyboards, toilets, faucets, and sinks.



Disinfect using a bleach solution (7 tablespoons [100 mL] bleach for 1 liter of clean water).



Disinfect your most used things (like phone, keys, eyeglasses, keyboard, etc.) with 70% alcohol solution.

RECENT UPDATES ON COVID-19 As of October 24, 2020

- DOH recorded **47,773 active cases** with the majority of the patients exhibiting **mild symptoms** (39,980; 83.7%) while **1,494 patients** are in **critical condition** (3.1%).
- DOH recorded **10,799 health care workers** positive for COVID-19. Of these, **10,228** (94.7%) have recovered, 65 (0.6%) have died and **506** (4.7%) were active cases. Of these active cases, 292 (57.7%) were mild cases, 177 (35.0%) were asymptomatic, 26 (5.1%) in severe condition and 11 in critical condition (2.2%).
- A total of 508,078 Returning Overseas Filipinos (ROFs) have arrived in the country (Land-based: 283,407; Sea-based: 223,085; and Transferees from Sabah 1,586). Of these, 504,241 were released from facility quarantine (Land-based: 281,241; Sea-based: 221,414; and Sabah: 1,586). Among the ROFs, 9,297 were confirmed COVID-19 patients (Land-based: 5,834; Sea-based: 3,463). Among these, 194 are currently admitted, 9,095 have already recovered; and 5 have died.
- A total of **315 donations** to the Department of Health were facilitated by the Donations Team from both foreign and local donors. There were 216 transactions, representing 63.9%, which have already been completed. The team is currently facilitating 73 foreign donations and 26 local donations, while no transaction is on hold.

TREATMENT

For case management of COVID-19 patients, healthcare providers are advised to adhere to the existing <u>PSMID Guidelines</u>.

POLICY IN-FOCUS

The Department of Health has issued Department Memorandum (DM) 2020-0384¹, "Interim Guidelines on the Continuous Provision of Health Services for Senior Citizens amid COVID-19 Pandemic", to mitigate the COVID 19 impact on the provision of health services especially with immunization service and minimize the risk of COVID-19 transmission.

This interim guideline was developed to ensure senior citizens are continuously provided essential health services since they are considered highly at risk of getting COVID-19.
