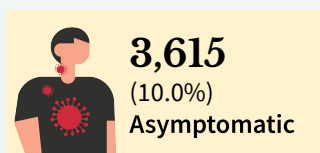

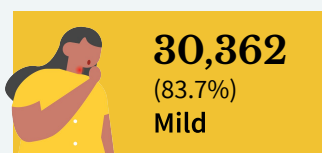

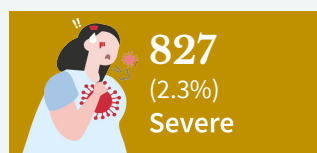
### Breakdown of Active Cases



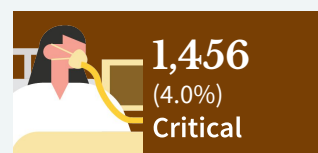
A patient with an RT-PCR confirmed case of COVID-19 without symptoms.



A patient with mild symptoms and stable vital signs. Unless the patient belongs to high-risk subgroups or has comorbidities, they are often not admitted to a treatment facility.



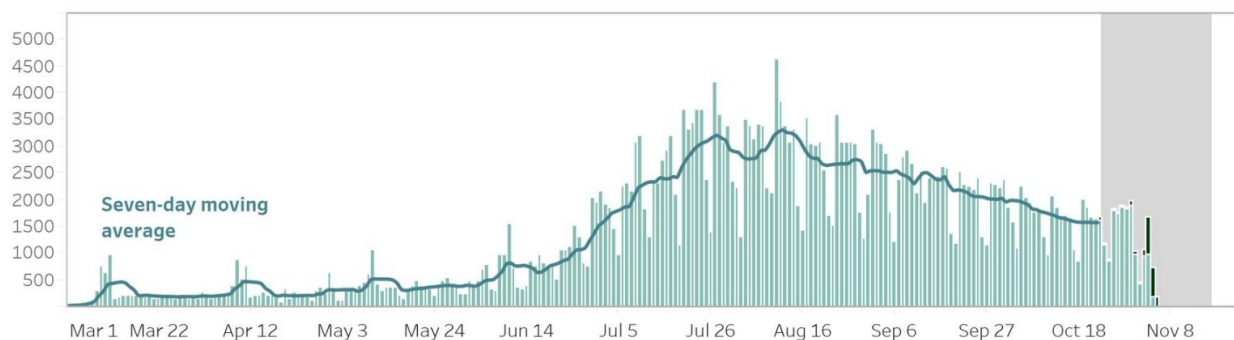
A patient with difficulty breathing, altered mental status, considered high-risk or in need of hospital care.



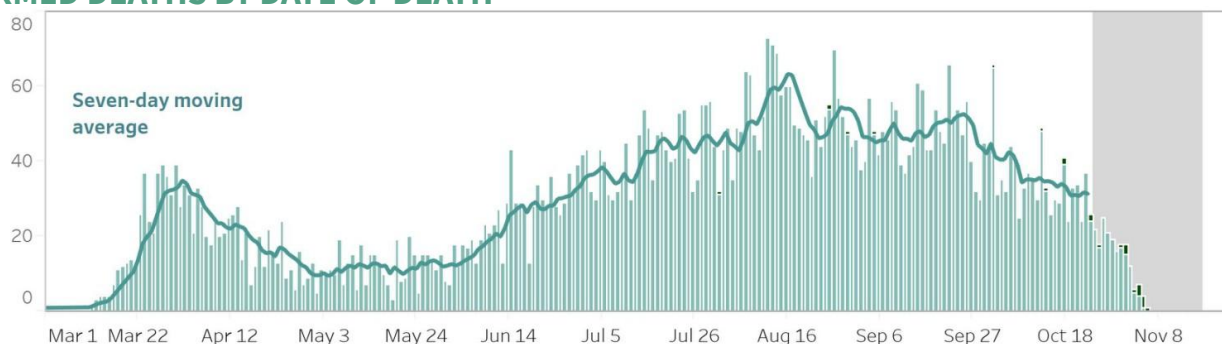
A patient with impending or ongoing respiratory failure, in need of mechanical ventilation, or with evidence of end-organ damage.

