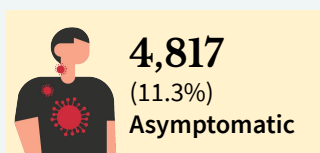

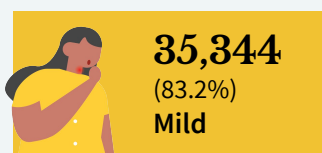

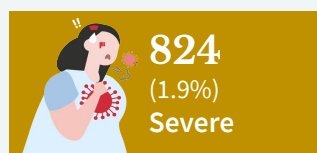
### Breakdown of Active Cases



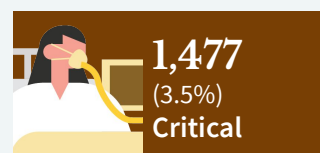
A patient with an RT-PCR confirmed case of COVID-19 without symptoms.



A patient with mild symptoms and stable vital signs. Unless the patient belongs to high-risk subgroups or has comorbidities, they are often not admitted to a treatment facility.



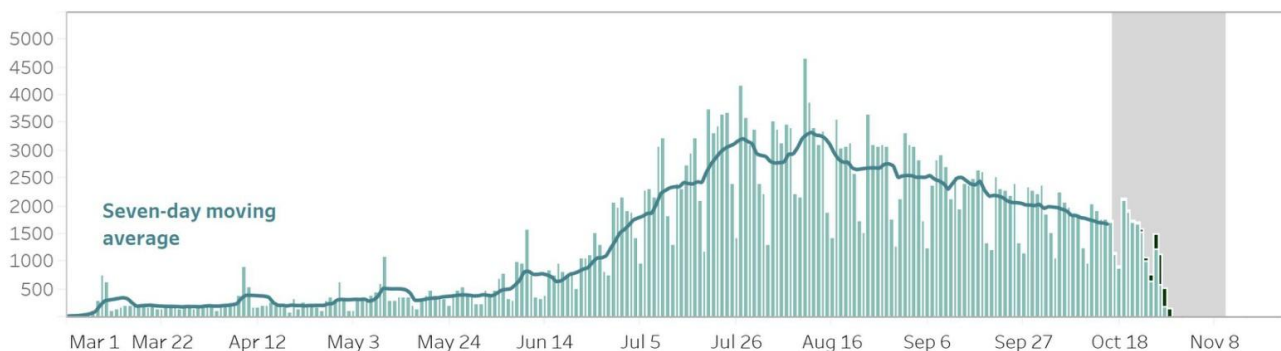
A patient with difficulty breathing, altered mental status, considered high-risk or in need of hospital care.



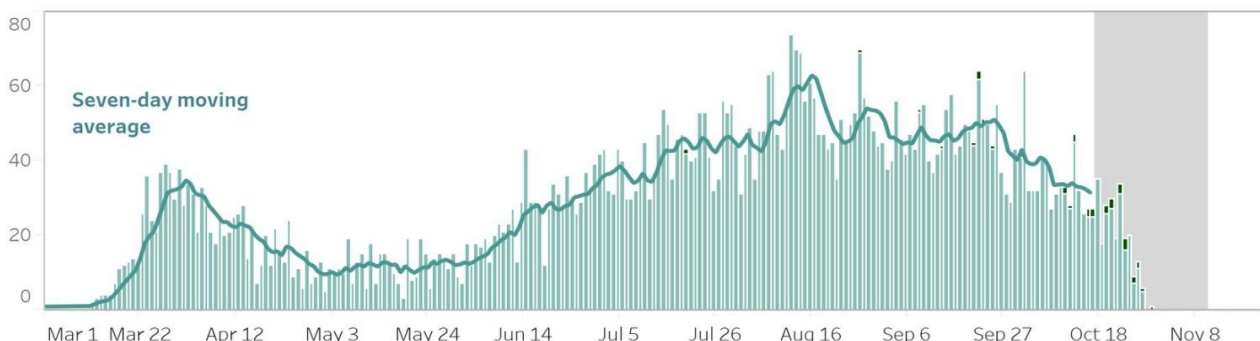
A patient with impending or ongoing respiratory failure, in need of mechanical ventilation, or with evidence of end-organ damage.

**Note.** A person who is classified as having a mild case of COVID-19 but is considered high-risk due to age or the presence of comorbidities must be admitted to a treatment facility. Severe or critical cases must be admitted to a treatment facility, regardless of inclusion in high-risk subgroups or presence of comorbidities.