**Note.** A person who is classified as having a mild case of COVID-19 but is considered high-risk due to age or the presence of comorbidities must be admitted to a treatment facility. Severe or critical cases must be admitted to a treatment facility, regardless of inclusion in high-risk subgroups or presence of comorbidities.

1. Bars with dark green colors indicate the actual date of onset or date of death for cases reported from August 9 to August 15.
2. In cases where date of onset of illness is unreported, date of specimen collection was used as proxy. Cases that do not have both are not accounted for in the date of onset histogram. As of this situation report, around 10% of cases have unreported dates of specimen collection and onset of illness.
3. **Owing to delays in reporting, case counts in the gray shaded area are still most likely incomplete. Hence, we urge caution in interpreting data beyond this date.** Rest assured that the DOH continues to work tirelessly to ensure the timely reporting of accurate data.

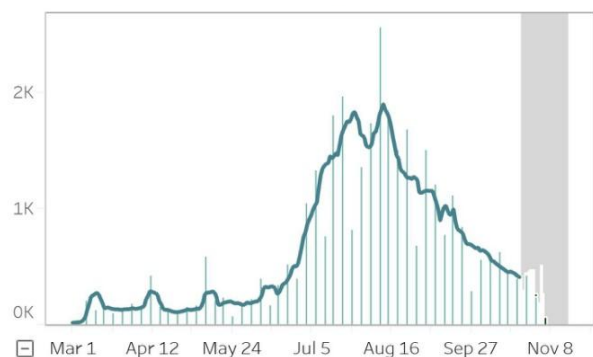

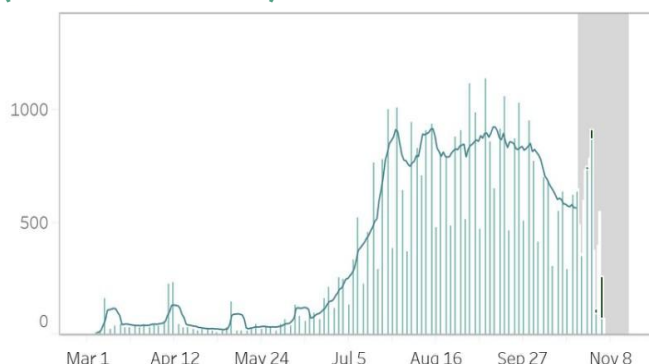

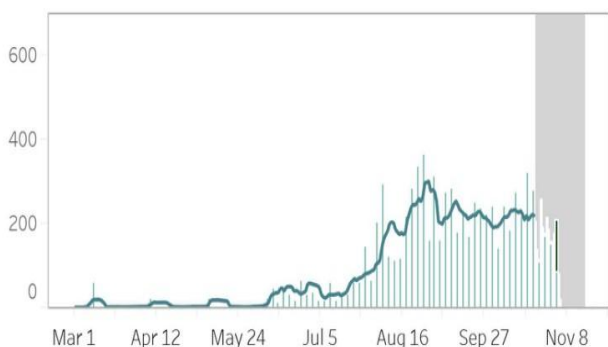
## CONFIRMED CASES BY DATE OF ONSET OF ILLNESS (DISAGGREGATED)