1. Bars with dark green colors indicate the actual date of onset or date of death for cases reported from August 9 to August 15.
2. In cases where date of onset of illness is unreported, date of specimen collection was used as proxy. Cases that do not have both are not accounted for in the date of onset histogram. As of this situation report, around 10% of cases have unreported dates of specimen collection and onset of illness.
3. **Owing to delays in reporting, case counts in the gray shaded area are still most likely incomplete. Hence, we urge caution in interpreting data beyond this date.** Rest assured that the DOH continues to work tirelessly to ensure the timely reporting of accurate data.

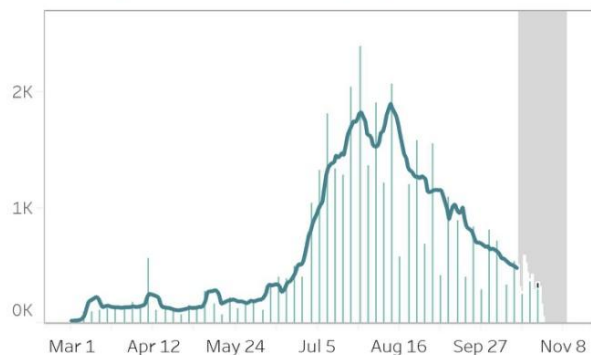

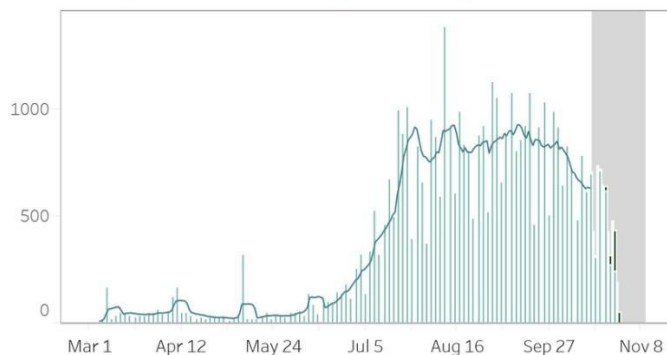

## CONFIRMED CASES BY DATE OF ONSET OF ILLNESS (DISAGGREGATED)



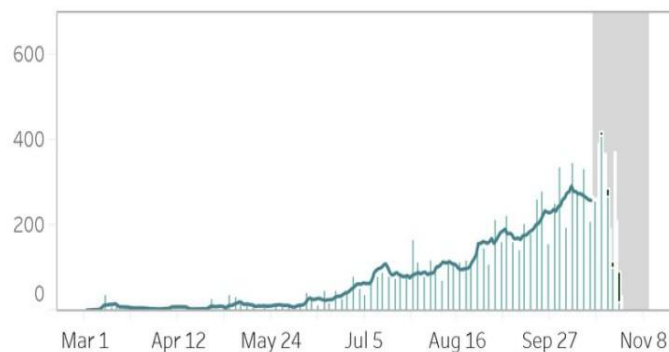

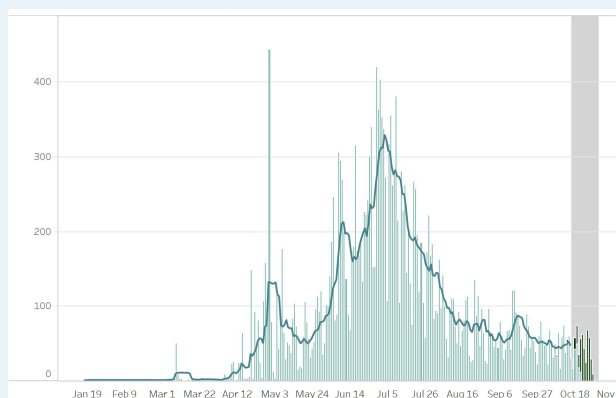

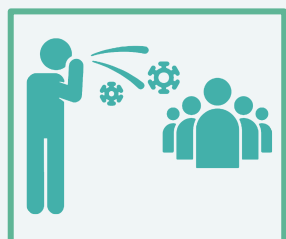

Reproduction number**



The time-varying **reproduction number ( $R_t$ )** indicates the possible number of people being infected by a sick person, at a specific time with control measures in place.

**IMPORTANT NOTE.** The reproduction number is measured using symptom onset, we do not include in the interpretation the past 14-16 days given the time between symptoms, health seeking, testing, and reporting. When interpreting the reproduction number keep in mind that it is a **lagging indicator (that is, it provides a snapshot of the situation two weeks ago)**. Please do not expect this number to change daily.