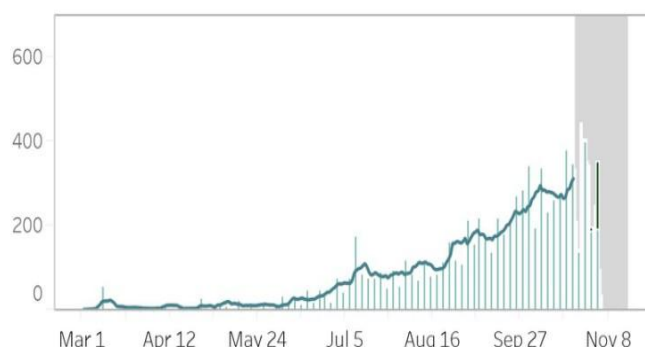

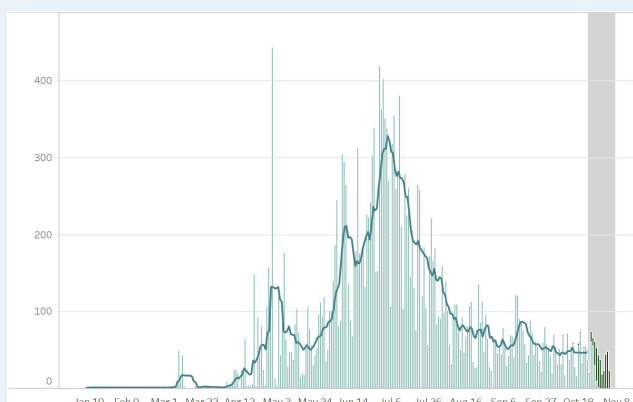

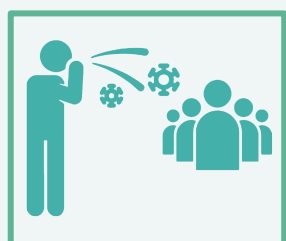

Reproduction number**



The time-varying **reproduction number ( $R_t$ )** indicates the possible number of people being infected by a sick person, at a specific time with control measures in place.

**IMPORTANT NOTE.** The reproduction number is measured using symptom onset, we do not include in the interpretation the past 14-16 days given the time between symptoms, health seeking, testing, and reporting. When interpreting the reproduction number keep in mind that it is a **lagging indicator (that is, it provides a snapshot of the situation two weeks ago)**. Please do not expect this number to change daily.

- The reproduction number ( $R_t$ ) was around 2 early on in the outbreak. This meant that each confirmed person with COVID was infecting 2 other people.
- Based on the latest data, we are 95 percent confident that  $R_t = 0.93 \pm 0.02$ , which means each infected individual was infecting an average of 0.93 other persons **around two weeks ago**.
- **Lowering this value is made possible through efforts such as social distancing, wearing of PPE, and other means to stop the spread of the virus.**
- The goal is for  $R_t$  to be less than 1, which would mean that, on average, an infected person is infecting less than one person, eventually stopping the transmission of COVID-19.

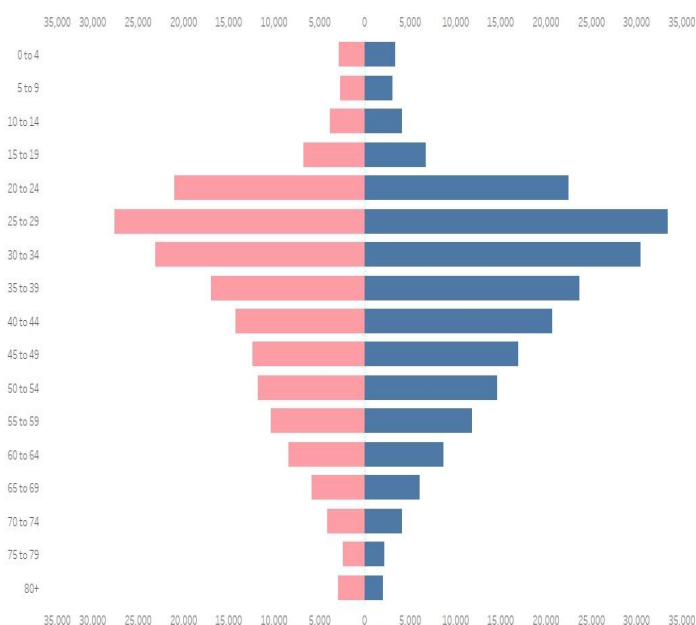

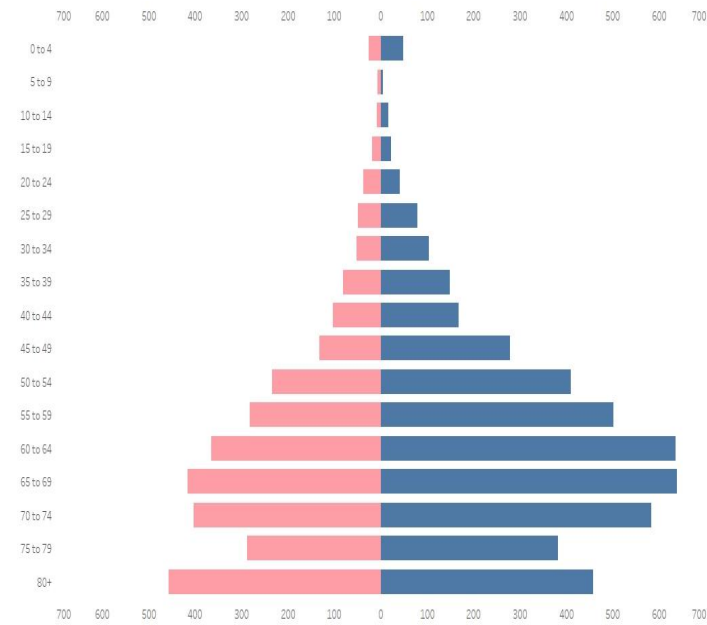

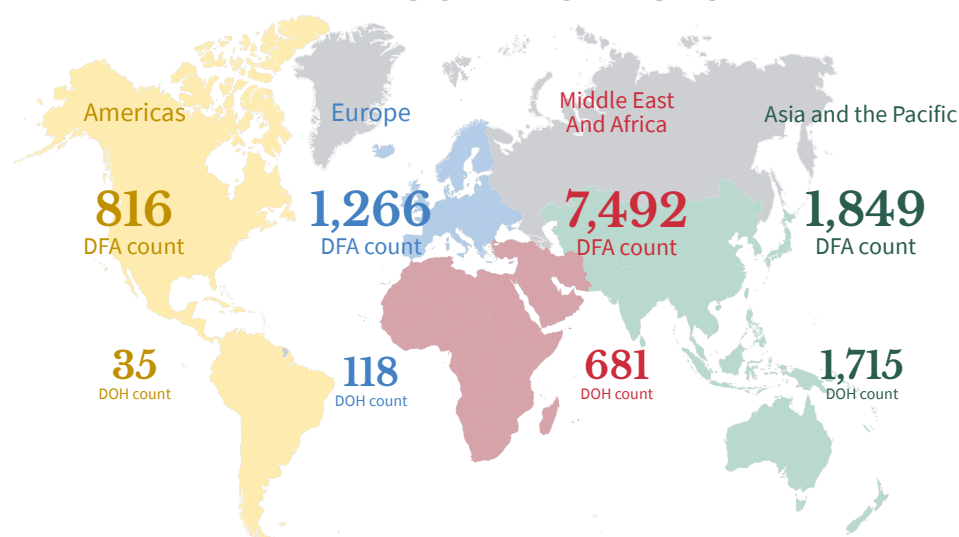

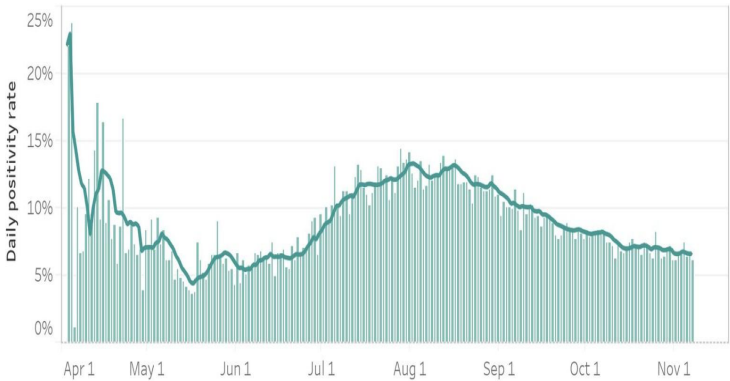

DAILY POSITIVITY RATE



This week, an average of **29,887** samples were processed each day by 149 licensed COVID-19 testing laboratories.

From 1 November to 7 November 2020, a total of 12,544 specimens tested positive, which brings this week's positivity rate to 6.6%. Of these, 1,158 (9%) came from labs in Central Luzon, and 5,386 (43%) came from labs in NCR.

In terms of positivity rates, 6.8% of individual specimens (1,158 out of 16,927) tested positive in Central Luzon labs, while 5.5% of individual specimens (5,386 out of 98,569) tested positive in NCR labs.