- The reproduction number ( $R_t$ ) was around 2 early on in the outbreak. This meant that each confirmed person with COVID was infecting 2 other people.
- Based on the latest data, we are 95 percent confident that  $R_t = 0.97 \pm 0.02$ , which means each infected individual was infecting an average of 0.97 other persons **around two weeks ago**.
- **Lowering this value is made possible through efforts such as social distancing, wearing of PPE, and other means to stop the spread of the virus.**
- The goal is for  $R_t$  to be less than 1, which would mean that, on average, an infected person is infecting less than one person, eventually stopping the transmission of COVID-19.

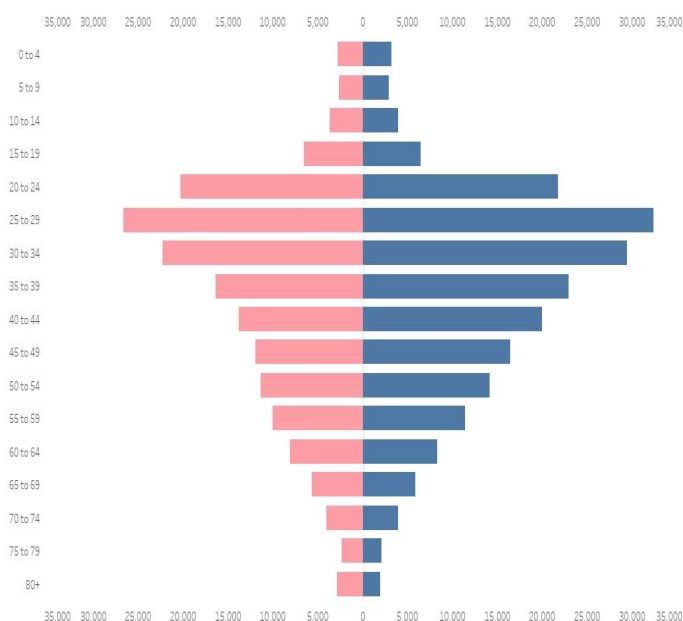

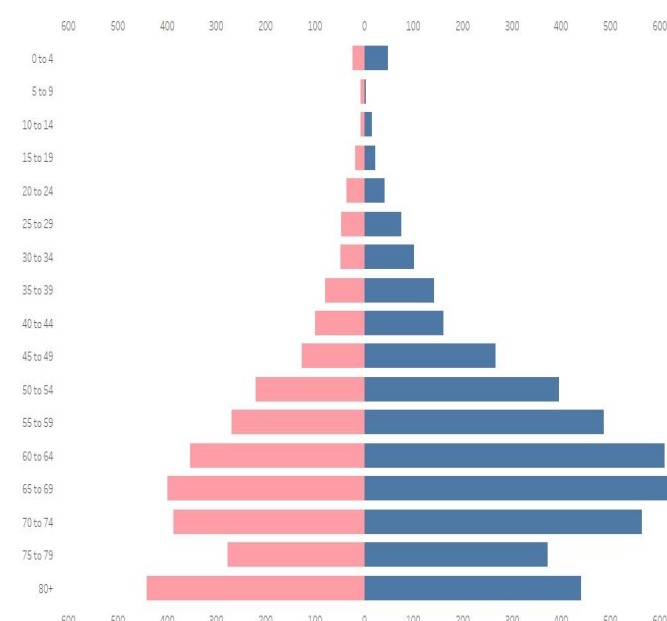

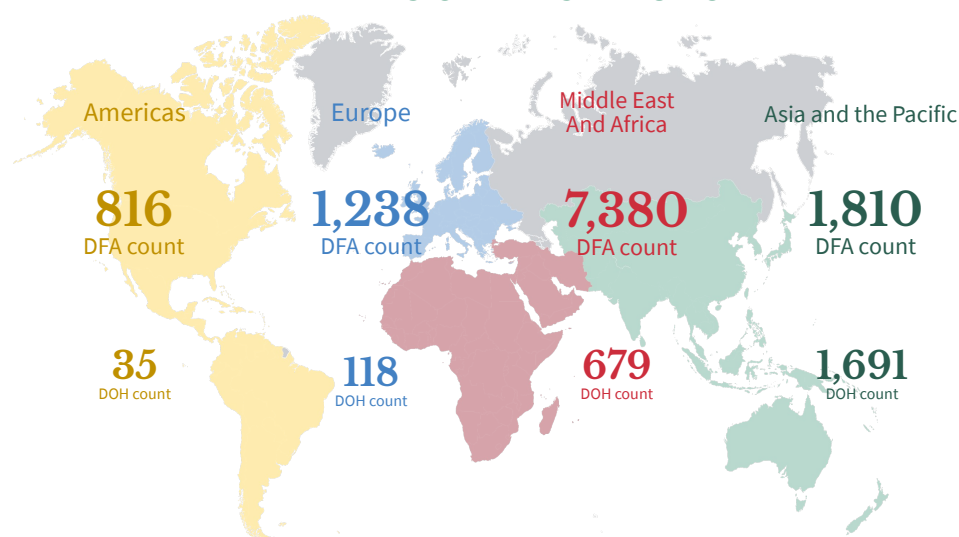

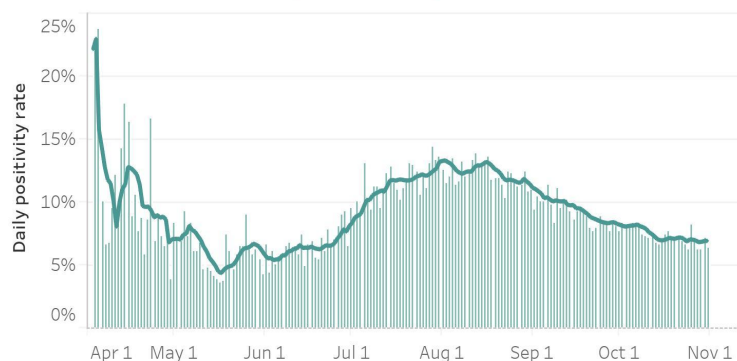

## DAILY POSITIVITY RATE



This week, an average of **30,095** samples were processed each day by 140 licensed COVID-19 testing laboratories.

From 25 October to 31 October 2020, a total of 13,704 specimens tested positive, which brings this week's positivity rate to 6.9%. Of these, 1,207 (9%) came from labs in Central Luzon, and 5,453 (40%) came from labs in NCR.

In terms of positivity rates, 6.6% of individual specimens (1,207 out of 18,397) tested positive in Central Luzon labs, while 6.0% of individual specimens (5,453 out of 91,389) tested positive in NCR labs.