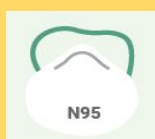

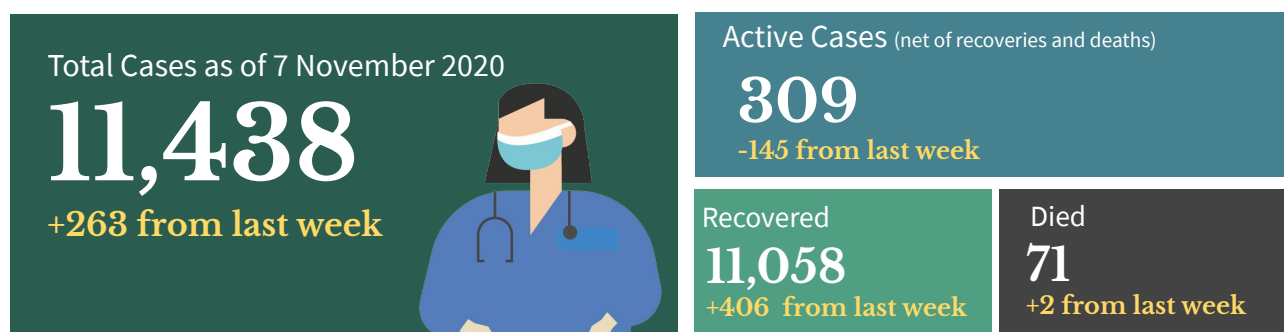

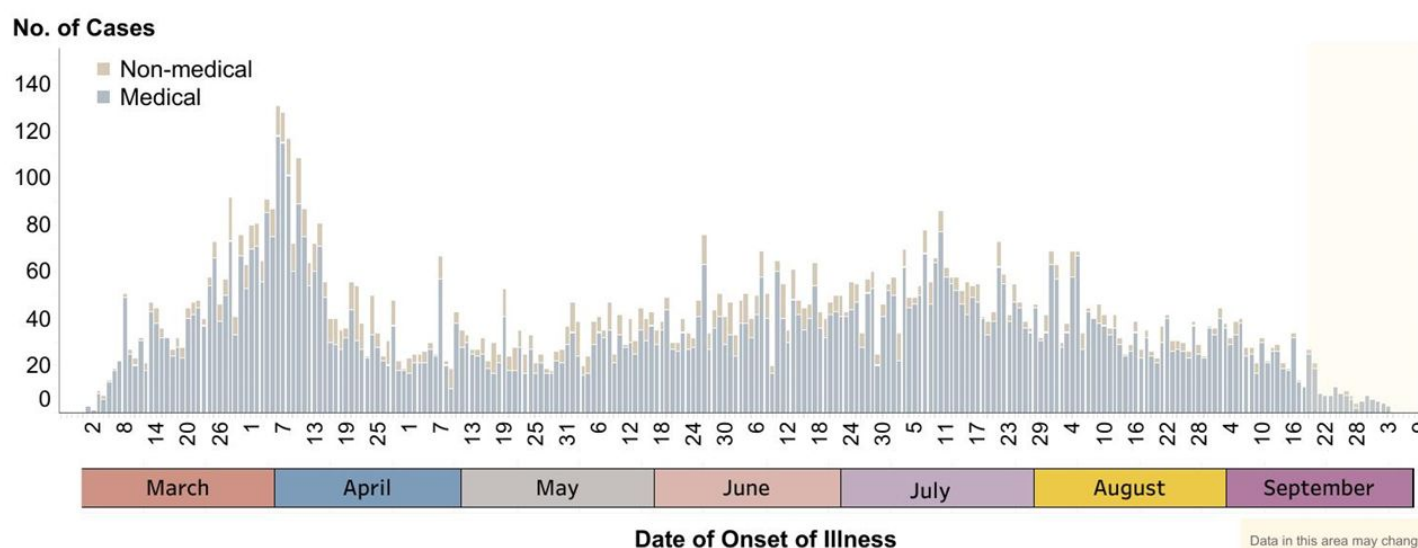

## BEHAVIORAL MESSAGES

- Household members should educate themselves about COVID-19 symptoms and preventing the spread of COVID-19 in homes. Practice routine cleaning of frequently touched surfaces like tables, doorknobs, light switches, handles, desks, toilets, faucets, sinks, coins, cellphones, etc., with household cleaners that are appropriate for the surface.
- Adults of any age with certain underlying medical conditions like hypertension and diabetes are at increased risk for severe illness from the virus that causes COVID-19. Severe illness from COVID-19 is defined as hospitalization, admission to the ICU, intubation or mechanical ventilation, or death. The best way to protect yourself and to help reduce the spread of the virus that causes COVID-19 is to limit your interactions with other people as much as possible. Take precautions to prevent getting COVID-19 when you do interact with others. Remember the importance of staying physically active and practicing healthy habits to cope with stress.
- Minimum health standards are essential to keep everyone healthy and safe, with more public transportation will already be available. Commuters are advised to maintain physical distancing inside the vehicle and report overcrowding to the Department of Transportation. Travelers should wear face masks at all times, practice hand hygiene and proper coughing manners. Those who have illnesses are discouraged from commuting to avoid possible spread of disease. ## HOW DO YOU REMAIN SAFE AND HEALTHY AMIDST THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC?

ALWAYS remember and practice the following:



Wash hands with soap and water for 20 seconds or more (Try singing the chorus of your favorite song while washing).



Use a hand sanitizer with 70% alcohol if you can't wash your hands for 20 seconds or more.



Avoid touching your face, especially your mouth, eyes, nose.



Make sure you keep 1 meter distance from other people.



Avoid touching things that many people touch like door handles, tables, chairs, etc.



Wear a mask while outside.



Frequently clean surfaces in your house, work or business. This includes tables, doorknobs, light switches, countertops, handles, desks, phones, keys, keyboards, toilets, faucets, and sinks.