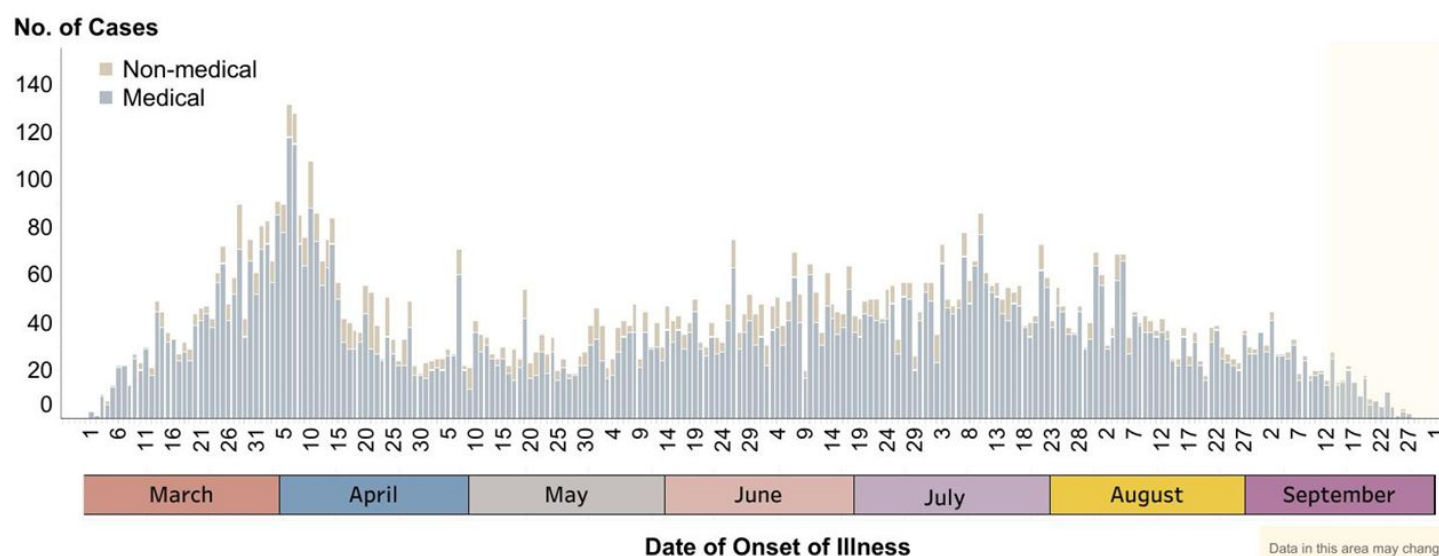

## BEHAVIORAL MESSAGES

- While we are amid the COVID-19 pandemic, it is more essential for us to be prepared on any natural disaster that may happen. Everyone is encouraged to be ready this rainy season. Every family should: check if there is anything to be repaired in their home; have an emergency bag and first aid kit; store clean drinking water and non-perishable food; plan and prepare for evacuation when needed; ensure that there are enough medication for fever, diarrhea, and maintenance drugs for the elders; secure their pets; charge their cell phones, other gadgets, and prepare extra batteries for radio; and listen to the news and advise of the government.
- Whether at home or in an evacuation center, everyone should protect themselves and others from COVID-19. Local governments are also encouraged to maintain the minimum public health standards regarding COVID-19 in evacuation centers and facilities, such as wearing of face masks, physical distancing, and designating handwashing areas.
- In situations of extreme stress, one can expect not to feel okay. Talking or venting feelings to somebody you trust helps overcome negative feelings due to stress. Talking with a mental health professional is okay. People should not be afraid of feeling judged and stigmatized for doing so.

## HOW DO YOU REMAIN SAFE AND HEALTHY AMIDST THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC?

ALWAYS remember and practice the following:



Wash hands with soap and water for 20 seconds or more (Try singing the chorus of your favorite song while washing).



Use a hand sanitizer with 70% alcohol if you can't wash your hands for 20 seconds or more.



Avoid touching your face, especially your mouth, eyes, nose.



Make sure you keep 1 meter distance from other people.



Avoid touching things that many people touch like door handles, tables, chairs, etc.



Wear a mask while outside.



Frequently clean surfaces in your house, work or business. This includes tables, doorknobs, light switches, countertops, handles, desks, phones, keys, keyboards, toilets, faucets, and sinks.



Disinfect using a bleach solution (7 tablespoons [100 mL] bleach for 1 liter of clean water).



Disinfect your most used things (like phone, keys, eyeglasses, keyboard, etc.) with 70% alcohol solution.

## RECENT UPDATES ON COVID-19

As of October 31, 2020

- DOH recorded **42,462 active cases** with the majority of the patients exhibiting **mild symptoms** (35,344; 83.2%) while **1,477 patients** are in **critical condition** (3.5%).
- DOH recorded **11,175 health care workers** positive for COVID-19. Of these, **10,652** (95.3%) have recovered, 69 (0.6%) have died and **454** (4.1%) were active cases. Of these active cases, 228 (50.2%) were mild cases, 193 (42.5%) were asymptomatic, 22 (4.8%) in severe condition and 11 in critical condition (2.4%).
- A total of **530,514 Returning Overseas Filipinos (ROFs)** have arrived in the country (Land-based: 296,884; Sea-based: 232,044; and Transferees from Sabah 1,586). Of these, **526,677 were released from facility quarantine** (Land-based: 294,718; Sea-based: 230,373; and Sabah: 1,586). Among the ROFs, **9,430 were confirmed COVID-19 patients** (Land-based: 5,917; Sea-based: 3,513). Among these, 165 are currently admitted, 9,296 have already recovered; and 5 have died.
- A total of **315 donations** to the Department of Health were facilitated by the Donations Team from both foreign and local donors. There were 216 transactions, representing 63.9%, which have already been completed. The team is currently facilitating 73 foreign donations and 26 local donations, while no transaction is on hold.
- As of October 23, 2020, the utilization of the DOH Managed Funds for COVID-19 is at Php 47.40 billion (87.32 percent) of the total managed cash of Php 54.28 billion. Majority of the total managed cash utilized or Php 23.64 billion (43.56 percent) is allocated for case management related commodities such as PPEs, masks, and medication, and is followed by laboratory related commodities at Php 16.097 billion (29.66 percent).

## POLICY IN-FOCUS

The Department of Health has issued Department Memorandum (DM) Number 2020 – 0457<sup>1</sup> “Interim Guidelines on the Delivery of Routine Lymphatic Filariasis Mass Drug Administration under the National Filariasis Elimination Program (NFEP) during the COVID-19 Pandemic”, to safeguard the health of the marginalized and vulnerable groups like children and indigenous communities from Lymphatic Filariasis.

This interim guideline is issued to give guidance to all health facilities, national government agencies and local government units involved on the conduct of Mass Drug Administration (MDA), Selective Treatment of positive case, Sentinel and Spot Check Surveys including Transmission Assessment Surveys (TAS), and vector control. Units involved in the provision of LF and NTD services including surveillance mechanisms, health promotion, behavior change and education opportunities to support implementation of NTD and COVID 19 measures are also included as appropriate in the affected communities and municipalities.

This interim guideline also follows the minimum public health standards as per DOH Administrative Order No. 2020-0015 Re: Guidelines on the Risk-Based Public Health Standards for COVID-19 Mitigation for Public Places.