Disinfect using a bleach solution (7 tablespoons [100 mL] bleach for 1 liter of clean water).



Disinfect your most used things (like phone, keys, eyeglasses, keyboard, etc.) with 70% alcohol solution.

## RECENT UPDATES ON COVID-19

As of November 7, 2020

- DOH recorded **36,260 active cases** with the majority of the patients exhibiting **mild symptoms** (30,362; 83.7%) while **1,456 patients** are in **critical condition** (4.0%).
- DOH recorded **11,438 health care workers** positive for COVID-19. Of these, **11,058** (96.7%) have recovered, 71 (0.6%) have died and 309 (2.7%) were active cases. Of these active cases, 149 (48.2%) were mild cases, 129 (41.7%) were asymptomatic, 20 (6.5%) in severe condition and 11 in critical condition (3.6%).
- A total of **564,248 Returning Overseas Filipinos (ROFs)** have arrived in the country (Land-based: 318,992; Sea-based: 243,670; and Transferees from Sabah 1,586). Of these, **560,352 were released from facility quarantine** (Land-based: 316,839; Sea-based: 241,927; and Sabah: 1,586). Among the ROFs, **9,874 were confirmed COVID-19 patients** (Land-based: 6,197; Sea-based: 3,677). Among these, 368 are currently admitted, 9,390 have already recovered; and 5 have died.
- A total of **315 donations** to the Department of Health were facilitated by the Donations Team from both foreign and local donors. There were 216 transactions, representing 63.9%, which have already been completed. The team is currently facilitating 73 foreign donations and 26 local donations, while no transaction is on hold.

## POLICY IN-FOCUS

The Department of Health has issued Department Memorandum (DM) No. 2020 – 0186-A<sup>1</sup>, Amendment to the Department Memorandum No. 2020-0186 entitled “Interim Guidelines on the Operations of Converted Public and Private Spaces into Temporary Treatment and Monitoring Facilities (TTMFs) for COVID-19”, to provide guidance on the operations of all TTMEF's established as a strategy to manage the surge of COVID-19 Cases and enhance the response for COVID-19 care.

This interim guideline was issued to include the recent updates on the clinical practice guidelines for the management of COVID19 cases in different contexts, and align the current guidelines in terms of the day to day operations of TTMFs.
